In his remark, Governor of Lemhannas RI stated that Training of Trainers (ToT) of National Values would help teachers, lecturers, military, and Indonesian National Police to realize teaching and studying process with national character effectively, inovatively anf creatively so it wil touch participants' sense of nationality.

Hopefully, after attending this event, the participants can utilize their time more effectively and explore their potency to themselves and to their learners.

Papua Regional Police Deputy Chief Share some Views on Papua Condition

Thursday, (4/8), Papua Regional Police Deputy Chief Brig. Gen. Drs. Rudolf Alberth Rodja became a sourceperson in Micro Teaching of Strengthening Program of National Values in Papua Province implemented by Directorate of State Defence Spirit of Deputy Office of Strengthening of National Values of Lemhannas RI. Rudolf Alberth Rodja explained the factual condition in ideology aspect, politic aspect, economic aspect, social and culture aspect, and security aspect in Papua Province. According to him, special otonomy implementation in Papua Province which based on Regulation No. 21 of 2001 had not yet optimal.

Images of Pancasila values in Papua Province currently lacks in its implementation (morality crisis, leadership crisis, corruption, etc.). He said that the number of programs had already promoted by Papua Police to tackle it, including creative breakthroughs such as the launch of a police program taught in schools as an effort to strengthen the quality of human resources in Papua and nationalism.

The arrival of Papua Regional Police Deputy Chief in Micro Teaching is a part of preparation of Directorate of State Defence Spirit Team in implementing Strengthening Program of National Values for Bureaucrats, Academicians, and Public Figures in Papua Province on December 23 to December 30, 2016. It is a part of Lemhannas' work programs to awaken nationalism in every nation components.

In fact, it is very dangerous.” said Dr. Etra Ariadno, SpPD, Department of Internal Medicine of Dr. Mintohardjo Naval Hospital on the Socialization with the title “Understanding Diabetes Mellitus and Hypertension” in Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI, Monday (15/08).

Agus Widjojo said that the actualization of Independence Day’s values in democratic era must be implemented in national corridor which prioritize the balance between rights fulfillment and individual freedom and obligation of every people to this nation.

Moreover, Agus Widjojo said that psychological barriers

caused by imbalance between those things must be harmonized so Indonesia can be a nation with advanced and noble civilization

Besides, Agus Widjojo encouraged all nation components to make Indonesia’s 71th Independence Day as an inspiration to win competition, to win humanity, to achieve some progress for this nation together like President Joko Widodo’s Mandate in Annual Session of People’s Consultative Assembly on August 16, 2016.

With the theme “Real Work” on the anniversary of Independence of the Republic of Indonesia in 2016, it should be understood since the theme confirms the government’s consciousness and desire to continue doing some real work without caught up in the rhetoric and political debates that takes time and energy.

Related to competition and global geopolitical dynamics, Agus Widjojo said that hard work itself is not enough. “Youth’s hard work must be accompanied by smart work ethic which should be based on knowledge and sense of nationalism so it can balance universalism point of view.” he said.

Agus Widjojo assessed that global outlook should not be placed in a paradoxical view with nationalism because of the contextual challenges of this era is how to build an effective national system which is compatible with the international system without losing our identity. He further explained that national system should be able to seize the opportunities exist in the international system to accelerate the achievement of national interests. Moreover, unity between the mindset, attitude and course of action is the key to success that must be built on different levels and layers of the society.

In connection with this theme, continued Agus Widjojo, as the institution which is directly under the president, Lemhannas RI continues its efforts to support and encourage the assertion of the government through the implementation of basic tasks and functions of Lemhannas RI, both in education program, strategic assessment and strengthening of national values. In addition, Lemhannas RI need to give special attention to three steps of government breakthroughs that became the focus of the acceleration of development this year

namely accelerated development of infrastructure, preparation of productive capacity and human resources, and deregulation and de-bureaucratization.

Besides those breakthroughs, Lemhannas RI must also examine and understand the four strategic aspects to be able to achieve the target to accelerate legal reforms and keep pushing the bureaucracy reform, the reform of development budget management, foreign policy, and democracy, political stability and security.
