Lemhannas RI Provides Training on National Values for Bandung Educators



As an effort to strengthen the national values for educators in Indonesia's provinces, Lemhannas RI's Deputy for the Strengthening of National Values Rear Admiral Dedy Yulianto officially opened a Training of Trainers (ToT) program on Monday (3/4) in the Ball Room of Hotel Aston Tropicana, Cihampelas, Bandung, West Java.

The activity which was going to be held for 10 days and followed by educators, consisting of teachers and lecturers as well as civil servant lecturers was expected to further refine the participants' skills, expertise and insight in the issues of national values and help them to become more reliable facilitators.

In addition, The Training of Trainers event which was followed by 100 participants employed several methods, including lectures, discussion, coaching, teaching practice, and outbound. The participants also gained knowledge and understanding on the four national fundamental consensus, namely Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia and Unity in Diversity principle. They also received basic materials (archipelagic concept, national resilience, national leadership and national vigilance) and supporting materials (introduction to national values, local wisdom, character building and interpersonal skills).

In Lemhannas RI Governor's speech read by Dedy Yulianto,

he stated that the Training of Trainers program would help strengthen the participants' abilities in delivering teaching materials and at the same time becoming good facilitators.

Besides, They should be able to create fun and exciting atmosphere in the classroom so that their teaching can be received well by the participants and to be manifested later on in their actions and life.

Dedy hoped that the participants would be able to utilize their potentials for maximum benefits of their students. "I hope that all of you as participants would be able to manage your time effectively and to tap into your own potentials or your students' potentials. You have to be open to change and at the same time remain alert to negative effects of globalization. You should be flexible in facing the reality in this ever changing and competitive world. Furthermore, during the training, I hope that all of you can show positive traits by being cheerful, empathetic, open, communicative as well as having a sense of togetherness," said Dedy in the opening.

The opening event was attended by Speaker of West Java Province House of Representatives, West Java Province Deputy Chief of Police, Chief-of-Staff III/Siliwangi, Commander of the Navy Main Base III, Commander of Husein Sastranegara Air Base Command, Head of Education Office of West Jawa Province, Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI and several structural and functional officials of Lemhannas RI. ●



National War College of the United State of America visits **Lemhannas RI**

A delegation from the National War College of the United State (NWC) led by Ambassador Piper Campbell made a visit to Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (4/4). Lemhannas RI Governor Lieu. Gen. (Ret.) The courtesy call was then continued with a discussion in Airlangga Room, 4th Floor Astagatra Building. Moderated by Air Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.I.P., the discussion was also attended by representatives of PPRA LVI and some faculty members of Lemhannas RI.

In his presentation, Maj. Gen. (Ret) Abdul Chasib explained briefly the roles of Indonesia in defence diplomacy. With regard to South China Sea, he explained that Indonesia maintained a neutral position on the issue. Moreover, Indonesia would not engage in an arms race with other countries and caused conflicts with other countries.

Furthermore, Indonesia was also committed to eradicating terrorism as a part of its defence diplomacy effort by building cooperation with other countries, such as Australia, as well as with the United Nations.

Abdul Chasib later explained the influences of Islam in Indonesia's politics and government policies related to Indonesia's maritime axis. The discussion was then ended with a question and answer session and a group photo session. ●

Therefore, Indonesia has to make those diversity as power, not as instability trigger. Besides, Prof. Dadan stated,

Indonesia has to stick with Four national Basic Consensus and also improve public welfare, educate the life of the people and participate toward the establishment of a world order based on freedom, perpetual peace and social justice. Prof. Dadan also briefly described the eight aspects used as bases to measure national resilience.

Discussion moderated by Air Vice Marshal (ret) Surya Dharma, S.I.P. was continued with question and answer session and ended with grouped photo session. ●

Geopolitics in a Changing World 2017



Jakarta Geopolitical forums or JGF is a sharing session for the world's geopolitical academics, experts and professionals in analyzing the situation of the regions in the world. This forum was initiated by the National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia (Lemhannas RI).

JGF are expected to be a strategic forum for the speakers and also participants to discuss more of geopolitical issues on a global level. Geopolitical is meant as a living space becomes the central issue for the whole country in the world.

The world geopolitical situation is affected by a surge in the population of the world. The increased of the population is equivalent to the rivalry between nations in keeping the region and manage their natural resources. The resilience of the countries is also influenced by the conflict in another countries. Drift of refugees from war-torn countries to another countries affected to their political stabilities and also to the world geopolitical situation.

The world phenomenon above are the topics of discussion in Jakarta Geopolitical Forum held on May 18th – 20th, 2017 at Borobudur Hotel, Jakarta. More than 17 academics, experts,

and professionals in a geopolitical field around the world will share their knowledge and thoughts about geopolitics that is divided into six discussion sessions.

According to the plan, the opening ceremony of Jakarta Geopolitical Forum will be officially opened by the President of Indonesia, Ir. Joko Widodo at the Istana Negara. On the second day, (Fri, 19/05) the first session of Jakarta Geopolitical Forum will be opened with the discussion about The Geopolitical Overview presented by Professor Dorodjatun Kuntjoro Jakti. The second and third sessions on the same day, the participants will discuss the topics about Global Peace and Security Issues and also the Development in the Global Economy.

On the third day, Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2017 will discuss three interesting topics including (1) Extremism, Radicalism, and Counter-terrorism, (2) Environment and Climate Change Resilience, and also (3) Migrants, Refugees, and Victims of Natural Disasters.

The closing ceremony of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2017 planned to be held in the afternoon and will be attended by Coordinating Minister for Political, Justice, and Security Affairs Wiranto and also the Governor of Lemhannas RI Agus Widjojo. ●
