Jusuf Kalla Gives General Lecture to PPRA LIV and LV Students

In Vice President palace of The Republic of Indonesia, Vice President Jusuf Kallas gave Lecture to PPRA LIV and LV students on Tuesday (30/8).

General Lecture began with report from Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo to Vice President of The Republic of Indonesia raised a theme about Tourism and Energy which are related to seminar theme of PPRA LIV and LV participants.

Talking about energy, Jusuf Kalla said that Indonesia is a country that rich with natural resources like coal, oil, and geothermal. Therefore, Indonesia must create right policy to be a prosper country with the existence of the resource.

Responding to questions from participants regarding renewable energy, such as nuclear, Jusuf Kalla said that nuclear is the last option due to its high risk.

In addition, renewable energy requires more complicated technology and currently Indonesia prefers the use of coal, oil, and geothermal. However, Jusuf Kalla said that in 2025, Indonesia should fill 25 percent of the electrical energy needed through renewable energy.

Tourism investment, according to Jusuf Kalla, is a low cost investment because tourism in Indonesia is already provided by

nature. The other things that supposed to be prepare by Indonesia are the facilities and power source to convenience the tourist especially foreign tourists. Besides, we have to provide hospitality so Indonesia's tourism can be fully enjoyed by foregn tourist.

Moreover, Jusuf Kalla also said that tourism is not only about culture but also traditional foods and natural resources available in this nation. The other factor should be given more attention is flight policy to make it easier for international tourist to visit Indonesia.
