Low Understanding of the Amendment of the 1945 Constitution

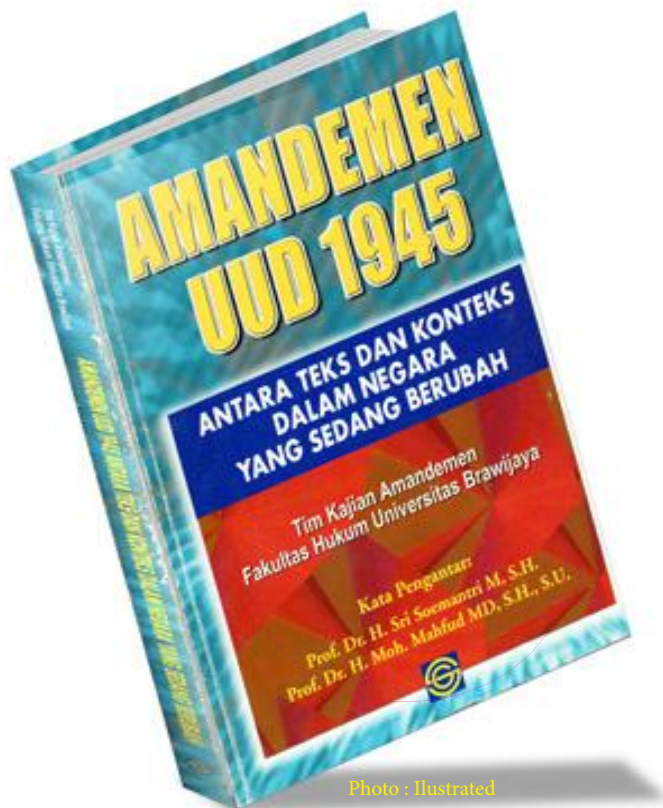

“Dissemination of the outcome of amendments had been carried out intensively and continuously, however, the understanding of the people at all levels of society, has shown no signs of progress”.

It was revealed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. when opening a Roundtable Discussion on the Understanding of the Values of the 1945 Constitution on Friday (15/6) in Nusantara I meeting room, Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI, Jakarta.

The event attended by the Deputy Governor, Secretary of the Governing Board, Principal Secretary, Deputies and Research Team of Lemhannas RI was aimed at discussing the results of research related to the understanding of national values and the values of 1945 Constitution. It was prepared by Working Groups of the Office of Deputy for Strengthening of National Values .

The one who delivered a presentation at the event was Brigadier General Ir. Lestari Wiyono, M.M., M.Sc. with

Inspector General of Police Drs. Herry Haryanto, Air Vice Marshal Syahrul Ansory, Dr. Adi Sujatno, Bc, IP, SH, MH, and Dr. Maswardi Rauf, MA acting as panelists.

“With the spirit of changes that comes with the reform, various aspects of the life of the people and of the nation have also undergone major fundamental changes,” said the governor in his speech.

“In its process and development, the reform does not go as expected. In fact, it tends to undermine our national unity”, he continued.

The amendment to the 1945 Constitution is one effect of the reform. Until now, the 1945 Constitution has been amended four times, nearly in all articles of the body of the 1945 Constitution.

The different interpretations and understandings that are not quite in tune with the spirit of the 1945 Constitution as agreed as one of national consensus, has created uncondusive situation for the achievement of national goals and objectives.

“This situation cannot be allowed to just drag on as it could threaten the existence of the unitary state of the Republic of Indonesia”, said the governor expressing his concern.

Therefore, Lemhannas RI, in its efforts to improve public understanding of national values, held the program of strengthening national values on target and obtained a good result based on the research conducted in 12 (twelve) provinces.

“We all hope that the research that had been conducted will bring substantial benefits in preparing the action plan for the strengthening of national values”, said the governor expressing his hopes.

He also realized that the research findings still needs further inputs in order to enrich the concept of the program “strengthening of national values” to become more comprehensive and realistic.



Isra' Mi'raj, Emulating Characters of Prophet Muhammad SAW

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. said that the commemoration of Isra 'Mi'raj serves as a means to emulate the characters of Prophet Muhammad SAW.

