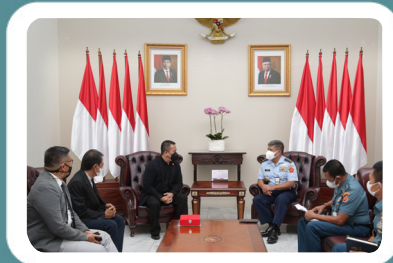

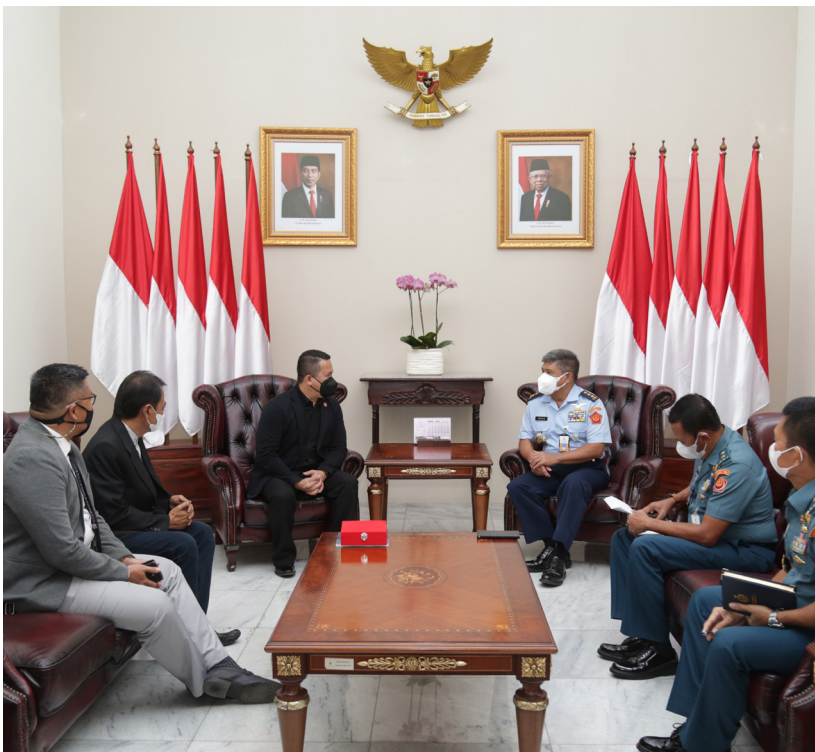


# Courtesy Call of Ikatan Arsitek Indonesia

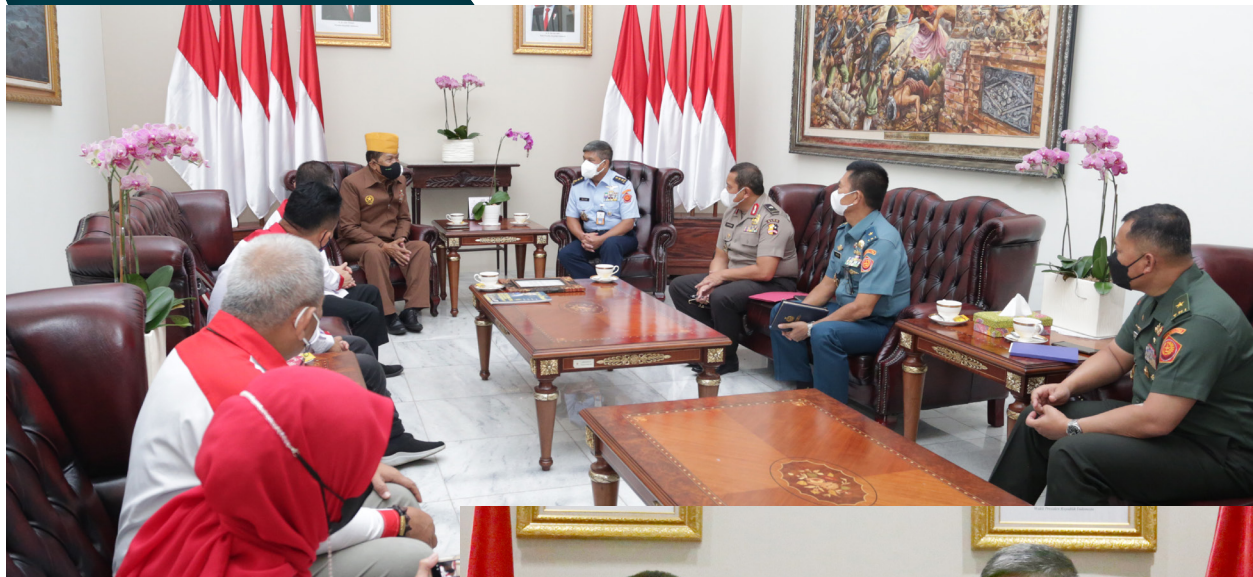

# Consolidation Meeting for the Implementation of the Lemhannas RI Bureaucracy Reform for 2022

The Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI, Police Commissioner General Drs. Purwadi Arianto, M.Si., led the Consolidation Meeting for the Implementation of the Lemhannas RI Bureaucracy Reform for 2022 on Wednesday (26/1/22), online.

