Before the end of the implementation of the Short Education Program Batch 22 (PPSA 22), Lemhannas RI conducted a training for the wives and husbands of PPSA 22 Participants. The training held for six days, starting on Tuesday (10/9) to Tuesday (9/17) was attended by 76 participants at Lemhannas RI.

"The training aims to increase the insight and knowledge of the wives and husbands of PPSA 22 Participants in line with the insight and knowledge of the PPSA 22 participants after finishing the PPSA 22," Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo said in his remarks at the Opening Ceremony of the training. In addition, the training also aims to strengthen the family ties between the husband and wife of the

PPSA 22 participants and Lemhannas RI Officials. By getting to know each other, a strong relationship is can hopefully be build in the future.

According to Agus, the success of PPSA 22 Participants in pursuing a career and carrying out state duties would not be possible without the role of their spouses. Therefore, the relationship between husband and wives should be maintained through the adjustment of their insight, morals and ethics. "Through this upgrading, the meaning of national ethics should be understood, which can then be implemented through their way of thinking, attitudes, and behaviour in daily life," Agus continued.

The basis of the training is to prepare the wives and husbands to strengthen their role in accompanying

the PPSA 22 Participants, both in their career and social life. "I hope the materials provided are able to raise awareness to motivate themselves as companions as well as national agents in their respective institutions," Agus concluded.

During the training, the wives and husbands of PPSA 22 Participants received various material delivered by lecturers and speakers such as the Role of Women in National Development, the Role of Wives/Husbands in Supporting their Spouses Careers, Building Communication in Creating Resilience, and Prevention of Drug.

The Closing of PPSA 22 Lemhannas RI

The Short Education Program Batch 22 (PPSA 22) of Lemhannas RI was officially closed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo on Wednesday (18/9), in Dwi Warna Purwa Room, Pancagatra Building. The closing ceremony of PPSA 22 began with a scientific speech by Garin Nugroho on "How to Read Indonesian-ness with a Cultural Strategy".

"People always said that culture is just an art, so it is not enough to solve the problems of this nation. But actually the cultural strategy is culture in a broad sense like the way of thinking, acting, and reacting in every period of time to face various problems," Garin said in his speech. According to Garin, cultural strategies to pursue various disciplines, state institutions, and cultural strategies that exist must be felt in daily life.

Garin also revealed that cultural strategies always contain observations, knowledge, and skills. Garin further stated that basically Indonesian multiculturalism existed from the very beginning when the diversity itself was developed. "Therefore reading Indonesia is reading diversity with different narratives and imaginations," Garin said.

Then Garin gave an example by raising the story of H.O.S Cokroaminoto. Referred to as the 'King of Java Without a Crown', Cokroaminoto uses dress as a cultural strategy. In the past, Garin explained, certain batik patterns could only be used by aristocrats, then Cokroaminoto made a rule that the all people could use those batik patterns. As a result, a sense of equality grows in the hearts of the people. Another strategy is language culture. Cokroaminoto said



that people could speak in informal language. This again makes people feelequal.

Meanwhile in his speech, Agus Widjojo said that the learning process that had been passed by PPSA 22 participants aims to strengthen their knowledge through understanding the Four Basic Consensus of the Nation namely Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia, the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia, and the Unity in Diversity, National Paradigm Archipelago Insight, National Resilience, and other fields of study so that they can carry out their respective duties.

"The materials that aims to increase their knowledge in carrying out their

tasks that lead to the making of public policy as well as its implementation in the framework of implementing the nation's basic consensus were given to the participants as strategic level leaders so thier work can run well," Agus continued

"I express my appreciation to the PPSA 22 Alumni who have shown their dedication and commitment throughout the education program," Agus said. Then on the occasion, Agus also gave the award of the best academic achievement to the First Air Marshal Age Wicaksono, S. IP., M.A as well as the award for the Best Individual Scientific Paper to Brigadier General Krishna Murti, S.IK., M.Sc.

