H.E. Kim Chang-Beom gives general lecture in Lemhannas RI



South Korean Ambassador to Indonesia, H.E. Kim Chang-Beom visited Lemhannas RI to give a Public Lecture which was attended by Lemhannas RI officials, Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts and Professional Experts of Lemhannas RI on Monday (19/9) in Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

Kim Chang-Beom was welcomed directly by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo before giving his lecture to conduct a courtesy call in Executive Guest Room at Trigatra Building, 1st Floor, Lemhannas RI.

In a public lecture titled “Indonesia-South Korea Bilateral Relations and the Inter Korea Summit”, Kim Chang-Beom discussed more about “Peace, A New Future: Inter-Korea Summit and Next?”.

Kim Chang-Beom talked about strategic partnerships built by Indonesia and South Korea. He said that the visit of President Joko Widodo to South Korea brought the mission to strengthen economic cooperation amid uncertain global economic conditions.

According to Kim Chang-Beom, South Korea and Indonesia have a Special Strategic Partnership and Indonesia is the only country in the ASEAN that has a strategic partnership with South Korea.

In addition, Kim Chang-Beom also explained that the amount of trade with Indonesia also increase. “The profit reached 9.8 billion US dollars until the first quarter of 2018, and is targeted to reach 30 billion US dollars in 2022,” Kim Chang-Beom explained.

Indonesia and South Korea, Kim Chang-Beom added, have also agreed on cooperation in the defense industry such as in the manufacture of submarines by PT. PAL and DSME Korea. . In addition, this defense industry cooperation can also continue in making Jet Aircraft.

In addition, Kim Chang-Beom also explained about the peace and security agreement between South Korea and North Korea which was used as a new culture and history for Korea. He also stressed that the two countries are serious about carrying out a denuclearization program, especially North Korea.



The Chairpersons of OKP visit Lemhannas RI

On behalf of Governor of Lemhannas RI, the Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI, Brig. Gen. Mindarto received a visit from the Chairmen of Youth Community Organization (OKP) on Friday (21/9) in Nusantara II Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The visit of sixteen OKP chairmen under The National Committee of Indonesian Youth (KNPI) for an audience that meant to ask for advice and input from Lemhannas RI in relation to the National Gathering and National Plenary Leadership Meetings (Silatnas and Rapimpurnas) ahead of the KNPI Congress XV in October 2018.

Dissemination of Lemhannas' Bill Settlement

“Verification of budget accountability is one form of supervision through testing of budgetary accountability documents administratively in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations,” said the Head of Finance Planning Division of Finance and Planning Bureau of Lemhannas RI Colonel Cku Andi Tjarwandi, S.E. when representing the Chief of the Finance and Planning Bureau in the opening of Dissemination of Lemhannas' Bill Settlement at BKT Hotel and Resort, Bogor, Thursday (27/09).

This dissemination was held as one of the efforts to expedite the bill settlement process within the Lemhannas. Settlement of state bills is part of the stages of the state budget implementation carried out by state treasury officials.

In the implementation of the State Budget, the treasury officials cannot work by themselves. There needs to be officers who help with administrative settlement, starting from the preparation of financial accountability, verification, submission of bills, and so on until the disbursement of funds. Therefore, this dissemination invited 46 financial management officers in Lemhannas.

Head of KPPN (State Treasury Service Office) Jakarta VI Wahyu Prihantoro was present as the speaker explaining the completeness of the bill settlement requirements in accordance with PMK (Finance Ministerial Regulation) number 190 and other related PMK. In addition, participants also received material regarding the mechanism of the Fund Withdrawal Plan (RPD) sheet III DIPA, daily, incidental, monthly RPD, as well as rejection and return of bills by Dimas Wijaya from KPPN Jakarta VI.



Training Field Coaches, Program for Strengthening Indonesian Leaders Capacity

Training Field Coaches (TFC) Program for Strengthening Indonesian Leaders Capacity had been held from October 1 until 3, 2018, in Mercure Hotel Sabang, Jakarta (10/3).

TFC is one of the series of Making Indonesia 4.0 which was held by Lemhannas RI together with Coordinating Ministry of Maritime Affairs, Ministry of Research and High Education and United and Diversity (UID).

Meanwhile the TFC itself was attended by participants from three institutions, State Administration Institute (LAN), Ministry of Research and High Education and Lemhannas RI.

Frans, one of the speakers from UID explained that the focus of this program is to give deep understanding about Theory U and System Thinking to improve Indonesian leaders capacity.

Train the trainers from three different institutions; LAN RI, Kemenristek Dikti RI, and Lemhannas RI is expected to produce trainers who can give deep understanding about Theory U and System Thinking to their trainees.

“We hope in 2019 there will be Indonesian leaders capacity building and synergy to create Indonesian leaders who understand global dynamic,” Frans said.

There are three major materials given in the TFC. The first is understanding about sensing to improve sensitivity through SPT (social, presence, theater) system. The second is model mentality which talks about how Theory U process build system to see itself in society. The last is data literation program, technology/digital, and human.

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo gave lecture to the participants of Strengthening of National Values Program (Taplai) for members of Association of Young Indonesian Businesspeople (HIPMI) in Pancasila Room, Trigatra Building, Third Floor, Lemhannas RI, Thursday (11/10). The theme of the lecture is “National Basic Consensus in the Horizon of Nation Journey”.

