Pancasila Ideology Should be Applied by the State and National Components

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA, officially opened the Roundtable Discussion themed “Conception of the Implementation of Pancasila Ideology in Order to Achieve People’s Prosperity for National Resilience” at the Kresna Room, Astragatra Building, 4th Floor, on Tuesday (28/4).

Budi Susilo Soepandji put forth that Pancasila was a basic concept that would remain relevant over time despite the changing circumstances, adding that it was a reflection of the Indonesia’s goals in achieving people’s prosperity and equity. “Therefore, Pancasila as an ideology must be understood, applied, and taught to the succeeding generations,” said Budi Susilo Soepandji in his opening remarks.

The event moderated by Police Brig. Gen. Drs. Daud Sihombing, S.H. featured five resource persons, namely Director General for Social Protection from the Ministry of Social Affairs Dr. Ir. Andi Zaenal Abidin Dulung, Secretary General from the Ministry of Agriculture Ir. Hari Priyono, M.Si., Expert Staff for Inter-Institutional Relations from the Ministry of Manpower and Transmigration Sunarno, SH, MH., Acting Director General for National and Political Unity from the Ministry of Home Affairs Drs. Indro Baskoro, M.Si. and Legal Researcher in the Constitutional Court Fajar L. Soeroso, S. Sos, MH.

In his presentation, Andy conveyed that social responsibilities had to be fulfilled by people based on caring and solidarity.

Meanwhile, according to Hari Priyono, the agricultural sector played a critical role in achieving people’s prosperity, however,

there needed to be government’s supports in the form of land allocation, infrastructure provision, incentives, and favorable regulations.

On the other hand, Indro Baskoro argued that Pancasila would generate social capital for Indonesia as the values contained in Pancasila, such as mutual respect, cooperation, social solidarity, willingness to sacrifice and nationalism, would drive and develop togetherness.

Some efforts, as highlighted by Sunarno, needed to be made in order to improve the quality of Indonesian human resources, especially its workforce, by revitalizing the roles of the public vocational training centers and properly managing the Indonesian workers abroad.

In terms of legal reform, Fajar L. Soeroso said that, thus far, the commitment to implement the Pancasila values was still weak and far from what was expected.

The event was also attended by Deputy Governor Vice Admiral Dudit Herdiawan, MPA, MBA, Deputy for the Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marsono, M. Agr., Deputy for the Education of National-Level Leaders Maj. Gen. Nasir Madjid, Primary Panelists comprising of Senior Analyst in International Relations and Diplomacy Air Vice Marshal Ir. Beng Tardjani, M.Sc., Professional Expert in National Resilience Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Lumban Sianipar, S.I.P., and Senior Lecturer in Economic Affairs Prof. Dr. H. Didin S. Damanhuri, S.E., Ms. DEA as well as other Lemhannas RI faculty members.

Sovereignty, Sustainability and Prosperity Required to Become Maritime Country



A roundtable discussion themed “Revitalization of Shipbuilding Industry in Order to Improve the Nation’s Self-Reliance for National Resilience” was officially opened by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Vice Admiral Didit Herdiawan, MPA, MBA at Kresna Room, Astagatra Building, 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI, on Thursday (30/4).

In his speech, which was read out by Didit Herdiawan, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that in the perspective of Lemhannas RI, the revitalization of shipbuilding industry must be based on the spirit of mutual cooperation, which was the distinctive characteristics and identity of Indonesia. “We have to get rid of egoism and sectoral interests so that the national power potentials can work in synergy, generating favorable policies for robust shipbuilding industry.

The event moderated by the Professional Expert in National Resilience Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Lumban Sianipar featured four resource persons, namely Minister of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries Susi Pujiastuti, Deputy for Infrastructure from the Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs Dr. Ir. Ridwan Jamaludin, M.Sc., Acting Director General for Technology-based Leading Industry from the Ministry of Industry Ir. Panggah Susanto, MM., and Assistant Deputy for Employment Affairs from the Coordinating Ministry of Economy Johnson Tampubolon, SH., M.Sc. The results of the study will later be recommended to the president.

During the discussion, Susi Pujiastuti said that the sovereignty, sustainability and prosperity were important factors that had to be paid attention to, apart from the changing of paradigm from an agriculture-based country to a maritime country.

Meanwhile, Ridwan Jamaludin said that the Indonesia’s competitiveness was still weak compared to that of other countries, and this was supported by the fact put forth by Panggah Susanto that 70% of ship components were still imported.

Furthermore, Johnson Tampubolon stated that shipbuilding industry in Indonesia still relied on imported components as the prices were relatively lower compared to those of local products. The event was also attended by Deputy for Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marsono, M. Agr., Deputy for Education Maj. Gen. M. Nasir Madjid, Director for Shipbuilding and Marine Affairs of the Directorate General of Sea Transportation from the Ministry of Transportation Capt. Sahattua P. Simatupang, MM, Advisory Board of the Indonesian Ship and Offshore Industry Association (Iperindo) Tjahjono Roesdianto, President Director of Pelindo II Richard Joust Lim and Professional Expert in Strategy and International Relations Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Robert Mangindaan, Senior Analysts, Professional Experts and some officials from the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries.

Managing and Utilizing Demographic Bonus Properly

Lemhannas RI Deputy for Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marsono, M.Agr opened a Roundtable Discussion themed Management of Demographic Bonus to Improve the Nation's Competitiveness for National Resilience at Kresna Room, Asta Gatra Building, 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI, on Tuesday (5/5).

In his speech which was read by Djagal Wiseso Marsono, Governor of Lemhannas RI said that Indonesia was projected to experience a period of demographic bonus within the next 10 to 20 years.