The Military Science Academy (AMS) of The People's Liberation Army (PLA) visits Lemhannas RI

Deputy Director of General of the Military Science Academy (AMS) of The People's Liberation Army (PLA) Major General Zhang Zhenjian along with five delegates AMS visited Lemhannas RI on Monday (9/23). Academy Military Science (AMS) is the highest research institution of the People's Liberation Army (PLA).

The visit was received directly by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. Through this visit, Agus hopes to find out more about China's plans and recommendations on the situation of the South China Sea and the trade war between China and the United States.

In addition, Agus also stated that Lemhannas RI needs to learn more about writing concepts of defense and security approaches from

AMS. "I believe that today's visit will be a stepping stone for these two institutions to share knowledge about strategic studies," Agus said.

Professional Expert for Natural Resource and National Resilience of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Dadan Umar Daihani, D.E.A. explained that Lemhannas RI is led by a Governor and three deputies, namely the Deputy for National-Level Leader Education, the Deputy for Strategic Studies, and the Deputy for Strengthening National Values.

"Lemhannas RI carries out two education programs namely the Short Education Program (PPSA) and the Regular Education Program (PPRA)," Dadan said. Dadan also mentioned that Lemhannas RI had a national laboratory for national resilience measurement.

The visit was continued with a question and answer session and ended with the exchange of between AMS of the People's Liberation Army (PLA) and Lemhannas RI.



Security College of Korea National Defense University (KNDU) visits Lemhannas RI

A total of 23 delegates from the Security College of Korea National Defense University (KNDU Security College) led by Prof. Kwon O-Sung visited Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (9/23), at the 1st Floor Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The visit received directly by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo was begun with a Courtesy Call in the Executive Guest Room. Prof. Kwon O-Sung said that Korea is currently experiencing a difficult time with other countries as there are threats from North Korea, then China and Russia whose planes pass through Korea, and with Japan which is a matter of history and current export restriction. Prof Kwon O-Sung also said that Indonesia is considered as a country with close relationship with Korea.

"We are proud to have Colonel Rudy from the Ministry of Defense as a student in KNDU. Rudy is very diligent and excellent student," Kwon O-Sung said. He also said that Indonesia is a country endowed with Natural Resources (SDA), develop very fast, and have a high enthusiasm for learning. "I hope there will be cooperation between the two countries in the field of national security and other sectors," Kwon O-Sung said.

According to Agus, Korea is a rich country and have a high work ethic. "Korea is a wealthy and prosperous country and its people have an excellent work ethic," Agus said. Agus also said that at this time, especially in the field of defense, Indonesia and Korea had already established many collaborations

and hoped that in the future the defense industry would grow rapidly.

After the courtesy call, the delegation moved to the Kresna Room of the Astagatra Building and the visit continued with a lecture delivered by Professional Expert for Natural Resources (SKA) and National Resilience of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Dadan Umar Daihani, D.E.A. On this occasion, Dadan explained the Vision, Mission, Organizational Structure, Education Program, Education Methods, Education Curriculum, and Facilities at Lemhannas RI. In addition, Dadan also explained that Lemhannas RI has a National Resilience Measurement Laboratory and was followed by a discussion and question and answer session.

Lemhannas RI for the second time held the Strengthening Program for the Regional-Level Leaders Batch 10 (P3DA 10) which began on Tuesday (24/09) and is planned to end on Wednesday (11/20). Deputy for National-Level Leader Education of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. Karsiyanto in his report stated that P3DA 10 was attended by forty-one participants consisting of seventeen Regents, eleven Deputy Regents, three Mayors, three Deputy Mayors, six DPRD Leaders, and one Adkasi National Secretariat.

Meanwhile, the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus

Widjojo in his remarks at the Opening Ceremony of the P3DA at the Constitution Room of the Trigatra Building said that the presence of P3DA participants in Lemhannas RI was expected to have strong determination to carry out a mental revolution in transforming attitudes and behaviors that reflected the figure of regional leaders with excellent national character.

"Participants need to have the ability to analyze, decide and think strategically and also being honest which are the main prerequisites of a regional level leader," Agus said. "Ethics, morals and honesty must be owned by each participant," Agus continued.

