National Management System XLV Simulation, an inter-sectors coordination in addressing social dynamic

Lemhannas RI held National Management System Simulation (Olah Sismennas) for Participants of PPRA LVI as part of Lemhannas RI's education curriculum. The National Management System Simulation was officially opened by Acting Deputy of National-Level Leader Education of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto represented Governor of Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (5/9) in Dwiwarna Room, Lemhannas RI.

Karsiyanto, delivering Governor of Lemhannas RI's remarks, stated that the theme "Cross-Sectoral Coordination of Government Apparatus and Stakeholders in order to address Social Cultural Dynamics as National Resilience Challenge" is considered appropriate.

"This is such a precise and actual theme where the socio-cultural sector as we see lately is used as a tool by irresponsible parties for political uniformity or for political interests of certain groups, it will erode the national character as a pluralistic, tolerant nation which uphold mutual cooperation as part of

strengthening national resilience," Karsiyanto said.

The four-day National Management System Simulation aims to provide direction and training for PPRA LVI participants so that they can work together in groups or teams as their capacity to become state apparatus in government administration.

Previously, in the report delivered by Director of Operational Education Brig. Gen. Harizon, M.M, said that PPRA LVI participants in this simulation will serve as state apparatus from several Ministries/ Institutions, Commission of House of Representatives, and Ambassadors The opening of National Management System Simulation that marked by Brig. Gen Harizon put on the participant ID Card symbolically was attended by by the structural officials and faculty members of Lemhannas RI. ●

Irwandi and continued with the first presentation that discusses the background and urgency of SIMAN formation for Ministries and Institutions.

According to M. Fariza, the background of SIMAN Team formation is due to the Government's programs, performance and achievements that must be socialized massively, especially in social media. Another problem urges SIMAN Team Formation is due to negative response by "haters", and "hoax" (fake news) spread in the society.

The current challenge faced by SIMAN Team is it has to be able to communicate and interpret Government's programs,

performance and achievements in an easily understood and popular 'slang' or informal language. In addition, the existence of SIMAN Team is expected to be able to counteract the negative issues related to Ministries and Institutions and disseminate positive vibes and news to public and make them more dominant.

Senior Journalist Irawan Ariefyanto conveyed about the strategic role of social media to develop opinions in his presentation. Irawan said that in the present, social media has become one of the determinants of public information sources and become one of opinion formers.

In the middle of the training, a speaker from the SIMAN Center Creative Team, Nurul Suci, taught the trainees how to create interesting memes. Meme becomes one of the most popular social media contents among society.

SIMAN team consisting of 78 Ministries and Institutions are under coordination of Coordinating Ministry for Political, Legal and Security Affairs. ●

Lemhannas RI's newsletter received an award for the best bulletin category at the Publisher, Magazine, Journal, Bulletin, Book and Gray Literature Awards organized by the National Library in 2017 as stated in the Decree of National Library Head Number 133 of 2017. The event held at International Book Fair, Jakarta Convention Center, on Sunday (10/9) was officially opened by the Head of Indonesian National Library Mohammed Syarif Bando.

The Indonesian National Library's Best Bulletin Award 2017 was awarded to Newsletter Lemhannas RI and Buletin Parleментарia. The awards were received by the Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI Brig. Gen. Mindarto and the Chief of Public Relations and News Bureau of DPR RI Djaka Dwiwinarko. This award is an appreciation to publishers for their active participation of sending their work to improve utilization, implementation and socialization of digitalization of publishers' recorded and printed products (KCKR) in the National Library.

Head of the Indonesian National Library in his speech expressed his greatest appreciation to the publishers who have

been actively participated in publishing their products.

Muhammad Syarif Bando said that in the upcoming 2018, Indonesian National Library will begin digitalization process and educating process of rectification, management and utilization of all KCKR in facing the development of digitalization era.

National Library of the Republic of Indonesia calls for cooperation of all recorded and printed publishers to create full-text digital format in submitting their work with related patent agreement. This is expected to dismiss the notion of a digital threat that can threaten printed products. On the opposite, it is expected to be seen as an effort to advance publishers and readers' interest based on increased readers during a year.

