The PPRA 60 will be held for seven months consist of off campus, on campus, Domestic Strategic Study (SSDN), Overseas Strategic Study (SSLN), and other programs.

Enhancing the Quality of Faculty Members, Lemhannas RI holds Consolidation and Evaluation

Lemhannas RI held a Consolidation of Education Program Implementation and Evaluation and Explanation of Study Policy Principles and Strengthening the National Values Program of 2020 which was opened by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan on Wednesday (15/01), at Pancasila Room, Trigatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI.

The consolidation which was held for two days is the first step as an effort to urge the implementation of education programs, strategic studies, and the strengthening national values program of 2020 achieve the targets planned.

The Deputy for National-Level Leader Education Major General

Karsiyanto in his report stated that the consolidation means to prepare the Faculty Members (Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts, and Professional Experts), and also Structural and Funtional Officials of Lemhannas RI in supporting the implementation of education programs, strategic studies, and the strengthening national values program of 2020.

According to Wieko on behalf of the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, this consolidations is important and strategic in the preparation process of and strengthening the national-level leader cadres who will join the education program in 2020.

The result of the annual evaluation

in 2019 showed that the improvements are needed in planning, implementation, and closing steps. The improvements aim to improve the quality to result not only in good output but also an excellent outcome. "All related aspects must be followed up seriously and responsibly according to its own role and functions," Wieko continued.

The consolidation also socialized technical instructions of scientific writing which will be applied in PPRA 60, PPRA 61, and P3DA 11. It is expected that deep comprehensive understanding of the technical instructions can result in the implementation of directed education programs and reach the targets planned.

The Pre-Course was opened by the Chief of Cooperation and Legal Bureau

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Officially Opens PPRA 60



The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo officially opened the Regular Education Program Batch 60 (PPRA 60) which will last for seven months on Tuesday (21/1) at Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Lemhannas RI.

The Deputy for National-Level Leader Education Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto in his report conveyed that PPRA 60 will be implemented through two stages, 1,5 months will consist of orientation, outbound, and e-learning called as off-campus, and the second stage for 5,5 months in Lemhannas RI called as on-campus.

PPRA 60 is followed by 100 participants coming from different professional backgrounds such as fourteen participant from Ministries/ Non-Ministrial Government Institutions, one participant from political party, two participants from the Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Kadin), eight participants from

community organization, fourty participants from The Indonesian Military, twenty participants from the Indonesian Police, and nine participants from friendly countries namely Australia, Bangladesh, India, Fiji, Cambodia, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka.

On the occasion, Agus said that the participants must have the determination to carry out a mental revolution of attitudes and behaviors transformation which reflects the image of national-level leader cadre with strong nationality. Mental revolution in formation of strong leadership is not only achieved through teaching good leadership and mentality, but also by showing tangible evidence where the participants follow and obey all the rules and regulations required by the institution to meet the graduation requirements.

The education program in Lemhannas RI aims to sharpen and

improve the leadership capacity and effectiveness of the participants. The intended leadership is at the strategic state through competence in formulating relevant national policy which is functionally needed functionally through the integration of strengthening the national values.

Furthermore, Agus explained that the education program is a refreshment and investment to enrich the participants' capacity in their respective fields after graduating from Lemhannas RI. "It is important for the participants to use this opportunity to enrich their capacity in their respective fields," Agus said.

Linda Agum Gumelar:

“Practice SADARI Method to Detect Early Breast Cancer,”



Perista of Lemhannas RI (the Association of Lemhannas RI's officials wives) held a socialization on the Detection of Early Breast Cancer cooperated with YKPI (the Indonesia Breast Cancer Foundation) on Tuesday (21/01) at Konstitusi Room, Trigatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI.

This quarterly meeting was attended by invited guests and female staffs of Lemhannas RI. This socialization was also attended by Linda Agum Gumelar as the Chairwoman of YKPI, dr. Martha Roida Manurung from Dharmais Cancer Hospital Jakarta, and staffs of YKPI.

Given the importance of maintaining health for women, the Acting Chairwoman of Perista of Lemhannas RI, Lisa Wiekko Syofyan who opened the socialization conveyed

about the importance of maintaining health for women. “Maintaining health for women is such an important thing and we should pay attention to it early to avoid various types of health issues,” Lisa said.

