



# NATIONAL SEMINAR OF LEMHANNAS RI: “STABILITY IN THE ERA OF DEMOCRACY”

**O**n December 13, 2011 Lemhannas RI held a National Seminar with the theme “**Stability in the Era of Democracy**” at the Lemhannas RI’s auditorium. The seminar was attended by experts in the fields of politics, socio-culture, law, economy, security and defence from home and abroad. The seminar began with a report from the person-in-charge of the seminar, which was followed by an opening remark from the Governor of Lemhannas RI. Later the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal and Security Affairs delivered a keynote speech and officially opened the event.

The National Seminar is a form of participation and concern of Lemhannas RI for the dynamic stability of the nation and state amid growing democratization process. The seminar was divided into two sessions, plenary and commission sessions. The plenary session, moderated by Ir. Siti Nurbaya Bakar, M.Sc. featured keynote speakers Prof. Dr. Juwono Sudarsono and Dr. Christanto Wibisono, while the commission sessions comprised of three Commissions A, B, and C.

Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono gave a briefing to the participants of the Lemhannas RI's Regular Education Program (PPRA) Batch XLVI at the State Palace on December 14, 2011. The briefing was attended by the Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal and Security Affairs Djoko Suyanto, Defense Minister Purnomo Yusgiantoro, Attorney General Basrif Arief, National Police Chief General Timur Pradopo, Cabinet Secretary Dipo Alam, Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts and Expert Professionals of Lemhannas RI.

The event began with a report

from the governor Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. on the activities of Lemhannas and the handing of the book containing the seminar results of Lemhannas RI's PPRA XLVI titled "**The Actualization of Legal Culture in Strengthening Democratization in the Framework of National Resilience**" to the president.

Then the Vice Governor Lieutenant General Moeldoko, S.I.P., as the chairman of the seminar, gave a presentation on the results of the National Seminar themed "**Stability in the Era of Democracy**", which was later followed with a presentation of the results of the seminar of Lemhannas

RI's PPRA XLVI from two of the PPRA XLVI representatives, Prof. Dr. Syahrizal, M.A. and Senior Police Commissioner Maltha, S.H., M.Sc.

The event was subsequently continued with a briefing from the president to the Lemhannas RI's PPRA XLVI participants. In his briefing, the president hoped that the alumni of Lemhannas RI can understand the important roles that they will play in the future. He also have high expectations for alumni of Lemhannas RI for they all have been prepared for becoming leaders at the higher levels. # SIMULATION OF THE NATIONAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF PPRA XLVI

**O**n November 22, 2011 the Opening Ceremony for the Simulation of the National Management System (OS) of Lemhannas RI's PPRA XLVI was held in Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI. The ceremony opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. was attended by the Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals as well as other structural and functional officials.

The activity was one of the main programs of the Lemhannas RI's curriculum for PPRA XLVI participants. It served as a training arena for the participants in which they would simulate certain activities and assume responsibilities as state apparatus in running the government and formulating development policies/strategies in accordance with the national management system.

The theme raised in the simulation of the national management system

of PPRA XLVI was the “**Cross-Sectoral Coordination among State Apparatus in the Framework of Law Enforcement**”. The governor expected that the participants will obtain insight and knowledge of the cross-sectoral coordination steps among government boards, state institutions and embassies of friendly countries in terms of law enforcement that is related to natural disaster, labor

and global market issues.

The indication of success of the national management system can be viewed from several aspects, including: **First**, the ability to analyze and anticipate the situational development. **Second**, the adjustments to the appropriate ways of thinking and action. **Third**, the level of integration of the analysis, policy formulation and implementation of each ministry simulated in producing strategic and quality products. **Fourth**, integrated coordination and cooperation among ministries, as simulated, are logical illustrations in an effort to mobilize the participation of all components of the nation within the framework of national development. The simulation of the national management system, which lasted for three days, was closed on November 25, 2011.

**T**he Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. **T**he Board for the Development and Empowerment of Health Human Resource (PPSDMK) of the Ministry of Health, in cooperation with Lemhannas RI, held a Focus Group Discussion on November 28, 2011 on the 3rd floor, West Wing of Trigatra building. The Focus Group Discussion raised the theme “**The Role of Health Profession in Supporting the Master Plan for the Acceleration and Expansion of Indonesia’s Economic Development 2011-2025**”. The event was attended by Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. Moeldoko, M.Si and a Professor from the Faculty of Public Health of the University of Indonesia Prof. Dr. Ascobat Gani, MPH as resource persons. The facilitators included Head of the Standardization, Certification and Education Center of PPSDMK Board Drg. Oscar Primadi, MPH, Head of the Center of Education and Training of Health Workers of the PPSDMK Board Dr. Faith Asjikin Dahlan, Chairman of FOPKI Drs. Fauzi Kasim, Apt, M.Kes, and Cand. Dr. Syahrul Aminullah, SKM.M.Si.

Related with the professional role in question, the PPSDMK Board, in cooperation with the Forum of Indonesia’s Health Professions (FOPKI), oversees health workers in terms of their type, quantity, quality and

distribution. It is aimed at enhancing the role of professional organizations in Indonesia. The professional organizations concerns about the systematic efforts in the implementation of the National Medium Term Development Plan (RPJMN) 2010-2015 in order to anticipate the challenges in the era of globalization. With the purpose of promoting clean and healthy behaviour, every citizen is expected to always be productive in any aspects of their life as it is closely related to the development of economic corridor.

