Governor of Lemhannas RI Officially Opens PPRA LIX

The Lemhannas RI's Regular Education Program (PPRA) Batch LIX was officially opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo on Tuesday (22/1) in Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Lemhannas RI.

PPRA itself is an education program held by Lemhannas RI every year for national leaders cadres consisting of various elements and various backgrounds.

In his report, Deputy for National-Level Leader Education of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto stated that this year, PPRA LIX was followed by 100 participants, namely 18 people from Indonesian Army, 11 people from Indonesian Navy, 8 people from Indonesian Air Force, 28 people from Ministries and Government Institutions such as Coordinating Ministry of Politics, Legal, and Security, Ministry of Maritime Affairs, Ministry of Transportation, Ministry of Youth and Sport, Ministry of Religious Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Human Rights, Ministry of Communication and Information, Ministry of Women Empowerment and Child Protection, Ministry of State-Owned Enterprises, Ministry of Public Works and Public Housing, Ministry of Manpower, Healthcare and Social Security Agency (BPJS Health), National Counterterrorism Agency (BNPT), Lemhannas, National Development Planning Board (Bappenas), Financial Services Authority (OJK), and Indonesian Child Protection Commission (KPAI); one person from Private College Coordination (Kopertis); one person Indonesian Chamber of Commerce (KADIN); four people from DPP Muhammadiyah, DPP

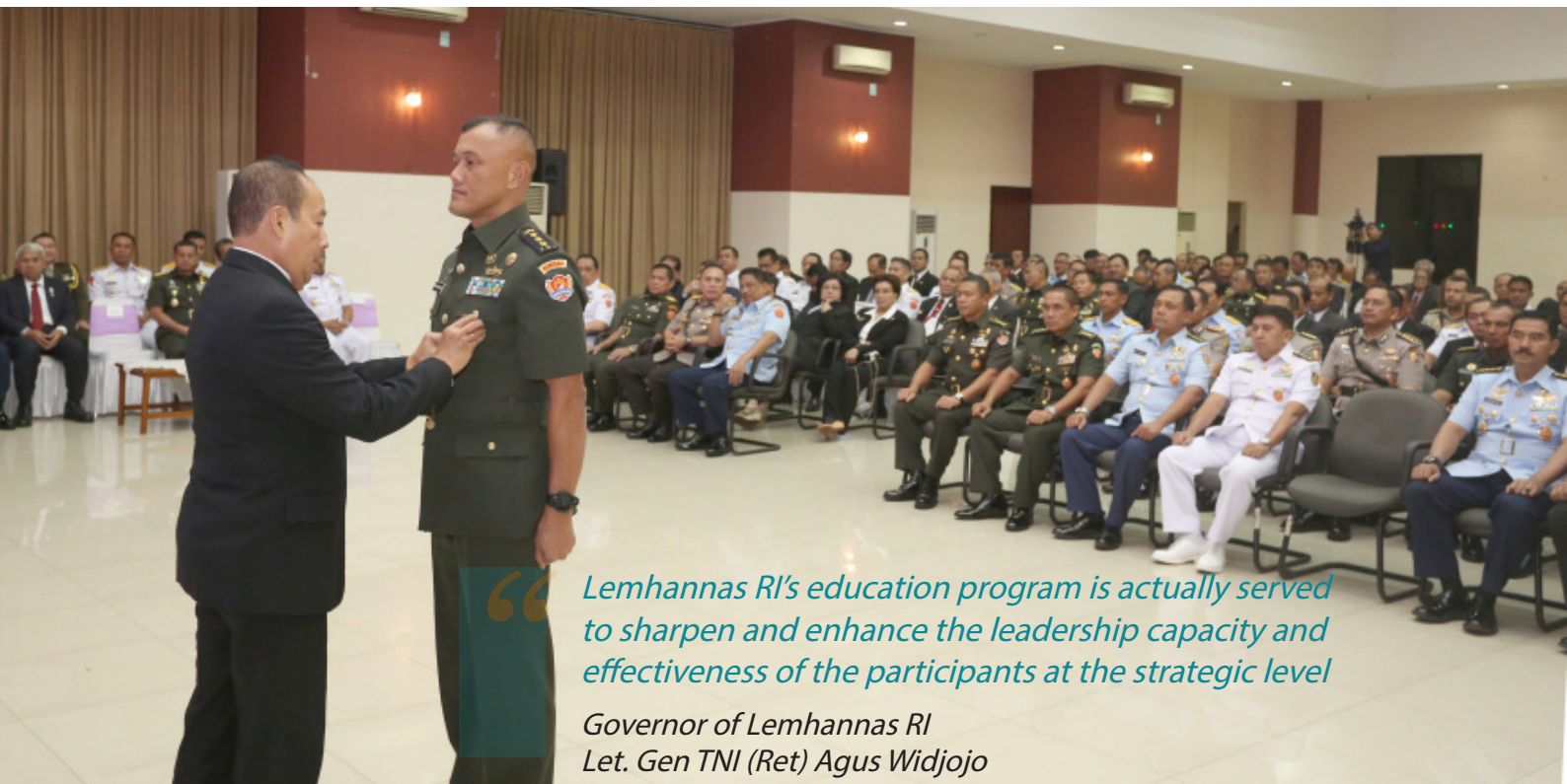
Indonesian Ulema Council (MUI), Bhakti Yogya Foundation, DPW Great Indonesian Creative House; and nine people from friendly countries.

