Chairman of Apindo pays **Courtesy Call** to the **Governor of Lemhannas RI**

Apindo (Indonesian Employers Association) General Chairman Hariyadi B. Sukamdani, Apindo Inter-Institutional Relations Head Anthony Hilman, Alumni Coordinator of Strengthening of national Values Program of Lemhannas RI for Apindo Lusya Karina, Head of North Sumatra DPP (provincial representative council) of Apindo Parlindungan Purba, and MSME Sector Manager of Apindo Arief Budiman paid a courtesy call with the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo on Monday (18/10), in the Executive Guest Room.

In the courtesy call, the General Chairman of Apindo expressed his gratitude for the educational opportunities and the provision of strengthening of national values given by Lemhannas RI to Apindo. He hopes that this cooperation can continue to be established and enhanced through a memorandum of understanding. "We hope that our cooperation can be strengthen. Will we be involved a lot in the future, both for PPSA, PPRA and Taplai," he said.

Therefore, entrepreneurs who are members of Apindo need to have strong national insight and be able to play a role not only as economic actors to seek personal gain, but for the nation and state.

"For us, we feel that this sector is important because we have a big impact," said the Chairman of Apindo.



Furthermore, he also said that the strengthening of deep national values for Apindo members could strengthen national resilience from an economic perspective.

Meanwhile, the Governor of Lemhannas RI welcomed the intention of cooperation and the signing of a memorandum of understanding between Lemhannas RI and Apindo. "It just needs to be discussed so that it can be transformed into a concrete change and we will implement it," he said.

The governor also said that the indicators of implication of strengthening of national values in character must be maintained. "If you don't take care of it, it will fade over time. Especially with the influence of the existing environment," he said. Therefore, the Governor emphasized that it must be considered how to maintain the strengthening of national values in character. In addition, he also reminded that social media has

a big disruptive role and is not easy to control.

The Chairman of Apindo said that Apindo has a unique position. On one hand, Apindo is government partner, but on the other hand, Apindo also oversees policies so that they continue to provide benefits to the community. Apindo can also provide criticism to existing companies. Therefore, the implication of strengthening of national values program in these characters can be implemented and maintained in overseeing policies to truly benefit the community as much as possible.

The Deputy Chairman of DPR RI Meets with Governor of Lemhannas RI

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo met with the Deputy Chairman of the Indonesian House of Representatives (DPR RI), Rachmat Gobel, on Tuesday (19/10) in the Executive Guest Room.

During the meeting, the Deputy Chairman of DPR RI conveyed his experience when visiting his Electoral District, namely Gorontalo. From the experience of his visit, he considered that the education of Lemhannas RI was very much needed to the village head. "Education through Lemhannas RI should be expanded further, up to village heads," he said.

In addition, the Deputy Chairman of DPR RI also expressed his concern

because many children in Gorontalo are more familiar with contemporary songs than national anthems such as Indonesia Raya. This encourage Rachmat to take the initiative to suggest an educational program, coaching, or strengthening of national values for village heads and teachers in Gorontalo.

With the provision of educational programs, coaching, or strengthening of national values, the Deputy Chairman of DPR RI hopes that in the future the village heads and teachers will be able to inherited these values to children. "There is no point in developing infrastructure if our human resources are weak and our human resources are easily shaken," he said.

Responding to this, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that this should be done in an integrated manner with many parties. "Must be implemented together," he said. According to the Governor, it would be better if it didn't just involve Lemhannas RI because the key is education that starts at an early age. "In my opinion, not only national insight, but also balanced with functional competencies such as leadership, village-level government management, and governance," he continued.

Following up on this, the Governor said that the plan for an education program, coaching, or strengthening national values could be initiated by signing a memorandum of understanding followed by a discussion of its method, curriculum, and syllabus.



Signing of Memorandum of Understanding between Lemhannas RI with Unnes and Lemhannas RI with Bakomubin

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, the Rector of the Semarang State University Prof. Dr. Fathur Rokhman, M. Hum., and General Chairman of the Indonesian Islamic Preachers Coordinating Board Ali Mochtar Ngabalin, signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Tuesday (19/10) in the Nusantara Room, Lemhannas RI.

The signing of the memorandum of understanding between Lemhannas RI and Unnes is an extension of the previous memorandum of understanding. Meanwhile, the signing of a memorandum of understanding between Lemhannas RI and Bakomubin is the first time. The scope of the two memorandums of understanding includes improving the

quality of human resources through education and training, exchanging Experts, and strengthening of national values, as well as exchanging information and conducting studies. Both memorandums of understanding are valid for five years from the date of the signing.

