# PPID Meeting Discusses Understaffing Issue

The enactment of the law on transparency of public information in 2008 has encouraged all public bodies to establish an Information and Documentation Management Unit (PPID) as stipulated in the Government Regulation No. 61 of 2010 on the implementation of Law No. 14 of 2008 on the Transparency of Public Information.

Pursuant to Article 7 of Law No. 14 of 2008 on the Transparency of Public Information, Lemhannas RI, as one of public institutions, shall provide, supply and / or publish any public information under its authority for the inquirers, except for the information that is exempted from disclosure in accordance with the regulation.

Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI, as the leading sector of PPID activity, held a meeting on Thursday (30/1) in Nusantara II Meeting Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The meeting, attended by representatives of all work units, was chaired by Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI Commodore E. Estu Prabowo as ex officio official of PPID.

The agenda being discussed at the meeting included, among others, list of public information, PPID understaffing issue, mechanism of public information disclosure, and lack of contents in Lemhannas RI's PPID website.

It was reported that in the near future more data or information will be uploaded to Lemhannas RI's PPID website which included, among others, Lemhannas RI's strategic plans, Accountability and Performance Report of Government Institutions (LAKIP), and Work Plan and Budget (RKAKL) as well as other public information and data of each work unit.

With regard to the PPID's understaffing issue, one obstacle being faced currently is the lack of human resources at the Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI. Therefore, further cooperation with other bureaus/deputy offices, in terms of provision of competent personnel responsible for sorting out public information documents efficiently and effectively, is required.

Furthermore, Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI reminded the meeting participants that each work unit of Lemhannas RI needs to cooperate and coordinate among themselves so that public information can be provided by adhering to the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) mechanism.

# Lemhannas RI's Echelon III Officials Formulate 2015 – 2019 Institutional Roadmap

Lemhannas RI organized a workshop for echelon III officials for three days (16 – 18 January 2014) in Ciloto, Cipanas Subdistrict, West Java, in order to formulate the concept of Lemhannas RI's 2015 – 2019 Roadmap, paving the way for the second phase of the roadmap to be implemented in an effort to achieve a World Class Institution (WCI) status, for which the products of Lemhannas RI will be recognized in Asia-Pacific region.

The workshop was followed by Echelon III officials of Lemhannas RI since they are the backbone of their respective work units and have the required knowledge of their work units' duties and functions as well as the goals that should be outlined in the budget plan.

The Prime Secretary Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., when opening the workshop, reminded the participants of the importance of realizing Lemhannas RI's vision to become a World Class Institution.

"It will be difficult to make a dream come true if we do not have the supports needed of all elements of the institution, which is formulated in the form of an action plan," said Prime Secretary. Therefore, the vision of the institution, he added, must be kept in mind, understood and implemented by all members of Lemhannas RI, which will be reflected in mindset, systems, products and behaviors as well as in the availability of adequate facilities and infrastructure.

On the first day in Ciloto, after the opening remark by the

Prime Secretary, Dr. Panutan Sakti delivered a presentation on the achievement of Lemhannas RI's goals by 2025 as well as the problems encountered to achieve them. Another facilitator, Dr. Herdis, gave a presentation on the outcome of the review of Lemhannas RI' activities for the year 2013.

Value-laden outbound activities were held on the sidelines of the workshop. It was expected to renew the participants' work motivation and strengthen their synergy and teamwork. Such activities benefit the participants as they come back to work and carry out their daily duties and help achieve the visions and missions of the institution.

The forms of activities in the workshop included lectures and group discussions. The resource persons were Mid-level Planners from National Development Planning Board (Bappenas) Dr. Ir. Heri Suhermanto, M.Sc. and Muhammad Naser, S. Kom., M.Si., as well as Head of Performance Monitoring and Evaluation from the Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform Devi Ananta, S.E.

As stated in the amended 2010 – 2014 Strategic Plan, and in accordance with the vision of Lemhannas RI to become a world-class institution, the products of Lemhannas RI should get recognized in the 1st phase (year 2015) in ASEAN region and in the 3rd phase at the global level (year 2025).

