Lemhannas RI Inaugurate 15 Officials

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo inaugurated several echelon I, II, and III Officials in Nusantara Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (16/1) morning. The inauguration was also attended by Deputy Governor Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, Principal Secretary Commissioner General Drs. Arif Wachyunadi, Secretary General of IKAL, Faculty Members, several Structural Officials and Perista Board.

In his remarks, Agus Widjojo hoped that the newly installed officials will be able to uphold their main responsibility. "Make our duty as a responsibility and honor that should be upheld," said Agus Widjojo

Lemhannas as a Think Tank institution for the president needs excellent people to change the institution into an effective and efficient institution to achieve its goals and objectives. "I believe that with all experiences and abilities, the inaugurated officials can actively involve to be a role model in working

environment, able to encourage all organization components, and able to interpret leader's policy into working programs with measurable achievement strategy," said Agus Widjojo.

Starting 2018 which is seen as "Year of Politic", Agus Widjojo expected all inaugurated officials to be able to keep Lemhannas from joining practical politics and keep being neutral as state apparatus. Agus Widjojo also reminded all Lemhannas' officials should make Lemhannas as a transparent, accountable, and responsive government institution towards national interest.

In this inauguration, 12 officials was replaced from their positions by Governor of Lemhannas RI and 15 officials were inaugurated. One of officials inaugurated were Kolonel Arh. Ramses Lumban Tobing, S.E. who was inaugurated as Director of Economics Studies in Lemhannas RI. In the end of his remarks, Governor thanked 12 former officials who have done their duties.

Monthly Flag-Raising Ceremony is one of a place to communicate for Lemhannas' leaders and staff," said Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo in his remarks in Monthly Flag-Raising Ceremony followed by all Lemhannas RI's officials in Center Field of Lemhannas RI Office on Wednesday (17/1). Agus Widjojo said that this momentum is also a place to exchange ideas related to society, nation, and state life dynamic and also related to institution dynamic.

Related to the dynamic of society, nation, and state life, Agus Widjojo conveyed that there will be a regional election scheduled to take place

simultaneously in 171 regions in Indonesia in 2018. In response to the change of politics dynamics regarding the upcoming regional election, Agus Widjojo reminded Lemhannas staff to maintain its neutrality towards negative issues related to regional election.

Moreover, Agus Widjojo also talked about several institutional matters such as Lemhannas budget realization in 2017 which reached 96,71 percent. Even though it is decreased compare to 2016 realization, Agus Widjojo still appreciate it.

Agus Widjojo also encourage all working units in Lemhannas RI to optimize planning, organizing, management and supervision functions in every working units.

Sinergy and solidity among working units, Agus Widjojo explained, must be maintained and increased.

Related to the second Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2018 that will be held in September, Agus Widjojo said that the committee should prepare the upcoming Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2018.

Before closing his remarks, Agus Widjojo also reminded about BPK RI Audit. All working units, Agus Widjojo said, are expected to support the finance management audit for fiscal year 2017. "Prepare all data for the accountability report of working programs that we have implemented in 2017. Present them transparently," said Agus Widjojo.●

Commission I of DPR RI evaluate the result of strategic issues studies in Lemhannas RI

Commission I of DPR RI held hearings (RDP) with Lemhannas RI and Wantannas to talk about several agenda such as work programs planning of both institutions in 2018, evaluation of work programs and budget realization in 2017 and also several issues related to the preparation of 2018 regional election, in Nusantara II Building, Senayan, Jakarta, on Wednesday (17/1).

The Commission I members focused on the studies that Lemhannas has conducted related to actual issues such as the implementation of regional election simultaneously in 2018. In the RDP, several fractions said Lemhannas that have strategic studies function should be able to disseminate its studies results to the society using social media. "The result of the studies should be shared to public. Lemhannas' studies should become a beneficial policy for this nation," said Andreas Hugo Pareira, one of Commission I members from PDIP fraction.

In response to Andreas Hugo Pareira's input, Agus Widjojo said that Lemhannas RI is a non-ministerial government institution without any operational authority to disseminate its studies result to public. Its studies results are used as policy inputs to the government. "Lemhannas has no operational authority. Our (Lemhannas) studies results are not to be shared to public but are used as policy-making inputs to the President," said Agus Widjojo.

