## COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGY ON CONTROLLING OVER TERRORISM

**T**errorism is human and civilization crime as well as being one of serious threats against sovereignty of every country because terrorism has become crime which is international in nature causing danger to world security and peace as well as inflicting a loss to people's prosperity so that it is necessary to take comprehensive and sustainable eradication measures to protect and honor human rights.

Facing the issues, Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia is very concerned about the development of strategic environment relating to survival of State and Nation Life, including terrorism issue. As a preliminary step on March 2009, Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia has made a study relating to terrorism through Round Table Discussion on **Increase of National Alertness to Anticipate Terrorism Act In the Framework of Political Stability and the findings thereof is already given to the President of the Republic of Indonesia**. The recommendation principally contains as follows: **first**, Terrorism Act needs to be watched out for, because Criminal Act of Terrorism can occur at anytime and anywhere; **Second**, it is necessary to promote the status of Terrorism Eradication Coordination Desk (DKPT) to eradication coordination board.

Follow up of Round Table Discussion on March 2009 was re-evaluated through Round Table Discussion on November 5, 2009 discussing the **Comprehensive Strategy on Controlling Over Terrorism** according to recommendation of National Summit resolutions, and the findings thereof remain supporting establishment independent body of Controlling Over terrorism. Taking into account terrorism as latent danger being one of serious threats against sovereignty of every country and also being crime which is international in nature that can endanger the world security and peace and inflicting a loss to people's welfare therefore it is necessary to take comprehensive and sustainable eradication measures to protect and honor human rights.

Therefore, National Alertness particularly anticipating Criminal act of terrorism needs to be increased following the development of strategic environment. Some comprehensive strategies to Control Over Terrorism are as follows:

1. Not resulting in conflict among government agencies.
2. Increasing coordinated synergy of entire existing potencies (National Army, National Police, BIN and others).
3. Paying attention to cultural, geo-politic and geo-strategic basis.
4. Increasing international cooperation.

Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia in his message readout by Vice Governor, Air Marshal of National Army, DR. Rio Mendung Thalieb in the opening of National Management System Process of PPRA XLIII of Fiscal Year 2009, November 10, 2009 in Dwi Warna Purwa Building of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia with a theme: "Inter-Sectoral Coordination of Government Apparatus in the Framework of National Energy Resilience", stated among others that the National Management System Processing Activity is one of methods of learning process in Education Program within Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, by applying the same into form of work simulation of government

apparatus.

Pursuant to theme of this time which is related to Law Number 30 of 2007 regarding Energy that energy plays important role to improvement of economic activity and National Resilience. To Indonesia, it is very important, because it does not only serve as capability to respond dynamicity of change of global energy (external) it is also as independence to secure availability of energy (internal), according to change of government policy from Supply Side Policy to Demand Side Policy.

Therefore, it is necessary to establish policy which is not only based on supply side but also demand side. Management of the two sides continuously and

complementary which can expectedly create national energy resilience which is more stable and sustainable. Scarcity of energy occurring at present time is a serious threat to the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia in the future so that it will disturb national development continuously which will in turn treat National Resilience.

It is expected that through this National Management System Process, participants can instill the importance of strengthening inter-sectoral coordination, to create integrity of planning, implementation and supervision as well as be able to give fresh ideas in the framework of creating national energy resilience.

# SOCIALIZATION ON GOVERNMENT INTERNAL CONTROL SYSTEM AND SOCIALIZATION OF BUREAUCRACY REFORMATION

Taking place in Dwi Warna Purwa Building of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia dated November 3, 2009, there was already held a program of Socialization of Bureaucracy Reformation and Government Internal Control System (SPIP) of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia.

The Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., stated, in his message, that in the modern government organization management, Internal Control System is a very important thing that should be developed continuously and performed in each work unit in its entirety in each government agency including in Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia.

Good government Internal Control system, will give good security

to quality and performance of government as well, so that expectedly, the government administration can fulfill principles of Good Governance and will be avoided from lawsuit, either administration, civil or criminal cases. Based on Government Regulation Number 60 of 2008 regarding Government Internal Control System (SPIP), Chairperson of Ministry or Institution will be obligated to apply Control over Government administration in its institution.

Bureaucracy reformation is an effort to make renewal and basic change to government administration system, particularly those relating to various aspects of institution or organization, management and human resources. It is aimed at developing or establishing profile and attitude of State apparatus having

high integrity. Existence of various issues that can hinder government administration system should be re-managed to make improvement, since basically, Bureaucracy Reformation is performed to materialize good Governance, and being strategic step in developing state apparatus, in order to be more efficient and productive in assuming mandates pursuant to task and function of organization.