"This education will run for 7 months with a variety of activities such as orientation, outbound, e-learning, strategic studies, lectures, discussions and seminars," Karsiyanto continued

While Agus Widjojo expressed his hope for the participants that this education program can provide motivation to improve leadership quality so that the participants who follow the Lemhannas RI education program were not just formalities. "Carrying out the role as a responsible education participant and not merely pursuing educational formalities in Lemhannas," Agus Widjojo said.

Agus Widjojo also revealed that Lemhannas RI's education program is actually served to sharpen and enhance the leadership capacity and effectiveness of the participants at the strategic level, through competencies that formulate national policies through strengthening national values. Participating in this education, Agus Widjojo said, will become an investment to enrich the participants capacity after graduating from Lemhannas.

In the opening ceremony of PPRA LIX, there were a number of ministries / Institutions representatives from participants such as the National Police Chief which is represented by the Head of the Indonesian Police Public Relations, Inspector General Muhammad Iqbal. In addition, there was also the Deputy Chairperson of the IKAL, General Commissioner of Police (Ret.) Togar Sianipar and former Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Ermaya Suryadinata

Agus Widjojo welcomed the delegation of National Institute for Policy and Strategic Studies (NIPSS) of Nigeria who was led by Director General of NIPSS of Nigeria Mr. Jonathan Mela Juma, mni, on Thursday (24/1) in Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

In the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) which was begun with a Courtesy Call to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Mr. Jonathan Mela Juma said that this MoU signing was expected to strengthen the relationship between NIPSS Nigeria and Lemhannas RI and both institutions can grow together and learn from each other experiences.

Mr. Jonathan Mela Juma, mni, then said that Nigeria and Indonesia face similar challenges so he expected this cooperation can help both countries to find solutions to those challenges. "I hoped this Memorandum of Understanding can be a strong foundation so the diplomatic cooperation of both countries can be done," Mr. Jonathan Mela Juma said in his speech.

Mr. Jonathan Mela Juma also expected there will be more Nigeria citizen visit Indonesia and vice versa. Moreover, He also said that

Indonesian companies in Nigeria also contributes to the economic growth in Nigeria.

Agus Widjojo in his speech said that the MoU signing is a form of Lemhannas RI commitment to cooperate with NIPSS of Nigeria. It is also an effort to strengthen bilateral relationship between two countries which include with rseveral aspects related to the functions ad duties of both institutions.

Regarding the relationship between Indonesia and Nigeria, Agus Widjojo said that cooperation between two countries have been built since 1965. Indonesia then build an its embassy in Lagos which was then moved to Abuja, Nigeria in 2008. Meanwhile Nigeria, Agus Widjojo continued, also build its embassy in Indonesia since 1976.

"Cooperations between both countries has been established really well and keep growing. It is based onf act that both countries have similar position in some areas. Both coutries join Non-Block Movement, member of Organizations of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), member of G77, G15, and D8," Agus Widjojo said.

Agus Widjojo then said that the cooperation between Lemhannas RI and NIPSS of Nigeria focus on improving human resources quality through education, implementing strategic studies for global issues, experts exchange, joint seminar, and other aspects related to both institutions.