# Lemhannas RI Holds Dissemination Event for Social Security Management Agency (BPJS) for Health



The Social Security Management Agency (BPJS) is a legal entity established to organize social security programs. It replaces several previous social security providers in Indonesia, including State Health Insurance Firm (PT. Askes) Indonesia which will be changed to BPJS for Health and State Worker Insurance Agency (PT. Jamsostek) to BPJS Manpower.

The BPJS for Health was inaugurated by President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono on 31 December 2013, and has been in operation providing health services. At its very early age, BPJS for Health continues to disseminate information to the people regarding social security program in health sector.

The transformation of PT. Askes to BPJS for Health is done in stages because it takes time to adjust the health benefits of the previous programs. It is an important measure taken by the government to provide

better health insurance to the people.

Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., on behalf of the Governor of Lemhannas RI, opened the dissemination event on the change of PT. Askes (Persero) into Social Security Management Agency (BPJS) for Health on Monday (23/1) at the Auditorium of Lemhannas RI.

Governor of Lemhannas RI pointed out in his written speech, which was read by the prime secretary that, since 2004, the country already has a law on National Social Security System, which is law number 40 of 2004. However, some issues need to be addressed in its implementation. More regulations are needed to support the technical aspects of the operation.

Based on the Law Number 24 of 2011, BPJS was formed as a legal entity providing national social security system, which is based on humanity, benefits and social justice for all Indonesian people.

At the time of its inauguration, Chandra Manan Mangan added, President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono has affirmed that BPJS for Health and BPJS for Manpower as well as the National Social Security System are a part of the government's commitment to ensure that all Indonesian people can meet their basic needs adequately.

Both programs from BPJS needs to be fully supported as it is a new milestone in people's social security which concerns with general improvement in the lives of the Indonesian people. In that regard, government apparatus should have a good understanding of both BPJS sectors so that they can provide information to the people in their neighborhood who still do not know much about it.

The dissemination was led by the Head of the Main Branch of BPJS Health for Central Jakarta area, Dr. H. Hidayat Sumintapura, M. Kes., and was attended by entire personnel of Lemhannas RI.

## Lemhannas RI Develops Nationalistic Insight in Political Parties' Members

Political parties in a democratic era, play a significant role in government. They serve as a vehicle for the people to play an active role in politics and to take part in running the government. With their highly strategic functions, political parties must constantly improve their members' understanding of the four basic national consensus.

As a governmental institution with the role in education, Lemhannas RI is responsible for strengthening the understanding of nationalistic values of all national components, including the cadres of political parties contesting the 2014 elections. To that end, Lemhannas RI has invited 12 parties which have been verified by the General Election Commission (KPU) to send its cadres to Lemhannas RI in order to follow the

strengthening program of nationalistic values.

Until February 2014, such a program has been carried out in five batches; with the first three batches being held in 2013 and the other two batches at the beginning of this year.

The program, which was intended to generate political parties' cadres with strong nationalistic insight, was facilitated by professional experts who were competent in their fields. The lectures they were provided with focused on basic issues like national archipelagic concept, national resilience, national vigilance and national leadership. Besides that, Lemhannas RI often invited heads or chairmen of bona fide institutions, such as from Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK) and the Constitutional

Court (MK), to be keynote speakers and deliver a lecture to the participants.

"In a democracy, a member of a political party should ideally be able to promote his or her party's functions without losing track of its purpose. Therefore, nationalistic values have become more relevant than ever to be implemented into the life of a political party," said Budi Susilo Soepandji with regard to today's democratic life.

The program was designed by Lemhannas RI in such a way that the political parties' members will always put the national integrity and unity front and center and that the political parties, with their diverse platforms, will not succumb to short-term and pragmatic political interests which will put the national interests at risk.

