



NATIONAL SEMINAR: MASTERPLAN FOR THE ACCELERATION AND EXPANSION OF INDONESIA'S (MP3EI) 2011-2025



The Coordinating Minister for Economic Affairs Ir. M. Hatta Rajasa opens a National Seminar MP3EI in Lemhannas RI

Lemhannas RI held a National Seminar on the Master Plan for the Acceleration and Expansion of Indonesia's 2011 - 2025 Economic Development (MP3EI) in order to Support the Acceleration of the National Development in order to Enhance National Resilience on July 25, 2011 in Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI.

The national seminar was opened by the Coordinating Minister for Economic Affairs Ir. M. Hatta Rajasa, who also acted as a keynote speaker. It also featured Dr. Anggito Abimanyu, and Chairman of the Indonesian Chamber of Commerce Bambang Suryo Sulisto, MBA as speakers; while the panelists include a Researcher of the Center for Economic Studies and Public Policy of UGM A. Tony Prasetyantono, Ph.D., Managing Director of Econit Dr. Hendri Saparini, Economic Researcher of IPB Dr. Iman Sugema, Chairman of the National Innovation Committee, which was represented by Expert Staff Dr. Ir. Ahmad Husin Lubis, M.Sc., Lecturer of the University of Indonesia's Faculty of Engineering Dr. Ismeth S. Abidin. The moderator of the seminar was Prof. Dr. H. Didin S. Damanhuri from Lemhannas RI. The national seminar was attended by 250 participants consisting of academics, practitioners, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), Media, Parliament, high-ranking officials and experts

from relevant stakeholders at the national level.

In his opening speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI said that in line with the vision of the national development as contained in Law No. 17 of 2007 on the Long-term National Development Plan 2005-2025, the vision for the Acceleration and Expansion of Indonesia's Economic Development is "Creating an Independent, Avanced, Just and Prosperous Indonesian Nation". It is expected that, through MP3EI, the acceleration and expansion of the economic development will establish Indonesia as a developed country by 2025 .

The Governor of Lemhannas RI also expected that the results of the national seminar which discussed the policies, strategies and implementation of MP3EI could serve as materials in formulating recommendations to national leaders.

SINGAPOREAN MINISTER OF DEFENSE'S VISIT TO LEMHANNAS RI

The Singapore's Defence Minister Dr. Ng Eng Hen and civilian and military officials from the Singapore Ministry of Defence, 11 (eleven) persons in total, made a visit to Lemhannas RI on July 26, 2011. The Singapore's Defence Minister and several representatives paid a courtesy call to the Governor of Lemhannas RI Budi Susilo Soepandji at the Governor's guest room. Then, a discussion was held at the Nusantara Room I at the Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI.

Acting as a moderator in the discussion was Air Vice Marshal Syahrul Ansory. The discussion was also attended by several structural officials and 7 (seven) participants from the Regular Course Program (PPRA) XLVI of Lemhannas RI, including 1 (one)

XLVI PPRA participant from Singapore. The Singapore's Defence Minister in the discussions conveyed that the purpose of the visit was to ensure

that a good cooperation and relation between Singapore and Indonesia, in particular the Singapore's Ministry of Defence and Lemhannas RI has been established in terms of economy and education, so that optimism for better relations, including the challenges that may be faced by both countries, can have a solid base.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI welcomed the visit and the discussion with the Minister of Defence of Singapore and hoped that it could improve the relations between the two parties and increase the cooperation between Indonesia and Singapore. The Singapore's democracy, vision and mission with regards to the open sky policy were also raised during the discussion.

GOVERNOR OF LEMHANNAS RI'S LECTURE IN THE NAVY STAFF AND COMMAND SCHOOL (SESKOAL): STATE DEFENCE IN THE PERSPECTIVE OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. delivered a lecture before the student officers of the 49th Regular Course of the Navy Staff and Command School (SESKOAL) on July 26, 2011 at the Navy Staff and Command School (Seskoal). The event was attended by 150 Student Officers (Pasis) in total, including those from several friendly countries. The theme of the Governor of Lemhannas RI's lecture was "**State Defence in the Perspective of National Resilience**".

In his lecture, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that based on Law no. 3 of 2002 Article 7, point (2) it is stated that the system of state defense in the face of military threats has placed the TNI as the main component with the support of reserve components and supporting components; while point (3) states that the system of state defense in the face of non-military threats has placed the government institutions outside of the defence field as the main elements in accordance with the forms and nature of the threats faced, with the support of other elements of national force. Further, under Article 1 point 2, it is stated that the State Defence Systems is Total People's Defence and Security System involving all citizens, territories,

and other national resources. The Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that it should be prepared early on by the government and be organized in a comprehensive, integrated, focused and sustainable manner in order to uphold the sovereignty of the nation, territorial integrity and safety of the entire nation from all threats.

