The Courtesy Call talked about several cooperation possibilities in education aspect especially in Strengthening of Human Rights Perspective and women position rights whether in national leadership aspect, strategic assesment and strengthening program of national values.

According to Azriana, based on violence againsts women's fact during 2015, sexual violence was dominated by violence against women cases so it needs serious attention.

Responding to the fact, Governor of Lemhannas RI stated that those violence cases againsts women in Indonesia are complex. Therefore, cooperation with National Commission on Violence Against Women was expected to bring out strategic thoughts to solve those problems and is also used as suggestions and inputs for policy recommendation to Government.

## Taspen and Bapertarum Socialization, Lemhannas's Effort to Fullfill ASN's Rights

**I**n Regulation No. 5 of 2014 about State Civil Aparature (ASN) in Chapter 21 stated that civil servant's rights besides monthly wage, working allowance, facility, leave, and profession development were retirement allowance and also protection which got less attention from Civil Servant (PNS).

In order to meet ASN Regulation mandate, Human Resources Department of Lemhannas RI held a sosialization related to Work Accident Insurance, Death Insurance, and Housing Savings Advisory Board (Bapertarum) for civil servants in Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (15/6) in Constitution Room Trigara Bilding 3rd Floor Lemhannas RI.

Chief of General Bureau of Lemhannas RI Brig. Gen. of Police Drs. Budi Setiyadi, S.H., M.Si. in his remark stated that insurance and protection are needed by civil servant so they will work in secure and they can improve their working quality.

The other sourceperson, Head of First Branch of PT Taspen Jakarta kristiyanto also said that automatically, wages paid to civil servant will be cut 10 % for The Healthcare and Social Security Agency and 8 % for Taspen but many PNS had not known the use of it.

"Even though civil servant already become Taspen member since they were prospective employees, but our survey showed a fact that not All civil servants already know their rights and responsibility.

for their responsibility, we had to cut their wage but they do not really know the rights that they deserve to get", explained Kristiyanto.

Besides improving its service quality through 1 hour claim and automatic claim for retirement insurance, Pension plan, and other services like mobile service and service partner, Taspen also has Work Accident Insurance (JKK) and Death Insurance (JKM).

JKK was meant for work accident risk protection or health problem. Meanwhile JKM is a program for death risk protection besides work accident. All PNS in Indonesia automatically deserve to get both insurance.

Meanwhile, sourceperson from Bapertarum, Executive Secretary of Bapertarum-PNS Linda Herawati conveyed that the use of Bapertarum is to help PNS to pay their downpayment in buying or renovating their house. The amount of Bapertarum help for downpayment is 5 million rupiah for civil servant from level I to IV.

Although the current amount of bapertarum help given relatively small, Bapertarum is proposing the addition of contributory schemes so that the amount of help given will be relatively large. Besides the addition of contribution, Bapertarum also initiated procurement of Housing Savings (Tapera) so that this facility can also be used not only by civil servant but also society in general.

## Lemhannas RI Discuss Deregulation in Investment Policy Package

**L**ed by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, Lemhannas RI held Round Table Discussion (RTD) with a theme “Evaluation of Investment Policy to Maintain National Development Continuity in the Context of National Resilience” on Wednesday (16/6) in Kresna Room, Astagatra Building 4th Floor Lemhannas RI.

“Investment is one of the critical factors for accelerating economic growth, creating employment opportunities and improving community prosperity,” said Agus Widjojo. Therefore, it is necessary for Lemhannas RI to discuss policies related to investment that had been made by the government so that later on, those policies can be evaluated.

The government in this recent period has issued a number of National Economic Policy Packages by doing deregulation and improvements, especially to improve the national investment climate.

According to the Deputy for Commerce and Industry of Ministry of Economic Affairs Irawady Edy Putra, SH., easy investment policy provided by the government at this time is not a form of liberalization but an attempt to boost the capacity of Indonesian economy with openness in investment, include in industry field. “Investment is the engine, because currently, there is only 33 % from investment contribution to economic growth, while we can not rely on government spending,” said Edy Putra Irawady.

In order to increase investments in Indonesia, a number of deregulation policy packages were implemented by the Government. Deputy of Development of Capital Investment Climate of Investment Coordinating Board (BKPM) Ir. Farah Ratnadewi Indriani, M.B.A. conveyed that The Government deregulated complicated legislation rule and did some cooperation which followed by “debureaucratization” by simplifying license and service. Both of those actions were

strengthened with business enforcement and business certainty.

The other sourceperson, Deputy Chief of Maritim and Fisheries Division of Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Kadin) Yugi Y Prayanto and Pricipal Commisioner of PT. Jababeka Tbk D.S. Darmono also gave their point of view from entrepreneur side regarding to some efforts that can be improved and done by The Government in increasing national investment climate.

Meanwhile, Director of Institute for Development of Economics and Finance (INDEF) Dr. Enny Sri Hartati as a responder of the discussion said that some efforts done to increase investment climate with deregulation policy package were not optimal yet. “Even though investment approvals were increased in 2015, more than 1800 billion, but its realization was only around 545 billion”, added Enny.

Similar expression was also revealed by economic observer Faisal Basri, M.A. who saw the investment coming to Indonesia was distracted by other government policies which still kept the crony system in economy.

Meanwhile, the other sourceperson, Head of Indonesia’s Provinces Government Association (APSSI) and also Governor of South Sulawesi Dr. H. Syahrul Yasin Limpo, S.H, M.Si, M.H. conveyed about the importance of development in East Indonesia that still lack of investment. Furthermore, Dean of Economic and Business Faculty of University of Indonesia Prof. Ari Kuncoro, S.E., M.A., Ph.d stated that education is an effort that has to be done in Indonesia to improve Indonesia’s competitiveness in investment.