On that occasion, the Rector of the Semarang State University (Unnes) conveyed that today, universities not only educate students to become smart, but also shape students to have character. According to him, intelligence is easier to develop in this era of disruption because the opportunity and access to intelligence is exceptionally easy. However, character building is an entirely different matter even though information

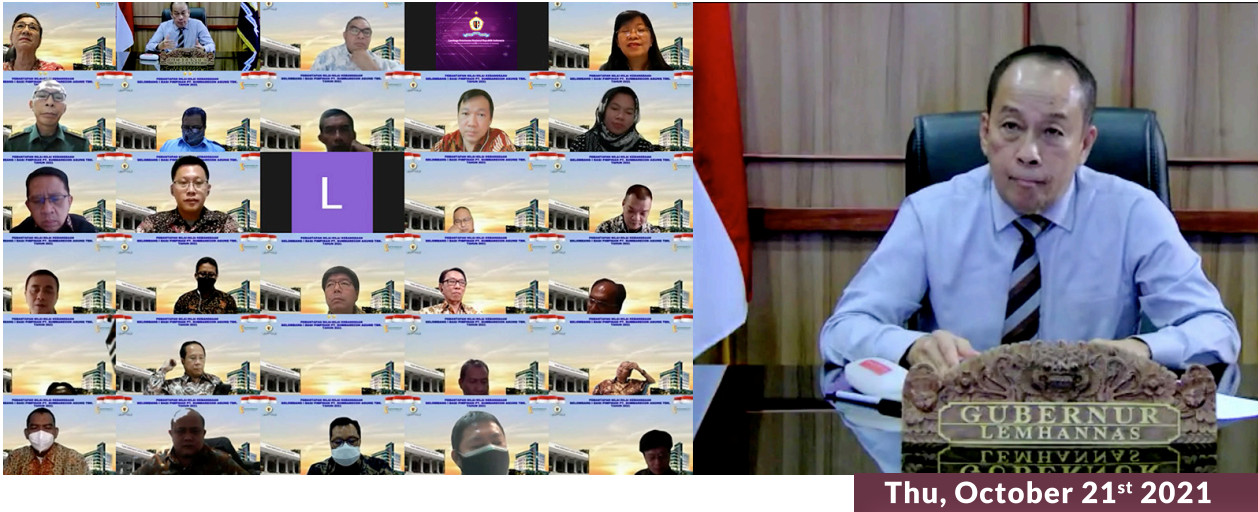
is broadly available and easy to access. He also said that research shows there is a significant correlation between students who possess national outlook with leadership and achievement. Therefore, Unnes considers the need for cooperation with Lemhannas RI to provide national outlook program.

Meanwhile, on the same occasion, the General Chairman of the Indonesian Islamic Preachers Coordinating Board (Bakomubin) stated that the advancement of the information technology industry affects the mindset of the Islamic preachers. Regarding this matter, in order to avoid the growth of a negative mindset and the spread of messages that are harmful to the nation, Bakomubin considers the need for cooperation with Lemhannas RI. Moreover, the Indonesian nation is a nation created with diversity. "God did not make us brothers and sisters in one faith, but God made us brothers and sisters in humanity. Destiny makes us different, but the love of God makes us one," he said.

Also on the occasion, the Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the comprehension of national values and outlook was not determined by Lemhannas RI alone. The more important point is that after the participants graduate and they could reflect the appropriate behaviour provided by Lemhannas RI based on the four basic consensus of the nation. Therefore, there is a need for cooperation between relevant institutions, including Lemhannas RI with Unnes and Lemhannas RI with Bakomubin. "I hope that the implementation carried out in actual activities can run consistently," he said.

The Governor believes that the synergy between Lemhannas RI with Unnes and Bakomubin can pose as a joint effort in developing national values and outlook as an absolute prerequisite in supporting the realization of strong national resilience. "The potential possessed by Lemhannas RI and the two institutions can create synergy in producing optimal results," he concluded.

Sc., Former Director of the Institute on Culture, Religion, and World Affairs (CURA), Boston University Prof. Dr. Robert W. Lemhannas RI Organizes Reflection Program for Lecturers to Improve Education Quality

After holding the Regular Education Program Batch 62 (PPRA 62) and the Short Education Program Batch 23 (PPSA 23), Lemhannas RI held a Reflection Program of Lecturers on the Teaching and Learning Process during the Covid-19 Pandemic Condition which was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo on Monday (25/10) in the Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI.

In his report, the Deputy for National-Level Leaders Education of Lemhannas RI, Major General TNI Sugeng Santoso, S.I.P. stated that the program was carried out to evaluate the implementation of education programs in 2021 in order to obtain suggestions or input for improvements in the teaching and learning process for the coming year. In this event, ten components of education were evaluated and inputs, suggestions, and thoughts that will be used in the readiness to implement educational programs in 2022 were discussed.

activity, we can discover obstacles and challenges from the learning process this year to determine the next steps for improvement so that the implementation of educational activities in the coming year can run more efficiently," he said.

