The US Seventh Fleet's Delegation Visit Lemhannas RI



Delegations of the United State Seventh Fleet (U.S. 7th Fleet) visited Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (11/4). The visit was welcomed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo in Nusantara II Room, Trigatra Building 1st, Lemhannas RI.

The visit continued with a discussion that began with the explanation from the Seventh Fleet's delegation regarding the priorities of the fleet centre, based in Yokosuka, Japan and some in Sasebo, and Guam to arrayed and estimated the readiness of the war, maritime cooperation, and to maximize the power posture. The Delegations also described the associated challenges and focused area of the Seventh Fleet.

In addition, the Seventh Fleet delegation also conveyed the full range of their assets such as ships, aircraft and troops. In terms of maritime cooperation, the Seventh Fleet has partnered with several countries of North Asia, Oceania, South Asia, and Southeast Asia including Indonesia. One form of cooperation conducted with countries in that region is joint exercises.

The explanation then continued with a question and answer regarding the response of the Seventh Fleet on the South China Sea conflict and some of the policies taken by the Seventh Fleet.

In the discussion, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo was accompanied by Professional Expert of Diplomacy Air Vice Marshal (Ret.) Surya Dharma, S.IP, teachers, researchers and several Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI. After the discussion, the visit was closed by souvenirs exchange and grouped photo session. ●

Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, opened Communication Forum between the leaders of Lemhannas RI and the Editor-in-chief of Printed, Electronic, and Online Mass Media in the 3rd Floor Pavilion of Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI on Monday (15/5).

In that occasion, Agus Widjojo said that currently, Lemhannas RI is preparing various activities related to the commemoration of the 52nd anniversary of Lemhannas RI on May, 20. The theme for the 52nd anniversary of Lemhannas RI is “In the Spirit of National Revival, Lemhannas RI Determined to Reaffirmed Nationality-Based on Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution”

Agus Widjojo revealed that the anniversary of Lemhannas RI which coincides with National Awakening Day indicated that Lemhannas RI is affected by the spirit of the national revival. “As we know, Lemhannas RI was inaugurated by the first president of Indonesia, Ir. Soekarno on May 20, 1965. Because of that, every year of Lemhannas RI anniversary was affected and imbued with the spirit of the national revival,” said Agus Widjojo.

Many activities are organized as a series of the 52nd anniversary of Lemhannas RI such as Sports event and Inbox

SCTV that was held on May 14, a pilgrimage to Taman Makam Pahlawan Kalibata, and continued with the oration by Dr. Anhar Gonggong on May 22. In addition, Lemhannas RI also carried out the anniversary ceremony, commemoration and inauguration of the Monument of President Soekarno by Megawati Soekarnoputri on May 24.

Furthermore, Agus Widjojo said, Lemhannas RI will also hold the Jakarta Geopolitical Forums on March 18 to May 20, 2017. The opening of the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum planned to be implemented at the State Palace on May 18 and proceeded with the implementation of the seminar plenary session on May 19 and May 20 at the Hotel Borobudur Jakarta.

According to Agus Widjojo, Jakarta Geopolitical Forums aimed as a place to exchange ideas and perspectives between the practitioners and the geopolitical experts from around the world to understand the meaning of the current geopolitical dynamics around the globe. Jakarta Geopolitical Forum will bring 16 speakers from various countries from five continents and five speakers from Indonesia. This Communication Forum was followed by a discussion with the editors and journalists of mass media and closed with warm-hearted conversations. ●

Roundtable Discussion of Lemhannas RI

Discussed on Solving the Impact of the Middle East Conflict



Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo opened Roundtable Discussion (RTD) about “Solving the Impact of the Middle East Conflict against National Security in Indonesia to Prevent the Development of Radicalism in the framework of National Resilience” in Kresna Room, Astagatra, Building 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI on Monday (10/4).

Attended the Roundtable Discussion are the Minister of Education and Culture Prof. Dr. Muhadjir Effendy, MAP, Head of the National Agency for Combating Terrorism Police Commissioner General Drs. Suhardi Alius, M.H., Chairman of the Executive Board of Tanfidziyah Daily Dr. H. Syuhud Marsudi, and Terrorism observers Al Chaidar.

