# Lemhannas RI Deputy Governor Opens Program of Dialogue on Nationalistic Insight for SKK Migas

The Opening Ceremony of the Strengthening Program of National Values for the participants from the Upstream Oil and Gas Regulatory Special Task Force (SKK Migas) Batch VII was opened by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Dede Rusamsi, S.E. on Tuesday (17/12) at the Dwi Warna Purwa Building of Lemhannas RI.

# Governor of Lemhannas RI Delivers Lemhannas RI's DIPA Fiscal for 2014

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., on Monday (6/1), handed Lemhannas RI's DIPA Induk (Budget Execution Document for Echelon I/Program Level) for the year 2014, which was set by the Minister of Finance on December 5, 2013, to all heads of work units in Lemhannas RI. The DIPA was handed symbolically to the Deputy for the Education of National-level Leaders.

Upon the handing of DIPA, Budi Susilo Soepandji conveyed that there are several policies that must be paid attention to, which include, among others, the discipline of each work unit in implementing programs and budget process so that deviation between the budget absorption realization and the target can be avoided as much as possible.

Concerning the capital expenditure programs, President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono had handed DIPA to Ministries and Institutions on 10 December 2013, allowing the financial realization to start from the beginning of January 2014.

Bringing to mind the revised work program and budget proposal, Budi Susilo Soepandji cautioned its impacts on the implementation of activities and budget expenditure, mentioning that all the process should always adhere to the Regulation of Finance Minister on the Procedures for Revision. "In this case, it is sufficient for the revised work programs and budget to go, at most, to the level of the Director General of Budget (DJA)", he said.

He further expressed that the outcomes or outputs, which are an indicator of the performance of programs and activities, must be immediately prepared in the planning work programs and budget



for the fiscal year 2015 in order to implement the Performance-Based Budgeting (ABK).

Based on the presidential directive dated May 20, 2013, Lemhannas RI must constantly improve the capacity of its human resources in order to support the institutional tasks and functions, especially the capacity of its faculty members, who are the spearhead in its implementation. In addition to that, the capacity of facilities and infrastructure shall also be increased through the construction of Lemhannas RI towers that will be completed within a four-year period.

Concerning the preparation of its work programs and budget for the fiscal year 2015, the governor instructed that internal consolidation be reinforced by all work units at the beginning of this year in order to plan work programs and budget for fiscal year 2015 ahead of the Planning and Development Meeting (Musrenbang) of Lemhannas RI which will be held after the convening of national Planning and Development meeting for the Fiscal Year 2014.

## RRI Pro 3 Broadcast Live Dialogue on Nationalistic Insight for Political Parties' Legislative Candidates

Lemhannas RI, in cooperation with Pro 3 RRI, held a Dialogue on Nationalistic Insight for the political parties' legislative candidates participating in the 2014 election on Thursday (19/12) at the Mini Auditorium of Lemhannas RI.

The resource persons at the event were Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., President Director of LPP RRI Rosarita Niken Widiastuti, M.Si., Deputy for the Strengthening of National Values of Lemhannas RI Rear Admiral Ir. Leonardi, Professional in Domestic Governance and National Management System Dr. Kausar AS., M.Si., Professional in National Resilience of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Lumban Sianipar, S.I.P. and Professional in National Vigilance of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen (Ret.) Dr. Ir. # Revitalization of the Values of 4 Basic Consensus, Strategic Development Measures and National Character Building

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. on Tuesday (7/1), delivered a scientific oration at the event "Open Session of the Senate and Celebration of the 51<sup>st</sup> Anniversary of Universitas Pembangunan Nasional or National Development University (UPN) "Veteran" Jakarta at Balai Graha Adhya Wicaksana, Research and Development Centre of the Indonesian Navy, Jakarta.

In the scientific oration themed "Accelerating UPN Veteran Jakarta's Breakthroughs to Become a Prestigious University", Budi Susilo Soepandji conveyed that Indonesia currently needs a quality institution of higher education which can serve as a model for the development of nationalistic insight.

Globalization and reform euphoria, which is filled with spirit of change, have affected the mindset, attitudes and behaviours of the next generation in dealing with national issues. Therefore, there is increasing concern about the future generation drifting away from the national identity Pancasila.

According to Budi Susilo Soepandji, the spirit of mutual cooperation is getting diminished in urban and rural communities. "Gradually, the rural people begin to adopt, and get used to, individualistic way of life", he added.

Therefore, he thinks of the value revitalization of four basic national consensus as a strategic step in building and developing national character. "However, such measures and efforts



should be accompanied by a character education which starts from an early age," he continued.

As an institution of higher learning, UPN "Veteran" Jakarta, in fact, has a crucial strategic role in building national character, especially for its young generation, which is in accordance with Three Principles of Higher Education (tri dharma), namely: education, research and community service.

The big name that UPN "Veteran" Jakarta has, continued Budi Susilo Soepandji, should serve as a source of motivation for all of its academic community members to develop nationalistic education curriculum through its unique three-in-one program (understanding nationalistic insight, especially state defence, having entrepreneurship skills, and having leadership skills).

## Contribution of Character Education and Development to Legal Awareness

**“Although the economy is a very important aspect in the development, it is not the only parameter for people’s equitable and fair prosperity”**

The statement was made by the Governor of Lemhannas RI when serving as a panelist in a National Convention (Silaknas) organized by the Indonesian Muslim Intellectuals Association (ICMI) on Saturday (21/12) in Assembly Hall, Jakarta Convention Center (JCC), Jakarta.

