Participants of the PPRA (Regular Education Program Batch) LVII and LVIII of Lemhannas RI attend a Public Lecture from the Coordinating Minister of Political, Legal Affairs and Security of the Republic of Indonesia, Gen. (Ret.) Wiranto, on Thursday (26/7) at Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

In front of the participants, Wiranto's public lecture talked about the synchronization of defense forces with national development. In the beginning of his explanation, Wiranto mentioned that based on the policy process theory, the center of government policy was in the executive and legislative branches.

According to Wiranto, the executive and legislative institutions are a forum that continuously cooperate, and discourse to absorb input from public in the form of public opinion and interest.

"The output is in the form of policy politics. The policy is developed in society with the ever-evolving dynamics and the feedback coming into public opinion," Wiranto explained.

On the occasion, Wiranto also talked about national development vision derived from founding father's roadmap in achieving national independence.

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo was present as one of the speakers at the National Symposium held by Expert Council of Indonesian House of Representatives (DPR RI) with the Agency for Pancasila Ideology Education (BPIP) on Monday (30/07), at Crowne Plaza Hotel, Jakarta.

In his presentation, Agus Widjojo explained that there are two things to be considered in the written law; content (substance) and process. “Content itself is not enough to understand the process, our society are not used to understand the process,” Agus explained.

Pancasila, if it refers to the substance of the values contained, it will experience difficulties in its implementation. “If we rely solely on the substance, this is indeed difficult. There will always be those who say ‘this is not the practice of Pancasila,’ this is wrong, Pancasila should not be like this,” Agus Widjojo said.

Continuing his explanation, Agus Widjojo analogizes that in democracy, every matters can be overcome by the process. After the process, we must also learn to be discipline to appreciate the process because it is our collective agreement.

Agus Widjojo also argued that the substance of the values of Pancasila should also be fostered through an unwritten legal instrument that was brought to the community. So far, according to Agus Widjojo, Pancasila values in society still depends on various written law.

The National Symposium which appointed “Pancasila Institutionalization in the Formation and Evaluation of Legislation” which was held for three days aimed to gather the thoughts and views of various sources to find out whether Pancasila values have been in the formation of laws and regulations.

In addition to Agus Widjojo, there was also a keynote speaker in “Discussing Pancasila and Law” session, namely the Head of Research and Development of Ministry of Education and Culture Ir. Totok Suprayitno, Ph.D, Member of the BPIP Steering Board Prof. Dr. Ahmad Syafii Maarif, and Member of the BPIP Special Task Force, Pastor Benny Susetyo.

The National Symposium opened by the Deputy Speaker of the Indonesian House of Representatives Utut Adianto, was attended by 200 participants and presented speakers from different backgrounds. According to Utut, in the decrease of Pancasila values in the community, hopes that new thoughts will emerge to increase public awareness of the importance of Pancasila as a state ideology. “I hope there will be new thoughts from the participants on the concept of Pancasila ideology and its implementation of the Laws and Regulations,” Utut hoped.

Anticipating Hoax, RI Lemhannas Socializing the ITE Law to its officials



After the implementation of routine morning call, Lemhannas RI held a socialization of the Information Act and Electronic Transactions (ITE Law) to all officials on Monday (6/8), at Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

The event was opened by the Chief of the Cooperation Bureau, Commodore Setiawan, S.T. representing the Governor of Lemhannas RI. In his remark, Budi Setiawan conveyed that this socialization was held to improve understanding of all Lemhannas' officials on the ITE Law.

Through the dissemination of this ITE Law, it is expected that all Lemhannas' officials have a deep understanding of the rules contained in the information law and electronic transaction, so they can avoid negative issues and information that can harm themselves and others.

Present as resource persons were the Head of Legal and Public Relations Bureau of National Cyber and Encryption Agency (BSSN), Y.B. Susilo Wibowo, S.E., M.M., and Head of Sub Directorate of Investigation and Action at the Directorate General of Informatics Application of Ministry of Communication and Information, Teguh Arifyadi, M.H.

In his presentation, Susilo Wibowo conveyed about the misuse of hoax information on social media and its anticipation. According to

the data reported from globalwebindex, Indonesia is the third largest country in using various social media platforms.

If it is seen from the negative side, Susilo Wibowo continued, it can potentially disseminate hoax fast. BSSN itself in handling hoax, has done monitoring and profiling social media issues and actors as well as its analysis. In addition, BSSN has also collaborated with the Ministry of Communication and Information and Indonesian police.

Meanwhile, Teguh Arifyadi explained how to deal with negative content by internet users. He delivered negative internet content complaints statistics for January - June 2018 period which was dominated by negative content related to gambling and pornography.

He claimed that with the cyberdone team under the Directorate General of Informatics Applications of the Ministry of Communication and Information, he had worked for almost 24 hours to "record" negative content both pornography, online gambling and disturbing content.

Meanwhile he said that the search for negative content is not only done at the downstream but at the upstream as well. He underlined, to change and minimize the influence of negative content, it must improve the literacy of internet users.

DSCSC of Srilanka visit Lemhannas RI

The Defense Services Command and Staff College of Sri Lanka (DSCSC Srilanka) paid a visit to Lemhannas RI, on Monday (6/8) to hold a discussion in the Airlangga Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

Prior to the discussion, the head of the DSCSC of Srilanka delegation, Colonel GWA Seneviratne USP ndc psc held a Courtesy Call to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo in the Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

Starting the discussion, Professional Expert for Diplomacy and International Relations welcomed and gave a high appreciation for the arrival of the DCSCS of Srilanka delegations.

