Harvard Kennedy School Visits Lemhannas RI

Harvard Kennedy School delegation visited Lemhannas RI to discuss issues in Myanmar and they were welcomed directly by the Governor of Lemhannas Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo on Wednesday (12/12) in Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, 1st Floor, Lemhannas RI.

During the visit, Thomas J Vallely talked about the military operations carried out by the Myanmar military in August 2017, the Myanmar military forced thousands of Rohingya people to move from Rakhine State to Bangladesh. This was considered as a big mistake made by Myanmar.

Currently, Bangladesh is trying to send Rohingya people back to Myanmar in a safe and dignified manner. What happened in Myanmar was considered as one of the effects of the democratic

transition. Vallely said that Asian Countries and even the world were considered as very good examples in solving the problem of democratic transition occurred in Myanmar.

Indonesia, Vallely explained, was considered successful in solving problems arising from the democratic transition. "Many countries have failed in facing the democratic transition, but Myanmar cannot be said as failed," Vallely said. Vallely also said that at this time the Harvard Kennedy School was also focused on solving the problem of the transition of democracy in complicated countries.

In addition, Vallely also talked about what happened in Maluku and Vallely considered that the incident had similarities with Myanmar and also talk about UN policies.





Lemhannas RI commemorates State Defense Day

Lemhannas RI held a Flag-Raising Ceremony to commemorate the State Defense Day which fell on December 19, 2018, Wednesday (19/12) in Cetral Field of Lemhannas RI. Since the issuance of Presidential Decree Number 28 of 2006, December 19 is commemorated as State Defense Day. On that day, there was a major historical event occurred called as the Establishment of Emergency Government of the Republic of Indonesia on December 19, 1948.

“Political effort and diplomacy done by Mr. Syafrudin Prawiranegara successfully overcame invaders’ military power and show the world the existence of the Republic of Indonesia,” Coordinating Minister of Political, Legal, and Security Affairs (Menkopolhukam) said in his speech read by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito as the inspector of the ceremony.

Moreover, in the Menkopolhukam speech read by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas it was stated that the stipulating of State Defense Day is an affirmation that state defense itself has had a very broad context since then. State Defense is not only related to physical power and weapon but it must be done through various efforts and professions.

“All state apparatus, both civilian and military who are struggling in carrying out their duties throughout the country are actually doing state defense. Those people are the ones who keep the country to continue to serve its people,” the Coordinating Minister of Political, Legal, and Security Affairs said.

In the last September, the Government stipulated President Instruction number 7 of 2018 about National Action Plan of State Defense for 2018-2019 to fulfill the mandate of State Defense implementation in the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia and legislation concerning state defense.

The Chief of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI Brig. Gen. Mindarto explained about introduction to Lemhannas RI to the foreign participants of PPRA LIX from friendly countries before they join the Regular Education Program Batch (PPRA) LIX in Gatot Raca Room in Trigatra Buinding 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI Jakarta, Monday (14/1).

By explaining Lemhannas' profile, the participants who come from eight countries namely Srilanka, Bangladesh, India, Malaysia, Singapore, East Timor, and Australia are expected to understand the history, vision, mission, duties and functions of Lemhannas RI.

The event was opened by Chief of Cooperation Bureau of Lemhannas RI, Commodore Budi Setiawan, S.T.. In front of the foreign participants, Budi Setiawan gave brief explanation related to pre-course mechanism for foreign participants. He also gave brief description about education process which will be implemented for the next seven months.

Furthermore, Mindarto talked about the history of Lemhannas establishment. "Lemhannas RI was established in 1960 due to the political escalation caused by ideological battle between liberal and communism, not only in the world but also in Indonesia," Mindarto

said.

In its development, in 1994 based on Presidential Decree Number 4 of 1999 on February 1, 1994, National Defense Institute was change into National Resilience Institute. It affected the repositioning of Lemhannas RI from under Indonesian Military to under Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Indonesia.

Then in 2001, based on Presidential Decree Number 16 of 2001 on January 23, 2001, Lemhannas RI restructured its organization. "Lemhannas RI restructures its organization as a non-departmental government institution (LPND) which is directly responsible to the President of the Republic of Indonesia. In addition, it was the first time when Lemhannas was led by civilian," Mindarto said.

Besides the history, Mindarto also explained the meaning of symbols, vision and mission, the organizational structure of Lemhannas RI in accordance with Governor's Regulation Number 12 of 2017 on December 20, 2017, the work program of Lemhannas RI, the requirements for receiving participants in the Regular Education Program, Short Education Program and Strengthening Program for Regional Leaders and also the National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas).