Also attended the event were Counselor of Foreign Affairs Ministry of Nigeria Mrs. Beatrice N. Archibong, NIPSS of Nigeria Staff Prof. Kyauta Bulus Tanyigna, Mrs. Abimbola S. Workshop on New Output Proposal for 2020 Fiscal Year Planning

The Head of the Planning Bureau of Lemhannas RI, Air Commander Antonius Sri Munada, S.E., M.M., officially opened the Workshop on New Output Proposal for 2020 Fiscal Year Planning on Monday (28/1) at the Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

In front of all Lemhannas RI employees after the morning routine call, Antonius conveyed several important things related to the planning of Lemhannas RI budget in 2020. According to Antonius, the workshop was important for all Lemhannas employees as part of the management of the National Budget for the 2020 fiscal year.

"This workshop is intended to make all Lemhannas employees obtain information related to budget planning in general and the work unit is able to make new output proposals so that the quality of Lemhannas budget planning will be better. Later on, assistance will be given specifically to the planning employees," Antonius workshop said.

Furthermore, he also mentioned that all planning will begin with the desired vision. "For this reason, we need to know together that Indonesia's vision up to 2025 is to become an independent, developed, just and prosperous Indonesia. Meanwhile the vision of Lemhannas RI is "To Become a Excellent, Credible and World Class Institution in National Resilience"" Antonius said.

On the occasion, Antonius explained the target of achievement of Lemhannas RI Working Performance in 2019-2020, such as, First, the Deputy Office for National-Level Leader Education in 2019 will carry out output programs as many as 230 people consist of 100 people of

PPRA LIX, 80 people of PPSA, and 50 people of P3DA while the 2020 plan proposes an output activity as many as 250 people that consist of PPRA LX activities, 100 people of PPRA LXI, and 50 people of P3DA. As for LIUN activities, the number of outputs in 2019 and 2020 will still be 20 people.

Secondly, the Deputy Office for the Strengthening of National Values in 2019 will carry out output activities as many as 600 people to be carried out through three activities namely Strengthening of National Values Program (Taplai), Training of Trainers (TOT), and national insight dialogue. Meanwhile in 2020, They propose Strengthening of National Values Program (Taplai), Training of Trainers (TOT), and national insight dialogue with a number of output around 5700 people.

Third, the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies in 2019 will carry out a study with 39 outputs while in 2020, they proposed activity with the 59 outputs.

At the end of the presentation, Antonius expressed his hope to all Lemhannas employees for being actively involved in determining the success of the preparation and implementation of Lemhannas program and activities.

"All components from the Top elements to the staff have to work together to improve the performance of Lemhannas. The way to improve the performance of Lemhannas RI starts from ourselves, from now on by putting in our minds and hearts a question that we have to answer together such as 'What can we give every day to Lemhannas to improve its performance,'" Antonius concluded.



To Learn about National Values, The Indonesian Medicine Council visits Lemhannas RI



Representative of the Indonesian Medical Council led by Prof. Dr. dr. Bambang Supriyanto, Sp. A (K) visited Lemhannas RI to hold an audience and was welcomed by the Governor of Lemhannas Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo on Friday (25/1) in the Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

At the beginning of the audience, the chairman of the Indonesian Doctors Council Prof. Dr. dr. Bambang Supriyanto, Sp. A (K) said that the Indonesian Medical Council is an Independent Institution that has the duties and functions to register and guide doctors and dentists throughout Indonesia and is responsible directly to the President.

dr. Bambang then said that as doctors, they were send throughout Indonesia because of doctors are needed, especially in remote area of the country. To prepare the doctors to be sent to various regions in Indonesia, doctors should have a high spirit of nationalism. Therefore, the Indonesian Medical Council hopes that doctors in Indonesia will have the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of national values at Lemhannas RI.

“I hope that doctors can deepen their nationalism before being assigned to other regions throughout Indonesia,” dr. Bambang said.

dr. Bambang also said that the Indonesian Medical Council had sent its representatives to take part in the strengthening of national values program in Lemhannas RI in two batches. Therefore, dr. Bambang hopes the program can be followed by more representatives of doctors and dentists who are members of the Indonesian Medical Council.

Agus Widjojo responded positively to the proposal. Agus Widjojo then explained that many organizations signed the Memorandum of Understanding to routinely attend the strengthening program. The Strengthening the National Values program, Agus Widjojo explained, can be attended by a maximum of 100 participants in one batch so that they can be implemented effectively.

