



## Leadership Characters Needed for Jakarta

Jakarta, as the center of economy, culture, ports, and the entry door to Indonesia certainly has many problems that need to be immediately addressed and resolved. "The Dutch built Batavia, now Jakarta, was not for 10 million people in mind as it is now, but for 250 thousand people only," said former Governor of Jakarta Sutiyoso in a Dialogue on Nationalism of Lemhannas RI and LPP RRI in Radio PRO3 RRI (22/02/12).

The dialogue with the theme "Leadership Characters Needed for Jakarta" featured the Governor of Lemhannas RI Budi Susilo Soepandji, President Director of LPP RRI Niken Widiastuti, and former Jakarta Governor Sutiyoso as resource persons.

"We need a leader with national moral characters and values. He or she should be intelligent, honest, and consistent," said the Governor of Lemhannas RI Budi Susilo Soepandji when asked by Maulana Isnarto what kind of characters needed for a governor. A former Jakarta Governor Sutiyoso added that the figure for the future leader of Jakarta should really know the problems faced by Jakarta, ranging from population density, the influx of 250 thousand of unskilled people each year into Jakarta, the geographical condition of Jakarta where 40% of which is below sea level, traffic congestion, and social gap issues. The next governor of Jakarta should also be able support the Jakarta's satellite

"The Jakarta governor should have leadership qualities to protect, give a feeling of security to the people and to serve. Therefore, the future governor of Jakarta is required to have the courage to execute all plans, and

Indonesia needs to learn from Tokyo which is able to connect all areas with a good mass transportation system, added the Managing Director of LPP RRI Niken Widiastuti.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the problems faced by Jakarta is a national, intersectoral issues. They could not be handled by the governor alone.