On the occasion there were also 2 (two) presentations on the “Conception of National Integrated Program Model of Rural Development Movement for National Resilience (Pandu Gerbang Desa Tannas) in Creating People’s Welfare and Alleviating Poverty in the Framework of National Resilience” by Expert Professional in the Field of Geography

of Lemhannas RI DR. H. Djoharis Lubis, M.Sc. and “Political Education in Order to Improve People’s Awareness in the Framework of Performance Controlling of Government Apparatus” by Expert Professional in the Field of Politics Brigadier General (Ret.) A. R. Wetik, S.I.P., M.Sc.

In his presentation regarding Village Development Movement, the Expert Professional in the Field of Geography of Lemhannas RI delivered the expected outputs, such as the realization of a pilot project in a village incorporating all people’s welfare development programs, creating social engineering laboratory by adopting national multisectoral and multidisciplinary resilience approach where the locus and focus are in the villages’ pilot projects, and the establishment of the National Resilience Village Modeling Standards that can be used as a reference in the Development of National Resilience Village.

Pakistan: Indonesian Navy to Always be in Reminiscence



The assistance given by the Indonesian Navy will always be reminisced by Pakistanis, said the Chief of Naval Staff of Pakistan Navy Admiral Muhammad Asif Sandilah in Lemhannas RI in Jakarta on Tuesday (10/7).

It was conveyed by Admiral Muhammad Asif Sandilah when giving a lecture before the participants of the Short Educational Course Program (PPSA) 18, Regular Educational Course Program (PPRA) 47 and 48 at the auditorium of Astagatra building.

He said that Pakistan still keeps the memories with regards to the assistance provided by the Indonesian navy when the country was facing a crisis.

"We, as the citizens of Pakistan, can never forget the support and assistance given to the Pakistan's navy when our country was facing a crisis", he said.

Since 1965, he added, the relationship of brotherhood and friendship between Indonesia and Pakistan are becoming increasingly stronger, which is based on mutual trust and understanding in the face of various challenges.

"Personally and from the deep of my heart, I really hope that the fraternal relationship and cooperation between the two navies of both countries can be further improved for the benefit of larger mutual interests", he added.

Furthermore, the Chief of Naval Staff of Pakistan Navy said that he felt his visit to Indonesia was like "pulang kampung" or going back to home. He discussed the friendly relations between Indonesia and Pakistan in general and naval relations between the two countries in particular.

The situation of geostrategic environment and its influence in the region were also discussed in the lecture of

Pakistan's Chief of Naval Staff who, 20 years ago, attended a regular course at the Naval Staff and Command College (Seskoal).

Previously, Admiral Muhammad Asif Sandila was received by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. Moeldoko, S.I.P. in a courtesy call. On the opportunity, the deputy governor was accompanied by the Head of Cooperation Bureau Captain (Naval) Sulistiyanto, M.Sc.

The cooperation between Lemhannas RI and partners from friendly countries continues to develop.

A week earlier, on Wednesday (4/7) Lemhannas RI also received a courtesy call of the delegation from the National Defence College of the Phillipines (NDCP).

Data, Key Success Factor for Decision Making

“We all agree that data is a key success factor for every decision,” expressed the Principal Secretary at the opening of consolidation on national resilience in the provinces as well as national and regional strategic issues in 2012 on Tuesday (10/7).

The opening event was attended by Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals and all consolidation participants comprising representatives from Bappeda at provincial level, BPS at provincial level and higher education institutions from 5 provinces throughout Indonesia.

The consolidation aims at improving the national resilience measurement system (Labkurtannas) and public policy simulation system as well as reviewing and validating the system that has been developed by

Lemhannas RI. It also seeks to discover national and regional strategic issues.

In his speech which was read by the Principal Secretary, the governor of Lemhannas RI expressed his appreciation for each province that has been actively giving its support in the form of data provision to Labkurtannas. After all the data are processed and validated, Lemhannas RI will then send out a portrait of national resilience to each respective governor.

