Capacity Building for National Character Teaching Strategy is held

Lemhannas RI held a Capacity Building for National Character Teaching Strategy for Teachers, Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts, and Professional Experts in Lemhannas RI on Monday (18/2) in the Constitution Room, Tri Gatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI.

Deputy for Strengthening Nationalistic Values Maj. Gen. Guntur Irianto Ciptolelono said that the program aims to improve the ability of education staffs for strengthening of national values program to be more educative, intelligent and constructive in building and fostering the national foundation of all components of the nation. The program, which was attended by 60 participants, consisted of Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts, Professional Experts and also Echelon II and Echelon III Officials in Lemhannas RI.

Meanwhile, the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo conveyed that lecturers were an important factor and a great potential in disseminating positive values contained in the four national basic consensus to all components of this nation. Therefore, this potential is expected to increase and make a positive contribution in overcoming various problems faced today.

Lemhannas RI holds a Leader Forum in the beginning of 2019

In the beginning of 2019, Lemhannas RI held Leader Forum at Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Pancagatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI, on Wednesday (20/2). The Leader Forum was led by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo and was attended by all the Lemhannas Officials.

Agus Widjojo said that this is the right momentum to carry out an evaluation of the work program that had been carried out by Lemhannas RI in 2018 and a work program that will be implemented in 2019.

In addition, this momentum is held because it coincides with several Lemhannas' officials position changes at Lemhannas such as Principals Secretary and Deputy Governor positions. This Leader Forum, Agus Widjojo continued, is also a place to disseminate the latest information in Lemhannas.

In his presentation, Agus Widjojo said that in 2018, Lemhannas had conducted a Regular Education Program, Strengthening of National Values Programs, and National Dialogue, produced 36 policy papers, 6 Labkurtannas (Laboratory of National Resilient Measurement)

Studies, received the title "Reasonable Without Exception" from BPK RI (Supreme Audit Agency) for its 2017 budget management audit and also received the "Good" or "B" predicate from the KemenPANRB (Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform) for the SAKIP (Government Agency Performance Accountability System) evaluation result and 2017 reform implementation.

Meanwhile, the achievement of Lemhannas RI Budget performance in 2018 reached 99.06 percent with the achievement of 100 percent program performance which was an excellent achievement for Lemhannas. It can be achieved, Agus Widjojo conveyed, because of the cooperation of all work units in Lemhannas RI.

In addition, Agus Widjojo explained that in 2019, Lemhannas will hold a Short Education Program (PPSA) for 80 participants, the Regular Education Program (PPRA) for 100 participants, and an International Seminar (Jakarta Geopolitical Forum).

Meanwhile, Lemhannas RI also held a program in line with the government's commitment, such as the Strengthening of Regional Leaders Program (P3DA) for 50 participants, Strengthening National Values Program for 200 participants, Training for Trainers for 200 participants, and the National Insight Dialogue for 200 participants to support successful the upcoming elections and stability of national security. The Leader Forum was then followed by detailed explanations regarding the Individual Paper writing and followed by a question and answer session.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI as a Speaker at the Special Plenary Meeting of the MPR RI Study Institute

The Governor of Lemhannas Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo attended the Special Plenary Meeting of the Indonesian People's Consultative Assembly (MPR RI) Study Institute with the theme "Defense, Resilience, and State Territory" on Wednesday (27/02) in the GBHN Room of Nusantara V Building, MPR / DPR RI.

The Plenary meeting which was opened by Deputy Chairman of the MPR RI, Dr. H. Mahyudin, S.T., M.M. was held to get inputs on Defense, Resilience, and State Territory discussions from several speakers, including the Indonesian Minister of Defense General (Ret.) Ryamizard Ryacudu and Commander of the Indonesian National Armed Forces (TNI), Marshal Hadi Tjahjanto, S.I.P. including the Governor of Lemhannas RI.

In the plenary meeting, Agus Widjojo discussed the role and authority of state instruments based on the 1945 Constitution. Agus Widjojo said that based on the constitution, it was the government who have to responsible for protecting the entire Indonesian people. "It means that the protectors are the Indonesian government, not directly the Indonesian National Armed Forces or the Indonesian National Police," Agus Widjojo explained.

In the Article 10 of the 1945 Constitution, Agus Widjojo continued, it was stated that the President have the highest authority over the Army, Navy and Air Force. Therefore, Agus Widjojo stressed that the TNI duties were carried out based on the President's decision. "There is no task that is carried out automatically by TNI, it must go through the President's decision," Agus Widjojo stated.

Based on the 1945 Constitution, Agus Widjojo gave policy recommended that TNI remained under the coordination of the Ministry of Defense. In addition, Agus Widjojo also proposed that the process of transforming the Indonesian National Police (Polri) into a civilian police is continued.