The FOPKI can play a role in the efforts of health development and feel the need to conduct a study so as to participate and give suggestions for the improved strategy in the masterplan implementation. Therefore, the focus group discussion was held to discuss the strategy, role and type of contribution in the context of fulfilling the basic requirements in achieving the accelerated development vision of 2025 from the perspective of health.

It is expected that a working paper will be produced from this focus group discussion as an elaboration of health profession organizations contribution to the policy of the National Development Acceleration 2011-2025. It will serve as an input for the government in the development and empowerment of health human resources in Indonesia.

# KORPRI'S 40TH ANNIVERSARY CEREMONY OF 2011

In the commemoration of the anniversary of the 40th Corps of the Civil Servant of the Republic of Indonesia (KORPRI), Lemhannas RI held a flag ceremony with the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. acting as the Inspector of the Ceremony. The event was attended by the Vice Governor, Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals and the entire personnel of Lemhannas RI as participants of the ceremony.

The governor, as the Inspector of the ceremony, read out a speech of the President of the Republic of Indonesia conveying that KORPRI, as a major part in the running of the government, is required to improve its professionalism and services to the community, yet maintain its neutrality as the government apparatus. Within 4 (four) decades KORPRI has played a big role and showed a big responsibility in its duty and devotion to the nation and state. It has strengthened the development of its members, both in the implementation of governmental duties and other tasks in accordance with the constitutional mandate.

This year's KORPRI anniversary raises the theme **"With the Spirit of the 40th Anniversary of KORPRI, Let Us Enhance the Development of KORPRI Spirit in Unity in Diversity in Order to Strengthen the Unity and Integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia"**. The theme has three main keywords that we should be focusing on. First, to improve the development of KORPRI spirit in the Unity in Diversity, second, to strengthen the unity and integrity of the unitary state of the Republic of Indonesia; and third, to support the successful implementation of the bureaucratic reform. These three key words are interlinked, and are very important to the successful implementation of the duties of government apparatus.

As the National Patron of the KORPRI, the President of the Republic of Indonesia, through a written speech, delivered a few messages and expressed his hopes to the entire members of KORPRI.

**First**, we should make a success of the entire agenda on the acceleration of Indonesia's development towards a developed country, improve the professionalism and

**Second**, be responsive and constructive in taking public criticisms by making innovation, improving the quality of public services and bureaucratic services that are cheaper, faster, easier and better.

**Third**, Realize good governance, build a credible and accountable bureaucratic culture, continue the efforts to eradicate corruption and corrupt behaviors at all levels of bureaucracy.

**Fourth**, carry out duties with full responsibility, do not disappoint the people, work hard, make endeavor with high discipline, promote a sense of responsibility with enthusiasm to do the best, carry out your duties as form of worship to the God Almighty.

**Fifth**, particularly, in addressing the regional elections in some regions in 2012, all members of KORPRI should act professionally and proportionately, hold fast to the commitment of neutrality, avoid all forms of practical politics, and make sure that the partisanship and loyalty of the KORPRI are only to the nation and the state.

**Sixth**, apply KORPRI doctrine *"Bhinneka Karya Abdi Negara"*. Even though KORPRI members carry out their duties in various areas with diverse works, the KORPRI itself remains one entity in serving the community, nation and state.

## ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION: RECOMMENDATION VALIDATION AND PREPARATION CONCERNING NATIONAL STRATEGIC ISSUES AND ITS IMPACTS ON NATIONAL RESILIENCE AND DEVELOPMENT POLICY AND PERFORMANCE ISSUES

On 30 November 2011 Lemhannas RI held a Roundtable Discussion (RTD) with the theme “**Recommendation Validation and Preparation Concerning National Strategic Issues and Its Impacts on the National Resilience and the Development Policy and Performance Issues**” on the 3rd Floor, West Wing of Astagatra building of Lemhannas RI. The roundtable discussion was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., and was attended by Vice Governor, Secretary of the Governing Board, First Secretary, Deputies, Expert

Lecturers, Expert Analysts and Expert Professionals of Lemhannas RI as well as several officials from relevant ministries/institutions, including the Deputy Minister for the Development Planning of the Directorate-General of Regional Autonomy from the Ministry of Home Affairs, General Planning Assistant (Asrenum) of the TNI Commander-in-Chief, Coordinator of Expert Staff of Chief of Police, and Lecturer in Civil Engineering of the Faculty of Engineering of the University of Indonesia.

The roundtable discussion was held as a follow-up of the workshop on 27-28 September 2011 with all the

provincial governments in Indonesia that were represented by the Heads of Regional Development Planning Agencies (Bappeda), Heads of Central Statistical Bureaus (BPS), and representatives of Higher Education Institutions from all over Indonesia. The governor also hoped that the roundtable discussion will produce a more comprehensive and discerning analysis on the national strategic issues, whether it is related to development policy or performance. The governor also hoped that the discussions should not only produce answers to strategic issues on national resilience, but also recommendations that can be used as a basis to determine national development priorities, including policies, both for central and regional governments.

At the end of the event the governor reaffirmed that Lemhannas RI already has a national resilience laboratory. The results of the national resilience measurement do not only benefit Lemhannas RI internally, but also all of the stakeholders. The governor hoped that in the future a more intensive cooperation with various Ministries / Agencies, Army, Police and Higher Education Institutions can be established in order to update data and benefit from the results of the measurements that have been performed.