The Governor considered that the existence of teaching experts, analysts, professionals and structural officials plays an important and dominant role in supporting the success of education programs in Lemhannas RI. "The quality of teaching experts, analysts, and professionals can be a reflection of the quality of education that will be produced by Lemhannas RI," he said.

Therefore, according to the Governor, the mutual understanding and perception of lecturers regarding the operational mechanism of education in the midst of this pandemic situation can support the efficient and successful implementation of educational programs and the duties of all those involved, both as lecturers, assistants, tutors, moderators, panellists, discussants, resource persons, as well as in other tasks.

Realizing the importance of this event, the Governor emphasized

several points to the participants, first to participate in all series of activities with a full sense of responsibility and discipline according to a predetermined schedule. Second, to explore and understand the entire mechanism for administering educational programs, especially technical scientific writing, case study discussion mechanisms, e-learning mechanisms, and other new issues in online learning methods using the Zoom application during the Covid-19 pandemic. Third, to avoid excessive personal and sectoral egos and improve professionalism, coordination, cooperation and solidity in the provision of education in order to achieve the expected quality outputs and outcomes. Fourth, to act and behave professionally, proactively, communicatively, and able to motivate and have character and abilities that can be used as role models for the participants.

The program which lasted for two days was carried out in a hybrid manner (online and offline) and was attended by teaching experts, analysts, professionals, and related structural officials of Lemhannas RI.

Visiting South Kalimantan, Lemhannas RI Evaluates Alumni Contribution

Lemhannas RI conducted monitoring and evaluation (monev) on the impact of PPR (Regular Education Program), PPS (Short Education Program) and P3DA (Regional Leaders Strengthening Program) participants on Wednesday (3/11) in South Kalimantan Province.

The monitoring and evaluation conducted until Friday (5/11) aimed to review the contribution of Lemhannas RI alumni based in South Kalimantan to the work place and society. In South Kalimantan Province, there are two alumni of Lemhannas RI who are active and become leaders in the region, namely the Head of the Community and Village Empowerment Service (DPMD) of South Kalimantan Province, Zulkipli MP, an alumnus of the Regular Education Program Batch 54 (PPRA 54) of 2016 and Danrem 101 Antasari, Brigadier General Firmansyah.

The Monitoring and Evaluation Team for the Impact of the Alumni of Lemhannas RI led by the Deputy for National-Level Leaders Education of Lemhannas RI, Major General Sugeng

Santoso, S.I.P. visited the DPMD of South Kalimantan at the Regional Secretariat of South Kalimantan Province at Banjarbaru and Makorem 101 Antasari in Banjarmasin.

The Deputy revealed that the results of the monitoring and evaluation will be utilized as material for the preparation of Lemhannas RI's education curriculum. "We want to know the outcome and contribution of PPR, PPS and P3D alumni including the contribution of alumni in their respective work places. We also want to obtain data directly and want to get opinions from alumni regarding the education program at Lemhannas RI we can improve the program's optimality in the future," the Deputy said.

According to the Deputy for Education, opinions and suggestions from alumni are very important for curriculum development at Lemhannas RI. This monitoring and evaluation activity at DPMD South Kalimantan is also part of the Deputy Office for National-Level Leaders Education of Lemhannas RI, namely to measure the impact and evaluate the results of the education obtained from Lemhannas RI.

"We want to evaluate the result of education at Lemhannas RI, whether it has been carried out by alumni in the work place, implemented as the benefits for the personnel who received education and the benefits for the community. It will be the references and opinions for the institution to improve the education program," the Deputy for Education explained.

In addition, the Deputy for Education hoped that alumni can be more critical in thinking, can implement the material on national outlooks obtained during their education at Lemhannas RI, and can participate in solving the nation's problems.

Lemhannas RI held a virtual Socialization of Goods/Services Procurement Governance Index Assessment for a number of Lemhannas RI's personnel on Thursday (4/11). 25 of 2020 concerning Road Map of Bureaucratic Reform 2020-2024 has regulated that the implementation of bureaucratic reform is divided into three levels, namely macro, meso and micro. At the meso level, the bureaucratic reform program is carried out by several agencies that are designated as the leading sector or in the organizational structure of national bureaucratic reform called as the National Bureaucratic Reform Management Unit (UPRBN).

Furthermore, the Head of the General Affairs Bureau also explained that the agencies included in the UPRBN act as coordinators in affairs which, among other, have functions in improving policies, fostering and implementing, as well as monitoring and evaluating the supervised

programs. "Agencies that function as the program's leading sector are responsible for formulating innovative policies, interpreting macro policies, coordinating the implementation of those policies, and monitoring the implementation progress," he explained.

The socialization program aims to provide enlightenment to the personnel of Lemhannas RI regarding the explanation of the indicators for the Good Minimum Procurement Governance Index. Therefore, it is hoped that in the future it can become a reference for the implementation of bureaucratic reform, especially the realisation of indicators for the Good Minimum Procurement Governance Index.