This data is very important as it is a key factor in the decision-making process in each province, in terms of its availability, punctuality, accuracy and uniqueness.

It was also discussed during the consolidation how to develop a unique, accurate, timely system with appropriate content and form as what has been done by West Java.

“We expect that this consolidation activity can produce maximum results concerning the system to be developed, the data to be collected and strategic issues to be formulated based on the measurement results”, said the Principal Secretary expressing the hope of the institution.



Historical Archives and Documents: Contribution and Role in National Character Building

The National Archives of the Republic of Indonesia, together with the University of Khairun and Archives Board and Library of North Maluku Province, held a National Seminar on National Character Building in Ternate on Wednesday (11/7).

The event was attended by the Governor of North Maluku Thaib Armayin, Ternate Mayor Burhan Abdurrahman, Head of the National Archives of the Republic of Indonesia M. Asichin, Rector of the University of Khairun Ghufroon Ali Ibrahim, Khairun University faculty members, Speakers and Members of North Maluku province Parliament, Local Leaders Consultative Forum of the North Maluku Province, Head of Provincial Archival Board and other invitees.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. was present as a keynote speaker in a seminar themed "Actualization of Function and Archives

for Integrating the Nation in the National Character Building".

"In the midst of changes that erode the national identity, the role of archives becomes very important as one of references in national character building", stated the governor at the start of his keynote speech.

In defending and giving substance to the nation's independence, Indonesia is constantly faced with numerous challenges, problems and obstacles that come one after another and threaten the integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia. However, with characters that are strongly embedded in the spirit of unity, Indonesia is able to maintain the existence and integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia to this day.

Along with the strong spirit of changes accompanying the reform of national life in 1998, Indonesia is now faced with potential threats of national disintegration caused by eroded national characters which have thus far unified the nation.

The governor of Lemhannas RI stated that the widespread and intense horizontal and social conflicts after the reform have resulted in a shift of values in the society. It is feared that there will be a negative excess in the form of primordialism, ethnocentrism and sectarianism in the life of the nation.

Archives currently serve as source of information, empirical evidence, basis for policy makers to determine the direction of development, and as repositories of memory. Besides, they can also be utilized synergically by the stakeholders as a major reference in building a strong national character in order to enhance national resilience.

"With the convening of this seminar it is expected that measures will be taken, and strategic and smart efforts will be made in order to give real contribution in improving the character of the Indonesian people through the role of national archives", said the governor of Lemhannas RI expressing his hopes.

Lemhannas RI Receives Unqualified Opinion for the Fifth Consecutive Time

For the fifth consecutive time since 2007, Lemhannas RI received an unqualified opinion for the financial statements of the fiscal year 2011 from the Audit Board of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI).

The fact was revealed by the Deputy Governor Lt. Gen. Moeldoko, S.I.P. as Authorized Budget Holder of Lemhannas RI in a hearing with Commission I of the House of Representatives at the Parliament in Senayan, Jakarta, Thursday (12/7).

According to the Deputy Governor, supervision is required to follow up the receipt of the unqualified opinion.

“Based on the results of BPK audit on the financial statements of Lemhannas RI for fiscal year 2011, Lemhannas RI again receives an unqualified opinion, though some things need to be followed up for improved optimal control”, said Lt. Gen. Moeldoko.

At the hearing with the Commission I, the deputy governor also elaborated on the performance of the institution known as the state think-tank.

The performance of Lemhannas RI, he said, had been evaluated by the Minister for Empowerment of State Apparatus and Bureaucratic Reform. According to the letter of Minister for Empowerment of State Apparatus and Bureaucratic Reform dated 14 February, Lemhannas RI got “CC” score, indicating a good enough performance.

The assessment needs to be followed up in order to establish a results-oriented government.

Lemhannas RI, added the three-star general, has implemented various changes in all areas.

Such changes were started with the preparation of legislative changes such as the Presidential Decree on Lemhannas RI. Changes were also made to the regulation of the governor concerning the duties, functions, organizational structure and work procedure of Lemhannas RI.

In the meeting the deputy governor was accompanied by Principal Secretary Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., deputies and heads of bureaus.