P3DA aims to strengthen regional leaders with integrity, character, nationalism, strategic thinking and skill in overcoming national development problems at the regional level. Then another goal is to make regional leaders understand the Four Basic Consensus of the Nation and to understand national insight, national security, and national vigilance.

In addition, P3DA also aims to create regional leaders who are able to solve regional problems and able to provide advice to first-level local governments on public policies and related national values.

Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2019: From Disarray towards A New Normal

Lemhannas RI held its third Jakarta Geopolitics Forum (JGF) on Thursday (8/26) at the Ritz-Carlton Hotel, Mega Kuningan, Jakarta. JGF 2019, which invited eight speakers on three different topics, was opened by the Minister of Defense of the Republic of Indonesia General (Ret.) Ryamizard Ryacudu.

"This forum aims to provide a place for practitioners, professionals and academics to exchange views and thoughts about the future of geopolitics and world order," said Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo at the beginning of his remark.

Agus explained that the end of the cold war led to the emergence of world disarray. The disarray caused a major change in the international order. This huge change can not be avoided. Besides, it also spread to various sides of life. Agus said that the change must be followed by better ideas, leaders, and institutions and in accordance with the

current state of the world. Agus said that on the one hand, this change caused disruption that had never existed before but on the other hand, it also created new power, new hope, and a new world order.

"I would like to say thank you to the government representatives, the private sector and academics for attending the JGF today and make me believe that in this precious moment, the invited guests can analyze the geopolitical framework and see what is really happening in the current world disarray and what is likely to happen in the normal world order through in-depth discussion," Agus said.

The Minister of Defense of the Republic of Indonesia General (Ret.) Ryamizard Ryacudu in his remarks said his appreciation for the implementation of JGF 2019. "I am very happy that we have this Jakarta Geopolitical Forum," Ryamizard said.

Ryamizard said that the Indo-Pacific region is the center of the

gravity of global security which is currently developing and has formed a new world order. Indonesia as one of the ASEAN countries that are also included in the Indo-Pacific Region, Ryamizard continued, must establish good cooperation with other countries in the Indo-Pacific in facing common challenges and making these challenges as an opportunity to build a more peaceful world.

At the end of his remarks, Ryamizard hopes that Lemhannas RI can be an institution that evaluate and assess action plans developed based on things happened in the past, so that in the future we can become more resilient. "I also hope Lemhannas can also develop defense and security indicators to monitor the geopolitical situation in the Indo-pacific region," Ryamizard concluded.



Governor of Lemhannas RI: Proxy War is nothing new

The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo became a speaker in the General Lecture on Nationalism organized by the University of Indonesia Alumni Association (ILUNI UI) post graduate school, School of Environmental Sciences and School of Strategic and Global Studies at the University of Indonesia with the theme "National Defense and Security Strategy in Facing Proxy War Attacks" . The general lecture was held at the 3rd Floor IASTH Building, Universitas of Indonesia, Salemba on Friday (27/09).

"This Proxy War has occurred everywhere and there is nothing new

about it. It has been around since a long time ago," Agus said. Proxy War is basically the desire to control other countries or the interests of other groups and get maximum profit. To make this happen, Agus said, a country will use another country to work together for its interests. The selection of other countries can be done based on contracts and the similarity on ideology and purpose.

Agus said that cyber war is also a driving force for organizing proxy war because cyber can hide the identity of perpetrators. American CSIS estimates that there have been at least 78 significant cyber incidents against



government agencies, sophisticated defense technology companies or economic crimes that have incurred losses in millions of US dollars. Countries in the world are now making adjustments to the new front wars that have opened up in the cyber world.

A lecturer is also expected to be able to build cultural values that reflect the personality traits and national values of the Indonesian people which will accelerate the creation of a sovereign, united, just and prosperous national life.

"I hope that this opportunity can be utilized by conducting a comprehensive exchange of opinions and discussions related to various issues so that the participants have more extensive insight in implementing national values," Agus concluded.