On the occasion, Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo said that the conflict that occurred in the Middle East will give negative impact to the security stability in Indonesia like radicalism movement. To deal with the threat of radicalism movement, the Indonesian government has implemented some programs but not quite effective. Based on these conditions, added Agus Widjojo, a strategy to prevent the development of the radicalism movement from the Middle East conflict are urgently needed.

Radicalism, according to Suhardi Alius, consisted of two kinds of things, which is destructive (with the violence) and static (with the idea). He explained, that the roots of radicalism in the international dimension is the oppression and assumed that the downtrodden action must be solved through the violence, because the easy ways

like peace procedures can not be obtained to solve the problems, and the violence ways are legitimate in order to achieve the goals. In the national dimension, the roots of radicalism coming from the misinterpretation of religious pedagogy in order to achieve the objectives of the groups, revenge, poverty, education, and injustice.

In addition, Suhardi Alius also presents potential threats of radicalism in Indonesia that come from the weakness of national education. Nowadays, the National Agency for Combating Terrorism, striving to overcome these threats with the soft Approach and the Hard Approach. National Agency for Combating Terrorism also involves social media, the younger generations, the former of radicalism offenders, the National Agency for Combating Terrorism experts, the Ministry and also government agencies.

On the other hand, the Minister of Education and Culture Prof. Dr. Muhadjir Effendy, MAP stated that radicalism is not necessarily negative because radicalism is part of the philosophy. The movements of the nationalist and passive radicalism should be supported yet the destructive and active radicalism should be eradicated.

According to the data from the Ministry of Education and Culture, the indicators of radicalism in the field of education such as, hate against the Government, refused to sing the National Anthem and the existence of overly solidarity groups in the educational area like school or college. Prof. Muhadjir said that Ministry of Education and Culture will attempt to revamp the education system of a program that requires schools to monitor their students in the school hours and after the school hours. ●

Komarudin Hidayat also explained that the events when Prophet Muhammad SAW went to the cave Hiro are one of the empirical examples of the Hijra while when Prophet Muhammad SAW met with the Jibril is a spiritual event.

Furthermore, Komarudin Hidayat also conveyed that words Isra in Arabic means “night” or “the night journey and Mi'raj interpret as “upward”. Komarudin Hidayat then continued his lecture with an explanation of the events of the Isra ' Mi'raj and the wisdom it. Lemhannas RI held Parenting Seminar



Lemhannas RI held parenting seminar with the theme “Fun Parenting without violence and Cries” at Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Pancagatra Building 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (10/5).

In the seminar which was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo is presenting three speakers they are, Child and Adolescent Psychologist and author of Happy Parenting book, Novita Tandry, Professional Experts of National Resilience of Lemhannas RI, Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Lumban Sianipar, and also General Chairman of Indonesian Commission for Child Protection (KPAI) Arist Merdeka Sirait.

In his speech, Arist Merdeka Sirait explained that the children are human beings who are under 18 years old, including the child in the womb. Children also have rights that must be met and protected as one of the rights to life, the right to grow and develop, the right to participate, and the rights of protection.

Arist then exposed recently there is too many crime happened in Indonesia. Sadly, one of the highest crimes in Indonesia is sexual violence on children. More surprisingly, said Arist these crimes committed by the closest relations to the victims who should have an obligation to educated and to protect their rights as children. To cut the chain of violence against the children, parents must know

and fulfill the rights of the children.

Meanwhile, Novita Tandry exposed that parenting in the family is the most basic thing to shaping and educating children about national resilience. To understand about which parenting methods are the best or suitable for their children, parents should understand the grown patterns of every child. Each process of growing pattern will gradually experience by each child. Parents should be taught to understand the process and do not impose terms that are not yet supposed to be experienced by the children.

At the growing moment children aged 1 to 5 years old are easily absorbed a lot of information, said Novita Tandry. Thus, at that age, the parents must provide education and also information that needed for their children.

On the other hand, Lumban Sianipar revealed that the effects of mental violence to children will be more traced and remembered than the physical effects. A child, added Lumban Sianipar, should be taught to balance the emotions of both positive and negative. Moreover, a child must have a good personal and gentle, a child must be capable of expressing his fury in a good way. In addition, children should also know about nationality are basic.

The seminar was attended by the entire staff and structural officials of Lemhannas RI, and closed with the symbolically book handover to the Governor of Lemhannas RI. ●