In his speech, the Prime Secretary stated that Lemhannas RI Bureaucracy Reform for 2022 will be implemented soon. This implementation is based on the issuance of the Decree of the Governor of Lemhannas RI Number 03 of 2022 on the Lemhannas RI Bureaucracy Reform Team for 2022 and the Order of Bureaucracy Reform Team for each Deputy Office and Secretariat. "Together, we must be committed to perfectly implementing everything that has been planned, for the increase in the Lemhannas RI bureaucratic reform evaluation result," he said.

The implementation of bureaucratic reforms began with drafting the Performance Report of Government Institutions (LAKIP) of 2021, drafting a Performance Agreement of 2022, filling

out the State Official Wealth Report (LHKPN), and the State Civil Apparatus Wealth Report (LHKASN) for state civil apparatus (ASN). The next stage is drafting Bureaucratic Reform Action Plans for each area of change and work unit, drafting work plans for each designated agent of change, and preparing the proposal of work units as integrity zones.

In addition, the implementation of bureaucracy reforms includes preparing the Self-Assessment of Bureaucratic Reform Implementation (PMPRB) by filling out the Evaluation Worksheet (LKE) for each area of change and work unit, and preparing the supporting data which is then sent to the Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform (PANRB). In the next few months, the team of bureaucracy reform will carry out the plan until the evaluation preparation in September.

According to the Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI, the implementation of Bureaucracy Reform in 2021 faced several failings and obstacles. Therefore, with this

opportunity, each coordinator of the area of change and work unit explained the implementation of bureaucracy reform and the obstacles faced during the year in order to find the solution. With this agenda, it is hoped that optimal results will be achieved for the improvement of the implementation of bureaucracy reform at Lemhannas RI in 2022.

The Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI also highlighted the area of performance accountability related to the Strategic Plan of Lemhannas RI that received repetitive recommendations for two consecutive years. "Immediately create a team and make a follow-up by revising the strategic plan and coordinating with the relevant ministries," said the Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI. This point is highly emphasized because the Strategic Plan of Lemhannas RI is a reference for the Strategic Plan of Work Units and as a guide in preparing Performance Agreements (PK), Key Performance Indicators (IKU) and Performance Report of Government Institutions (LAKIP).

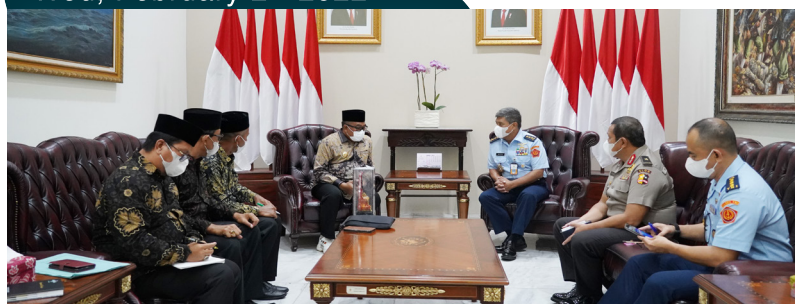


# Courtesy Call between Lemhannas RI and the Regent of West Aceh

# Entry Meeting of BPK RI Audit on LKKL of Lemhannas RI Year 2021 Conducted Virtually

The Acting Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan, the Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI Police Commissioner General Drs. Purwadi Arianto, M.Si, and the Inspector of Lemhannas RI Police Brigadier General Drs. Gusti Ketut Gunawa, M.M., CfrA. attended the BPK RI Audit Entry Meeting on the 2021 Ministry/Institution Financial Reports (LKKL) at AKN I on Friday (4/2/22) online.

“As a concrete manifestation of us as the Coordinating Ministers and Ministers, as well as the Leaders of Institutions and Leaders of Non-Ministerial Government Institutions to carry out transparent and accountable state budget management administration,” said the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs (Menko Polhukam) Prof. Dr. Mohammad Mahfud MD, S.H., S.U., M.I.P. on that occasion.

Furthermore, Menko Polhukam emphasized that Law No. 17 of 2003 concerning State Finance in Article 36 requires all entities to implement actual-based financial reports, which means that

the financial reports must be measurable and can be evaluated.

Therefore, in order to ensure the efficiency of the audit, Menko Polhukam hoped that all leaders of Ministries/Institutions being evaluated aid the implementation of the BPK audit through good cooperation by providing documents and information needed for the audit.

