Marzuki Alie, Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Secretary of Governing Board, First Secretary, the Speakers and Panelists, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals of Lemhannas RI, as well as other invitees.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI in his keynote speech conveyed that a good system of legislative elections will produce representatives of the people who have the character as a statesman with competence corresponding to the duties, roles and functions in legislation, budgeting and supervision. It is believed that a good election mechanism will be able to accommodate the will of the voters as well as political parties, resulting in a strong and authoritative legislative council. to examine various alternatives and aspects, including the psychosocial dimension that is often overlooked in a policy which affects the level of social participation.

ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION:

“REVITALIZATION OF FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM IN ORDER TO IMPROVE PEOPLE’S WELFARE IN THE FRAMEWORK OF NATIONAL RESILIENCE”

On Wednesday, October 19, 2011 in Nusantara Room I, Trigatra Building of Lemhannas RI, the Deputy for Strategic Analysis of Lemhannas RI held a Roundtable Discussion (RTD) with the theme **“Revitalization of Family Planning in Order to Improve Public Welfare in the Framework of National Resilience”**. The roundtable discussion was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., and was attended by Vice Governor, Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, as well as Structural and Functional Officials. The speakers, among others, included Acting Deputy for Population Control of the National Family Planning Coordinating Board (BKKBN) Dr. Ida Bagus Permana, M. Sc, Chairman of the Mandiri Foundation Prof. Dr. H. Haryono Suyono, M.A., Head of the Institute of Demography of the University of Indonesia Dr. Sonny Harry B. Harmadi. The panelists included a member of the House of Representatives’ Commission IX Dr. Surya Chandra Surapaty, Mph. Ph.D., the Vice Executive Director of PKBI Drs. Nanang Munajat, M.M., Professional Expert in Social Culture of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Sudaryono, SU.

In his Keynote Speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that Indonesia with a population of 237.6 million people become the fourth most populated country after the PRC, India, and the United States. It was also pointed out that a population is a determinant for the consequence of

development, either as a subject or object of development. In order to realize a balanced population growth with a quality environmental capacity, support and family, the government has established a policy of family planning through the implementation of family planning programs which is supported by the Law of the Republic of Indonesia Number 52 of 2009 regarding the Population and Family Development. This is also asserted in the National Long Term Development Plan (RPJPN) 2005-2025 that the progress of a nation is also measured based on indicators of population.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI perceived a strong link between the progress of a nation with a population growth rate, including the health level. An advanced nation is marked with a lower population growth rate, higher life expectancy rates and better quality of social services. Overall a better quality of human resources will be reflected in higher productivity. The family planning program today is no longer identical and limited to the issue of contraception only, but it also covers wider issues. The family planning program is not only intended for the declining birth rate, but is also related to the goals of fulfilling reproductive rights, promotion, prevention, treatment of reproductive and sexual health as well as well-being of mothers, infants and children.

At the end of the keynote speech, the Governor of Lemhannas RI reminded the participants of the President’s call during the celebration of the National Family Day XIV in Ambon in 2007 for all the components of the community, especially the Governor, Regent, Mayor and all government officials, to revitalize and revive the family planning program on an ongoing and sustainable basis. Of course, it should be followed up with a variety of programs and action plans for the successful revitalization of family planning program. It is hoped that the success of the family planning programs will be the starting point for the success of development programs that in turn will improve the welfare of the people in a fair and equitable manner. With this roundtable discussion, the Governor of Lemhannas RI hoped that it can be used for an intellectual exercise in order to explore the thoughts and constructive opinions or suggestions in improving the analysis report of Lemhannas RI.

ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION : **IMPROVING REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF PAPUA FROM THE CULTURAL PERSPECTIVE IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN PUBLIC ORDER AND SECURITY IN THE FRAMEWORK OF INTEGRITY OF THE UNITARY STATE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA**

Considering the condition of regional development of Papua that is increasingly left behind compared with the other provinces, the government has given high attention to raise the standard of living of the people of Papua by giving special autonomy to the province. With regards to the duties and functions of Lemhannas RI, on 3 November 2011 a Roundtable Discussion was held on “**Improving the Regional Development of Papua from the Cultural Perspective in Order to Maintain Public Order and Security in the Framework of the Integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia**” in Nusantara I room in Trigatra building of Lemhannas RI.

The Roundtable Discussion, which was led by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, was attended by a number of structural and functional officials of Lemhannas RI. It also involved resource persons such as Director General of Regional Autonomy of the Ministry of Home Affairs Prof. Dr. H. Djohermansyah Djohan, M.A., the Unit for the Acceleration of Development in Papua and West Papua (UP4B), a member of parliament from the PDI-P faction Manuel Kaisepo, S.I.P., a member of Papua Assessment Team from LIPI Dr. Adriana Elisabeth, and from the Department of Anthropology of the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences of the University of Indonesia Achmad Fedyani Saifuddin.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI in his speech conveyed that so far the

government has made various policies. One of which is the Special Autonomy under the Law No. 21 of 2001, which shows a concern and seriousness of the Central Government to build Papua so that backwardness can be resolved soon and the condition of Papua can immediately be aligned with the other provinces in Indonesia. However, the fact shows that after 10 (ten) years of implementation of the special autonomy, the people are still not satisfied with the results of the development. One of the reasons is the lack of cultural factors in any development in Papua.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI gave 4 (four) emphasis, **first**, the development approach in Papua should be prioritized on welfare; **second**, the instability of politics, security and government in Papua shows that the

social political foundations in Papua are fragile; **third**, Papuans are cultural community which has native social order and institutions, and **fourth**, the central government through Presidential Decree number 66 of 2011 formed the Unit for the Acceleration of Development in Papua and West Papua (UP4B) which is deemed an appropriate measure.

According to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, the success of the Papua Regional Development is greatly hoped by the people of Papua and the Indonesian people. Therefore, a manifestation of moral concern and responsibility of all components of the nation is needed in order to seek and find concrete solutions that are effective, efficient, and appropriate to address the issue of Papua.