The law contains state defence spirit that must be maintained by the main component, reserve component, and supporting component. It is also based on patriotism, awareness as a nation and state, belief in the Pancasila as a state ideology, willingness to sacrifice for the sake of the nation and state, and basic capabilities in state

defence.

Then, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the state defence must also be viewed in the perspective of national resilience.

Therefore, state defence also needs the eight determinants (astagatra) approach which views the national life as a system that consists of 8 (eight) determinants (gatra). Those determinants mutually influence each other, either in the static aspects (Trigatra), such as geography, natural resources and demography, or in the dynamic aspects (Pancagatra) of ideology, politics, economy, social affairs, defense and security.

THE INAUGURATION OF VICE GOVERNOR

On Friday, July 29, 2011 an inauguration and swearing-in ceremony for Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. Moeldoko was held in Lemhannas RI. The ceremony, which was led by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., was attended by the Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Structural Officials, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts and Expert Professionals as well as the Chairman and Board Members of Lemhannas RI's Perista.

In his opening speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that the preceding leadership has brought Lemhannas RI to a better progress. However, the regeneration

process needs to be carried out so that changes can be made in an institution which lead to a comprehensive improvement, which is in line with the required situational development and bureaucracy reform.

The changes and performance improvement are highly determined by high responsibilities and concern from high-ranking officials that are mandated and are supported with their capability and creativity in implementing the organization's vision and mission. The change in leadership or high-ranking officials in a dynamic organization such as Lemhannas RI, is essentially aimed for the sustainability and organizational development, including personnel development.

NATIONAL SEMINAR: OVERCOMING TERRORISM FOR THE UNITY OF THE NATION IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE

One of the main activities of the XVII Short Course Program (PPSA), leading up to the end of the course, was a national seminar. Therefore, the XVII participants organized a national seminar from August 2 to August 3, 2011 in Dwi Warna Purwa Building in Lemhannas RI. The seminar was organized for 2 (two) days with the theme “Overcoming Terrorism for the Unity of the Nation in the Framework of National Resilience”. The theme was consistent with theme of the course and seminar, and was relevant with the factual conditions being faced by the nation.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., who was accompanied by the seminar chairman Air Vice Marshal Ir. Moh. Amin Syahbudiono, M.Sc., opened the seminar with the gong beating. Present in the seminar were relevant officials, academics, practitioners, NGOs, experts and mass media.

On the first day, the focus of the seminar was directed to the overcoming of terrorism by using soft approach or soft measures. Through this means, a number of programs such as deradicalization, economic capability improvement, basic education strengthening and etc. became known. Indonesia has experienced a very complex problem regarding terrorism, but it is not serious yet to adopt this

approach. This will be discussed by Inspector General of Police Drs. Bekto Soeprapto M.Si (Deputy Chief of the Police Crime and Detective Body), Al Chaidar (the University of Indonesia), K.H. Said Agiel Siradz (General Chairman of PB NU) and Prof. Bilveer Singh, Ph.D from the National University of Singapore.

On the second day, the focus of the seminar was directed to the efforts to overcome terrorism using the hard approach or hard measures. Present as speakers on the second day were Rear Admiral Soleman B. Ponto, S.T. (Head of TNI Strategic Intelligence Agency), Drs. Andi Widjajanto, M.Sc, Ph.D Cand (Intelligence Observer from the University of Indonesia), Sidney Jones (Director of the International Crisis Group), Maj. Gen. Lodewijk Paulus (Commander of Kopassus) and Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. (Intelligence Observer). This approach will promote three means, which are through intelligence, law enforcement and military.

It is expected that this seminar will be able to formulate the strategic conception as a contribution from the XVII participants in terms of insight to the overcoming of terrorism comprehensively. It can be done through improved strategy in law enforcement and the utilization of all the potentials and resources of the nation for the unity and resilience of the nation.

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA BRIEFING FOR THE THE PPSA XVII PARTICIPANTS

On August 9, 2001 the participants of the XVII Short Course Program (PPSA) of Lemhannas RI and the Students of the University of Defence received a briefing from the President of the Republic of Indonesia DR. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono at the State Palace. Present in the event were some ministers from the United Indonesia II Cabinet, such as the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal and Security Affairs Djoko Suyanto, the Coordinating Minister for the Economy Hatta Rajasa, the Coordinating Minister for People's Welfare Agung Laksono, Minister of Defence Purnomo Yusgiantoro, Minister of Foreign Affairs Marty Natalegawa, Military Chiefs of Staff, Head of State Intelligence Agency (BIN), General of Police (Ret.) Sutanto, Head of National Counterterrorism Agency (BNPT) Inspector General Ansyad Mbai. While from Lemhannas RI, present were Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A along with the structural officials, expert lecturers, expert analysts and expert professionals.