Starting his lecture, Agus Widjojo said that the archipelago’s insight was a way of looking at himself and his homeland as an archipelago and the attitude of the Indonesian people towards themselves and their environment, by prioritizing regional unity in the implementation of national, state and social life. “Our perspectives must be archipelago-oriented. We are one,” Agus Widjojo explained.

National resilience, Agus Widjojo continued to explain, is a dynamic condition of the nation, containing tenacity and resilience, which contains the ability to develop national strength, in facing and overcoming all challenges, threats, obstacles, and disturbances that come from outside and within. “Basically national resilience is how an object will still be in its original shape after it is stretch,” Agus Widjojo said

Related to national awareness, Agus Widjojo said that we must be aware of all forms of challenges, threats, obstacles, and disturbances that disrupt the nation’s ideology.

Then, Agus Widjojo explained about the aspects used to find out Indonesia’s national resilience level. The aspects are divided into two types ; dynamic and static. The aspects that are relatively static which is called as Trigatra, Agus Widjojo explained, is a geography, natural resources, and demographic. Whereas relatively dynamic aspects are ideology, politics, economics, socio-cultural, and defense security which is called Pancagatra.

The lecture was then continued with a discussion on Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution and the latest national issues.

Ahead of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum, Lemhannas RI Holds Communication Forum

Ahead of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum for the second time in 2018, with the theme “Mapping The Future of Geopolitics” which will be held on October 24, 2018 in Jakarta., Lemhannas RI held a Communication Forum with Mass Media Editor-in-Chiefs at the Trigatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI (15/10).

Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo, when opening the event said that the implementation of JGF was a form of the existence of Lemhannas in the global arena, as one of the institutions in Indonesia that studies geopolitics.

“It is expected that the results of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum in 2018 can provide recommendations to the government regarding the geopolitical dynamics, both at the national, regional and global levels that occur and of course will have an influence on national development,” Agus Widjojo said.

In addition, Prof. Dadan Umar Daihani as Steering Committee Chairman of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2018 stated that there are three main issues to be raised in JGF 2018, namely Trade War Issues, OBOR / BRI Issues, and Indo Pacific Issues. “JGF is expected to be able to provide the mapping of the future geopolitics, in an unpredictable situation, which we must see what will happen and where should we stand,” Prof. Dadan said.

Those three issues will be the focus and see its impact on the world. JGF will be a forum for Geopolitics experts and academicians from all around the world, to become a forum for discussion, and to

give an input for the development of Indonesia’s resilience, both at national, regional and international levels. This is a step to provide recommendations for Indonesia in the midst of world uncertainty, as well as a discussion for Scenario Indonesia 2045.

Besides JGF, Agus Widjojo also talked about hoax or post truth era in the midst of the rapid development of current information and communication technology and socio-political dynamics in Indonesia. According to him, information does not always contained factual truth values. A lot of information is still in doubt. This is a characteristic of the post truth era phenomenon which tends to emphasize opinions and interpretations of existing facts.

While other speakers, Chief Commissioner of Police Drs. Raden Martono Sindhu, M.Sc. Senior Analyst for Science and Technology of Lemhannas RI said that currently, the society often reveals a thing called hoax and post truth, even without any supporting data. The hoax spread is believed to be the truth.

“And if we allow one lie continuously build collective perceptions and gradually form a collective nature and mass destruction and war that will occur. The mass destruction and war that caused by hoax and post truth,” Sindhu explained.

Also attending the forum were LPP TVRI President Director Helmy Yahya, CNN Indonesia President Director Titin Rosmasari, chief representatives, and journalists and a number of structural and functional officials of Lemhannas RI.

Synergy between Lemhannas RI and three institutions through the signing of MoU

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo signed Memorandum of Understanding with Minister of Home Affairs Tjahjo Kumolo, Chairperson of the National Commission on Violence Against Women (Komnas Perempuan) Azriana RM, SH, and Chairperson of the Indonesian Notary Association Yualita Widyadhari in Nusantara Room, Trigatra Building Lemhannas RI, on Monday (15/10).

The Memorandum of Understanding with these three institutions includes improving the quality of human resources through education and training, exchanging experts / academics and strengthening national values, exchanging information in the context of measuring national resilience, conducting strategic studies and other fields according to the needs agreed by the parties in accordance with the applicable legislation.

“In particular, with the Ministry of Home Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, we agree in conducting studies and research, the exchange of experts for assessment, information and technology support in the context of measuring national resilience,” Agus Widjojo said.

The Memorandum of Understanding with the Ministry of Home Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia and Komnas Perempuan is an extension of the previous Memorandum of Understanding that has expired. Meanwhile, the Memorandum of Understanding with the Indonesian Notary Association is a form of joint commitment to establish cooperation. The Indonesian Lemhannas and Komnas Perempuan agreed on strengthening the perspectives of human rights and women’s constitutional rights on education, strategic studies, and strengthening national values aspects.

The commitment and synergy of Lemhannas together with the three institutions are expected to be one of the joint efforts in strengthening nationality insights in supporting the realization of strong national resilience.
