Lemhannas RI held a Closing Ceremony of the 19<sup>th</sup> Short Educational Course Program (PPSA) of Lemhannas RI in the Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI, Jakarta on Thursday (21/11).

The 19<sup>th</sup> PPSA, which lasted for 5.5 months, was closed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA. The course was filled with educational activities, such as lectures, discussions, Domestic Strategic Studies (SSDN), Overseas Strategic Studies (SSLN), seminars, briefing by the President, and individual paper work (Taskap) and so on.

Budi Susilo Soepandji, in his remarks, said that the 5.5 month-long course is a process to enhance the understanding of the six cores of Lemhannas RI, namely Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, National Resilience, Nationalistic Insight, National Management System, National Vigilance, and National Leadership.

# Lemhannas RI Ready to Implement Quality Management System

Lemhannas RI held a dissemination program on the Implementation of ISO 9001:2008 Quality Management System on Tuesday (26/11) on the 3rd Floor, East Wing of Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The quality management basically aims to boost service quality and customer satisfaction. According to the explanation given by a speaker from consulting firm PT. Karisma Primalulang, a management system must contain vision, value, strategy, process, system and structure. All the six elements, he continued, must exist entirely in running a quality management system as they are interrelated with each other.

For Lemhannas RI, ISO 9001: 2008 Quality Management System will be beneficial in supporting a structured management system, as well as in documenting each stage of its process. It also can be as a tool to examine the effectiveness of a system.

The dissemination event is the initial stage that Lemhannas RI has to go through in order to obtain ISO 9001:2008 certification, which is useful in improving quality management.

# Labkurtannas Carries Out Further Reviews and Assessment of Strategic Issues

The National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas) organized a roundtable discussion on the "Validation of Strategic Issues and Formulation of National Resilience Recommendations" on Tuesday (26/11) on the 4th Floor, West Wing of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The roundtable discussion opened by the Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc. featured Regional Development Director from Bappenas Ir. Arifin Rudiyanto, M.Sc., Ph.D and Deputy for Balance and Statistical Analysis from BPS Kecuk Suhariyanto as speakers.

Throughout 2013, Labkurtannas has examined a range of strategic issues which need to be further validated and refined.

Based on the studies conducted on 623 indicators, it is found that the aggregate national resilience is still less formidable, even though the composite index has improved.

Labkurtannas stated that, after a further review, it is found that the indicators that are used to be strategic issues in the 2012 studies have remained as such up until now, such as the quality of human resources, unemployment, poverty, social inequality, food security, energy and water, dependence of national economy, border areas, decreasing natural resources, understanding of national values, good governance, and provision of accurate and precise data on natural resources potential.

Meanwhile, Labkurtannas also viewed that the accuracy of demographic data has become a serious concern ahead of the 2014 election. If not taken seriously, it is feared that there will be potential conflicts that could disrupt national stability.

The roundtable discussion examined and further analyzed these strategic issues so as to produce an accurate recommendation about public policies that need to be made in order to accelerate the achievement of national development goals.

Apart from Labkurtannas working group, the roundtable discussion was also attended by senior lecturers, senior analysts and professionals of Lemhannas RI.

# Benefits and Impacts of Lemhannas RI's Studies

Lemhannas RI held a roundtable discussion themed "Benefits and Impacts of the Studies Conducted by the Office of the Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI", Thursday (28/12), on the 4th Floor, West Wing of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The roundtable discussion opened by the Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI Inspector General of Police Drs. Herry Haryanto featured three speakers, namely Deputy for Education of the Ministry for People's Welfare Prof. Dr. R. Agus Sartono, MBA, Deputy II for Foreign Political Affairs of the Coordinating Ministry for Political, Legal and Security Affairs Agus Sriyono and Assistant Deputy for Fiscal Affairs of the Coordinating Ministry of Economy Andie Megantara, Ph.D.