Expectedly, participant of socialization of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia can, through this forum, understand and apply the same in the implementation of task and further the findings of socialization can be formulated appropriately and concretely, for improvement and increase of accountability of performance of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia.

# LABKURTANNAS

National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia (Lemhannas RI) will use, in performing its main function and tasks, among others some approaches based on thoughts which are historical in nature through geo-politic and geo-strategic approaches in the context of National Resilience analyzing national issues. Some of national issues are among others impact of strategic environment development, either regionally or internationally. It is certainly closely related to either high or low of National Resilience of a certain Country.

Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia in this information era has an obligation to improve the benefit of information system by construction of National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas) which will further have a function to monitor and analysis level/index of National Resilience, and National Resilience in Region in 33 provinces through geo-politic and geo-strategic approach (static and dynamic dimension). Referring to the said National Resilience Measurement, there was already established Socialization Team on National Resilience Measurement which had on weeks II and II on November 2009,

In the socialization, Team explained among others on increase of the benefit of National Resilience Measurement which is initially only for Academic Exercise in education and training activities, in the future it will become instrument that can be used as Early Warning System and Policy Advice both to Central and Regional Government.

Further, there was also explained principles on National Resilience Measurement which included principle of system approach, incorporated, competitiveness. Inter-Sectoral and inter-discipline, professionalism, Benefit, as well as high technology. Team also explained some matters, such as: Process in National Resilience Measurement Laboratory, Labkurtannas (National Resilience Measurement Laboratory) Concept, Matrix Data and some variable aspects and relevant indicators of National Resilience Measurement, among others: Specimen of National Resilience Index Measurement Findings using Hypothetic Data and Specimen of National Resilience Index Measurement Simulation using Hypothetic Data.

Speech of President of the Republic of Indonesia Dr. H. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono readout by Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., in the 38<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration of KORPRI on November 30, 2009 in Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, stated that since its incorporation on November 29, 1971, KORPRI has always demonstrated role and responsibility pursuant to present condition to direct its members in performing government tasks and serve people's need in various sectors.

In his speech, the President of the Republic of Indonesia stated that journey of state has led KORPRI as professional and independent organization, which position and activity are not separated from official services, to always cooperate together with the other state components in order to consistently struggle for state goal. Although challenge we encounter to attain the state goal is getting harder and complex if compared to challenge in the past times.

Therefore, a number of members of KORPRI as State Apparatus shall remain improving its three roles as State Servants, Public Servants and Government Servant. Let us develop the three roles as worshipping, being a State Apparatus which is not easy, can be performed appropriately if performed as sincere and truthful worshipping, with spirit and affection to work and profession.

Effort to improve prosperity of Government Apparatus is still limited by affordability and State budget, but we are grateful that it does not decrease discipline, loyalty, and professionalism of members of KORPRI. Although our budget is still limited, the government kept trying to increase budget relating to improvement of prosperity of Civil Servants. This effort is important, to improve prosperity of Civil Servant, to

improve performance quality of bureaucracy as an integral part of bureaucracy reformation, including improving morality of Civil Servants to assume tasks as given by State.

As National Adviser of KORPRI, President of the Republic of Indonesia gave some messages as follows :

- First** : Continue reformation, to keep developing democracy, enforce law, developing clean system.
- Second** : Keep satisfying basic necessities of people and regional economy, throughout Provinces, Districts and Cities.
- Third** : Show that members of KORPRI throughout Indonesia are responsive in listening people's criticism for reaching the best efforts.
- Fourth** : Develop mental to serve, not mental to be served. Since the needed public service should be easy and not complicated.
- Fifth** : Stipulate good governance and bureaucracy reformation as priority.
- Sixth** : See forward namely taking any effort which is also important to avoid corruption that should be performed seriously.
- Seventh** : Jointly perform task to dedicate to State and Nation with principle which is accountable to perform task appropriately.

# DEPUTY OF NATIONAL VALUES STABILIZATION

In the Round Table Discussion regarding Study Result of Deputy of National Values Stabilization dated November 25, 2009, the Governor of Lemhannas (National Resilience Institution) of the Republic of Indonesia Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., declares that one of the main problems encountered by Indonesia in social, state and national life at present time is that how to understand appropriately the national values as contained in national consensus consisting the principle of 4 (four) main pillars, namely: Pancasila, 1945 Constitution, Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia and blessing of Bhinneka Tunggal Ika (motto), thereby being able to increase pride to be the part of the unitary state of the Republic of Indonesia.