Discussion moderated by Professional Exeprt of Economic Affair of Lemhannas Ri Dr. Panutan Sakti Sulendra Kusuma was also attended by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas Ri Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M., , several Faculty Members, and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI.

In the discussion session moderated by Professional Expert of International Relations Sebastianus Sumarsono, S.I.P. , a delegation from CDSS who is also a participant of DSSC FARV Capt. Scott M Ritchie, explained about 'Drone Diplomacy' as an effort to improve maritime cooperation between Indonesia and Australia. Meanwhile, delegation from Lemhannas RI, Senior Analyst of Diplomation Vice Marshal Ir. Beng Tardjani, M.Sc explained about corruption eradication effctiveness in Indonesia.

Australia Defense Attache, Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI and Structural Official of Lemhannas RI also attended the discussion.

## ***Halalbihalal, a Moment to Strengthen Cooperation in Lemhannas RI***

**T**he first day after long Holiday due to Idul Fitri 1437 H Day, Monday (11/7), Lemhannas RI held *halalbihalal* which was followed by all staffs in Lemhannas RI.

*Halalbihalal* was inspired by a tradition held by Sultan Mangkunegara I (Surakarta Palace) that holding a "silaturahmi (connecting ties with family, friends, etc)" between the King and the member of the palace after Idul Fitri Day.

In the beginning of the independence day, President Soekarno held silaturahmi as a place to forgive each others. The event was called as *halalbihalal* and until today, this tradition was followed by society in Indonesia.

After shaking hands each other and luceon, *halalbihalal* in Lemhannas RI was ended with Keroncong Show by 7 Putri in Gadjah Mada Auditorium.

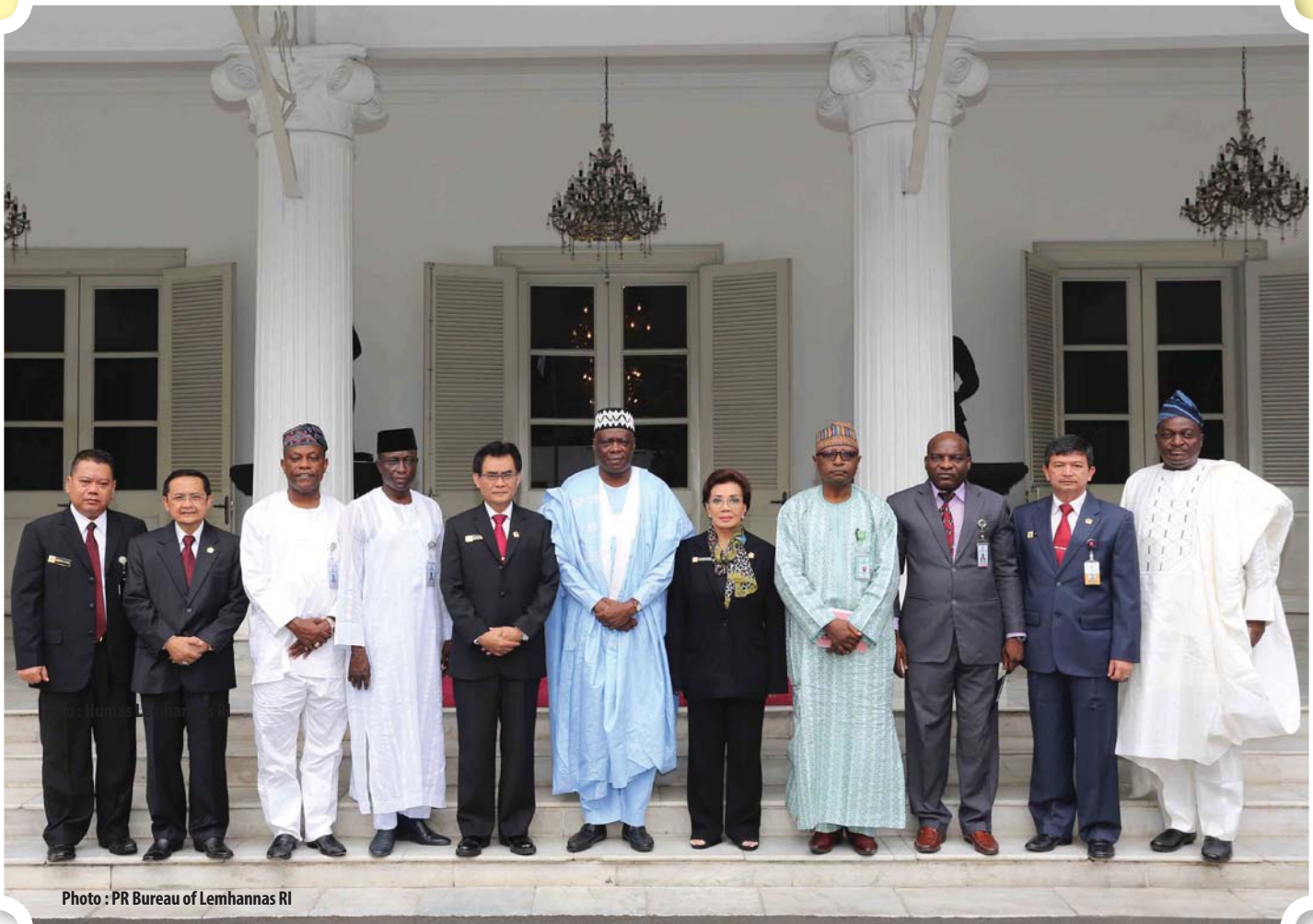
