“Nationalism is a matter of heart, not only about right or wrong norms,” said Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Police Commissioner General Drs. Suhardi Alius, M.H., during a discussion with Metro TV journalists in an event themed “Resonance of Nationalism for Metro TV Journalists” at Metro TV’s Executive Meeting Room, Kebon Jeruk, Jakarta (23/02).

When it came down to heart, explained Suhardi, we ought to promote honesty, culture, spiritualism, empathy, and other similar traits, that would result in our own self-control.

Given the rapid development of media channels nowadays, Suhardi put forth that they played a significant role in changing the values within the community. Therefore, he invited Metro TV journalists to inspire and touch any stakeholders with their questions so that they could contribute their insights and knowledge to the long-term national interests.

IKIP Veteran Semarang Visits Lemhannas RI for Field Study on Nationalism

Lemhannas RI received a visit of the students of the Civics Education Program of the Faculty of Social Sciences Education (FPIPS) from the State-run Teachers' Training Institute Veteran (IKIP Veteran) Semarang on Tuesday (01/03). According to the group leader, the FPIPS Head Drs. Augustinus Sutriyanto Hadi, M.Si., the visit was intended to prepare civics teachers so that they would be well aware of the concept of national insight, nationalism, democracy, and human rights.

Lemhannas RI, which was represented by Chief of Public Relations Bureau Commodore E. Estu Prabowo, M.Sc. welcomed the event positively, while saying that the teacher candidates would have an important role in the future to educate the nation's children and instill a sense of patriotism in their students," he said.

Other than being briefed on Lemhannas RI profile, the participants were also given the opportunity to discuss issues of

nationalism and state administration. The resource person Brigadier General (Ret.) A. R. Wetik, M.Sc. raised the issues of Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, and other contemporary issues for a discussion.

According to Wetik, Pancasila was born out of Indonesia's culture and the founding fathers' dream about the single entity of Indonesia, meanwhile the 1945 Constitution served as the legal ideals of the nation to establish an ideal community as stated in the Preamble of the 1945 Constitution. Although Indonesia's constitutional system was already established by the founding fathers, it does not necessarily mean that it is without weaknesses. Therefore, constitutional amendments are required in order to improve Indonesia's state administration.

In addition to the constitutional issues, the discussion also addressed other current issues, such as terrorism, human rights, Indonesia's history, and national leadership.

Thursday (10/3), Lemhannas RI held a kickoff meeting on management system themed “Audit of Human Resources Management System” with PPM Management at Nusantara II Room, Trigatra Building 1st Floor, Lemhannas RI. Led by Lemhannas RI Governor Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA, the meeting was intended to analyze and create a roadmap of management system that allowed human resources to carry out their duties, functions and roles properly in order to help the institution achieve the world-class status.

Concerning Lemhannas RI’s strategic grand design in developing professional and proactive human resources, Consulting Team of PPM Management elaborated that in order for Lemhannas RI to develop its personnel, an audit of its human resource management system was certainly needed. The result of which would be translated into a model of competence, both in soft skills and hard skills aspects.

“The challenge in producing this analysis does not lie in the system, but rather in the paradigm, whether it is attached to the organization or to the individual,” said the PPM Management Consulting Team.

Budi Susilo Soepandji conveyed in his remarks that human resources played a very crucial role in determining the success of the institution. Therefore, the improvement in the quality of its education program graduates, outcome of studies and strengthening program of national values as well as cooperation with various relevant domestic and foreign agencies were quite indispensable.

In response to the presentation delivered by the PPM Management Consulting Team, Suhardi Alius hoped that the result of the analysis carried out for 3 months could be further mapped out in order to determine the number of ideal and proactive employees required by Lemhannas RI based on its workloads.

Through the training, the participants were expected to be able to understand and apply the management concepts and tools when managing project and focusing on its results.

This training was held for the first time by Lemhannas RI and NUFFIC in cooperation with training and consulting institution called MDF Pacific-Indonesia (MDF-PI).

Sulendra Kusuma, S.H., S.E., M.T., Akt, as a speaker and one of the scenario’s writers.

In the occasion, the Editor-in-Chief of The Jakarta Post Endy Bayuni said that Indonesia’s Scenario 2045 invited all of us to think further by predicting and preparing this nation through four scenarios 2045.

Responding to what was said by Panutan S. Sulendra Kusuma, as a political analyst, Andi Widjajanto argued about the island scenario that he thought there will be no war if the hegemony states are in crisis.

The concern is when the condition of the hegemony state improve and normal so those states will struggle to find resources. On the other hand, it is also necessary to anticipate a scenario written by non-state actor which possibly exist.

Led by Prof. Purnomo Yusgiantoro and Indonesian Defence University Rector Lieu. Gen. I Wayan Midhio, M.Phil., 40 students of economic defence and energy security study programs from the University of Defence visited Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (15/3).

On the opportunity, Purnomo Yusgiantoro explained that the students' visit was a part of learning process in the decision-making process. "Learning is not just a theory, but it also involves the implementation of decisions as carried out in the National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas)," he said.

Meanwhile, Lemhannas RI Governor Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. in his remarks said that he was very proud to receive the visit of Prof. Purnomo Yusgiantoro and the students of Defence University. Furthermore, he explained that it was Purnomo Yusgiantoro who pioneered the establishment of Labkurtannas system.

Labkurtannas, which was the focus of the visit, was owned and developed by Lemhannas RI in order to analyze national resilience issues. It also has a public policy simulation system. Thus far, Labkurtannas has built a system that can provide a portrait of national resilience in the region with all of its aspects. The system will demonstrate the conditions of Indonesia's resilience, the strategic issues being faced, and also the possible decisions and social impacts.

The visiting students later engaged in a discussion with Labkurtannas. They also had the opportunity to listen to the presentation on other Lemhannas RI products, such as Indonesia's Scenario 2045 by Dr. Panutan Sulendrakusuma and Lemhannas RI National Leadership Laboratory (Labpimnas) by Dr. Adi Sujatno.

Lemhannas RI Holds Strengthening Program of National Values in Yogyakarta

Lemhannas RI Governor Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA opened the Strengthening Program of National Values in Yogyakarta, on Wednesday (16/3), at Jatayu Room, Jayakarta Hotel, Yogyakarta. The program was followed by 100 participants, consisting of 35 people from bureaucracy, 21 people from academics, 35 community leaders, and 9 people from military and police.

The 7-day program was held from March 16 to 22, 2016 employing various methods, including lectures, discussions, and coaching with the theme "Implementing National Values Derived from Four State Consensus in Order to Improve Quality of Life of the People, Nation and State".

In his remarks, Lemhannas RI Governor Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. put emphasis on the strengthening of national values and regarded it as an absolute necessity. He further added that people should be careful as not to get caught up in a democratic euphoria which would only stir them away from Pancasila as their national identity.