Appropriate comprehension to the 4 (four) pillars of National Consensus as basic values in national and state life will be important and simultaneously serves as national bond reflecting togetherness. In globalization era which is full of dynamic and social turbulence is highly needed, since awareness on firm togetherness is social capital. In the absence thereof the State role will become very weak and ineffective, particularly if being faced with globalization and

regionalization course tending to be stronger. Fading away of interactive followed by social trust will give impact to the decrease of state productivity.

Togetherness as a state is very strategic in nature, it does not only focuses on routine, practical and pragmatic approach, but it will stabilize state character and strengthen state integrity as well as political will to always increase national sense, since it constitutes national strength that will be taken into consideration by the other state and nation. Any state will always honor history, geo-politic, civilization and others.

Appropriate comprehension to national values as a state identity is one of efforts to stop susceptibility and development of conflict within society simultaneously as filter against globalization. Therefore, re-actualization and revitalization of state values are much needed to face global challenge which is getting more complex and developing rapidly. The Implementation thereof is emergence of fresh ideas which are developed in cultural context and state values supported by pillars and local wisdom values living and developing within society in region.

3. **John F. Kennedy**, in Inaugural Address on January 20, 1961, stating that Ask not what your country can do for you, ask what you can do for your country.

# Idul Qurban

## (The Feast of The Sacrifice 1430 H)

In November 30, 2009, the Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H., accompanied by Vice Governor, and the First Secretary, conducted Slaughter of Sacrificial Animal Program in the framework of celebrating Idul Adha 1430 H with a theme:

***Let make Idul Qurban 1430 H increase our Social Solidarity and Concern of Human to materialize piety to Allah SWT.***

Idul Qurban program conducted in yard of Sudirman Mosque of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia was also attended by Deputies, Professional Staff, Structural Official, and entire personnel within Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia, as well as board of management of *Dharma Wanita Persatuan Lemhannas* of the Republic of Indonesia.

In Idul Qurban 1430 H of this year, Lemhannas (National Resilience Institute) of the Republic of Indonesia gave sacrificial animal of 15 cows and 8 goats. A part of meat of Sacrificial Animal was distributed to personnel of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia who were entitled to receive the same and another part of sacrificial animal meat was distributed to residents living around Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia. The meat of sacrificial animal was a participation from various parties as received by committee for Idul Qurban 1430 H of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia.

In his speech, the Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia said that Idul Qurban contained broad meaning, particularly in spiritual

and social aspects, as exemplified by Prophet Abraham and Ishmael for their adherence and surrendering in exercising order by Allah SWT. Socially, the adherence contains meaning that every human should be willing to, adhere to and wholehearted without expecting anything in return to exercise sacrifice to help those who are in need, namely sacrifice performed solely hoping blessing from Allah SWT. The sacrificial animal is only a representation, containing meaning to help those who are in need.

It constitutes materialization of our affection to Allah SWT actualized in affection to human, as said by Prophet Mohammed PBUH (Peace Be Upon Him):

***No deed which is mostly loved by Allah from the Human Race upon Idul Adha, but slaughtering sacrificial animal.***

Further, the Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia appealed that in elucidating sacrifice of the Prophet Abraham and Ishmael, we can improve our faith and piety to Allah SWT, reflected increase of our worshipping to Allah, *Hablumminallah* and relationship with human, *Hablumminannas*.

In the end of his speech, the Governor of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia expected that this implementation of Idul Qurban worshipping will give motivation to improve our respective performance to state and Nation.

All series of registration with completeness of requirement was conducted from October 26 through November 3, 2009, and further, 4 selection phases shall be conducted as follows:

**First Phase:** from November 4 – 6, 2009 was administrative selection to 765 applicants fulfilling requirements already publicized through website of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia. From November

7-8, 2009, any applicants already fulfilling requirements will take test number by carrying applicant's achieves as needed. 301 persons were present out of a number of applicants fulfilling requirements.

**Second Phase,** from November 10-11, 2009 General Knowledge Test was conducted (Basic Competency Test/TKD and Specialty Competency Test/TKB) and 71 persons passed the test.

**Third Phase,** from November 17-18, 2009, health test was conducted in Polyclinic of Lemhannas of the Republic of Indonesia and 65 persons passed the test.

**Fourth Phase,** From November 23-24, 2009, final test was conducted namely interview. Final test of selection whether or not any applicant passes the test will be determined by Pantukhir with education qualification according to allocation of need, and 28 persons passed the test.
