## Lemhannas RI conducted the 2012 Training of Trainers (ToT) in 2012 at the Dwiwarna Building Floor I, Lemhannas RI on Monday (6/2/2012) at 08.00 A.M.

With the theme “**Strengthening of National Values in Lemhannas RI Year 2012**”, the event intended for the Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts and Expert Professionals was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., and was attended by Deputy Governor, Principal Secretary and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI.

After the opening, the event was continued with a briefing from the Governor on the 3rd Floor, West Wing of Panca Gatra Building on the topic “the Building of National Character”, which was later followed by the Deputy Governor Lt. Gen. Moeldoko, S.I.P. regarding the purpose of the ToT and the efforts made by the nation in building optimism.

The Training of Trainers is scheduled to last for 5 (five) days, from 6 to 10 February 2012. Through this activity, the participants are expected to have the same perception of the teaching methods and materials in Lemhannas RI.





# INDONESIA, STILL FULL OF HOPE

**“Does Indonesia still have hopes amidst an atmosphere of pessimism among the people?” the intriguing question came up from Maulana Isnarto, the moderator of a dialogue on nationalism which was held in cooperation between LPP RRI and Lemhannas RI (31/1).**

The event themed **“Indonesia Still Full of Hope”** was broadcast live by Program 3 RRI, with the speakers Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., the Director of LPP RRI Dra. Niken Widiastuti, Imam Prasojo, sociologist from the University of Indonesia, UI, and the Powerplan Program Chief of SMKN 29 Jakarta Budiman in order to discuss the hope and optimism for Indonesia.

Currently, Indonesia is facing various social injustice issues, such as gaps in information, accessibility issues, employment, education, and etc. “The Indonesian people still have the potential for conflict, but what is important is how to address the belief, ethnic group, and racial differences,” said the Governor Lemhannas RI.

The national mass media are currently required to promote media literacy in the community so that they will be able to respond to overwhelming news of violence more cleverly. They should look for the root of the problem when reporting news and avoid media sensation. Negative views on Indonesia often appear in the media along with the increased problems and conflicts, both vertically and

horizontally. “This is at odds with the fact that the Indonesia’s economy rose 6.2% in 2011, and an estimated 6.7% this year. This certainly is an optimism,” said Niken Widiastuti when addressing the pivotal role played by the national mass media in spreading the optimism in the community.

According to the sociologist Imam Prasojo, the government and media play a very important role in shaping expectations and empowering the community. “From the creative aspect of the community, it is still lacking, but the roles of the government and media are very important in the empowerment that is now pioneered by the community. The government is required to make a policy that is favourable to the people, to develop creativity and open up job opportunities for the community,” said Imam Prasojo.

# EMPOWERMENT OF NATIONAL CAPACITY IN KOHANUDNAS

**The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. acts as a speaker at a workshop organized by the National Air Defence Command (Kohanudnas) on Tuesday (7/2/12) in order to commemorate Kohanudnas' 50th anniversary in Persada Club, Halim PK.**

The event themed "the Development Strategies for Kohanudnas in the Future" was attended by the Kohanudnas Commander Air Marshal J.F.P. Sitompul, the Director of Human Resources from the University of Defense Air Commander Suparman Djapri, and Commander of the National Air Defence (Hanudnas) Sector III Air Commander Bonar Hutagaol.

One important element in maintaining the territorial integrity of the Unitary State of Indonesia lies in the roles and performance of Kohanudnas, which is to protect and patrol the air territory and to guard the airspace jurisdiction of Indonesia.

It is within this framework that the national capacities related to the national civil aviation system and infrastructure needs to be empowered so that it will integrate with the air defense systems managed by Kohanudnas, as outlined in the reliable standard operating procedures.

"The radars of military's air defence and civil aviation need to be integrated in the operation of air defence", said the Governor Lemhannas RI when delivering his paper at the workshop.

Furthermore, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the Civil Aviation Radar Network which has been deployed to the regions is able to close the gaps which are not covered by the military's air defence radars, therefore, both of them need to be integrated.

The governor of Lemhannas RI hoped that there will be a cross-sectoral ad-hoc cooperation between the ministry of defense and related agencies in bridging various interests, whilst waiting for the issuance of laws related to the transformation of national resources for the sake of national defense. The empowerment of national capacities in improving the performance of Kohanudnas can be carried out by building the air defence strength through improvement in its role and capacity as supporting components.

"The improvement in role and capacity can be carried out through the revitalization of the defense industry by developing and manufacturing of primary weaponry defense system. Juridically this has been realized through the Presidential Decree No. 41 of 2010 on General Policy of National Defence, which is further regulated by the Presidential Decree No. 42 of 2010 on the National Committee for the Defense Industry", said the governor of Lemhannas RI in his concluding remarks.





# SOUTH CHINA SEA AS A FLASH POINT IN THE ASIA PACIFIC REGION

**The South China Sea has now become one of the flash points in the Asia Pacific region. The waters dispute does not only involve six countries, namely China, Taiwan, Vietnam, the Philippines, Brunei and Malaysia, but also concerns with the interests of major powers in the region such as the United States.**

The statement above was conveyed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. as a speaker in an evening discussion organized by the Founding Fathers House on Tuesday night (7/2/12).

Regarding the South China Sea dispute, since the early 1990s Indonesia has predicted that the waters would be come a flash point in the region, and therefore, it has encouraged Indonesia to actively seek solutions the South China Sea dispute.

“The political and security dynamics that are now

occurring in the South China Sea involve great powers with different interests,” expressed the president in his elaboration.

It is said in his paper that Indonesia’s strategic interests in the waters cover three aspects, which are political, economic and military. Therefore, in order to maintain regional security and stability in the South China Sea, the countries involved, either the claimant or non-claimant states, should take the following approaches: **first**; refrain from provocative actions; **second**, accelerate the creation of Code of Conduct (CoC) in South China Sea, **third**; set the roles of non-state actors.

The evening discussion was started at 7 P.M., and was attended by the Chairman of the Founding Fathers House Ir. Suko Sudarso and all the board management as well as experts from Lemhannas RI.