The event moderated by Professional Expert in Natural Riches Prof. Dr. Ir. Dadan Umar Daihani, DEA. was attended by several resource persons, namely Acting Head of the National Population and Family Planning Agency Ir. Ambar Rahayu, M.N.S, Researcher from the Center for Population and Policy Studies (PSKK) of the Gadjah Mada University Prof. Drs. Muhadjir Darwin, Ph.D., Director General for Secondary Education from the Ministry of Education and Culture Prof. Dr. Ir. Achmad Jazidie, M. Eng. and Deputy Head of Demographic Institute of the Economic Faculty from the University of Indonesia.

According to Muhadjir Darwin, the demographic bonus allowed rapid economic growth which was preceded by changes in people's age structure; two-thirds of the population were productive workforce.

Meanwhile, Achmad Jazidie put an emphasis on two factors, widening the window of demographic bonus and making the best use of demographic bonus. These two things were related to the improvement in life quality, productivity and competitiveness, the 12-year compulsory education program, access and quality of education as well as national character.

Similarly, Dwini Handayani also argued that the demographic bonus had a potential to increase the number of productive workforce and people's savings, which was a source of economic growth.

The discussion featured several panelists, including Secretary General of the Ministry of Manpower and Transmigration Ir. Abdul Wahab Bangkona, M. Sc., Director of Population, Women Empowerment and Child Protection from the National Development Planning Board Ir. Suharti, M.A, Ph. D, Middle-level Researcher from Research Center for Population of the Indonesian Institute of Sciences (LIPI) Dr. Makmuri Sukarno, M.A., and Professional Expert in National Vigilance Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Dr. I Putu Sastra Wingarta, S.I.P.



Lemhannas RI Deputy Governor Didit Herdiawan Obtains Doctoral Degree from IPB

Vice Admiral Didit Herdiawan, MPA., MBA was bestowed with a Doctoral Degree in Management and Business in the Postgraduate Program of the Bogor Agriculture Institute (IPB) after defending his dissertation with a public presentation at the Auditorium of Andi Hakim Nasution Building, On Wednesday (6/5).

The dissertation titled "Maritime Industry and Its Roles in Food Distributions in Remote Areas for Strengthened National Resilience" was successfully defended by Didit Herdiawan in front of a panel of judges with IPB Deputy Rector for Research and Cooperation Prof. Dr. Anas Miftah Fauzi, M.Eng. serving as Chairman of the Judging Panel, Chairman of Study Program of Management and Business of IPB Dr. Ir. Arif Daryanto M.Sc. as Chairman of Advisory Commission, Deputy Rector for Resources and Strategic Research Prof. Dr. Ir. Hermanto Siregar, ME. and Research Professor in Research and Development Agency from the Ministry of Agriculture Prof. (Research) Dr. Ir. Haryanto, M.Sc. as members of Supervisory Commission. While Former Head of Food Security Agency from the Ministry of Agriculture Prof. Dr. Ir Achmad Suryana, MS. and Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA served as external examiners.

The research, which used Second-Order Structural Equation Modeling, is based on the phenomenon of food inequality in Indonesia between regions with high-risk food insecurity and those with food surplus.

In the mapping of World Food Programme, which is in the form of Food Insecurity Atlas, it is shown that the majority of regions with high-risk food insecurity are located in remote islands. This fact indicated that the issues of food distribution from surplus regions to the deficit one must be immediately addressed.

The outcome of the research proves that the maritime industry has a significant influence over the national food security system through food distribution. Therefore, appropriate strategies need to be developed in order to improve the national food security system, such as by taking care of the subsectors that are directly related to the distribution systems, encompassing seaport, shipbuilding and warehouse industries.

Even since he was little, he has been taught to always be honest by his parents. Honesty is something that is very important, and therefore, must be practiced from a very early age.

Addressing child behaviors in this era of digital natives, Budi Susilo Soepandji stressed that today children should not be educated using violent methods as it would just scare them and affect their psychological development. "Parents must be aware that all those modern gadgets were

Visiting Soekarno's Tomb

As a series of activities in the commemoration of Lemhannas RI's 50th golden anniversary, Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA. and several staff members visited the tomb of President Soekarno in Blitar on Tuesday (12/05). The ceremonial event is an annual agenda carried out usually a few days prior to the commemoration of Lemhannas RI's anniversary that falls on May 20.

Ir. Soekarno, known as Bung Karno, was one of two figures who proclaimed Indonesia's independence and later became the first President of the Republic of Indonesia. Like other high-ranking military officials in early 1960, President Ir. Soekarno, at that time, also had an idea to establish a defence institution in order to respond to the challenges of changing strategic environment by focusing on the development of national resilience. Nowadays, Lemhannas RI has developed into an institution which remains steadfast in upholding the national noble values through the education of national-level leaders, strategic studies, and strengthening program of national values.

According to Budi Susilo Soepandji, the visit was part of the efforts to not forget the history as Bung Karno once said in his most profound speech titled "Jas Merah", an abbreviation of *Jangan Sekali-sekali Melupakan Sejarah* (Do Not Ever Forget Our History). "And our visit here is to remember the history, the founder of Lemhannas. And according to Bung Karno, history is important, and therefore, in the realm of Indonesian geopolitics, do not ever forget history," said Budi.

After visiting Soekarno's tomb, Lemhannas RI handed over books to Bung Karno library in Blitar. On the opportunity, the Governor and his staff members also had an informal meeting with Blitar Mayor Samanhudi Anwar and Blitar Consultative Forum (Muspida).
