## Laskar Ampera ARH 66 has an audience with Lemhannas RI

Six representatives of Laskar Ampera Arief Rahman Hakim (ARH) 66 visited Lemhannas RI to have an audience with Lemhannas RI Governor Let.Gen. TNI (Ret.) Agus Widjojo and Vice Governor Air Marshal TNI Bagus Puruhito. The visit was led by Fahmi Idris, S.E., a former Industrial Minister of Yudhoyono Cabinet (2004-2009), to discuss national matters with Lemhannas officials, at Nusantara Room II, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI, on Monday (13/11).

On the discussion, Agus Widjojo introduced Lemhannas RI to the Laskar Ampera as a government agency by playing video profile of Lemhannas. In this opportunity, Agus explained, Lemhannas doesn't have an operational function likes ministries.

"What I want to clarify is there are common misunderstanding about Lemhannas as if Lemhannas has an authority to implement government policy. Lemhannas functions and tasks are to educate and to do strategic studies. We don't have such operational authority to implement the government policy. Our function is as a supporting system for the government," said Agus Widjojo.

When discussing about social-political development, Fahmi

Idris stated that what have been said by Agus Widjojo is actually quite important for socio-political development. "I quite capture the portrait described by the Governor, it is something important related to strengthening of socio-political development," Fahmi Idris who was once served as Minister of Labor in the development reform cabinet said.

Furthermore, the discussion addressed various national issues with a Q&A session, which most of them are confidential. Because of the range issues discussed, this event was also attended by Professional Expert of Social-Culture Prof. Dr. Anhar Gonggong, Professional Expert of Economic-Strategy Dr. Rosita S. Noer, M.A., Professional Expert of National Awareness and Social Culture Dr. I Putu Sastra Wingarta, S.I.P., M.Sc., Deputy of Education Maj. Gen. TNI Karsiyanto, S.E, Senior Lecture of National Awareness Maj. Gen TNI Ibnu Triwidodo, S.I.P, Chief of PR Bureau Brig. Gen. TNI Mindarto, Chief of Cooperation Bureau Commodore TNI Budi Setiawan, S.T, Director of Political Studies Drs. Hanif Salim, M.A., and the Deputy of Strengthening National Values Rear Admiral TNI Deddy Yulianto. ●

Islamic values from Prophet Muhammad SAW

Lemhannas RI Lemhannas RI commemorated the birthday of Prophet Muhammad SAW known as Maulid Nabi in Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI on Monday (4/12). In the occasion which raised a theme “Through Commemoration of The Birthday of Prophet Muhammad SAW, We Learn about Good Behaviour and Moral in Daily Life”, a former rector of Jakarta Islamic State University Prof. Dr. Komaruddin Hidayat was present as a speaker.

In Governor of Lemhannas RI's remark read by Deputy of National-Level Leader Education Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto, S.E., stated that this commemoration is part of our efforts to reflect moral values from Prophet Muhammad in our daily life.

“It is written in history that prophet Muhammad SAW was sent by God to guide human to enlightenment. A new civilization built on the basis of Islamic values as a mercy to the universe. Universal values of Islamic teachings such as tolerance, justice and social concerns are expected to be imprinted in everyday behavior,” Karsiyanto said.

The historical link was begun from his birth, his residence, and his closest companion.

Prophet Muhammad SAW received Al-Amin title, a title given by the people of Mecca because which means honest and trustworthy. At the war era, the Prophet Muhammad was present to bring peace.

In his da'wah, Rasulullah taught tawheed to his people that is God Almighty, as stated in Al-Quran Surah Al-Ikhlash. He also always invites his people to go through Allah's way and make the Quran as a guide. In addition, the Prophet Muhammad taught not to hate on the basis of diversity “Those examples of what Prophet Muhammad SAW had done in his life should be implemented in our life as well,” Komaruddin Hidayat said at the end of his lecture. ●

# Jusuf Kalla:

## Diversity becomes our strength



**V**ice-President of the Republic of Indonesia Drs. H. Muhammad Jusuf Kalla gave a lecture to PPSA XXI (short course) participants and PPRA LVI (regular course) participants of Lemhannas RI in Vice-President's Palace on Monday (20/11). In the lecture, PPSA XXI and PPRA LVI Participants presented their national seminar results.

The lecture was begun with the report from Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo to Vice-President Jusuf Kalla regarding the seminar result which will be use as a recommendation of government policy. The PPRA LVI's national seminar result with the title "Strengthening National Values to Knit Diversity in the Context of National Resilience" read by Colonel Czi Rido Hermawan, M.Sc., suggested to solve the problems related to strengthening of national values by implementing the national values material, and strengthening the institutional function.

