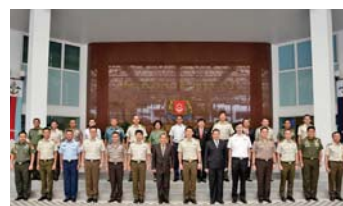

On Friday (18/11), Chairman of the National Sport Council (KONI) Major General (Ret.) Suratman, S.Ip accompanied by Deputy Chairman V of Internal, foreign and Legal Cooperation Division Air Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.Ip, Head of Organization Division Nana Djuana Priadi and Deputy Chairman III of Education and Training Division Ruslaini paid a Courtesy Call (CC) with Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo in Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building 1st Floor, Lemhannas RI.

In the CC, Suratman explained that KONI is a government's partner and referred as independent community organizations which is also included in the constitutional system. Furthermore, KONI is also a government stakeholders in providing advice and input regarding coaching sports achievements in Indonesia in cooperation with the Sports Minister.

Currently, Suratman continued, the achievements of Indonesian athletes is declining. It encourages KONI to plan a grand strategy to improve the achievement of Indonesian athletes from 2014 to the upcoming 2024. The Grand Strategy had been presented in a seminar at 11 universities that related to sports. With the involvement of Lemhannas RI, KONI expected to be able to hold a strategic and qualified national seminar to obtain useful recommendation for Indonesian athletes achievements. "We hope it can give useful recommendation to be submitted to The President," said Suratman.

Commodore (RNCN) (Ret.) Michiel Bart Hijmans Gives Lecture Concerning Maritime Security

Commodore (RNCN) (Ret.) Michiel Bart Hijmans visited Lemhannas RI and welcomed by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo in Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building 1st Floor on Tuesday (22/11).

After paying a Courtesy Call with the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Commodore (RNCN) (Ret.) Michel Bart Hijmans then headed to Syailendra Room, Astagatra Building 3rd Floor to the West to give a lecture accompanied by Deputy of Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marseno, M. Agr., Professional Expert of Diplomacy / International Affair Rear Admiral (Ret.) Robert Mangindaan.

In the lecture which raised a Maritime Security as its theme, Hijman explained about Indonesian maritime territory, the laws and also the regulations that oversee Indonesian maritime territory. Then, Hijmans Talk about maritime threats faced by Indonesia such as boundaries of the sea, marine pollution, illegal immigrants, illegal fishing, over fishing, natural disasters, terrorism and piracy.

One right thing that has been implemented by Indonesia to secure the sea area according to Hijmans is to blow up the ships that do illegal fishing in Indonesia sea area. "What has been done by Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries is correct," said Hijmans.

Then, Hijmans explained that the solution to overcome these threats is to create a Maritime Security Strategy. The first strategy is identification of strategic interests between all parties related to maritime security such as institutions and ministries, police, customs,

Navy, local governments and also local fishermen. In addition, the parties must also cooperate with the Air Force or even the Organization related to outer space in order to facilitate the data collection to achieve the same goal to protect Indonesia's maritime security. The second strategy is to identify various threats, challenges and risks that would be faced by Indonesia in maintaining maritime security. Then, the third strategy is to specify what actions will be taken to counter threats at Indonesia's sea.

Hijmans then asserted that Indonesia should formulate concrete actions from the Maritime Security Strategy which has been approved. Concrete actions should be done by Indonesia are building a maritime situational awareness, building joint capabilities, doing research, innovation, education, training, improving stakeholder communications, risk management, and international cooperation on the field of maritime security.

One of the real action is emphasized by Hijmans is building maritime situational awareness. To create awareness of the maritime situation, the government especially relevant stakeholders should provide information and knowledge to the whole society, especially the younger generation since at the basic education level. It will greatly assist Indonesia to realize maritime security.

The lectures on maritime security was attended by Faculty Members, Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI and Defense University Students.

Coffee Morning Discuss the Reflection of National Resilience in 2015 - 2016

Lemhannas RI held Coffee Morning which is a face-to-face occasion between Top Officials of Lemhannas RI and Editor-in-Chiefs of Mass Media in Trigatra Pavilion, Trigatra Building 3rd Floor on Wednesday (23/11). The Coffee Morning was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo.