In the beginning of the event, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed a report to the President of the Republic of Indonesia that the XVII PPSA participants of Lemhannas RI, 79 participants in total, have carried out the course program well, including e-learning/off-campus, which was then followed by on-campus activities. Besides that, the XVII PPSA participants of Lemhannas RI had

carried out Domestic and Foreign Strategic Study, national seminar, testing and presentation of the individual working paper (taskap) and interview. The event was later continued with an explanation of the result of the national seminar of the XVII PPSA by two representatives of the participants, Brigadier General of Police Tito Karnavian and Maj. Gen. Agus Surya Bakti with the theme "Preventing and Taking Actions against Terrorism in the Framework of National Resilience".

The subsequent activity was a briefing by the President of the Republic of Indonesia Dr. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono. Addressing the result of the national seminar, the President asked all the components of the nation to consider terrorism as the main threat. When it is treated as such, then the government no longer needs to carry out socialization and education. The people can also be prepared to face terrorism threats. The government will always cooperate with other countries in dealing with terrorism threats. The president also conveyed that Indonesia is one of the countries that has been successful in overcoming terrorism. Adding to the outcome of the seminar, the president conveyed 3 (three) approaches to be highlighted. The first approach is 'nation in arms', that in order to face serious threats being faced, then the whole nation must be united to jointly overcome them. The second approach is the awareness of all the national

elements that terrorism in an extraordinary form of crime. The third approach is the use of problem-solving method, which is to eliminate the causes. The President also mentioned the needs to continue carrying out deradicalization.

Further, the President affirmed the need to seriously discuss the terrorism issue as terrorism acts which cause losses of materials and lives will always exist in this world.

The event was ended with fast breaking get-together and evening prayer. In his briefing, the President conveyed his hopes for Lemhannas RI to be a world class institution and to continue reform and revitalization as well as the efforts to become a world class institution. The event was closed with fast breaking get-together and evening prayer.

INTERNAL DISCUSSION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF LEMHANNAS RI

The Governing Board of Lemhannas RI organized an internal discussion on August 10, 2011 at the Nusantara I room in Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI. The discussion was led by the Coordinator of the Governing Board of Lemhannas RI, who is also the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. The event was also attended by structural and functional officials, including the First Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts and Expert Professionals of Lemhannas RI.

The discussion was conducted as a follow-up on the visit to 4 countries, which are the United States, Australia, Spain and Belgium in the foreign strategic study of the XVII PPSA on relevant strategic institutions for exploring cooperation with Lemhannas RI, in line with the decision of the President of the Republic of Indonesia in accelerating Lemhannas RI to become a world class institution.

The discussion was started with presentations from each head of groups of the Overseas Strategic Study (SSLN) about the institutions visited which allowed an exploration in order to maintain cooperation with Lemhannas RI as a world-class institution. Those who gave the presentations were heads of groups for the visits to the US by Air Vice

Marshal Syahrul Ansory, Australia by Prof. Dr. Sudaryono, SU, Belgium by Prof. Dr. Didin S. Damanhuri, SE, M.Si, D.E.A, and Spain by Maj. Gen. Kusworo, M.Sc.

Governor of Lemhannas RI, as a Coordinator of the Governing Board, conveyed that the most fundamental essence for creating a world-class institution is the trust and recognition from the world, with the support of key performance indicator, criteria, physical and non-physical infrastructure. One of the criteria is needed for the development of cooperation with similar institutions abroad. Therefore, cooperation with similar institutions abroad is one of the strategic entry points and that this discussion be a part of Lemhannas RI's efforts to become a world class institution.

THE CLOSING OF THE XVII PPSA OF LEMHANNAS RI

Taking place in Dwi Warna Purwa building of Lemhannas RI on August 11, 2011 the XVII Short Course Program 2011 of Lemhannas RI was officially closed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. The event was attended by officials from ministries, institutions, or the institutions of the participants. It was also attended by structural and functional officials of Lemhannas RI and other invitees.