Sebastianus Sumarsono, S.I.P welcomed the DCSCS Srilanka Delegations to Lemhannas RI. Sebastianus Sumarsono also said that as long as the Regular Education Program (PPR) was held, the Government of SriLanka had sent nine representatives from SriLanka to become education participants.

Continuing the discussion, Head of International Cooperation Division, Colonel Lek Rujito D. Asmoro, Gdipl In DS., M.A., RCDS. conveyed the vision and mission of Lemhannas RI. In addition, he also explained that the Lemhannas were directly responsible to the President through the Coordinating Ministry for Politics, Law and Security.

Lemhannas RI has three tasks, namely to organize education for national level leader cadres, conduct strategic studies and organize strengthening of national values program. Regarding the education sector, Rujito said that in 2018, Lemhannas carries out 2 (two) batches, namely PPRA LVII and LVIII. "This year Lemhannas held two regular education programs, namely PPRA LVII and LVII whose participants came from the military, civil, police, bureaucrats, and academicians," Rujito explained to the DSCSC of Srilanka delegations.

Lemhannas allocates 80 to 100 people to participate in regular education programs (PPR) at Lemhannas RI every year. Participants who will take part in education at Lemhannas RI are required to fulfill the requirements and pass the tests carried out by Lemhannas. PPR which is held for seven months, Rujito said, uses two teaching methods, namely On Campus and Off Campus methods.

Besides PPR, Rujito also explained about Short Education program (PPS) which lasted for five and a half months. For this short program, Rujito explained, participants were required to sit at least as second echelon. The methods used in education is no different from PPR, namely On Campus and Off Campus methods.



PPRA LVII conduct Overseas Strategic Studies



Participants of the Regular Education Program (PPR) Batch LVII of Lemhannas RI conducted Overseas Strategic Studies (SSLN) to 4 (four) destination countries on August 6 to 9, 2018.

This SSLN is one of the learning methods as understanding enrichment after the lecture session, to write a strategic assessment and carry out discussions on the Contemporary Strategic Environment, assessing the extent of the Prospective Bilateral Relations of the destination country with Indonesia in the National Development Perspective.

The purpose of this SSLN implementation is to equip participants about objective conditions that focus on desired topics and can be achieved / obtained from the destination country in order to increase a broader horizon to be used as an input in formulating strategic conceptions for national interests.

The PPRA LVII participants themselves are divided into 4 (four)

groups, each of which simultaneously conducts strategic studies in four countries, namely Poland, Hungary, Romania and Turkey.

In general, the strategic study includes visits to the Indonesian Embassy, several government agencies, strategic objects and other international organizations in each destination country.

In the strategic study, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo accompanied PPRA LVII group to Turkey, while the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito accompanied a group of participants in Hungary. While the Deputy for National Level Leader Education also accompanied the group of participants to Poland.

By conducting this strategic study, it is expected that the participants will have a broader horizon towards the development of the strategic environment of other countries that have an impact on Indonesia.

After carrying out the Overseas Strategic Study (SSLN), Regular Education Program (PPR) Batch LVIII participants conducted the National Management System (Sismennas) Simulation XLVI which was held on August 13-16, 2018 at the Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

Sismennas Simulation, which is one of the main program in the education program, is a simulation of cooperation, coordination and synchronization between institutions in producing and operating a government policy and national development policies that aim to improve people's prosperity.

The aim of this simulation is to transform a unified mindset in governance in an archipelagic insight and national resilience approach and train the education participants in the process of state administration.

The theme raised in this socialization process was "Cross-Sectoral Coordination between Government-related and Stakeholders in order to Respond to the 2019 Political Year as a Decline Point towards Substantive Democracy based on Pancasila".

The lecture began with a speech from the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo and continued with Dr. Cho Kong which was moderated by the Director of Political Studies of Lemhannas RI Drs. Berlian Helmy, M.Ec.

On this occasion, Dr. Kong delivered the relationship of the corporate structure and the building infrastructure of the Shell office in Den Haag. "The future that often changes dynamically and unpredictable as it should is likely to occur, so now scientists often practice to face these challenges. Shell is not an intellectual company but a business company.

Paris Agreement, which is an agreement on climate change agreed in December 2015, is an extraordinary document that offers a pragmatic blue print to solve one of the most difficult problems faced by society to hold back global average temperature rise to be below 2 ° C, above pre-industrial levels. The agreement calls for a balance between antropogenic emissions from various sources and greenhouse gas emissions reductions in the second half of the

century,"Cho Kong said.

According to him, the world needs "balance" or also referred to as "net-zero emissions" in terms of energy systems.

"By learning a lessons from the results of the previous Shell scenario and additional analysis, we are presenting a possible route to achieve Paris Agreement goals, including net-zero emissions from energy use up to 2070. A scenario called 'Sky,'"Kong explained.

Sky Scenario is the latest scenario of PT. Shell, which describes a vision of the future when the community together helps to realize the creation of an emission-free world in 2070. Shell's latest scenario aims to enrich critical thinking of leaders and decision makers in understanding all possible events and uncertainty as an effort to achieve a low-carbon world through Sky scenarios.

Sky Scenario states that to add to the current effort is not enough. Relevant transformations in energy and natural systems require the application of new, disruptive technologies on a mass scale in government policy environments that greatly encourage investment and innovation. Sky presupposes a complex combination of motivating facts that both strengthen and accelerated rapidly by the community, the market, and the government.