The occasion was attended by Rudi Hernada and Mrs. Rosidayati Rozalina (Chairperson of Central IKAPI), Ibu Kartini (Head of Yayasan Obor), and the Director of Indonesian National Library with the theme e-deposit. The talkshow took place also got enthusiastic responds from the participants. ●

General Lecture by Indonesian Ambassador to Myanmar in Lemhannas RI



Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Indonesia to Myanmar, DR. Ito Sumardi DS Drs., S.H., M.H., M.B.A., M.M. gave a public lecture to PPSA XI Participants, PPRA LVI Alumni, Structural and Functional Officials of Lemhannas RI, IKAL Board, and Perista Boards of Lemhannas RI at the Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (12/9).

The general lecture was begun with a speech from the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo. Agus Widjojo said that the current developing issue in Indonesia is humanitarian crisis that occurred in Myanmar, related to Rohingya, which is being viral in social media. “Many things are related to the technical capabilities of social media. For example “hoax”, and the reappeared pictures of old issues which caused negative impacts,” said Agus Widjojo.

According to Agus Widjojo, Ambassador Ito Sumardi has done his job very well by maintaining close relationship between Indonesia and elite circle in Myanmar, building close relationship with Aung San Suu Kyi, National League for Democracy (NLD) Leader, fighting for Indonesia’s interest, and opening access to Rohingya. In addition, Ito Sumardi is also able to convince Myanmar government that Indonesia could become a close country to find conflict-related solutions in Rakhine.

In his general lecture, Ambassador Ito Sumardi explained

about the cause of the outbreak of humanitarian crisis in Rakhine. For Myanmar Government, Rohingya in Rakhine village are considered illegal immigrants. Therefore, Myanmar will not recognize Rohingya as Myanmar Citizen.

On August 25, 2017, there was a coordinated attack on 30 police and army posts in the North Rakhine region which caused several deaths. The three areas targeted by the attack were Rathedaung, Maungdaw, and Buthidaung. The perpetrator came from a militant group known as ARSA or Arakan Rohingya Salvation Army. The group is led by Abu Ammar, and mostly consists of Rohingyas.

Ambassador Ito Sumardi also talked about the final situation in the Rakhine in front of general lecture participants. The development of the situation in North Rakhine since September 7 are no longer involve firing contact, the Security Service of Myanmar prioritize their programs in patrol and custody of Myanmar residents for humanitarian aid access. ARSA sent a request letter for a month-long truce from September 10 to October 10, 2017.

This general lecture is basically meant to provide information related to conflict in Rakhine, Myanmar experienced by Rohingya. In addition, Ito Sumardi also assured that Indonesian government has acted in accordance with its free and active foreign policy and prioritizing world peace and humanity. ●

Directorate of Social and Culture holds RTD regarding education and teaching



Directorate of Social and Culture of Deputy for Strategic Studies conducted a Round Table Discussion (RTD) on “Revitalization of Education and Teaching (Pedagogy) in National Education System to Improve Nation’s Competitiveness in National Security”. The discussion opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo was held on Tuesday (11/9) at Krishna Room, Astagatra Building IV Floor Lemhannas RI and moderated by Dr. Adi Soejatno, Bc. I.P., S.H., M.H., as the Professional Expert of Legal and Human Rights of Lemhannas RI.

Agus Widjojo in his speech hopes that education and teaching can produce qualified human resources so as to form morally strong character.

“Education and teaching is expected to create tenacious, persistent, and tough human resources who also have broad knowledge and skills so they will grow into creative, inovative, and competitive human beings. Therefore, character education is necessary to be applied since early age, adolescents, and even adults so as to build morally strong character,” Agus Widjojo said.

As the first speaker in the discussion, the Secretary General of Learning and Student Affairs Dr. Rina Indiasuti explained about “Education and Teaching Policy and Strategy (Pedagogy) in Higher Education System in order to improve the Nation’s Competitiveness in National Resilience”.