BPK Penabur Foundation Visits Lemhannas RI

Twelve representatives from the BPK Penabur Foundation led by Adri Lazuardi made a visit to Lemhannas RI and were received by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo accompanied by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito on Monday (1/14), Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

During the visit, Adri Lazuardi said that as a foundation engaged in education, BPK Penabur also focused on national values education. Adri said that national values education is very important for students in primary and secondary school because it is the front guard in disseminating national values.

In addition, Adri also said that currently, the government is focusing on human development which aims to create quality human beings. Therefore, BPK Penabur asked for input from the Governor of Lemhannas RI regarding the national values education in schools and human development since school age.

Responding to this, Agus Widjojo then explained that Lemhannas RI has three functions; to educate national-level leader cadres, to carry out strategic studies that are in line with the core of the Lemhannas RI, and to carry out strengthening of national values program. Agus Widjojo advised the teachers at BPK Penabur to take part in the

Strengthening of National Values program and Training of Trainers for teaching staff.

Furthermore, the Deputy of Strengthening the National Values Lemhannas RI, Maj. Gen. TNI (Mar) Guntur Irianto Ciptolelono, S.E. explained about the Strengthening the National Values program. Guntur Irianto said that the program was held for seven days with several teaching methods such as lectures, discussions and groups discussion. In addition, at the end of the program participants were required to join outbound.

Meanwhile, Professional Expert of Lemhannas RI for National Vigilance, Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Dr. I Putu Sastra wingarta, also advised that BPK Penabur prepare teaching representatives to attend regular education at Lemhannas RI. In addition, I Putu Sastra also suggested if BPK Penabur send its representatives to follow the Strengthening of National Values Program, they can choose a theme that focused on human development.

“Commissariats that have been formed in several regions will basically add central IKAL instruments to encourage and increase their capacity in national level. “I hope that the IKAL Commissariats formed today will also be able to act as a catalyst in the implementation of strengthening national values in their respective regions,” Agus continued.

In addition to the inauguration of the board, this event was also a place for gathering as well as coordination meetings of the Central IKAL Board with the Provincial Commissariat of IKAL throughout Indonesia. This coordination meeting was held based on the mandate of the association and internal bylaws (AD / ART) to responsible for the implementation of IKAL work program during 2017-2018 and also evaluate the IKAL’s vision and mission.

Agus Widjojo: Lemhannas RI remain neutral in Practical Politics



Lemhannas RI held a Flag-Raising Ceremony which is held regularly every month at Lemhannas RI Central Field on Thursday (1/17). Acting as the Inspector of Ceremony, was the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI, Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, who represented the Governor of Lemhannas RI Let. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo.

At the beginning of the Governor's speech which was read by the Deputy Governor, the Governor wished Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to all the ceremony participants and hoped that 2019 could give new inspiration, enthusiasm and become a momentum to give their best performance at work.

Regarding the implementation of presidential and legislative elections, it was stated that at present, the stages of the election have entered the campaign stage for both legislative cadres such as DPR, DPD, Provincial DPRD, and district / city DPRD and candidates for President and Vice President.

Although the contestation and political dynamic are increasing, Bagus Puruhito said while reading the Governor's speech, all Lemhannas RI Officials as state servants must maintain the neutrality both in the presidential election and legislative elections. In the Governor's speech, it was also stated that Lemhannas RI explicitly did not engage in practical politics that supported one particular candidate.

“We also have to act wisely towards the potential of social conflicts arise in the community,” the Governor of Lemhannas RI said in his speech read by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI.

In addition, several matters related to Lemhannas were also conveyed such as the achievement of the realization of the Lemhannas RI budget in 2018 which increased when compared to the budget realization in 2017. Related to the 2019 work program, Agus Widjojo through his speech also able to optimize planning, organizing, implementing, controlling and monitoring functions carefully and precisely.

Furthermore, Agus Widjojo said in his speech that based on the new Lemhannas RI organizational structure based on the Governor's Regulation Number 12 of 2017, it must be fully applied in all work units. Before closing his speech, Agus Widjojo reminded about the preparation for the BPK RI examination and also the Regular Education Program batch LIX which will be opened on January 22, 2019.



Lemhannas RI Holds Consolidation of Faculty Members

In order to prepare for the implementation of the education program in 2019, Lemhannas RI held a Consolidation of Faculty Members in Pancasila Room, Trigatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI. The consolidation held for two days was opened by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo.

In the report delivered by Deputy of National-Level Leaders Education Maj. Gen. (Ret.) Karsiyanto to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, it was stated that the purpose of the consolidation was to disseminate technical guidelines and to equalize the perception of the implementation PPRA LIX, PPSA XXII and P3DA X in 2019.

With these objectives, it is expected that the consolidation can help to achieve the intended goals such as the readiness of the Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts, Professional Experts, and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI regarding the implementation of PPRA LIX, PPSA XXII, and P3DA X.

