The President of republic of Indonesia Inaugurated Lieutenant General (Ret.) Agus Widjojo As The New Lemhannas RI Governor on Friday (15/4) in Presidential Palace, Jakarta.

Agus Widjojo, who is Former Head of Military Territorial Staf and a son of a revolutionary hero Major General Sutoyo Siswoharjo, was inaugurated as Lemhannas RI Governor based on Presidential Decree Number 43 of 2016 dated April 7, 2016.

Agus Widjojo was one of Lemhannas RI Alumni in 1994. In the same year, Agis Widjojo also received master degree in public administration. Previously, Agus Widjojo who was graduated from Military Academy in 1970, was a Gol-IV lecturer in the Army Staff and Command School (Seskoad) from 1986 until 1988. George Yeo Gives Lecture in Lemhannas RI



“ **T**his is the awakening period of China and India. So, (we) should remain neutral and not too aggressive even though there are influences that can increase the escalation,” added the former Minister of Foreign Affairs 2004-2011 period Y.M. George Yeo on Monday (28/3), at a lecture in the Constitution Room , 3rd Floor of Trigatra Building themed “The Power of China and India as well as the Implications for Indonesia, Singapore and ASEAN”.

A cooperation that aimed at reducing political tensions should be used in dealing with the condition. “We must not get stuck in a narrow interest and leave the global interests for peaceful purposes”, said the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA.

Meanwhile, the determination of China, America and India to expand their power in Asia would impact on development in Southeast Asia.

According to Yeo, there will be difficulties due to the conflict interest in ASEAN. “We have to minimize negative impacts, if we can do that, it means we talk about “resilience”, said George Yeo

“Indonesia is the key country. Automatically, the world’s power will come to Indonesia as a negotiation key holder in the world. Therefore, Indonesia have to be a safe and neutral country.” Said George Yeo

A lecture moderated by Professional Expert of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.P.P., was also attended by The President of Jababeka Setyono Djuandi Darmono, Deputies, Faculty Members, and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI and also invited guests. This lecture was closed with discussion and question and answer session.

Related to this, Budi Susilo Soepandji also pleased to convey his SPT via e-filing. Ken Dwijugasteadi said that the help of all government agencies in matters of taxes is necessary due to the importance of taxation role.

MoU Signing between Lemhannas RI and Clingendael Institute Netherlands

Wednesday (30/3), at the Clingendael Institute, Den Haag, Netherlands, the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) had been done between Lemhannas RI which was represented by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M. with the Clingendael Institute of the Netherlands which was represented by Mr. Ron Ton, as Director of the Clingendael Institute of the Netherlands. The MoU signing is part of a cooperation program between Lemhannas RI and NUFFIC Netherlands in NICHE IDN 143 Project.

NICHE IDN 143 Project aims to increase Lemhannas capacity building in 5 aspects; organization management, education, research, knowledge management, and project management. The short course in Clingendael Netherlands is an implementation of NICHE IDN 143 Project in order to improve research capacity or assesment to support Lemhannas RI to be a world class institution.

In his remarks, Mr. Ron Ton, Director of Clingendael institute said that the cooperation between Lemhannas RI and Clingendael Institute has been going on since 20 years ago, so the signing of the MoU is actually a form of commitment affirmation to cooperate.

Implementation of strengthening of cooperation commitment was done through short courses which are divided into four topics of study or assessment, namely: Corruption, Communal Conflict, Resource Conflict and Terrorism. This course was started on March 29 until April 8, 2016 and the participants were divided into four teams (each team consists of four people).

Before the MoU Signing, Lemhannas RI delegations led by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI had a Courtesy Call (CC) with Indonesian Ambassador to The Netherlands, Y.M. I Gusti Wesaka Pudja, who was also witnessed the MoU Signing together with all delegations of Lemhannas RI and Structural Officials of Clingendael Institute Netherlands.

A Discussion between Lemhannas RI and National War College

National War College (NWC) of The United States visited Lemhannas RI. The visit was welcomed by Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., on Thursday (7/4). After doing Courtesy Call in Executive Guest Room in Trigatra Building, 1st Floor Lemhannas RI, the NWC delegations engaged in a discussion about cyber security and South China Sea with Lemhannas RI which was followed by representatives of PPRA LIV participants.

A discussion which started with an introduction between two institutions was moderated by Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.I.P.. One of the NWC Delegations, Dr. Daniel Hannan, explained about cyber security strategy of the United States. He conveyed that in The US, the handling of cyber crime especially in economic issues has not been effective. It is because of cyber security in economic field is not related to individual's attitude.

Meanwhile, Lemhannas RI delegation, Rear Admiral Robert Mangindaan explained about unfinished South China Sea Conflict. Robert conveyed that this time, Indonesia is threaten by China with the ilegal fishing they do in Indonesian Sea Area. To solve those problems, maritime security power must be increased by doing some maritim collaboration so that strategic policy related to it can be created.

Liutenant Colonel John Lynch from NWC agreed with Robert that Indonesia get many maritime sovereignty threats, one of them is illegal fishing. To solve those threats, Indonesia's maritime power must be increased. To increase Indonesia's maritime power, there are



several things that can be done such as the addition of smaller vessels, improvement of communication infrastructures, and the addition of observer batalion for Maritime Interdiction Operation (MIO).

The occasion was attended by Brigadier General Yuniar Ludfi as a delegation from National Counterterrorism Agency (BNPT). Yuniar explained about Counterterrorism Strategy in Indonesia. In his presentation, he explained further about terrorism attacks occured in Indonesia like ISIS and some efforts that had been done to counter those terrorism threat.

After two sessions of discussion followed by question and answer session, it was then continued by foto session and luncheon.

Beng Tardjani, M.Sc., Director of International Studies Agus Budijarto, S.H., M.Hum, Chief of Public Relations Bureau Commodore E.
