Strengthening Program of National Values for Senior and Middle-Level Diplomats



he Strengthening Program of National Values, which was organized for diplomats, was one of the efforts by Lemhannas RI to reinforce national insight among the diplomats so that they would be more well-equipped in carrying out their diplomatic duties for the national interest.

The statement was made by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA in his speech during the opening of the first batch of the Strengthening Program of National Values for the Diplomats for the year 2015 in Syailendra Room, Astagatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI, Jakarta. (20/2)

He further hoped that the program would help the diplomats in carrying out their functions in the field of foreign relations, which were based on national values and four national consensuses, so that they could play their roles optimally in maintaining Indonesian national interests.

Meanwhile, on the same opportunity, Foreign Affairs Minister Retno Lestari Priansari Marsudi stated that as the vanguard of Indonesian national interest abroad, the diplomats needed to be equipped with strong national values, and enriched with a strong sense of nationalism so that they would not be easily influenced by external environments.

"With strong national values, the diplomats will be more confident in maintaining the national interest abroad," said Retno.

The program held by Lemhannas RI in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs was attended by 59 Senior and Middle-Level Diplomats and high-ranking officials of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Officials from Ministry of Foeign Affairs attended the meeting were General Secretary, Inspector General, Expert Staff in Management, Director of the Foreign Service School, and Director of the School of Staff and Leaders of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The officials of Lemhannas RI, namely Secretary of the Governing Board, Principal Secretary, Deputies, Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts and Professional Experts, were also in attendance.

He further mentioned several obstacles currently being faced by the Supreme Court's Research and Development Agency where they were only able to accommodate 15% of the total number of its 8000 personnel. Therefore, some improvement in its e-learning system, added Agus, was highly needed in order to allow it to provide education and training services for all Supreme



Court employees.

On the same opportunity, Baskoro Alrianto conveyed that Lemhannas RI had utilized information technology system in order to support Lemhannas RI's performance through e-learning program, digital library and email.

uring an interactive dialogue held jointly by Lemhannas RI, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) and Radio of Republic of Indonesia (RRI), the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA said that diplomats played important roles in the arena of international relations. "The diplomats are the representatives of our country abroad," said Budi Susilo Soepandji during the dialogue held in Syailendra Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI, on Thursday (26/2)

Therefore, he went on to say that the diplomats needed to join the strengthening program of national insight held in Lemhannas RI in order to help them encounter difficulties in carrying out their duties, such as, the negative sentiments coming from certain countries toward Indonesia over the case of death penalty for drug dealers as widely reported recently in mass media.

Meanwhile, one of the discussion participants, Rheinhard Sinaga, said that the strengthening of national insight program, which adhered to the four basic consensuses, namely Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia principle, and Unity in Diversity principle, were very important considering the Indonesian foreign affairs that the diplomats had to take care of abroad. Moreover, continued Rheinhard, the strengthening of national insight program could enhance the participants' love of their country.

According to RRI Director Rosarita Niken Widiastuti, there had been some changes in Indonesia's foreign policies toward a more strict and pragmatic approach, which required a high initiative. One of which was in the domain of law enforcement.

Furthermore, she continued, saying that Indonesia was currently in a situation of drugs abuse emergency so that a high commitment of all parties were required in the fight against drugs abuse.

The interactive dialogue program, which was followed by the MFA diplomats and hosted by the Radio of Republic of Indonesia broadcaster Maulana Isnarto, was attended by secretary of the governing board, principal secretary, deputies, senior lecturers, senior analysts, professional experts, MFA secretary general and officials as well as the RRI director.

In his opening remarks, Budi Susilo Soepandji said that Lemhannas RI had duties to prepare national leadership cadres who had integrative way of thinking and national character, universal point of view, national insight and good problem-solving skills through the education and strengthening programs that it provided.

He hoped that the education participants would be able to adjust themselves physically or mentally during the course, manage their time efficiently and also uphold academic ethics and integrity.

The PPRA LIII program will be held for 7.5 months, consisting of one-month distance learning (off-campus system) and 6.5-month-oncampus learning in Lemhannas RI. The PPRA is scheduled to be closed on October 29, 2015.

The education programs include Introduction to Strategic Objects, Domestic Strategic Studies (SSDN), Overseas Strategic

Studies (SSLN), National Management System, Individual Working Paper and national seminar that will be held by PPRA participants with the theme "Improving Indonesia's National Security System toward a Sovereign Maritime Country".

The 53 PPRA is followed by 111 participants from Instituions, state ministries and institutions, attorney general's office, supreme court, state universities, provincial governments, Private Higher Learning Institutions Coordinating Bodies (Kopertis), LPP RRI, National Commission on Violence against Women, state-owned companies, Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN), Indonesian Army, Navy and Air Force, National Police and also representatives from several friendly countries, such as Sri Lanka, Cambodia, Thailand, Singapore, Papua New Guinea, Australia, Myanmar, Timor Leste and Zimbabwe.

Besides Lemhannas RI officials, the event was also attended by Navy Chief of Staff, Air Forces Chief of Staff, Deputy Governor of Jakarta, Deputy Governor of Gorontalo and several highranking military and police officers as well as representatives from Coordinating Ministry of Political, Legal and Security Affairs and Attorney General's Office.