Meanwhile, PPSA XXI's national seminar result with a title "The Role of Pancasila in Strengthening The Unitary State of the

Republic of Indonesia presented by Andy Yentriani, S.Sos., M.A. recommends policies for the mass media in presenting their programs on the actualization of Pancasila and encouraging political parties, mass organizations, and other institutions to integrate the actualization of Pancasila values.

In response to both seminar results, Jusuf Kalla stated that the diversity in Indonesia is actually the strength of this nation. "We recognize the difference. That is why Bhinneka Tunggal Ika exist. Those diversity becomes our strength," Jusuf Kalla said.

In facing diversity, Jusuf Kalla continued, tolerance becomes one of important matters. Pancasila as this nation's ideology has to be implemented. According to Jusuf Kalla, admitting Pancasila as an ideology without any implementation of its values is not enough and It will not solve any problem.

Also attended the lecture were Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, Principal Secretary Commissioner General of Police Drs. Arief Wachyunadi, Deputies, Faculty Members, Structural and functional Officials of Lemhannas RI. ●

# PPSA XXI spouses received a lecture from Deputy Assistant of Gender Equality



**T**he Short Course for PPSA XXI Participants' wife/husband listened to the lecture of the Deputy Assistant of Gender Equality in Politics, Law, and Security of The Ministry of Women's Empowerment and Child Protection Dr. A. Darsono, M.Si. in NKRI Room Pancagatra Building 3rd floor, Lemhannas RI, on Friday, (17/11). The lecture explained about the women development as human resources and the gender equality.

As an introduction, Darsono gave a brief explanation about Human Development Index (HDI). According to him, there are 4 variables to assess HDI. "Indonesia's development in a plain view, in national or international level, also can be seen from the growth and the progress of the Human Development Index (HDI) of the women. The women's HDI is assessed from 4 important variables, which are the education background, women population, women contribution on the national income per year, and health," Darsono said.

Then, Darsono explained that gender equality is not something new for Indonesia because we had history about that. He continued, in the Indonesian history, gender equality

was never a problem. This was shown on how men and women have the same right and equality to be a leader. Women already had an important role in the politics during the revolutionary struggles against the Dutch occupation such as Cut Nyak Dien leadership, Kartini's movement, and the girl participation on the youth movement. Thus, gender equality in Indonesia doesn't necessarily need to orientate to other countries.

The United Nations General Assembly on September 2015 in New York, which attended by the heads of state and government, launched a program enacted Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). One of the targets of this program is to target gender equality and women empowerment. To achieve that target, UN Women as one of the UN body, launched an initiative program named HeforShe Impact 10X10X10 Initiatives. Indonesia (President Joko Widodo) is one the head of state impact champions, a term given to the states which participate, among 10 states which joined the program to actualise the Planet Gender Equality 50:50 vision by the year of 2030.

This lecture was then continued with in-depth discussion about the women role in the development and Q&A session. ●





## Agus Widjojo lectures on diversity management to 13 Constitutional Court Representatives

On Tuesday (14/11), Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo gave a lecture to participants of Constitutional Courts (Mahkamah Konstitusi RI) short course in Syailendra Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The short course held for staffs of constitutional courts from foreign countries as followed by representatives from 13 countries such as Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Cambodia, Myanmar, South Korea, Mongolia, Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Pakistan, Tajikistan, and Azerbaijan. In his presentation, Agus Widjojo talked about “Diversity Management in Framework of Unitary State”.

Indonesia as a resource-rich country reflects the harmony, the spirit of maintaining diversity and tolerance. According to Agus Widjojo, the dynamics of the strategic contemporary international environment will be a challenge for diversity management in Indonesia in the future.

Several important elements in facing future challenges to manage and maintain diversity in Indonesia are by implementing the values of Pancasila in society life. Agus Widjojo then explained that implementing the values of Pancasila is a compulsory because it is the ligature of the state. Ligature, Agus Widjojo further explained, is cultural bond developed naturally in the society. This cultural bond is needed to maintain society’s harmony and unity.

Diversity management process in Indonesia was also implemented by deepen the democracy and regional autonomy exist in the society so they will understand their role in the government administration.