In his remark, Agus Widjojo expressed his appreciation to the Editor-in-Chiefs attended the Coffee Morning. Agus Widjojo hoped that this Coffee Morning will able to generate various views, thoughts, as well as a shared commitment to overcome every problem facing by this nation.

Then, Agus Widjojo conveyed three things concerning the national resilience which should be discussed namely the result of the measurement of national resilience in 2016 that reflects the issues that needs synergy from all components of this nation, the existence of some issues related to ideology and racial intolerance in the society which indicate a potential that can trigger the threats to this nation unity, and the last is related to capacity and capability that is much needed by this nation to carry out its duties and functions.

In the end of his remark, Agus Widjojo said that the synergy of duties and functions between Lemhannas RI and press media is immensely strategic positioned in the context of developing national resilience embodied in society's life which harmonious and peaceful in diversity; as well as fairness in this nation's prosperity.

Then, It was continued with brief explanation of reflection of national resilience in 2016 by Head of National Resilience Measurements Laboratory (Labkurtannas) Prof. Dr. Miyasto, SU. Prof. Miyasto explained that the duty of Labkurtannas is to observe the portrait of national resilience and conduct analysis of cause and effect from the portrait of national resilience. Later, Prof. Miyasto outlined that the fundamental

basis from the measurements in Labkurtannas is Indicators which are divided into 8 aspects namely geography, demography, natural resources, ideology, politic, economic, social and culture, and defence and security. Those aspects are formed by 108 variables and 821 indicators.

Prof. Miyasto then explained firther that the data measured in Labkurtannas consist of two kinds of data namely qualitative data (policy data) and quantitative data (performance data). These data are correlated. From these data, it will resulted composite index or national resilience index. National resilience index is divided into 5 levels or grades; weak (red), quite weak (yellow), quite tough (green), tough (blue), and very tough (purple). In addition, Prof. Miyasto also said that the currently, Labkurtannas has had national database up to provincial database of national resilience index.

The portrait of Indonesia national resilience index in 2015 until 2016, explained Prof. Miyasto, have increased, but it is still in a quite weak position. From 8 aspects in total, 5 aspects increase; geographic, demographic, political, economic, defense and security. However, three other gatra decrease and need to get more attention. "We will see a portrait based on the trends so if it is not solved soon, it will certainly affect national stability" explained Prof. Miyasto.

After the brief explanation of the reflection of national resilience in 2015 and 2016, the occasion was continued a further discussion with the Editor-in-Chiefs of the mass media, which was moderated by Maulana Isnarto.

Also attended the Coffee Morning were Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E.,M.M., Deputies, Chiefs of Bureaus, Faculty Members, and Editors-in-Chiefs of Electronic, Press, and Online Media.



Ten Best Graduates of PPRA LIV and LV of Lemhannas RI Visit Singapore

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. Agus Widjojo, along with 10 (ten) Best Graduates of PPRA LIV and LV of Lemhannas RI 2016 attended the invitation of Permanent Secretary of Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Singapore to conduct a comparative study on November 13 to 18, 2016.

The visit was received by Chief of Defence Force (CDF) of the Singapore Armed Forces (Singapore Armed Forces) Lt. Gen. Perry Lim who was accompanied by Chief of Staff-Joint Staff Brig. Gen. Chia Choon Hoong, Director of Joint Operations RADM Frederick Chew, Head of Joint Logistic Col. Tan KanWhye, Head of Joint Plan Department Col. GauravKeerthi, Head of Joint Manpower Col Francis Kee, Head of Joint Research Col. SeetUei Lim, Head of National Service Affairs Department Col. Clifford Keong, and Head of Army Inspectorate, Col. Marcus Tan.

The Meeting was begin with a Courtesy Call between the Governor of Lemhannas RI and Singapore Armed Forces Commander and it was continued with the meeting of both delegations to hold a discussions. The presentation described about several Singapore defence policy like Total Defence which has been started since 1984. The policy introduces 5 pillars namely Military Defence- Secure Singapore's defense, Civil Defence - Keep your family, friends and people around in times of crisis, Economic Defence - keep economic sector to be strong and tough, Social Defence - Living in harmony and

mutual regard, Psychological Defence- Being a tough human.

On the occasion, There was also a presentation about National Service (NS) , which was begun in 1967. NS was done in the form of compulsory military service for all men with Singapore Citizenship and the second generation of permanent residence after reaching 18 years. Eighty percent of the citizen who conducted Full Time National Servicemen (NSF) for two years will be served in Singapore Armed Forces (SAF) and the rest will be served in Singapore Police Force (SPF) or the Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF).

