



ORIENTATION COURSE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA TO PARTICIPANTS OF PPRA XLIV

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR Muladi, S.H gave a Report to the President of the Republic of Indonesia regarding seminar results of the Regular Education Program (PPRA) Batch XLIV on October 12, 2010 at the State Palace. In his welcoming speech, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., also conveyed that one of functions of Lemhannas RI is to serve as a place in which national leader cadres are prepared. Currently, PPRA XLIV program has already lasted for 9.5 months and it nears its closing. During the course of education, the participants of PPRA have carried out main activities namely: remote learning through e-learning and off-campus program for 3.5 months, and on-campus learning for 6 months consisting of Domestic Strategic Study (SSDN), Foreign Strategic Study (SSLN), Optional Program to some Ministries, National Management System Process, Writing and Presentation of Individual Working Paper, as well as Seminar with the theme of "Mastery, Utilization, and Advancement of Science and Technology in the framework of National Resilience".

The President of the Republic of Indonesia, DR. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, in providing orientation course to participants of PPRA XLIV Lemhannas RI also expressed his appreciation for the Seminar of "Strategic Industrial Revitalization for National Development in the framework of National Resilience" that had been conducted in line with the most recent National Development. The National industrial development is aimed at improving industrial competitiveness with a healthy, fair and sustainable structure as well as ability to strengthen national defense. The main challenge encountered by strategic industry currently is the decreased tendency of industrial competitiveness in international market, caused by high cost of energy, high-cost economy, smuggling, as well as inadequate bureaucratic service. The other challenge is structural weakness of industrial sector itself. In this respect, government assistance will be required to revitalize strategic industry by taking into account the previous strategic industrial failure.

OPENING OF NATIONAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM PROCESS OF PPRA XLIV

On September 21, 2010, at 08.00–09.30AM in Dwiwarna Purwa building. The Vice Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, Air Marshal DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb opened the National Management System Process (Olah Sismennas) of PPRA XLIV 2010.

In the welcoming remarks of the Governor of Lemhannas which was read out by the Vice Governor, it was stated that the National Management System Process is a learning method developed in Lemhannas using simulation. This method gives an opportunity to participants to apply more the science and knowledge that have been obtained previously in class or field by trying to practice them in the form of government employees work simulation.

The National Management System Process of PPRA XLIV adopts the theme "Inter-Sectoral Coordination of Government Employees in the Framework of Mastery, Utilization and Advancement of Science and Technology. only relying on natural assets, but also mastery of reliable technology created by human resources of the nation.

By mastery of technology, any region can develop, increase and resolve any issue in national development for people's prosperity. To that end, policy integrity capability of national level leaders will be required. In the Technology Development of Indonesia that will support economic growth, it is necessary to build a deep understanding about nationalism values for the development and utilization of technology to leaders of all levels.

Therefore, the participants of PPRA XLIV of Lemhannas RI as national leader cadres are expected, through the Sismennas, to be able to instill the importance of stabilizing inter-sectoral coordination, to create integrity of planning, implementation and supervision. Furthermore, the participants are expected to be able to come up with bright ideas in the framework of mastery, utilization and advancement of Science and Technology.

In September 20, 2010, at 10.00 AM, the Governor of Lemhannas RI and his delegation visited Rand Corporation in the United States, and was welcomed by DR. Robin Meili, Director of International Program in Rand Corporation. The meeting lasted for one hour discussing anything related to activity and history of Rand Corporation.

Since 1950s, Rand Corporation, which is located in Santa Monica, has played an important role in defining military strategy of the United States of America. Its most significant contribution is seen in nuclear deterrence through Mutually Assured Destruction (MAD).

Rand Corporation was established as a non-profit global policy think tank organization trying to advance scientific, education and charitable interest for prosperity and security of the public of the United States of

America. Its mission is to assist in correcting policy and decision making through research and analysis using its core values in terms of quality and objectivity.

At 14.00 pm, the Governor of Lemhannas RI and delegation made a courtesy call to the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), the United States of America, and was welcomed by Prof. Randal Johnson.

UCLA is a public research university duly established in 1919 and being the second oldest campus out of 10 campuses affiliated to the system of the University of California. UCLA offered 300 undergraduate and graduate program in various disciplines and received around 26,000 undergraduate students and 11,000 graduate students annually from the United States of America and throughout the world.

UCLA is consistently in the top rank within academic and university

ranking, and included into top ten ranking for schools in the United States of America earning the largest number of faculty award.

On September 21, 2010 at 11.30 am, the Governor of Lemhannas RI and delegation made a courtesy call to the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS) in Monterey, USA, and was welcomed by DR. James Wirtz. After Lunch in NPS, the activity was continued with discussion session with staff and students of NPS with the topic "democracy and national resilience".