“The audit team must make objective conclusion and assessment, so that at the end of the audit, the team will be able to provide accurate opinions on the extent to which Ministries/Institutions have managed state finances which must be accounted for in accordance with the laws and regulations,” concluded Menko Polhukam.

“In conducting the audit, the entry meeting is one of the most important stages that affects the success and efficacy of the audit,” said Head I of BPK Dr. Hendra Susanto, S.T., M.Eng., M.H., CfrA., CSFA. Furthermore, the Head I of BPK stated that the audit on the LKKL year 2021 has the purpose of providing an opinion on the financial reports of each Ministry/Institution by considering

four criteria. First, the appropriateness of the presentation of the numbers in the financial reports with the government accounting standard. Second, the adequacy of disclosure of information in the notes to the financial reports is in accordance with the government accounting standard. Third, the compliance with laws and regulations related to financial reports. Fourth, the effectiveness of the Internal Control System (SPI) both in its design and implementation.

The Head I of BPK hoped that communication between the auditors and all related parties can run well and effectively. The communication must be carried out by upholding the values of integrity, independence, and professionalism. “We need to synergize with each other in the context of managing state finances and for the development of the nation and state,” he said.

It is expected that the audit on the LKKL year 2021 can run well, smoothly, and punctually. On this occasion, a letter of assignment was also symbolically handed over by the Head I of BPK to Menko Polhukam.

# Entry Meeting of BPK RI Audit on Financial Reports of Lemhannas RI Year 2021

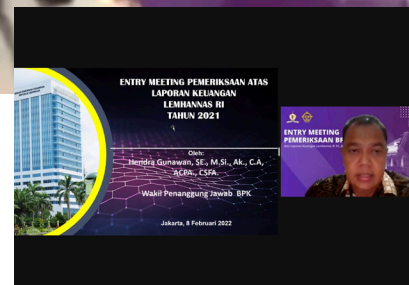

Purwadi Arianto, M.Si., conveyed that all leaders of the inspected work units within Lemhannas RI were to fully aid with the execution of the BPK RI audit through good cooperation by providing necessary documents and information. According to the Prime Secretary, this aid aims to ensure the efficacy of the BPK audit.

The Prime Secretary also appealed to all parties for preparing documents related to budget execution and accountability in a complete, fast, and communicative conduct. This is intended so that the audit

team can make objective conclusions and evaluation and then the team will be able to provide accurate opinions on the extent to which Lemhannas RI has managed state finances which must be accounted for in accordance with the laws and regulations.

On the same occasion, Deputy in Charge I BPK RI Hendra Gunawan, S.E., M.Si., Ak., C.A., ACPA., CSFA. showed appreciation for the improvement of the opinion of the Lemhannas RI's financial report because it has obtained a WTP opinion in 5 consecutive years. It is hoped that Lemhannas RI can maintain this achievement and obtain a WTP opinion on the Financial Report of 2021. "This inspection will be conducted for 80 days and it is planned that the submission of the inspection report will be carried out in May or June 2022," he said.

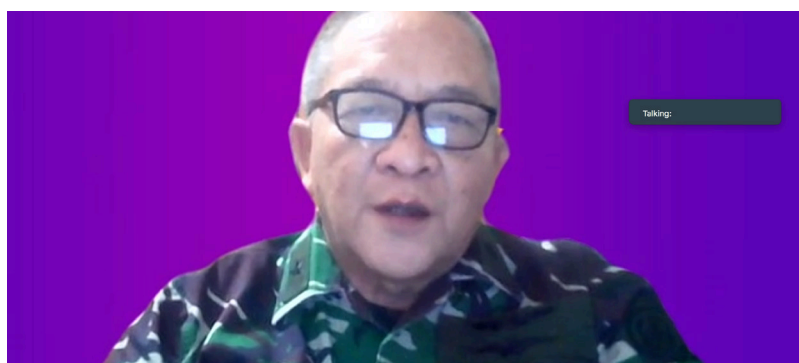
Related to this, the Deputy in Charge I of BPK RI conveyed several points that were of concern. First, the data information

Fourth, the discipline of health protocols during all inspection processes.

Meanwhile, for Echelon I officials, particularly senior lecturers and senior analysts, the Acting Governor reminded that each personnel have duties as a lecturer, analyst, and person in charge of fostering education participants, and carrying out other tasks assigned by the Governor of Lemhannas RI. For Echelon II officials, the Acting Governor emphasized that strong communication and synergy between leaders and their subordinates is extremely necessary in order to realize the development of an integrated strategy to support the achievement of organizational goals and the realization of capabilities in each work unit.

The Acting Governor also highlighted the important role of Echelon III and IV officials in implementing the programs that have been determined by the organization. He emphasized that all activities must be carried out in accordance with standard operating procedures, so that performance improvements can be realized on a constant basis. "It is an honor as you have dedicated yourself, carried out your duties earnestly, and passed down the exemplary values for us," he said.