Meanwhile Roy Suryo, a member of Commission I from Demokrat fraction interested in a study in the last point from seven title delivered by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret)

Agus Widjojo. "I think the first until the sixth points still talk about theory. I am interested with the seventh point which is more technical or more focused on action," Roy Suryo explained.

The study titled "Overcoming Proxy War to Maintain National Security Stability in the Framework of National Resilience", has explained the form of implementation of the proxy war itself. "How is the detail to overcome proxy war in order to maintain national security stability in the framework of national resilience," Roy Suryo asked.

Responding the proxy war, Agus Widjojo said that proxy war is an indirect way to achieve specific interest of a party. "Proxy war is actually a way to achieve specific interest for a party indirectly," Agus Widjojo explained.

Related to Lemhannas strategic studies, DPR RI hopes Lemhannas also involved DPR RI regarding the studies of strategic issues, for example by holding a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) in order to create a synergy between Commission I of DPR RI and Lemhannas RI.●

Head of Public Relations Division Dr. Wahyu Widji P, S.Kom., M.M. accompanied by Head of Protocol and Documentation Lt. Col. (P) Eddy Tarjono welcomed students of IKIP Veteran Semarang in their visit to Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (18/1). The visit, which was implemented as one of Fieldwork Study programs, was held in Syailendra Room, Astagatra Building.

The Dean of Faculty of Social Sciences Education, Drs. Srihadi, M.Pd. said that the purpose of this visit is to learn about nationalistic insight and Pancasila ideology in depth in Lemhannas RI, in accordance with one of the institutional functions namely the strengthening of nationalistic values. "Our visit to Lemhannas RI aims to make the students who will become the teachers of Civic Education to have better understanding in nationalistic

insight, state ideology, and ideology of Pancasila," said Srihadi.

Wahyu Widji also hopes that this visit will be beneficial for the students and the students can use this momentum to gain beneficial material delivered by Professional Expert of Domestic Politics and Human Right Kisnu Haryo Kartiko, S.H., M.A. During the visit, the students were also introduced to Lemhannas RI through video profile playback.

In the beginning of his presentation, Kisnu Haryo explained that understanding nationalistic insight is an important thing. "Every individual should understand about nationalistic insight which means that everyone should understand and acknowledge their surrounding before they understand about anything else further," said Kisnu. According to him, by understanding the nationalistic insight, an individual can understand their

identity, character, and build awareness toward national system in managing nation and state life.

In addition, Kisnu Haryo explained that ideology can be described as an organism that must be developed. Ideology has three dimensions: the dimension of reality, the dimensions of idealism, and the dimensions of flexibility. It is also similar to Pancasila which is also valued as the foundation of the state of Indonesia. At the end of his presentation, Kisnu Haryo concluded that the awareness to build the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia originated from nationalistic insight and the understanding of Pancasila ideology to achieve the ideals of the nation as stated in the fourth paragraph of the 1945 Constitution. Initial Briefing of BPK RI begin financial management audit of 2017 in Lemhannas RI



The Audit Board of Indonesia (BPK RI) conducted an initial briefing related to the financial audit of 2017 in front of Lemhannas RI High-Ranked Officials at Nusantara II Room, Trigatra Building, on Thursday (18/1) morning. The financial audit will be conducted for seventy days by the BPK RI audit team which is chaired by Drs. Heru Kreshna Reza. The initial briefing was attended by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo and Deputy Governor Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito.

Agus Widjojo in his speech hoped that all heads of each working unit can help and establish good cooperation with BPK RI audit team

so the audit run well. "In order to guarantee the audit to run well, all the heads of each working units within Lemhannas RI will assist in this audit implementation conducted by the BPK RI team and expected to establish a good cooperation by providing documents and information needed during the audit," said Agus Widjojo.

After achieving "Reasonable With Exception" (WDP) predicate for 2014 audit by BPK RI, Lemhannas RI continues to improve its performance in accordance with the bureaucracy reform agenda and Lemhannas RI finally achieved "Reasonable Without Exception" (WTP) predicate from BPK RI in 2016. "It cannot be done without the coordination and guidance from BPK RI," Agus Widjojo stated.

Heru Kreshna stated that the purpose of this audit is to adjust Lemhannas RI financial statements with Government Accounting Standards (SAP), sufficient disclosure of financial information, compliance and effectiveness of internal control system.