The XVII PPSA lasted for 5.5 months since its opening on February 22, 2011. The XVII PPSA has carried out educational activities according to the curriculum with 6 core teaching materials of Lemhannas RI, such as Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, Archipelagic Principle called Wawasan Nusantara, national resilience, national management system, national vigilance, and national leadership. The curriculum adopted has referred to the revitalization principles conducted in Lemhannas RI, among others, include efficiency and effectiveness, balance between inward-outward looking, quality assurance principle, technological adaptation principle, continuing education principle, intellectual integrity principle, academic freedom and academic culture in following education.

The XVII PPSA curriculum in 2011 raised the theme "Overcoming Terrorism in the Framework of National Resilience". It was an educational theme to better understand and appreciate the importance of the roles of the government and the people in preventing and overcoming terrorism that is currently growing. The theme was elaborated in the lecture materials and various discussion that were deemed highly relevant and appropriate to national socio-political conditions that are being faced, and will continue to be faced by Indonesia in the future.

In his opening speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed his expectation that the alumni of the XVII PPSA participants should be able to create a new atmosphere

in the nation's social and political order which promotes respect for the basic principles of democracy, such as law supremacy, human rights protection, independent judicial authority, the creation of healthy and strong civil society, implementation of checks and balances system, good governance, free and responsible mass media. By doing so, sufficient national social and political life can be created. The alumni were also expected to give an example in their every move and step as leaders, to be sensitive to the continuation of national social and political life, and national interests.

SOCIALIZATION OF WORLD CLASS INSTITUTION OF LEMHANNAS RI

Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that, in line with the direction from the President of the Republic of Indonesia Dr. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, Lemhannas RI is expected to be become a world class institution. Then the Governor explained that to become a world class institution, it needs to be supported in 3 aspects, which are Key Performance Indicator (KPI), physical and non physical aspects.

In line with the above, the Governor, in the socialization event on the world class institution, asserted that history cannot be forgotten as it is the foundation of the characters and identity of Lemhannas RI. So that in the development and transformation of Lemhannas RI to become the world class institution, the identity of Lemhannas RI should never change.

GOVERNOR OF LEMHANNAS RI'S GENERAL LECTURE IN IPDN: NATIONALITY-BASED LEADERSHIP EDUCATION IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN THE NATIONAL RESILIENCE

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. delivered a general lecture to the students of the Institute of Home Affairs Governance (IPDN) on August 15, 2011 at the General Rudini Hall in IPDN Jatinangor. Present at the general lecture were the Rector of IPDN Prof. DR. Drs. I Nyoman Sumaryadi, M.Si, Rector Asisstant I in Academic Affairs, Rector Assistant II in Administration, Rector Assistant III in Student Affairs as well as other staff members. The general lecture was followed by 1,945 junior students and level 2 students of IPDN with the theme "Nationality-Based Leadership Education in Order to Strengthen the National Resilience".

At the beginning of the general lecture, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed at a glance a description on the dynamic change of national life in the face of global competition. It needs the presence of a qualified figure and leaders who can promote and prioritize nationalistic viewpoint and national interests. The biggest challenge in global competition today is globalization. One of its challenges is that the rapid advances in information technology. On one hand, it gives a positive contribution to the development process and the improvement in the quality of people's life. But on the other hand, the information technology can be used as a means to weaken ideological, political, economic, social and cultural resilience as well as security and defence of a nation. It is not easy for the young generation and leadership cadres to face globalization flow that brings new and more promising values and hopes.

Given the impacts of globalization being faced, they need to be addressed cleverly through a correct, complete and and comprehensive understanding in relation to national resilience conception by cadres and potential leaders in the context of the nation's unity. The future leaders are expected to be able to deal with a variety of the nation's problems based on the mindset, behavior and attitude pattern that always prioritize the Pancasila morality, sense of unity and the nation's interests. Therefore, their knowledge should be applied based on moral values and character of

leadership that are based on the four pillars of the concept of nationalistic viewpoint (Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonseia, and Unity in Diversity).

At the end of his lecture, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed his hope as a form of appreciation for the community of scholars of IPDN as follows: first, in an era of globalization and amidst the changes in national life, IPDN to develop into one of the institutions which will prepare qualified, moral, honest leaders who have a caring and exemplary attitude and always uphold the four pillars of national values and the interests of the nation; Second, in their devotion to the community and nation, the IPDN graduates to set an example through real works and positive contribution to the development and improvement in the quality of life of the Indonesian people and the nation; Third, the IPDN graduates to be able to develop the mindset, behavior and attitude patterns that are consistent with the nation's moral values in the face of the nation's problems by promoting a sense of unity and the interests of the nation; Fourth, in the midst of the complexity of the nation's problems, the IPDN graduates to be able to become pioneers in the inheritance of the four national pillars in order to strengthen the national resilience.