# Initial Briefing Marks the Start of BPK RI's Audit in Lemhannas RI

Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Dede Rusamsi, S.E. led an initial briefing by the State Audit Board (BPK RI) on its audit of Lemhannas RI's financial statements for Fiscal Year 2013 on Monday (3/2) in Nusantara I Meeting Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

In accordance with the mandate of the 1945 Constitution, Article 23 E, BPK is tasked with auditing state finance management and responsibility in order to encourage transparency and accountability of state finance management.

Governor of Lemhannas RI, in his written speech, urged all heads of work units, who were attending the event, to fully support the audit by BPK RI through a good cooperation by providing documents and information that fall within the scope of BPK RI's audit.

"Documents related to the implementation and accountability of budget should be prepared completely, quickly and communicatively, allowing the audit team to make an assessment and draw a conclusion objectively," he added.

Furthermore, Dede Rusamsi emphasized that in order to be accountable in financial management as one of the elements of good governance, there needs to be a good cooperation and coordination which allow for proper auditing process without the BPK Audit Team compromising their independence.

"I urged all work unit heads to immediately address any clarifications and findings of the materials being audited with valid evidence based on the principal criteria which will serve as a legal basis, thus speeding up the follow-up / completion in accordance with applicable regulations," said Governor of Lemhannas RI at the end of his written speech as read out by Dede Rusamsi.

At the consolidation meeting, Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI put a greater emphasis on five important things, namely, first, the participants are expected to follow the programs responsibly; second, the participants should understand and agree on the technical implementation of the education program; third, make some improvement in the educational process or mechanism; fourth, participants are encouraged to avoid sectoral ego and improve the professionalism and

cooperation between faculty members and educational organizer, and fifth, participants are expected to act in a professional, pro-active, and communicative way and can be role models for the participants of educational programs in Lemhannas RI.

The consolidation meeting, which was closed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. # Legislative Candidates are Optimistic to Restore People's Faith

A dialogue on nationalistic insight that was broadcast live by the RRI on Thursday (13/2) from the Mini Auditorium of Lemhannas RI has renewed the optimism of political parties' cadres and legislative candidates in restoring people's faith in the-so-called democratic fiesta of 2014.

In the dialogue themed "Strengthening of Nationalistic Values ahead of the 2014 Elections", various issues of common concerns were raised with regard to election campaigns.

One of such issues was the antipathy of the people toward political parties and their cadres. The haunting problem in politics remains the conflicts of interest that political parties' cadres face when they sit in the parliament. Instead of carrying out their duties and functions properly, they, in fact, work for the interest of a handful of people at the expense of public interest, in an apparently

transactional politics.

Addressing the issues, the legislative candidates, who had followed the strengthening program of nationalistic values for ten days in Lemhannas RI, expressed their optimism. Working together with their colleagues from their own parties, or with those from other parties, or with media people, the cadres of political parties contesting the coming legislative election believed they can prove that the disappointment the people feel for the cadres currently sitting in the parliament will not be repeated again.

Affirming their commitment to people's interest, they revealed their concrete contribution that they were making before they become legislative candidates. "If the people are disappointed with the old cadres, do not vote for those at the bottom of the legislative candidate lists, but vote for those at the top", said one of the legislative candidates.

One common mistake often committed by party cadres who have been elected and are sitting in government posts is that they put the interests of their parties above those of the people. In fact, when they are elected and seated in the House of Representatives, they no longer belong to their parties, in fact, they represent the people who vote for them. Such trust must be maintained with hard work and concrete work programs so that they can regain people's trust.

The live program engaged the listeners of RRI Pro 3 throughout Indonesia. Many issues raised during the program by the listeners were addressed by both the faculty members of Lemhannas RI and the legislative candidate themselves. "Some people say that politics is dirty, which is not true in my opinion. In fact, politics is sacred as the resulting political decisions will influence the unity and prosperity of the nation, affirmed Budi Susilo Soepandji.

The PPRA LI, which will last for 7.5 months, consists of e-learning / off-campus education program for 1.5 months and on-campus education program for 6 months.
