JUDICIAL AND SOCIOLOGICAL REVIEW OF SOCIAL ORGANIZATION POSITION IN INDONESIA



Roundtable Discussion of socio-cultural division opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H.

Lemhannas RI holds a Roundtable Discussion of socio-culture division regarding “**Judicial and Sociological Review of Social Organization Position in Indonesia in order to maintain social reconciliation values in strengthening National Resilience**” in Nusantara Room I, Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI on November 25, 2010.

Mass Organization, if observed from judicial aspects shall be reflection of liberty to associate and gather, voice opinions either orally or in writing. It constitutes a strategic media to attain social justice and simultaneously becomes basic rights of citizen protected by the 1945 Constitution.

Meanwhile, if observed from sociological aspect, existence of mass organization shall constitute one of forms of civil organization based on democratic, partnership, vigilance and public participation principles duly established voluntarily and non-profit oriented. The mass organization is media to channel social and politic consciousness toward various public actual issues.

In the last 5-10 years, the development of mass organization is very dynamic and difficult to predict. External factor dominated by global and regional environment will affect significantly to the implementation of the mass organization function. The internal factor impact such as national dynamicity also influences the change to mass organization orientation which is co-opted by political party power or parties who are very concerned. It results in various diversion of purpose and function of the mass organization. In relation to national defense, the mass organization arrangement is an urgent matter taking into account capability that shall be owned by state shall be capability of adapting itself to positive development of ecological resilience and predicting the anticipatory resilience.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI states that every regulation and policy is integrating facility of adaptation function of all life sectors so that Indonesian country shall in any condition be able to maintain the pattern of maintenance in terms of state values inherited by ancestors.

ACCELERATION OF DISPUTE RESOLUTION ON STATE BORDERS TO MAINTAIN SOVEREIGNTY OF THE UNITARY STATE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

Indonesia has sovereignty territory from sabang to merauke, by the effectiveness of the United Nation Convention on law of The Sea (UNCLOS) of 1982 on November 16, 1994, it makes Indonesia becoming archipelagic state with strategic position and has abundant source of natural assets. Geographically, land territory of Indonesia is bordering to 3 (three) countries namely Malaysia, Papua New Guinea and Timor Leste, meanwhile sea territory is bordering to 10 countries namely: India, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, The Philippines, Republic of Palau, Australia, Timor Leste and Papua New Guinea. In this case, every bordering Countries have different interest and identity either from the ideological, politic, economic, social, cultural, or defense and security aspects. This condition is vulnerable and potential to result in conflict particularly on the issue of state territory border.

The recent fact indicates that all countries bordering to Indonesia still have dispute on state territory border, so that sovereignty of the territory of Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia is posed to a certain threat either by non-state actors or state actors (neighboring country) in relation to dispute on inter-state territory border. Therefore, the Directorate General of Defense and Security Division, Deputy of Strategic Research of Lemhannas RI convened a Roundtable Discussion with a theme of **“Acceleration of Dispute Resolution on Inter-State Territory Border to maintain the sovereignty of the Unitary State of Indonesia in the framework of National Defense”** on November 24th, 2010 in Nusantara I Room, Trigatra.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., in his keynote speech conveyed that if the condition is not immediately be resolved then it could interrupt or worsen bilateral relationship, even it can affect social, state

and national life aspects as well as interruption of national resilience including regional security which will gradually cause foreign countries (countries not in dispute) interfere in the resolution thereof.

The Governor expects the suggestion and opinion or input from various parties in the Roundtable Discussion shall become mutual thought to find strategic idea regarding acceleration of dispute resolution on inter-state territory borders to maintain the sovereignty of the Unitary State of Indonesia in the framework of national resilience. Although the dispute resolution on inter-state territory border either land or sea border is very complex, but to Indonesia as independent, sovereign and dignified country, the dispute should be immediately resolved, by considering principles of UNO charter and Treaty of Amity and Cooperation (TAC) as well as other regional and international instruments.

DEVELOPMENT MODEL OF BORDER REGION FROM PERSPECTIVE OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

The Directorate General of International Sector of Deputy of Strategic Study Division of Lemhannas RI organizes a Roundtable Discussion on the “**Development Model of Bordering Area Observed from Perspective of National Resilience**” convened in Nusantara Room I, Trigatra Building dated November 29th, 2010. The Roundtable Discussion was opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H.

Constitutionally, a legal system plays an important role in securing the materialization of sovereignty, security and prosperity of state and nation. Meanwhile, judicially, Indonesia is a sovereign country already acknowledged by the international

world. However, Indonesia, until now, still has a border issue which is complicated and not yet resolved.