Heru Kreshna also briefly mentioned some statements from President Joko Widodo which was delivered during the submission of Budget Implementation List (DIPA) for 2015, 2016, and 2017 which stated that the budget must be accountable, and the ministry/institution is required to continuously improve the budget competency in each ministry/institution so the budget allocation can be used for the right target.●

Christmas Celebration Committee of Lemhannas RI organizes social service program

As a series of 2017 Christmas Celebrations, Christmas Celebration Committee of Lemhannas RI organized a social service held at Yayasan Rumah Piatu Muslim located in Kramat Raya, Central Jakarta on Thursday (18/1) and Vincentius Puteri Orphanage in Jatinegara, East Jakarta on Friday (18/1). In the social service, the Committee which is represented by the Chairman of the Committee of Social Service dr. Corrie Mary Milka Inkiriwang, M.A.R.S. handed over a parcel of groceries and cash received directly by the Head of Yayasan Rumah Piatu Muslim Mrs. S.Z. Goenawan and the Head of Vincentius Putri Orphanage Ms. Natal.

Yayasan Rumah Piatu Muslim has been established since 1931, and now, there are 58 children from elementary to high school live in the orphanage and raised by 10 caregivers. While Vincentius Puteri



Orphanage which has been established since 1855 is currently inhabited by 118 children from elementary to high school, accompanied by 11 caregivers and 32 other employees.

Agus Widjojo visit USA, promote Indonesia's democracy

Governor of Lemhannas RI Let. Gen. TNI (Ret.) Agus Widjojo visited USA on Wednesday, (24/1) to attend some events with several institutions in Uncle Sam for 8 days.

During his visit to USA, Agus Widjojo was visiting prominent institutions with some agendas followed, such as being a speaker in the discussion forum at Westminster Institute talking about Indonesia's democracy and pluralism in Westminster Institute on Wednesday (24/1), attending a round table discussion held by Center for a New American Security (CNAS) on Thursday (25/1), then the security threat in Indonesia's maritime jurisdiction in front of members of Center for Asia Pacific Policy of RAND Corporation on the same day.

He also visited National Defense University for 2 days, and then gave presentation about Indonesian military reformation in the Indonesia's democracy transition context at US-Indonesia Society (USINDO) on Tuesday (30/1).

Speaking in front of 30 discussion participants who are mostly writer and researcher in the Westminster Institute, Agus Widjojo explained about the applied democratic government system in Indonesia based on its diversity and differences of society. According to him, the differences ethnic and religion in Indonesia are not easy to be put together, but the founding fathers can accommodate the existing differences through the state constitution into mutual consensus.

Besides promoting about Indonesian democracy and its reformation progress, in his trip to USA, Agus Widjojo also attended some informal event. He took a dinner with

President of USINDO David Merrill, along with the former US Ambassador to Indonesia Mr. Robert Blake on Thursday night, (25/1).

Agus Widjojo also visited the broadcasting agency Voice of America (VoA) on his last day of visit, accompanied by Lemhannas staff. Agus made a round tour in VoA Indonesia office and then had a discussion forum with around 20 media crews of VoA Indonesia who attended this occasion.●



UNS send a hundred of lecturers to join Lemhannas programs

University of Sebelas Maret (UNS) Surakarta sent their lecturers to join the National Values Strengthening Program and leadership training in Lemhannas RI for 8 days, 22-29 January 2018. Lemhannas personnel attend KRISNA features development

As Budget Working Plan for Ministry/State Agency (RKA-K/L) for next year should be arranged on this early year of 2018, Lemhannas RI held a special workshop to discuss the arrangement of RKA-K/L 2019 and to brief the features development and information system utilization of Planning and Budget Performance Information Collaboration (Kolaborasi Perencanaan dan Informasi Kinerja Anggaran/KRISNA) to the heads of working unit in Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (23/1), at Krisna Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The workshop invited two speaker from National Development Planning Agency (Bappenas), they are the Director of System and Procedure for Development Funding Bappenas Ir. Basah Hernowo, M.A., and Acting Head of Sub Directorate of System and Procedure for Regional Government Bappenas Agus Riyanto Kurniawan, S.E., M.Dev. Econ (Adv).

In his presentation, Basah Hernowo mentioned the arrangement of RKA-K/L 2019 by using Planning and Budget Performance Information Collaboration (KRISNA) feature is expected to make the coordination and access information to RKA-K/L easier and quicker by tripartite state agencies whose in charge in this matter the Finance Ministry, Bappenas, and the relevant ministry/state agency. Meanwhile, State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform Ministry will involve in the arrangement of 2019 Working Plan. The central government has arranged the Government Development Plan (RKP) for 2019, emphasizing on the equitable development for quality growth.