NPS is accredited research university run by the Navy of the United States of America and offers master and doctoral program. NPS students are mostly active duty officers from all military branches of the United States of America. Nonetheless, the civil society can also register in NPS for various study programs.

RESPONSE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF CYBER INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

On September 23, 2010 at 08.30 AM in Trigatra Building, Floor I Lemhannas RI, a roundtable discussion was convened with the theme “response to the development of cyber information technology to prevent moral degradation of the nation generation in materializing cultured social life”.

The information technology development has created many changes in social life at present. Therefore, the information technology empowerment should definitely be made to anticipate global challenge which is getting more competitive. However, otherwise, if it has not yet been balanced with system development, it would hinder the information technology utilization effort which could further result in threats from opposing party in committing illegal access to certain information, such as: modification, deletion, insertion, substitution, interception, forgery and so on.

If they are not appropriately handled, then it is possible that the effort of increasing the information technology utilization will not run optimally. It would affect the young generation by the availability of a large number of sites causing moral decadency, degradation of social norms and values in society and increase of criminality.

In his keynote speech, the Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Marshal DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb, stated the necessity of government role in saving morality of young generation and applying strict law enforcement to overcome the misuse of information technology as well as to implement the conception to develop awareness of young generation in order to be able to master and utilize information technology as optimum as possible for positive purposes and encourage the young generation as knowledge-based society to increase knowledge of people and mastery of science and technology. STRENGTHENING OF GOVERNOR ROLE AS GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE IN REGION TO SUPPORT NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Panel discussion of politic sector convened on September 29, 2010 in Astagatra Building, Floor III West, was opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., which was also attended by the Minister of Home Affairs, Gamawan Fauzi, S.H., MM, the Governor of North Sulawesi, Drs. Sinyo H. Sarundajang, as well as other Lemhannas Officials.

As a consequence of the unitary state, it is indeed impossible to decentralize all government authorities and grant autonomy. The implementation of de-concentration principle is put on provincial territory in its position as administrative area to implement government authority as delegated to governor as government representative in provincial area to facilitate and make efficient scope of control of implementation of government's task and function including in development and supervision of government

administration in district and municipality.

The strengthening of the role and function is aimed at strengthening inter-government level relation. Relation between governor and district head/mayor is hierarchical in nature. The governor may exercise his/her development and supervision role over the provincial government administration, as well as strengthen orientation of area development and minimize impact of decentralization policy toward spatial, social, and economic fragmentation in region.

Reposition of role and function of governor as representative of central government in region is by reconnecting hierarchy between province and district/municipality. Law should give a set of instrument to governor to actively perform his/her function as representative of central government. This thought is in line with the spirit of regional autonomy to decrease the role of central government in the regional government administration by entrusting the governor to do coordination, supervision and development tasks over the district and municipality in his/her area.

In his keynote speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the strengthening of governor role as representative of government in region can expectedly encourage competition among political actors because they are the most important part in cultured democratic system process. The significance of the said matters confirms that the quality government system should go through certain mechanism thereby being able to encourage synergy of central and provincial government that will support national development.

STABILIZATION OF STATE VALUES FOR MANAGEMENT OF BP MIGAS AND CONTRACTORS OF COOPERATION CONTRACT

Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Marshal DR. Upstream Oil and Gas Supervisory Agency (BP Migas) as institution entrusted by the Government to manage natural assets of Indonesia, plays a strategic role in giving contribution for state revenue to finance development in the interest of security and prosperity of the Indonesian people. Stabilization of state values for Management of BP Migas and Contractors of Cooperation Contract as well as stakeholders of BP Migas, is the real effort to do transformation of leadership attitude and morality in line with demand for good governance and clean government, so that they are able to manage natural assets of Indonesia, and

are able to integrate the interest of central, and regional government by objective orientation for prosperity of all the Indonesian people.

The production of source of natural assets will, in terms of petroleum already exploited and explored, gradually be decreased and even used up. The laws of the Republic of Indonesia No.30 of 2007 and No.22 of 2001 provide that energy will be managed to the extent possible for people's prosperity. In real, in the management of national energy (as contained in Regulation of President No.5 of 2006 regarding national energy policy) requiring utilization of petroleum to be less than 20%, natural gas more than 30%, coal more than 33%, biofuel more than 5% , geothermal more than 5%. Meanwhile, new energy and other renewed energy, particularly, particularly biomass, nuclear, water, solar energy, wind to be more than 5% as well as liquefied coal to be more than 2%.

In the end of his welcoming remarks, the Vice Governor appeals us to perform "Green Economy" relating to petroleum issue, provision of food, and water source management for life. The state has moral responsibility to build "mindset" of all state components to abandon the use of petroleum, gas, and coal energy.