Various issues on border still looms this country, such as non-agreement of some segments of borderline with neighboring countries either land or sea as well as air, non existence of regulation that serves as adequate legal basis for determination of state territory border comprehensively, uneven distribution and non arrangement of state physical border sign as well as non optimum management of frontier small islands.

Non-agreement of issue on the border has caused physiological impact on most people living in the bordering areas who are difficult to fulfill even their basic needs, meanwhile they have

to face the reality to see the condition of people of neighboring countries who are facilitated adequately by their country (prosperity imbalance).

The Government has, in the effort of advancing bordering area, also stipulated Law No. 43 of 2008 regarding State Territory, President Regulation No. 12 of 2010 regarding National Body for Border Management, President Instruction No.1 of 2010 regarding Priority of Development Acceleration, President Instruction no.3 of 2010 regarding fair development for all, and Regulation of the minister of Home Affairs No.31 of 2010 regarding Organization and Work Procedure for Fixed Secretariat of National Body for Border Management. But until now the materialization of bordering area as the most frontier part of state is still identical to “context and conception”, which is very difficult to materialize.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, stated that the government should resolve the issue on border comprehensively, because the issues that arise is not only limited to issue on economy, but also politics, culture and security. And it is not just merely the physical isolation. Therefore, the development model should not only be comprehensive in nature, but is also inter-discipline and inter-sectoral in nature, by placing policy and regulation as mechanism of integration that can integrate functions of economic adaptation, attainment of political goal and maintain pattern in terms of ideology and other basic consensus.

INAUGURATION AND RELEASE CEREMONY OF ECHELON I, II, III, AND IV LEMHANNAS RI

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., chaired the transfer of function, inauguration as well as release of echelon I, II, III, and IV officials of Lemhannas RI on November 30, 2010 in Nusantara Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

NATIONAL SEMINAR OF PPRA XLV OF LEMHANNAS RI



A national seminar was held by PPRA XLV in Trigatra Building Floor III Lemahannas RI on December 9, 2010 adopting a theme of “**Revitalization of Regional Government for Acceleration of National Development in the framework of National Resilience**”. Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H. as Governor of Lemhannas RI opened the National Seminar. The event was attended by 5 respondents, among others Speaker of the House of Regional Representatives (DPD RI) H. Irman Gusman, S.E., M.M., the District Head of Kutai H. Isran Noor, Director General of Regional Autonomy, the Ministry of Affairs, Prof. DR. H., Djohemansyah, M.A., Secretary of the State Minister for Supervision of State Apparatus Tasdik Kisananto, S.H., and Professor of the University of Indonesia, Prof. DR. Benyamin Husein.

The Seminar constitutes the form of concern of the Participants of PPRA XLV in the national development process of regional autonomy era which still requires development acceleration which is, among others, **first**, caused by low index of human resources development if compared to other countries in the world; **second**, high rate of corruption, based on survey findings of the International Transparency Society; **Third**, high dependence of region on transfer of fund from central government; **fourth**, original income of region is not able to cover regional routine budget, **fifth**, many lawsuits on dissatisfaction toward the regional head general election particularly from the lost parties, it

causes considerable socio-politic cost; **sixth**, non maximum management of regional potency; **seventh**, ineffectiveness of regional moratorium policy in preventing the intention of regional elite to expand region.

Based on the above problems, PPRA XLV Lemhannas RI 2010 proposes some main ideas to solve the problems, namely:

First, Rapid accomplishment of grand design of regional government;

Second, necessity to build commitment of regional apparatus to perform aspiring regional development.

Third, necessity to improve quality of checks and balances which is not limited to formal institution but opening of public access in supervision mechanism with system and procedure as already agreed and shall be contained in regional regulation;

Fourth, the Central Government should make a model which is able to encourage region to optimize transfer fund allocation in the interest of development in region which gives impact on the regional economic growth so that the dependency of region on fund transfer from central government will be gradually diminished;

Fifth, necessity to establish political communication media, so that the leader of national level will be able to make political communication effectively, intensively with all elements of society in region to develop political awareness of citizens thereby creating democratic activities;

Sixth, the central Government should, through its fiscal intensive policy, encourage the regional government to focus on regional potency management optimally and avoid any pattern of economic development which is not having a carrying capacity in its region thereby high competitive.

In press a conference after the seminar session ended, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. DR. Muladi, S.H., gave his view in relation to regional autonomy, namely a number of opinions after regional expansion stating that anything will be better, while after the regional expansion there are many development to implement. The Governor also sees the occurrence of excessive primordial approach, if it is not immediately handled, it can damage the development of state character, he also expects that recruitment of regional head should no longer depend on approach of candidate, group, or political party, and willing to respect freedom of media.
