This event was intended to establish friendship as well as to have a discussion with influencers and to build equal perceptions and synergies between Lemhannas RI and influencers.

In addition, in accordance with the theme raised, this event also aims to increase the spirit of heroism, especially the millennial generation including the influencers. The influencers are expected to contribute in maintaining the integrity of the Republic of Indonesia. The event was moderated by Iman Brotoseno and Netty Nursi.

In his remarks, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo said that currently, the Indonesian people were in several transitional periods at once. “Some of them are in political transitions, cultural transitions, technological revo-

lution transitions, and generation transitions,” Agus said.

According to Agus, the current political transition is transitioning from authoritarian to democracy. The transition then demands a cultural transition from traditional, paternalistic towards a more democratic egalitarian culture which is a requirement for democracy itself. The development of technology today has also entered the era of the industrial revolution 4.0. The Last is the generational transition. “whether you realize it or not, whether you want it or not, Indonesia is in a generation transition,” Agus stated.

On this occasion, several influencers such as Yosie Project Pop, Christine Hakim, and Addie MS were presented. Yosie said that he is currently active in Digital Literacy in Cyber Creation as well as Nationalism and Radical (Nakal). Digital Literacy in Cyber Creation is a reactionary movement towards negative content and disinformation. While Nationalism and Radical (Nakal) is a movement through

historical discussion that goes to campus and school.

While Christine Hakim said that there were two things that became the protectors in the nation and state life which are culture and the next generation. “If these two things are broken, this nation will ruin,” Christine said. Christine said that culture is certainly not only about products, but also about human civilization. Unfortunately, according to her, there is a lack in assessing the history of Indonesian civilization due to historical references were only written by historians and invaders with their perspective. Christine also emphasized that it is very important to see culture not just about products.

Lemhannas RI signs Memorandum of Understanding with BPIP and BPS

Lemhannas RI signed a memorandum of understanding with the Agency for Pancasila Ideology (BPIP) and the Central Statistics Agency (BPS) on Monday (9/12), in Nusantara Room, Trigatra Building. Basically, this memorandum of understanding was carried out to increase efforts in carrying out the roles and functions of their respective agencies.

The memorandum of understanding with BPIP regulates the coordination and cooperation in the use of expertise, the implementation of socialization in the context of fostering the ideology of Pancasila, the harmonization of the material for the development of Pancasila ideology, the measurement of the Pancasila ideology index, as well as the preparation of teaching materials, determination of teaching qualifications, methods and implementation of Pancasila education.

Whereas the memorandum of understanding with BPS covers the improvement of the quality of human resources and the strengthening national values, studies and the implementation of studies and research, support for conducting census and / or survey program, and the provision, utilization and development of data and statistical information in the field of national resilience.

On this occasion, the Acting Head of BPIP, Prof. Hariyono expressed his hope that the collaboration can make Pancasila filled with achievement and innovation. "Hopefully this collaboration can strengthen Pancasila as a state foundation as well as guide the nation to the future," Hariyono said.



While BPS Chief Inspector Ahmad Jaelani, who represented the Head of BPS Suhariyanto, said that Lemhannas RI is one of the state institutions that had very important and strategic tasks. In 2007, Lemhannas RI established the National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas) in order to increase the capacity and quality of the implementation of its basic tasks and functions. The development of the National Resilience Measurement System (Siskurtannas) is also created as an effort to realize national development acceleration and increase national resilience.

"For BPS, Siskurtannas is a milestone in the model of information services to data users. Lemhannas RI through the application has stimulated BPS to transform into an era of data interoperability," Ahmad continued. Siskurtannas is also the first application to successfully implement electronic data exchange with BPS.

"I hope the memorandum of understanding can be implemented with full commitment by both parties and can be a good start for the cooperation between both institutions in the future," Ahmad said while closing his remarks.

According to the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, this collaboration certainly has important meaning for increasing the capacity and capability of the three institutions in accordance with their main duties and functions. "It is hoped that it can further encourage the creation of synergy and collaboration between Lemhannas RI and the Central Statistics Agency (BPS) and Agency for Pancasila Ideology (BPIP) in carrying out their respective duties and functions," Agus concluded.

SA number of Lemhannas RI's Structural Officials, Faculty Members, as well as personnel attended the State Defense Day ceremony at Lemhannas RI's central Square, Thursday (19/12). Acting as the Inspector of the Ceremony, the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan who deliver the remark of the Governor of Lemhannas RI.

The commemoration of Stat Defense Day of 2019 has the theme "Defending the State for the Prosperity of the People". Reading the mandate of the Governor of Lemhannas, Wieko explained that in accordance with Law Number 3 of 2002 Concerning National Defense, state defense is an attitude and behavior of citizens imbued with his love for the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia based on the Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution in establishing the survival of the whole nation and state.

"In the recent times, Indonesia has been confronted with a phenomenon of disruption in which various things are uprooted and there is a shift of actors both in the political, economic, educational and other aspects," Wieko said.

Furthermore Wieko who read the mandate of the Governor of Lemhannas RI explained that awareness of state defense sourced in the noble values of the nation must be embedded in the soul of Indonesian people from an early age through the education and acts of state defense in various fields.

"I believe, until now, various forms of state defense have been realized by the nation's leaders and successors to show the world that the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia remains and will continue to exist," Wieko said.

The state defense is not an easy task along with the increasingly complex challenges, threats, disturbances, and

obstacles faced. However, the synergy of all Indonesian people must be able to bring Indonesia to become a sovereign, just, and prosperous country.

The State Defense Day is celebrated every 19 December based on the issuance of Presidential Decree No. 28 of 2006. The History of the State Defense began on 19 December 1948 when Syafoeddin Prawiranegara established the Emergency Government of the Republic of Indonesia (PDRI) in Bukittinggi to defend the nation. At that time, besides the government vacuum, there was also Dutch Military Aggression II and the arrest of Sukarno, Hatta, Sjahrir, and several other figures.