Raising the theme “Indonesia’s New Economic Movement: Mobilization of Access to Justice and Governance for the Sake of People’s Welfare”, the event was moderated by Dr. Ir. Johan O. Silalahi, MH with the KPK Chairman Abraham Samad, Chairman of the Association of Indonesian Muslim Intellectuals (ICMI) Presidium Drs. Priyo Budi Santoso and Dr. Yudi Latief serving as the panelists.

At the event, Budi Susilo Soepandji explained that the national development

should be supported by ideological, political, economic, social, cultural, and defense and security aspects in order to ensure a harmony and balance between the aspects of prosperity and security.

“Adhering to the conception of national resilience, mobilization of access to justice and governance is a strategic move to further drive people’s economy-oriented development”, he explained.

With regard to the mobilization of access to justice and governance for the sake of people’s welfare, Budi Susilo Soepandji further said that it should be started from the character development of all the citizens. “In this regard, character building and education become a dominant factor that will determine the level of people’s legal awareness”, he

added.

Character education should be introduced from an early age so that when a child grows up he or she will actively disseminate and maintain the values that have been taught to them.

“The values, such as piety, honesty and patience, should become the spirit of the national life, starting from home, school, workplace or in the fields of arts and culture, politics and so forth,” continued Budi Susilo Soepandji. It is only when they are applied that the mobilization of access to justice and governance can be realized for the sake of people’s welfare, which will eventually strengthen national resilience in all of its aspects.

Titled "Policy and Planning Scenario of Border Areas in Indonesia (Case Study of Land Borders in Kalimantan)", Moeldoko defended his dissertation in front of a panel of lecturers chaired by Dr. Arie Setiabudi Soesilo M.Sc.

Acting as the promoter was Prof. Dr. Eko Prasodjo, Mag rer Publ with co-promoter Azhar Kasim. The committee members were Son Diamar, Roy Valiant Salomo, Dr. Sodjuangan Situmorang, Sudarsono Hardjosoekarto, Martani Huseini and Irfan Ridwan Maksum.

Moeldoko once assumed the post of Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI for two years from 2011 before being entrusted to be



Deputy Chief of Staff of the Army (Wakasad) in 2013. In the same year, he was appointed as Chief of Staff of the Army (Kasad) replacing Gen. (Ret.) Pramono Edhie Wibowo, and three months later, he was installed by the President as the Commander-in-Chief of the Indonesian Military (TNI).

The defence of Moeldoko's doctoral dissertation was also attended by Defence Minister Purnomo Yusgiantoro, IKAL Chairman Gen. (Ret.) Agum Gumelar, former Governor of Lemhannas RI Muladi, Chief of Naval Staff (Kasal) Admiral Dr. Marsetio and a number of other invited figures.

# Lemhannas RI's Prospective Foreign Participants Gains Deeper Insight Into Local Culture

Ahead of the opening of the 51<sup>st</sup> and 52<sup>nd</sup> Regular Educational Course Program (PPRA), Bureau of Cooperation of Lemhannas RI carried out a special program for 13 prospective foreign participants for five days (6 – 10 January 2014).

The purpose of the program is to give an insight to the prospective foreign participants into the richness of local culture before they start following PPRA education of Lemhannas RI. Previously, they took a course in Indonesian language in the Language Center of the Defense Ministry in Jakarta for six months.

On the first day of the program, Chief of Cooperation Bureau of Lemhannas RI Commodore Sulistiyanto, M.Sc. introduced the institutional profile and the main subjects offered by Lemhannas RI to the prospective foreign participants. Later in the day, they were invited to inspect the office complex of Lemhannas RI.

They also made a visit to Kota Tua Jakarta or Old Jakarta to learn more about the history of the city through the heritage of old buildings and statues of historic significance. Other than the Old Jakarta, they



also went to several other places, namely the Satria Mandala Museum, Taman Mini Indonesia Indah or the Beautiful Indonesia Miniature Park (TMII), Indonesian military "Museum Keprajuritan" and the National Monument (Monas).

After following the introduction program to the local culture for five days, the prospective foreign participants admitted that they were very impressed and astonished to see the unique and diverse richness of Indonesian culture as well as its history of long, heroic struggle for independence.

The 51<sup>st</sup> PPRA program was followed by eight foreign participants from friendly countries, which are from Algeria, Liberia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Timor Leste, Zimbabwe and Malaysia, while the 52<sup>nd</sup> PPRA was followed by five foreign participants, namely from Myanmar, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Zimbabwe and Singapore.

# Lecturers from across Jakarta Follow Training of Trainers (ToT) Program in Lemhannas RI

**T**raining of Trainers (ToT) Program for the Strengthening of National Values for lecturers of public and private higher education institutions from across Jakarta Province was officially opened by Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. on Tuesday (20/1) in Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI.

The training, lasting for ten days, was followed by 79 lecturers from various universities in Jakarta. The current state of Indonesian human resources still needs improvement, both in terms of intelligence and mastery of science and technology, as well as in the social aspects of culture, morals and character.

In order to address the situation, Budi Susilo Soepandji said that various efforts are needed in order to improve the nationalistic insight, such as through education, training, upgrading/outreach with educative, persuasive and motivational methods.

Improving the quality of human resources is very important for the enhancement of national values, which in turn will strengthen our unity in diversity.

National values should become the main element, both in building national character and establishing a guideline for nationhood, so that Indonesia will be known for its national identity and dignity as well as respect for other nations and self-sacrifice for the sake of the nation.

The success of these efforts is greatly determined by national education system, which is through educators who are not only able to provide education on the intellectual aspects, but also on the aspects of national identity that derives from four basic national consensus.

Budi Susilo Soepandji hoped that lecturers, as agents of change, can develop a common perception of the concept of nationalistic insight and reinvigorate the methods of character education for their students.