The Audience was then followed by an in-depth discussion about the Strengthening of National Value program.

Lemhannas RI attends the RDP Commission I of DPR RI to present Lemhannas RI's achievement in 2018 and its Work Plan in 2019

Lemhannas RI led by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo attended a Hearing (RDP) with Commission I held in the Commission I Meeting Room, Nusantara Building, House of Representatives of The Republic of Indonesia, on Wednesday (30/1). The RDP which was led by Deputy Chairperson of the Commission I of the Indonesian House of Representatives Asril Hamzah Tanjung, S.IP. discusses the Evaluation of Lemhannas RI Achievement in 2018 and Lemhannas Work Plan in 2019.

In his presentation in front of the Commission I, Agus Widjojo said that from the 2018 budget which was set at Rp. 288. 239. 118. 000, -, the achievement of the Lemhannas RI budget performance is 99.06% of Rp. 285,563,266,909, -. Agus Widjojo also said that Lemhannas RI in 2017 received the predicate "Reasonable Without Exception" from the Supreme Audit Agency (BPK RI) for the examination result of the management of Lemhannas budget in 2017 and received the title "B" from Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Buraucracy Reform (Kemenpan RB) for the SAKIP evaluation result and implementation of 2017 bureaucratic reform.

Regarding the work plan in 2019, Agus widjojo continued, Lemhannas RI received Rp. 201,379,786,000. Agus Widjojo then explained that the budget was divided into three focuses, namely the management support and the implementation of other technical duties budget of Rp. 137,320,648,000, -, the supervisory and increased accountability of the apparatus budget of Rp. 1,789,863,000, - and the developing national security budget is Rp. 62,269,275,000.

The management support and the implementation of other technical duties budget, Agus Widjojo explained, are divided into five

services, namely Public Relations Service, Planning and Finance Service, General Affairs Service, Cooperation Service, and Telematics Service. Meanwhile, the national defense development budget is divided into four parts, namely the Deputy Office for National-Level Leader Education, the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies, the Deputy Office for Strengthening of National Values Program, and the Laboratory Center.

The meeting was then followed by a discussion on issues relating to radicalism, politics, and studies conducted by Lemhannas RI.

At the end of the meeting, Asril Hamzah Tanjung stated a number of conclusions from the RDP, namely commission I asking Lemhannas RI to conduct studies in an effort to counter the escalation of the danger of money politics in various levels of political activity and the danger posed as threats to democracy and culture. The second conclusion, Asrim Hamzah Tanjung explained, was Commission I asking Lemhannas RI to continue to disseminate information on the results of strategic studies related to national politics to the society selectively.

Regarding to the issues in the community related to the surplus of the middle and high ranks officers in Indonesian Military, Asril Hamzah Tanjung revealed that Commission I asked Lemhannas RI to take part in a study to assist the positions and services management within Indonesian Military and recommendations for solutions.

In the meeting, Governor of Lemhannas RI was accompanied by Deputy of National-Level Leader Education Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto, Deputy of Strengthening of National Values Maj. Gen. (Mar) Guntur Irianto Ciptolelono, Acting Deputy of Strategic Studies Brig. Gen. of Police Drs. Basuki, M.M., Chiefs of Bureaus, Professional Expert of Lemhannas RI, and Lemhannas RI's staffs.



The Governor of Lemhannas RI Becomes a Speaker at Satu Meja



The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo became one of the speakers at Satu Meja at Kompas TV on Wednesday (1/30). The event was also attended by Mochtar Pabottingi, Dr. Dina Wisnu, and Sudirman Said. On this occasion, Agus Widjojo saw that the reform phenomenon in Indonesia resulted in suppression of democracy to create a free political system.

“Reform is an effort to build a democratic, or more democratic political system if we have actually tried from the very beginning to build a democratic political system,” Agus Widjojo said.

According to him, democracy leads to freedom but in the process of democratization, it cannot be separated from the values that apply in the society. Freedom, Agus Widjojo explained, actually moves to leave a centralized or authoritarian system.

“However, when you want to change into freedom, freedom itself is not enough because it can be torn apart if it is not bounded by important elements. The freedom that is torn apart means a freedom which leads to anarchy. It will happen if it is not tied to responsibility,” Agus Widjojo said.

“There is no freedom without obligation and a sense of responsibility because to adopt and try to pursue freedom will look easier but then, responsibility is forgotten,” Agus added.

