The Deputy for Consolidation of National Values of Lemhannas RI held an event "Consolidation of National Values, National Conception and Leadership for Speakers, Members of Regional Legislative Council (DPRD) and Regional Government Officials Batch XXVI on Monday, March 21, 2011 on the 3rd Floor, East Wing of Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The activity was held as a result of cooperation between Lemhannas RI and ADEKSI. It was started with an opening ceremony by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. which was attended by Vice Governor Air Marshal Dr. Rio Mendung Thalieb, Secretary of the Governing Board, Dr. Ardi Partadinata, M.H., M.Si., Chief Secretary Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc, Deputies, General Chairman of Apkasi and Adeksi, and structural officials of Lemhannas RI.

In his speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that some of the problems that need attention are the ability of all national components in maintaining the integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia. Therefore, one

of the things that must be done in relation to the national development is to improve the competitiveness or resilience of the regions by making some efforts, such as in improving the synergy between the central and regional governments and among the regions as well as regional development policy (big islands) and in supporting the acceleration of regional development.

The consolidation of national values is essentially an attempt to dialogically enlighten the participants through the provision of materials that have become the core teaching materials of Lemhannas RI. Equipped with the understanding of such materials, the participants are expected to be able to: **first**, think systematically, comprehensively, integrally and holistically for the national interests within the framework of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia; **second**, develop an anticipatory, cooperative, synergistic attitude for the interests of the people; **third**, care for the potentials owned by the regions and develop the regions' self-reliance, and commitment to continued national development that ensures peace and good order of society as well as people's welfare.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. officially opened the 2011 Regular Education Program (PPRA) XLVI of Lemhannas RI on March 22, 2011 in the Dwiwarna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI. The event was not only attended by structural officials of Lemhannas RI but also by invitees consisting of high-ranking military officers and civil officials. The Coordinating Minister for People's Welfare H.R. Agung Laksono was also present.

In his speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the PPRA is an education program designated for state or government officials of echelon II, Field-grade Officers at a level of Colonel/Senior Chief Commissioner of TNI/POLRI, including General-grade Officers in the rank of Brigadier General, and national-level leaders from political parties, as well as other national political components. The education program also serves a purpose to prepare national-level leaders that must be prepared early so that they can understand and adjust to each other towards the incorporated ideas, including those potential leaders from abroad. In addition, the PPRA is implemented as a response to the phenomenon of global, regional and national strategic development that requires a response from all national components.

The PPRA Education XLVI has a theme “**Law Supremacy within the Framework of National Resilience**”. This theme is relevant to current conditions given the fact that the law enforcement is one of priorities in government programs. Until now, a comprehensive legal development has yet to be achieved which results in a legal uncertainty and poor legal guarantee. This will eventually weaken the national resilience. The education will be held for 9.5 months, covering a distance learning (e-learning)/ off-campus program for 3 months and on-campus program for 6.5 months.

The 2011 PPRA XLVI was attended by 100 participants consisting of 32 military officers, 20 officers from POLRI, 4 persons from Ministries, 7 persons from Non-Ministry Government Institutions (LPNK); 1 person from state higher institution, 1 person from SOE, 2 persons from regional-owned enterprises, 1 person from university, 2 persons from political organizations, 8 persons from mass organization, 8 persons from functional organizations and 1 community leader. The PPRA XLVI was also attended by foreign participants coming from 13 countries namely, Thailand, Algeria, Jordan, India, Malaysia, Pakistan, China, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Fiji, Cambodia, Madagascar, and Singapore.

THE 2011 JAKARTA INTERNATIONAL DEFENSE DIALOGUE (JIDD)

On 23-25 March 2011, the Ministry of Defence organized the Jakarta International Defence Dialogue (JIDD) at the Jakarta Convention Center, Jakarta. The 2011 JIDD activities were livened up by the Asia-Pacific Security & Defense Expo (APSDEX). The 2011 JIDD was held with a purpose to show the latest technological advancements and to serve as a forum of dialogue for ministers of defence in the Asia Pacific region. It also aimed at providing key solutions for leaders, military officers, academics and policy makers in the Asia Pacific region in order to strengthen a harmony between security and strategy priorities.

The 2011 JIDD themed **“Strengthening Security and Stability”** was followed by representatives from 40 countries and was also attended by Ministers of Defense as well as Commanders-in-Chief of the Armed Forces from several countries. President of the Republic of Indonesia DR. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono opened the event which lasted for 3 days. There were 50 speakers, both from home and abroad, who conveyed their views before 1300 listeners. One of whom was Governor of Lemhannas RI

Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. who conveyed a keynote speech entitled **“The Strategic Roles of Offset for Indonesia’s Resilience”** on March 23, 2011. Offset policy is expected to reach at least 20% in order to meet the needs for defence equipment. In order to support the regulation and policy, it is deemed necessary to have regulations which accommodate the interests of various stakeholders in the defense industry, particularly the integrated relationship among government institutions, business players and academics. In addition, Indonesia will also depend on financial schemes that are used to meet the needs for primary defence weapon system.

Therefore, the government must always look for different approaches related to financial mechanisms for defense needs. The approach must be based on three aspects: **first**, meeting the needs for defense materials in accordance with technical and operational standards; **second**, existing mechanisms should not worsen the position of Indonesia as a buyer with regards to certain rules such as: offset and local content policies; **third**, the scheme must authorize the use of national defense industry.

Religion has been used as a justification for acts of violence committed. Considering this fact, Lemhannas RI deems it necessary to hold a panel discussion on the theme "Strengthening of Religious Harmony in Order to Maintain National Unity in the Framework of National Stability" on Thursday, March 31, 2011 on the 3rd floor, West Wing of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The panel discussion, which was attended by Minister for Religious Affairs Drs. Suryadharma Ali M.Si., was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A.