Furthermore, there are five national development priority which are human development through poverty reduction and improvement of the basic services; reduction of inequality among regions through strengthening connectivity and maritime affairs; increasing economic added value through agriculture, productive industry and services, strengthening energy security, food security, and water availability; and the last are the national security stability and the success of general election.

The features development and information system utilization of Planning and Budget Performance Information Collaboration (KRISNA) is a database and information for ministry/state agency in planning. This features also serves as media monitoring and evaluation, a tool to control and coordinate in arranging the planning work and performance indicator, a tool to look the logical framework in examining the connection between strategic objective and resulted output, and a tool to analyzing the report (pivot table).●

Minister appeals UNS lecturer to reconstruct curriculum

Research, Technology, and Higher Education Minister (Menristekdikti) Muhammad Nasir was giving a lecture in front the participants of the National Values Strengthening Program for Universitas Sebelas Maret's (UNS) Lecturer (Taplai UNS) on Saturday (27/1), at NKRI Room, Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The Minister conveyed "National Policy of Higher Education in Indonesia in facing the fourth industrial era".

He told that Kemenristekdikti had hold a National Working Meeting (Rakernas) and produced 7 recommendations of priority scale to face the fourth industrial revolution era. Those seven recommendation are including the learning field and student affairs, institutional, resources, strengthening research and development, strengthening innovation, bureaucracy reform, and achieving integrity zone toward Corruption-Free-Zones (WBK) and the Serving and Clean Bureaucracy Zone (WBBM).

According to President Jokowi's direction, Mohammad Nasir also said that all the head of higher education institution must support any innovation to face the global changing and meet the needs of creative, innovative, and competitive human resources. It's because in the 21st digital, the system and the management of higher education need to be adjusted to suit the fourth industrial revolution, among others by reconstructing the curriculum, giving a

broader competency or skills to the students, and using a new learning process format such as face to face, blended learning, and full online learning.

Future challenges faced by the higher education in the fourth industrial era, added Mohammad Nasir, are the increasingly expensive tuition fee and the limited number of the lecturers while the students are increasing. In his explanation in front of the participants of Taplai UNS batch II, Mohammad Nasir also informed one of the solution that can be taken to face those challenges by utilizing the communication and information technology to boost productivity (effective and efficient) as maintaining the quality, harmonizing and developing the existing regulation of higher education. ●



Lemhannas must maintain its "Reasonable without Exception" predicate

After morning call routine on Monday (22/1) morning, Lemhannas RI held a brief information event regarding Lemhannas RI Work Plan (Renja) in 2019 and budget management of 2018 by Head of Planning and Budget Division Colonel (S) Trismawan Djonisajoko, S.E., M.M. representing Head of Planning and Finance Bureau at Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Pancagatra Building.

The presentation aims to share information related to Lemhannas RI budget ceiling which will be used for operational costs in implementing work plan in 2018. On that occasion, Trismawan conveyed a message from President Jokowi during the delivery of Budget Implementation List (DIPA) in 2018 at Bogor Presidential Palace on Wednesday (6/12). On that occasion, Jokowi said that BPK will audit the financial statements of each ministry / institution. Trismawan also advised all working units in Lemhannas RI to maintain the "Reasonable

Without Exception" (WTP) and to improve its performance.

The budget allocation received by Lemhannas RI in 2018 is Rp277,698,000,000 with 99 percent target for budget performance or realization target and 100 percent output. Meanwhile, the budget performance achievement in 2019 is planned to reach 99 percent with proposed work plan taken from the working unit.

"Obviously, this plan can be achieved if we share the data and information needed, share the budget planning and program, and deliver the information regarding Lemhannas RI to the President," Trismawan said.

According to Trismawan, to simplify the budget planning, each working unit should pay attention to whether the work plan created is in line with the vision and mission of President Jokowi or not. "If you get support from the president, in line with the vision and mission, priority scale, of the President,

it would make it easier for Lemhannas RI to get the budget needed," Trismawan added.

As for all work programs implemented, it must be measurable and the process must be transparent because it is a sign of an excellent organization. "Of course, Lemhannas RI work programs must be measured, both output and quality, both time and quantity," Trismawan said in his statement. ●