Furthermore, he stated the fact that freedom itself contained responsibilities such as two sides of a coin that were inseparable. According to him, it cannot be separated from our traditional culture, such as individual responsibility which is not a strong characteristic in our traditional cultural systems.

“Since childhood, children have been taught one source of truth in the family which is parents. If there are problems in the family, the head of the family will decide the solution and the children will obey. In education, the source of truth in schools is teachers,” Agus Widjojo said.

According to him, this phenomenon resulted to a culture that grew in the community, the source of truth, called as boss. This is where the origin of “apple polishing” exist in our community. The traditional culture of giving freedom is responsible for taking a decision by ourselves in the family, and parents who consider what is the best for their children.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret.) Agus Widjojo was invited as a keynote speaker for “Seeking Clean and Virtuous Leaders for Indonesia” Seminar, which was held by Sam Ratulangi University (Unsrat) Alumni Network on Saturday (2/2) at Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

In the seminar, Agus Widjojo argued that the formation of leaders in national politics was not enough without a system that facilitated cadres to undergo trial and error. Agus Widjojo also said that it was too risky if the leader was left to grow alone. According to Agus Widjojo, it is political parties’ task to create that system.

Agus Widjojo considers that political parties that function effectively will carry out the process of looking for leaders start with recruitment so that they can distinguish them (red-prospective leaders) who show leadership traits and are included in the leader’s preparation process.

“Political party is also a part of process of accelerating the cadre of leaders who show talent, by giving priority to the acceleration of debriefing of experience, self-development, increasing challenges and promotion of responsibility. This whole process is certainly fenced off with a system of rewards and punishment,” Agus Widjojo explained.

Agus Widjojo also added that if political parties function effectively in recruiting prospective leaders, then voters will be presented with al-

ternative candidates who are clean, competent and have a good quality. According to Agus Widjojo, leader selection in a democratic system is the selection of leaders based on “political market”.

In addition to discussing the role of political parties in producing good quality national leaders, Agus Widjojo also stated that in an effort to find wise and competent (and clean) leaders, we must play a role in the system of selection and fostering leaders so that leaders are born in accordance with the desired characteristics.

“We cannot create leaders just by listing the characteristics we want from a leader and hoping the leader will be born alone,” Agus concluded.

Perista's Routine Meeting Presents Micro Expression Expert

The Association of Lemhannas Officials' Wives (Perista Lemhannas RI) held the first routine meeting in 2019 on Monday (11/1) in Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Pancagatra Building, 2nd Floor, Lemhannas RI. The meeting which was opened by the chairman of Perista, Mrs. Ninik Agus Widjojo, also invited all Lemhannas female employees.

On this occasion, Perista Lemhannas RI invited Micro Expression Expert, Poppy Amalya. Ninik Agus Widjojo said in her speech that knowing people's expression is very important so as not to misinterpret the intentions of the person's expression. Ninik also introduced several new members of Perista Lemhannas RI who were present at the event.

In her explanation, Poppy Amalya introduced that micro expression is a way of reading the human mind by looking at the facial expressions and body language shown by a person. Micro expression can be seen in 0.4 seconds. So, Poppy said, evidence was needed by recording the expression during interviews.



Poppy then explained that micro expression was first discovered by Paul Ekman, a psychologist who conducted research on facial expressions for 50 years. From the study, Poppy explained, it was found that humans have facial expressions from birth so that babies can also express their emotions through the same facial expression as adult.

Lemhannas RI held a Flag-Raising Ceremony in Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI, Monday (18/2). In strategic studies, Agus Widjojo said that Lemhannas RI had planned the implementation of various studies in various fields both in the short and long term. Strategic results of the study are expected to be submitted to the president as a form of input into policy making.

Moreover, in strengthening of national values program, Agus Widjojo said that there had been a consolidation and it is expected that the program met the targets.

Seeing recent political dynamic, Agus Widjojo also reminded all state servants both from the Military, Police and state civil apparatus to be able to be neutral in the midst of society. "Before closing this, I reminded that the of presidential election and the regional election for DPR RI, DPD RI and DPRD in 2019 are getting closer. With the increasing temperature of politics in the community, I remind you that as state servants whether from the Military, Police, and state civil apparatus are able to be neutral, in the midst of society even though a state civil apparatus has the political right to vote on the election day," Agus Widjojo concluded.