Lemhannas RI hold Socialization on Indonesian Electoral Law



Located at the Gajah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI, on Monday (25/2), Lemhannas RI held a Socialization of the Indonesian Electoral Law to all Officials of Lemhannas RI after the morning call. The event presented two speakers from Director of National Awareness of the Ministry of Home Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Dr. Drs. Akbar Ali, AP, M.Sc. and from the Chief of the Technical and Community Participation Relations Bureau of the General Elections Commission, Nur Syarifah, S.H., LL.M.

In the speech of the Governor of Lemhannas RI read by the Chief of Cooperation Bureau, Commodore Budi Setiawan said that in the Legislative and Presidential Elections to be held on April 17, 2019 has its own challenges such as the neutrality of the civilian apparatus, the Indonesian Military (TNI) and the Indonesian National Police (POLRI) which challenge the democracy resilience in Indonesia.

In addition to the neutrality, Governor of Lemhannas RI explained in his remarks read by the Chief of the Cooperation Bureau, Elections also faced other challenges, such as money politics, various issues regarding ethnicity, religion, and race, hoaxes, to post-election conditions. Various phenomena underlying the occurrence of those matters, Governor of Lemhannas RI explained in his speech, encourage us to pay more attention to the development of the nation's democracy according to the Electoral Law.

Akbar Ali in his presentation entitled Neutrality and the Role of the Government in the Implementation of 2019 Simoultaneous Elections said that the implementation of the 2019 Election was not only the responsibility of the electoral organizers, such as KPU, Bawaslu (the Elections Supervisory Body), and DKPP (the Election Organization

Ethics Council) but also the responsibility of all Indonesian people. "This is our responsibility in helping technical organizers like KPU, Bawaslu and DKPP," Akbar Ali said

The role of the government and regional government in the implementation of the legislative and presidential elections as stipulated in Law No. 7 of 2017 is to form a selection committee to select KPU and Bawaslu commissioners, assisting the KPU and Bawaslu in disseminating election policies, preparing people for the elections implementation in the regions, and preparing the election infrastructure and facilities.

Meanwhile, the second speaker, Nur Syarifah explained that to strengthen the presidential system and for the efficiency of the budget of voter mobility effectiveness, there would be five ballots in this simultaneous election. This 2019 election, Nur Syarifah explained, the State guarantees Indonesian people voting right in Indonesia and abroad. At present, the KPU manages and organizes elections in 130 Indonesian representatives abroad.

Regarding the voting right, Nur Syarifah also said that voters live in a city different from the data listed in the voter list can use their voting right in this 2019 Presidential and Legislative Elections by coming to the nearest KPU office in the current city before the election day or visiting the nearest polling station one hour before the end of the election schedule.

"For voters who live in different city with those listed on the voter list can to the nearest KPU in the current vity they live in before the election day or come to the nearest polling station one hour before the election schedule ends," Nur Syarifah said.

Lemhannas RI holds Powerpoint Training entitled “Painting Slide with Heart”



Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI held a Powerpoint Training, entitled, “Painting with Hearts” in Airlangga Room, Astagatra Building, 3rd Floor, Lemhannas RI, on Tuesday (3/14). The training presented the Head of Inter-Institution Relations subdivision of Lemhannas RI, Endah Heliana, S. Sos., M.Sc. as a speaker.

At the beginning of her presentation, Endah said that people tend to use powerpoint ineffectively by displaying too much writing that contained all presentation material. Basically, Endah explained, Powerpoint should make presentation to be more attractive, inspire the audience, show visual stories, have a simple systematic flow.

Endah Heliana explained that there are several pillars of power point such as the content must be prepared before change into power point. The next pillar, powerpoint must contain a visual that aims to strengthen the verbal message delivered. “We don’t just use powerpoint to show our written materials that we read in front of the audience and end up ignoring them,” Endah said.

Endah also said that the visual message contained in power point aims to simplify complicated material. In addition, Endah also explained that in making powerpoint presentation, we must know in advance what to achieve and also the type of audience.

The training was held for two days until March 15 and was attended by the Chief of the Public Relations Bureau Brigadier Mindarto and all participants.

During this inauguration, the signing of the handover of the grant of the Soedirman Mosque expansion from the Commissioner of PT Teknoland Karya Jaya Ir. Darwis Ismail to the Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Commissioner General of Police Dr. Mochamad Iriawan, S.H., M.M., M.H. “The construction of this mosque is not only conducted by PT Teknoland Karya Jaya, but it is assisted by other parties participating. PT Teknoland Karya Jaya only starts and initiates the expansion,” Darwis explained

The Deputy Chairman of the Da’wah Commission of Central MUI (the Indonesian Ulema Council) Dr. K.H. Samsul Ma’arif, M.A. also presented at this event to give Da’wah (religious lectures) before the donation giving was carried out. Ma’arif advised, with the expansion of