Meanwhile, Linda Gumelar said that the amount of cancer patients in Indonesia is increasing every year. According to the data from Dharmais Cancer Hospital, 56 percent of cancer patients at Dharmais Cancer Hospital is suffer from breast cancer and 70 percent of the breast cancer patients there are mostly advanced-stage cancer patients. “Breast Cancer occur mainly in women, but men can get it, too. At YKPI, there are two men diagnosed with breast cancer,” Linda Said.

YKPI has been running its socialization program to every part of the country such as East Nusa Tenggara

(NTT), Papua, and other provinces. It also has a shelter house which is visited by patients from many regions in Indonesia such as Medan, Maluku, Lampung, Pontianak, and other regions. “We also have mammography car unit cooperates with Dharmais Cancer Hospital as a part of our visions which is “Making Indonesia free from advanced breast cancer,” Linda added.

Linda Gumelar also reminded everyone to practice SADARI method (breast self-examination) to detect early breast cancer. This method is practiced directly by dr. Martha and followed by all socialization participants. Linda also encourage to a newly diagnosed breast cancer patient, whether benign or malignant, to as soon as possible see the doctor to undergo clinical treatment.

Dr. Martha herself explained that early-stage breast cancer has no specific symptoms. “Patients will not know that they suffer breast cancer because they do not feel anything wrong in their body. This is where the early detection play its role to find the abnormality,” said dr. Martha. According to her, the more dangerous thing is those cancer can spread to other internal organs. “Oftentimes, it does not show any symptom at the breasts, but when it spreads to other internal organs like lungs, bones, and show several symptoms, the patient come to see the doctor for treatments,” dr. Martha said.

issues emerged," Radar explained.

The meeting, Radar added, had resulted some conclusions and recommendations. Those national issues mentioned were Radicalism, excellent human being, Papua, Industrial Revolution 4.0., and Civilization and Culture, those conclusions and recommendations are expected to be used as studies materials at Lemhannas RI as Government's think tank.

On the occasion, Radar said that people are now become the victims of the civilization and culture shifting that resulted in the declining of people's ethics and behaviors. "Our culture is experiencing degradation, at its lowest," MBI stated.

Radar believes that resilience or defense must be carried out by humans. If that can be done by 265 million people with a cultural character, it will create a

Responded to that, Agus said that currently, Indonesia is experiencing transition period, one of which is cultural transition. According to Agus, related to cultural character, Indonesia can conduct benchmarking study to Japanese who famous for their discipline and togetherness.

Agus also explained that resilience and defense are two different things. Resilience, Agus said, is an ability of a society to empower its resources to encounter the challenges threatening its survival.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI gives lecture to PPRA 60 Participants

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo gave lecture to PPRA 60 (Regular Education Program Batch 60) participants on Thursday (23/01) at Auditorium Gajah Mada.

During the lecture, Agus emphasized the introduction to Lemhannas RI, the writing of Individual Scientific Paper (Taskap), and critical thinking. Agus explained that at the beginning of its establishment, Lemhannas RI used to be national defense institute. Along

with the rapidly developing strategic environment, Lemhannas RI has finally become a national resilience institute.

Agus also explained that national values such as four basic consensus of the nation (Pancasila, The 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia, the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia, and Unity in Diversity) and national paradigm (Archipelago Insights, National Resilience, and National Vigilance) have become the core of Lemhannas RI in carrying out its functions.

Related to the Taskap writing, Agus conveyed that several criteria of scientific writing is the objective fact as its background; systemically, conceptually, and procedurally arranged using certain method; written correctly



with effective language; contains point of views supported by evidence based on hypotheses (temporary answer to presumptive problems because they still need to be proven) are not estimations; and contain factual truth.

Related to the Taskap topic, Agus said that it can be chosen through several researches in relations to similar topic conducted in the past. "There is a gap that leaves us with questions in the research stages that had been done in the past and can be used as the research topic," Agus said.

Agus also explained that in Taskap arrangement, the participants must have logical scientific thinking such as the problem identification, factual data collection, data analysis (logic and cause and effect process) until the

conclusion and suggestion.

In addition, according to Agus, in writing a Taskap, the participants need to think critically where a process of thinking follows a broad range of attitudes and skills towards oneself and others. "To develop the ability to think critically requires attention to detail, identifying patterns and inclinations, repetition, seeing from a different perspective and objective, and considering the consequences and implications in the future," Agus added.

In the lecture which was attended by Faculty Members and several structural officials of Lemhannas RI, Agus held a question and answer session to PPRA 60 participants to talk about the material that had been delivered.