In her presentation, Rina revealed that based on the four components in national curriculum, teaching should focus more on learning materials and teaching methods so material presented can be understood by the learners.

In the second presentation, Doni Koesoema A. M. Ed as Director of Character Education of Education Consulting explained about “Method of Implementation in National Education System in order to Improve Nation’s Competitiveness in National Resilience Framework”. Doni mentioned that in educational units, there are three points to be analyzed that become ideas in the development of character education. Those three points are classroom teaching, school culture development, and community participation.

In this discussion there are three responders, namely Member of the House of Representatives Vice Chairman of Commission X Education Division Drs. Abdul Fikri, M.M., Founder of Indonesia Heritage Foundation Dr. Ratna Megawangi, and Senior Analyst of Social and Culture of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Sudaryono, S. U. .

Attended the RTD were Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, Faculty Members, and a number of Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI. ●

discusses Pancasila implementation



PPSA XXI participants held RTD (Round Table Discussion) on Thursday (14/9) at Gajah Mada Auditorium, Pancagatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI. This Pre Seminar RTD with the theme “Implementation of Pancasila Values in Education System to Strengthen National Unity in order to Improve National Resilience” was moderated by Brig. Gen. Drs. Firli Bahri, M.Si. and Aviani Malik.

In the discussion opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo, there are four speakers namely Education Figures Prof. Dr. Indria Samego, M.A., Armed Forces Intellectual Brig. Gen. (ret) Saafroedin Bahar, Practitioner of Pancasila Clinic Dr. Dodik and Education Figures Nani Nurrahman Sutojo.

Before the discussion began, Prof. Dr. Reni Mayerni as the Head of Seminar read the RTD report which is a series of seminar which will be held on November 16, 2017. Prof. Reni said that the purpose of this Pre-Seminar RTD is to obtain a comprehensive view of several issues related to current education in Indonesia.

“Round Table Discussion held today aims to obtain a comprehensive view of the current state of affairs related to our educational issues. At this stage, the parties involved in the

seminar can display objective facts related to our education system both positive and negative and its influence on the national unity,” Prof. Reni said.

In his speech, Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo who also acted as a keynote speaker revealed that Pancasila is a guideline for society.

“As the foundation of the state, Pancasila is an ideology, a view, and a philosophy of life that should be guided by Indonesian in the process of organizing nation and state life to realize the ideals of the independence proclamation. The noble values contained in Pancasila are the noble values unearthed from the nation’s culture which has universally recognized values and will not change over time,” Agus Widjojo stated.

The discussion was followed by the explanation from Brig. Gen. Heri Wiranto, S.E., M.M., M.Tr. (Han) and Andy Yentriani, S. Sos., MA. In their presentation, implementation of Pancasila values in the education system to strengthen NKRI (Unitary State of The Republic of Indonesia) is expected to produce an effective education system, integrated educational materials which equipped with local wisdom, teachers and education personnel with a qualified national understanding and skilled in the methodology, conducive educational environment and reflective and varied teaching methods and approaches. ●

Agus Widjojo: Lemhannas RI must address regional geopolitical issues wisely



Lemhannas RI held a Routine Flag-Raising Ceremony at Lemhannas RI Central Field on Monday (18/9). The flag-raising ceremony led by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo was attended by all Structural Officials, PPRa LVI Participants, PPSA XXI participants, and Lemhannas RI's staff.

In his speech, Agus Widjojo said that Lemhannas RI must be aware to be able to observe and understand national, regional, and global strategic environment dynamis. Lemhannas RI, which is also a center of geopolitical study, should be able to address the regional geopolitical issues wisely.

Agus Widjojo said that rapid and intense changes in geopolitical sphere encourage us as a nation to continue to move in accordance with the dynamics of strategic environment development. "We can no longer use a paradigm that is only focus on the past without having a vision into the future," Agus Widjojo stated in his remark.

In terms of ways of acting and order, Indonesia must be oriented to scientific arguments and context.

In addition, Agus Widjojo also reminded that the current society dynamics encourage our society to prioritize their attention to their similarity rather than differences. When

looking at the national problems, Indonesian must see similarity based on the Four National Basic Consensus.