Karsiyanto also reported that the consolidation which was attended by 120 Lemhannas RI Faculty Members will discuss the evaluation of 2018 education programs, education mechanism and the readiness of the implementation in 2019, revision of the KKA, KKK, and Individual Paper writing guidelines, technical guidelines revision of the term of references and revision of the participants assesment.

Meanwhile, Agus Widjojo in his remarks said that this consolidation was the first step so that the education program could achieve the planned targets. This program is considered to have important and strategic meaning in the process of preparing and strengthening the national level leader cadres in 2019.

To support the education programs, all parties involved must work together to improve the quality of education and not only focus on good output but also good outcomes. From the results of the evaluation of the Education Program in 2018, there are several improvements that must be made in the planning, implementation and closing stages. Therefore, Agus Widjojo continued, all related parties must follow up seriously.

Agus Widjojo said that in order to implement the 2019 education program namely PPRA LIX, PPSA XXII, and P3DA X optimally, intense cooperation and coordination are needed from all supporting elements to prepare 10 components of education, namely curriculum, students, educators, supporting staff, instructions tools, teaching materials, budgets evaluation, infrastructure, systems and methods.

This consolidation also aims to equalize the perceptions of the participants in each process of implementing education, revise the technical guidelines for the implementation of PPRA, PPSA, and P3DA. With the similarity of perceptions, Agus Widjojo hopes that educational programs can take place more directed and fulfill all targets.

"This consolidation is not just a routine but a joint effort to improve the quality of the education program every year," Agus Widjojo stated in his speech.

Meanwhile, Karsiyanto in his presentation on the evaluation of the education program 2018 said there were several aspects that must be addressed in the implementation of the education program in 2019. Some aspects that must be addressed are in the education material aspect, education operational aspects, and instructor / instructor / personnel reviewers / professional staff / tutors / resource persons aspect. The aspects that must be addressed are gathered from the input from the education participants.

In addition, Karsiyanto also explained about the preparation of ten important educational components of education. Karsiyanto stated that the teaching staff, budget evaluation, instructions tools, and infrastructure had been prepared. While several other components are in the process. Seminar themes for PPRA LIX Participants have also been decided.

The consolidation was then followed by a discussion of revisions to the terms of reference, revision of technical guidelines of KKA, KKK, and Individual Paper, revision of technical guidelines for the terms of reference and revision of technical guidelines for participants' assessments.

Socialization of PPRA 2020 to Friendly Countries Defense Attache

Lemhannas RI held a socialization of the Regular Education Programs Batch (PPRA) LX and LXI in 2020 to defense attaches of friendly countries in Airlangga Room, Astagatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI, Friday (18/1). The event was opened by the Chief of Cooperation Bureau of Cooperation Bureau Lemhannas RI Commodore Budi Setiawan S.T ..

During the presentation session, the Head of the International Cooperation Division, Colonel Rujito G. Asmoro explained about the vision and mission of Lemhannas. Rujito explained that Lemhannas's vision was to become a quality, credible and world-class institution in the field of national resilience. while the Lemhannas mission is to organize education for national level leaders cadres, conduct strategic studies for input to the government, and organize strengthening of national values programs.

Rujito then explained that PPRA was held for seven months and was divided into two systems namely off campus and on campus. Off campus was held for 1.5 months. During the off campus, foreign participants conducted the process of learning by teleconference, and chatting with teachers and other education participants. Meanwhile, the on campus system was carried out for five months at Lemhannas RI with lecture and discussion methods.

During their education, foreign participants will also take part in core programs in education, namely Domestic Strategic Studies (SSDN), Overseas Strategic Studies (SSLN), Writing of Individual

Paper Work (Taskap), Simulation of National Management System (Olah Sismennas), and Organizing National Seminar.

To become an education participant in Lemhannas RI, Rujito explained that participants must fulfill several requirements, namely an active member of the Military, National Police, or State Civil Apparatus, Colonel, Senior Colonel, Brigadier General rank or equivalent for the State Civil Apparatus, maximum 53 years old recommended by their institution, has followed School of Command or education for the State Civil Apparatus, and is physically and mentally healthy proved by a complete examination in a government or military hospital.

In addition to the general requirements, prospective participants from friendly countries must also fulfill administrative requirements such as diplomatic passports, visa, security permits issued by Indonesian Defense Attaches at the Indonesian Embassy in the candidate country of origin, and Indonesian visa 20-1A.

Colonel Rujito also explained the detailed schedule that must be attended by prospective participants before starting the education program. The schedule includes registration and collection of required documents as well as a short course of Indonesian and core education material at Lemhannas RI. Before closing his presentation, Rujito opened a question and answer session with prospective participants and ended with a group photo session.