For those who have carried out mandatory military service will be known as Operationally-Ready National Serviceman (NSman) and will be reserve components, as well as being the backbone of the Singapore Armed Forces. On that occasion, it was also explained about the two pillars of Singapore's defense; Deterrence and Diplomacy. In addition, related to SAF Corporate Brief, it was explained about the 3rd Generation of SAF, especially in the field of defense equipment with a focus on the development of unmanned systems, Network and Precision Fires.

The visit initiated by the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Singapore has been implemented since 2012 and Singapore has also been consistent in sending participants in Lemhannas RI educational Program since 2009.

The event opened with a remark from the Chairwoman of KORPRI Board of Lemhannas RI drg. Sri Wahyu Pujiastuti, MM. In her remark, Sri Wahyu said that one of the challenges faced by KORPRI in the future is to improve competency and performance as Civil State Apparatus, and also respond to the constructive matters, realize governance and carry out our duty with a sense of responsibility. Therefore, Sri Wahyu expected all members of KORPRI in Lemhannas RI to work professionally.

Related to the Talkshow and Sharing theme, Sri Wahyu said that health is a major factor in our life because if we are healthy our productivity will increase. Therefore, it is immensely important for state civil apparatus to remain healthy.

At explanation session, dr. Deasy Erika, Sp. KFR explained that bone growth will begin to stop growing at the age of 30 to 40 years and bone mass will begin to decrease after the age of 40 years. The decrease in bone mass will lead to degenerative diseases such as osteoporosis. Osteoporosis, said dr. Deasy, is a bone disease that affects bone and caused by a reduction of bone mass. In addition, other degenerative diseases that often attack the bone at the age of 40 years and over is osteoarthritis that attacks joints throughout the body. Both of these diseases can not be cured but can be slowed.

To slow these degenerative diseases, dr. Deasy suggested to take enough calcium since a young age, do exercise that suitable with degenerative disease suffered, maintain ideal weight, do balanced diet, and live a healthier lifestyle.

Until now, PBNU adhering to The Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (NKRI), Pancasila, Unity in Diversity and the Constitution of 1945. "At any given time, PBNU, even though we have to stand alone, we will keep it that way! (Adhering to the Four Pillars)," said Said Aqil Siradj.

Said Aqil Siradj also revealed that P4 education needs to be revived. It is considered necessary because of the dissipation of national values in young generation. Young generation, ujas Said Aqil Siradj, need to understand more about the Four Pillars of the Nation, namely The Unitary State of The Republic of Indonesia, Pancasila, Unity in Diversity and the Constitution of 1945 in order to maintain the existence of this nation.

Meanwhile, Lukman Said also expressed their efforts as a representative in the region in maintaining the integrity of The Unitary State of The Republic of Indonesia like what they had done in Manado. Lukman Said also agreed with Said Aqil Siradj about the phrase "NKRI harga mati" of The Unitary State of The Republic of Indonesia to the death. "What was said by the Chairman of the PBNU, that NKRI to the death and it is our vow as regional officials," Said Lukman said

In addition, Lukman Sadi also agreed with Said Aqil Siroj on the importance of nationality knowledge given to primary education so sense of nationalism can emerge in since early age.

Later in his remark, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo said that the MoU is a joint effort among Lemhannas RI, PBNU, and ADKASI to strengthen synergy in working program among three institutions. This Memorandum of Understanding includes improving the quality of human resources through education and training, exchanging of experts, strengthening of national values, exchanging of information, technology support in the context of national resilience measurement, implementation of the assessment, and several other matters in accordance with what has been agreed among three institutions.

In addition, Agus Widjojo also stated that this MoU will be followed up. "This Memorandum of Understanding will certainly be followed up with real programs related to specific areas within the scope of the cooperation," said Agus Widjojo.

For Lemhannas RI, continued Agus Widjojo, this cooperation will certainly enhance RI Lemhannas RI's role in socializing and strengthening national insight to all components of this nation including the human resources in PBNU and ADKASI.

The signing of this MoU was also attended by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M., Deputies, Chiefs of the Bureaus, Faculty Members, Structural Officials and all staff of Lemhannas RI.