"We must put our attention to the past, the present, and the future in a proportional and contextual way. Our challenge today is how we take the intrinsic value or the tangible value of the doctrine we inherited from the past and were compiled in the struggle for independence era in order to gain instrumental value on implementation value adapted to social and national development," Agus Widjojo said.

Furthermore, Agus Widjojo conveyed about Lemhannas RI's performance, budget efficiency, and also Lemhannas RI's achievements until the third quarter. Regarding the Regular Education Program batch LVI and Short Education Program batch XXI, Agus Widjojo also appealed to all parties who participated in the enrollment of both programs to always prepare as well as possible.

In the end of his speech, Agus Widjojo reminded the entire officials of Lemhannas RI to get prepared for the implementation of bureaucratic reforms evaluation conducted by the Ministry of Administrative and Bureaucracy Reform. ●

The seminar began with the report of the Chairman of Seminar of Colonel Dr. Ivan Yulivan, S.E., M.M., M.Tr. (Han) regarding the process of seminar implementation. “The process of manuscript writing of this seminar has been through several stages, including the selection of titles from 13 titles into a single title selected based on the latest phenomenon and various issues related to nationality and diversity values. Next, we hold RTD (Round Table Discussion) with related experts and then revised the manuscript and finally held the seminar today,” Ivan Yulivan explained.

In his speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (ret) Agus Widjojo said that this seminar is an exchange of ideas for PPRA LVI participants. “The seminar is one of the main programs from regular education program held in Lemhannas RI. This seminar is an opportunity to exchange some ideas for PPRA participants as well as to gather knowledge and experience gained while enrolling education program in this institution. Through this seminar, PPRA participants are expected to be able to formulate strategic concepts in solving national problems faced by this country,” Agus Widjojo stated.

Sri Sultan Hamengkubuwono X in his presentation explained several ways to maintain the consistency of Pancasila values. Sri Sultan also said that pancasila should be started from its 5th Principle about social justice which is such an basic for every matter. Meanwhile Franz Magnis more focused on how religion can e connected with national values so how every religion talks about national values needed to be acknowledged.

After the presentation session over, this seminar was continued with discussion and ended with token of appreciation giving from Governor of Lemhannas RI to the speakers. ●

Lemhannas RI holds management review meeting on the progress of QMS implementation



Wednesday (20/9), Lemhannas RI held a Management Review Meeting (RTM) on the progress of Quality Management System (QMS) implementation based on ISO 9001: 2015 at Gadjah Mada Room of Pancagatra Building Lemhannas RI 3rd Floor.

At the meeting discussing the status and follow-up on the previous management system, Vice of Management Representative Sukendra Marta, M.Sc, M.App. Sc. presented the recommendations of the management system for all work units in Lemhannas RI as part of the report on implementation status of QMS based on ISO 9001: 2015.

“Most of the work units have followed up on recommendations and emphasis from the Governor of Lemhannas RI to take corrective action against the discrepancies that were discovered during internal audit in August 2016,” Sukendra Marta said.

The meeting continued with Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo discussing the report submitted by Vice of Management Representatives. Agus Widjojo explained that this activity is a checkpoint, saying “This activity is a checkpoint

to know whether things are already in accordance with the requirements or not and also to find a way for improvement. As I often say that these requirements are what we must meet, we should meet these requirements not solely because they are demanded by these rules,”

These requirements, Agus Widjojo continued, should become a daily habit so there is no need for special preparation if at any time there will be re-examination. This will make all units work according to the quality management system.

As the closing ceremony, Sukendra Marta convey a summary of the discussion in the RTM. In summary, it is stated that it takes a joint commitment by all elements of Lemhannas RI to comply with the rules that have been imposed by ISO 9001: 2015. In addition, these rules should become a habit within Lemhannas RI.

The RTM was attended by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, Deputies, Professional Experts, Senior Analysts, Senior Lecturers, Structural Officers of Lemhannas RI, Lemhannas RI Staff, and invited guests. ●