Therefore, through this short course, it is expected that the participants can understand the values of Pancasila as a national ideology which can protect the rights of citizen and human rights in Indonesia, and also Pancasila as a point of reference and norm in the Indonesian society life. ●

## Inaugurates a number of Officials, Governor of Lemhannas RI expects employees’ capacity to increase

Bambang Nariyono, M.M. who will sit as a high-ranked official in Indonesian Armed Forces Headquarters (Mabes TNI), Inspector General of Police Drs. Harwiyanto, S.H., M.M., M.Hum. who will serve as First Policy Analyst in Police Short Course Education Institute of Indonesian National Police (Lemdiklat Polri), Colonel Sus Dr. Ir. Rudy A. G. Gultom, M.Sc. who will sit as Secretary of Sensing Technology of Faculty of Technology of Defense University, and Commissioner General of Police Dra. Sri Suari, M.Si. as Senior Policy Analyst of Community Service of Indonesian National Police.

# PPSA XXI Successfully host a national seminar on Pancasila



**P**PSA XXI successfully hosted a National Seminar of Lemhannas RI with the theme “Pancasila’s Role in Strengthening NKRI”, on Thursday (16/11), at Dwiwarna Purwa Room, Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The seminar presented the 6th Vice President of Republic of Indonesia Gen. TNI (Ret.) Try Sutrisno as a keynote speaker, with the topic “Pancasila Actualization in the Education System to Strengthening the Nation’s Unity and Solidarity, in order to Improve National Resilience”. Along with the keynote speaker, there are also 5 speakers from various expertise which are the 1st Constitutional Court Chief Dr. Jimly Asshiddiqie, S.H., Islamic activist and politician Yenny Wahid, poet and sociologist Dr. Ignas Kleden, Professor of Jakarta State University Prof. Dr. Arif Rahman, and the last is Indonesian historian Prof. Dr. Anhar Gonggong.

In the early session, Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P. as the chairman of the seminar committee reported the process of this seminar in front of the invited guests, consisting of Lemhannas officials, other ministries officials, Indonesian Armed Forces officials, Indonesian Police officials, rector from universities, and from student representatives.

According to Reni, the national seminar was a part of PPSA XXI events series which consist of four main events. The event was begun with focus group discussion on September 7, 2017, then it was continued with round table discussion on September 14, 2017. After the round table discussion, it was continued with PPSA XXI Seminar

in October 24, 2017, and the last event is this national seminar in November 16, 2017. “This national seminar is the peak of seminar series which will result strategic concept regarding the implementation of Pancasila values in education system in order to strengthen national unity to strengthen national resilience,” said Reni in her report.

In his remark Agus Widjojo said that Pancasila will be meaningless if the values in it are not implemented in every aspect of our life. “The values in Pancasila must be implemented in every aspect of our life. The implementation process also have to be maintained,” Agus Widjojo said. In this globalisation era, Pancasila face challenges from other contradictive ideology. The existence of ethno nationalism which focus on ethnicity and religion which urge Pancasila implementation in education system as a part of Pancasila rejuvenation efforts. Unfortunately, Agus Widjojo continued, education system in Indonesia have not reflected the values of Pancasila yet so it has not contributed in strengthening nation’s unity either.

Try Sutrisno as the keynote speaker talked about the awareness of independency based on education. Indonesian predecessors awaken awareness through education rather than using physical resistance to fight against colonialism. “Education was awaken, multi parties were formed and national awakening was enthusiastically welcomed by Indonesian youths which stimulate youth pledge,” Indonesia’s Sixth Vice President said in his presentation. ●

# Public Relations Bureau achieves the 1st Winner of Performance Exhibition 2017



The series of Rakor Renaku 2018 and Performance Exhibition 2017 of Lemhannas RI which had taken place for two days since last Tuesday, December 5, 2017 was concluded with award giving for The Best Working Units on Performance and Budget Management 2017 (6/12). Public Relations Bureau was bestowed with the award since it has the highest score among other working units in Lemhannas RI with a score of 17,16. The assessment team of the event come from Finance Ministry, Administrative and Bureaucratic Reform Ministry, and internal officials of Lemhannas RI with scoring composition consist of 60 percent from external team and 40 percent from internal team.

Meanwhile, the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies won second place with a value of 16.32. In the third position is Financial Planning Bureau stands with a score of 16.18, and the National Resilience Measurement Laboratory won the first runner up with a value of 16.07. The trophies and prizes for the winner representatives were given directly by the Chief of the general Affair Bureau, Drs. Triyono Basuki Pujono, M.Si. The scoring was based on three

aspects such as information delivery media, performance output, and performance outcome.