The panelists at the roundtable discussion comprised of Senior Analyst of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. M. Nasir Madjid, Professional in Economy of Lemhannas RI DR. Panutan Sakti Sulendrakusuma, S.E., M.T., Akt., Senior Analyst in Socio-culture of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Sudaryono, SU, Senior Analyst of Security and Defense of Lemhannas RI Insp. Gen. Pol. Drs. Johny Samosir, M.Sc., and Professional of Diplomacy and International Relations of Lemhannas RI Rear Admiral (Ret.) Robert Mangindaan.

The roundtable discussion focused on the usability of the studies and performance evaluation of the Office of the Deputy for Strategic Studies. Throughout 2013, it has produced 15 titles for actual studies, 5 titles for ongoing studies, 5 titles for strategic environment studies and 5 titles for desk-conflict studies.

Structurally, those strategic studies are carried out by five directorates for strategic studies, covering politics, economy, social affairs, culture, security and defense, and international affairs, respectively. The study papers containing policy recommendations are submitted to the president, which will then be disseminated to relevant coordinating ministries for a follow-up action.



The roundtable discussion aimed to obtain objective data with regard to the benefits and impacts resulting from Lemhannas RI's recommendations. Those results will later be evaluated by the Office of Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI in order to continue improving the quality and validity of its studies.



## Lemhannas RI Carries Out Simulation of Fire Hazard Handling

Lemhannas RI carried out fire hazard handling training on Thursday (28/11) at the central courtyard of Lemhannas RI.

This exercise simulated the handling of fire disaster that occurred at the facilities of Lemhannas RI by members of security team and cleaning service staff of Lemhannas RI.

The simulation was witnessed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. along with a number of officials of Lemhannas RI. The exercise was held by Lemhannas RI in cooperation with the Office of Fire Extinguishing and Prevention of the Jakarta Province.

Lemhannas RI itself has a standard security for office buildings with the installing of fire extinguishers in each building.

The mounted extinguishers are easy to operate and placed in easy-to-grab spots, of appropriate size and in good condition.

As for large-scale fires, Lemhannas RI has also installed hydrants in certain spots which allow firefighters to easily find sources of water.

The training exercise was aimed at maintaining the readiness and capability of the personnels of Lemhannas RI to deal with fire hazards at any time while carrying out their duties and achieve 'zero accident' goals.

The simulation exercise is expected to equip the personnels of Lemhannas RI with the capability to prevent and avoid the occurrence of fires, as well as to cut power in accordance with proper procedures if a fire was to break out.

# Lemhannas RI Cooperates with Four Aceh's Institutions



The cooperation was a continuation of dissemination of national values, which will last for a period of five years. The three initial strategic issues are work environment, education and settlements.

Budi Susilo Soepandji, after delivering a general lecture, conveyed his assessment of the current situation in Aceh which was deemed as conducive in terms of socio-culture and life of Aceh community. Therefore, according to him, it is a positive effort that must continually be maintained.

"Both of these colleges can serve as a symbol for national thinkers coming from these universities to develop nationalism in their environments," said Budi Susilo Soepandji.

The event was also attended by a number of officials from Regional Executive Conference (Muspida), including Assistant I of the Regional Secretariat Dr. Iskandar Gani MH representing the Governor of Aceh, Iskandar Muda Military Region Commander, Deputy Chief of Police and other invitees.

Lemhannas RI established a cooperation with four institutions in Aceh through the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) which was held at the Postgraduate Hall of State Islamic University (UIN) of Ar-Raniry on Tuesday (3/12). The four institutions are UIN Ar-Raniry, University of Syiah Kuala (Unsyiah), Ulama Consultative Assembly (MPU) Aceh, and Aceh Custom Assembly (MAA).

The memorandum of understanding signed by the Governor Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji D.E.A., Rector of UIN of Ar-Raniry Prof. Farid Wajdi Ibrahim M.A., Unsyiah Rector represented by Assistant Rector IV Dr. Ir. Darusman M.Sc., Head of MPU Aceh Tgk H. Ghazali Mohd. Syam, and Chairman of MAA represented by Drs. H. Abdurrahman Kaoy.

The signing of MoU is aimed at enhancing institutional relationship among the parties. The cooperation covers five areas, namely cadre education and strengthening of national-level leadership, strategic research and studies, strengthening of national values, measurement of national resilience, and community service.