Lemhannas RI and RSIS Discuss Maritime Issues



n a discussion themed "Developing Indonesia as a Maritime Power: Problems and Prospects," which was held on Tuesday (3/3) in Lemhannas RI, Prof. Geoffrey Till from the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) put forth in his presentation that the most recent development had seen some countries starting to change their national orientation from being agricultural and industrial-based countries to maritime-based ones, including Indonesia.

Till later affirmed that such a shifting orientation required special attention, particularly in the planning and managing of Indonesia's maritime potential resources in its effort to become a strong maritime country.

According to him, there were four important decision levels needed in order to develop Indonesia into a strong maritime country. First, establishing national security policies. Second, determining national strategy and its allocated resources. Third, determining military strategy and its allocated resources. Fourth, determining navy military strategy and its allocated resources.

Furthermore, Till explained that the first-level decision was concerned with national security council, lack of knowledge

and awareness of maritime sector, unknown future of maritime sector, civil-military relations and macroeconomic policy. The second-decision level was concerned with directions of general policy, general maritime policy and level of resources. The thirddecision level was concerned with public services apparatus, inter-services relations and representation in competition. Meanwhile, the fourth-decision level was concerned with navy and maritime approach, industrial capacity, planning and roadmap realization.

"If all the four important decision levels cannot be managed well, the Indonesia's maritime potential power could be weakened," added Till. In order to solve such problems, Till suggested a synergy be developed between maritime policy and effective resources allocation.

The discussion between Lemhannas RI and RSIS was led by Deputy for Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marsono, M.Agr. and moderated by Professional Expert in Diplomacy and International Relations of Lemhannas RI Rear Admiral (Ret.) Surya Dharma. The event was also attended by Chairman of University of Indonesia Alumni Association, senior lecturers, senior analysts, professional experts, and echelon officials of Lemhannas RI.

Albert Inkiriwang conveyed in his presentation that leadership was one of fundamental factors determining the national resilience of a country during a discussion themed "National Leadership: Opportunity or Threats towards Indonesia National Resilience?" in front of Master's program students of the Swiss German University at Syailendra Room, 3rd Floor of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI, Jakarta, on Thursday (5/3).

Furthermore, he continued, a leader played a strategic role in maintaining the unitary state of the Republic of Indonesia and determining the course of the nation's future.

According to him, a leader must have the courage and strong nationalism in order to solve various national issues, such as violation of human rights and genocide, poverty, contagious diseases, nuclear, radiology, biological weapons, terror acts and crimes.

Meanwhile, the Dean of Engineering and IT Faculty of Swiss German University Dr. Ir. Gembong Baskoro, M.Sc. put forth that students, as Indonesia's future leaders, needed to be equipped with leadership skills.

He further expressed his hope that those students would be able to develop a comprehensive, integral and holistic way of thinking and to act as a statesmen, while maintaining their identity as Indonesian citizens.

The discussion, which was moderated by Senior Lecturer in Leadership Dr. H. Dharma Kusuma, M.Si., was attended by 21 students of Master's program in Mechanical Engineering and 21 students of Master's program in Information Technology of the Swiss German University.

Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA, Minister of Home Affairs Tjahjo Kumolo and Head of the Institute of State Administration (LAN) Prof. Dr. Agus Dwiyanto, M.P.A. signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the Development of Competencies of the State Civil Apparatus (ASN) at the Auditorium of F Building, Ministry of Home Affairs, Monday (9/3).

Tjahyo Kumolo said that the MoU had long been initiated, and that it was one of the concrete measures to accelerate the mental revolution, especially among the government apparatus, which would then be expected to spread to the entire Indonesian people.

"The implementation of mental revolution, as a form of national character building, is the core of the central value system for the enlightenment of all national components. The national cultural values must be manifested in one's daily life activities and in concrete actions through work discipline, law obedience and humility. Besides, we are also expected to be a role model in our environment and offer our best services in the community," explained Tjahyo Kumolo.

Meanwhile, according to Budi Susilo Soepandji, the development of excellent state civil apparatus, which was aligned with the developing dynamics and the public demand for government's transparent and accountable performance in the framework of bureaucratic reforms, needed to be managed strategically according to the proper management of human resource development. "The competence of state civil apparatus needed to be developed optimally in order to create excellent state civil apparatus that is in line with the changing dynamics," explained Budi Susilo Soepandji.

The newly established cooperation, continued Budi Susilo Soepandji, would further expand the work networks in harmonizing the policies, studies and innovations as well as the development of the state civil apparatus competence in the organizing of the strengthening program of national values for national resilience.

Head of LAN Agus Dwiyanto hoped that the MOU would serve as a starting point for the three parties to carry out further development in education, studies and agencies in order to improve the competence of state civil apparatus and its mapping in each region.

Prior to the signing of the MoU, the Ministry of Home Affairs carried out an inauguration ceremony of Building F of the Agency of Human Resource Development, which was then continued with the opening of the Education and Coordination Training for Heads of Education and Training Agencies throughout Indonesia.

The signing ceremony was also attended by officials from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Lemhannas RI and LAN RI. The three parties hoped that the MoU signing could be followed up immediately through more concrete and consistent work programs so that a government based on national insight could be created.
