The Elected Formature Committee from the Indonesian Policy Analyst Association (AAKI) for the 2019-2022 period paid a Courtesy Call to Lemhannas RI in the Governor's Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (28/01).

This Courtesy Call was conducted based on the President's policy to simplify the bureaucracy into two echelon levels and replace the Administrator (Echelon 3) and Supervisor (Echelon 4) with Functional Position (JF). DR. Ing. Totok Hari Wibowo, M.Sc as the Elected Formature Committee Chairperson from the Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs explained that the Elected Formature Committee would like to have a deeper discussion on the future cooperation possibility between the Indonesian Policy Analyst Association with Lemhannas RI.

"From our observation, the high interest in eliminating the echelon 3 and 4 positions is led to policy analyst functional position despite other functional positions such as researcher, engineer, and lecturer," Totok said. furthermore, Lemhannas RI is asked to compare the advantages of each functional positions and to check the conversion process due to its to the

very standard stages.

The Indonesian Policy Analyst Association also considers an increase of policy analyst due to the conversion of at least 10,000 members so Policy Analysts are getting more important in Indonesia.

"throughout my career, I see that the policy making process adhering to the standard rules can find the weak part, However, the process to move towards refining the policy must take place, even though there are national policies that lead to it, but Ministries / Institutions are still hesitant in the process of improving existing policies," Totok added.

Therefore, in the process of forming a new functional structure, the Indonesian Policy Analyst Association wants to explore various Institutions. Lemhannas RI became the first phase of Ministries / Institutions encountered by the Indonesian Policy Analyst Association.

Lemhannas RI is Ready to Welcome the 2019 LKKL Inspection Team

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo accompanied by several Echelon I and II of Lemhannas RI attended the Entry Meeting of 2019 Financial Report of Ministries/Institutions in Principal Auditorate of State Finance I (AKN I) on Friday (31/1) at Auditorium of BPK RI (Supreme Audit Agency of the Republic of Indonesia).

"Inspection Team of BPK RI has huge responsibilities to be able to implement those state duties because they have to be accountable to the people through DPR RI (The House of representatives)," the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo said.

Therefore, Agus expected all parties that become the inspection objects by BPK RI to provide documents and information inspected to support the inspection process. The smoothness of the inspection can support BPK RI performance in giving their opinion according to appropriately in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Furthermore, Agus also asked the heads of ministries / institutions of the object of inspection in each clarification / discussion of the material to provide the first portion in responding to the audit findings with valid evidence based on the main criteria as a legal basis, so as to speed up the follow-up and resolution according to applicable regulations.

Meanwhile the Head of State Financial Inspection I for Political, Legal, and Security Division Dr. Hendra Susanto S.T., M. Eng., M.H.,



CfRA., CSFA., said that in conducting the inspection, the entry meeting is a crucial part. He conveyed that audit communication is one of the standards, so the implementation of the entry meeting is needed.

"I hope that in this year's BPK audit, communication between the auditors and all parties can run well, both carrying out their duties and obligations in accordance with their respective authorities," Hendra continued.

Hendra also reminded all parties involved to cooperate in improving the state financial management for the advanced nation and state by paying attention to integrity, independency, and professionalism values.

The LKKL Inspection of 2019 has been being held from January 6 to May 21, 2020. The inspection began with the submission of the Audit Assignment Letter on the 2019 Financial Statements by the Head of the State Financial Inspection I Political, Legal, and Security Division to the Leaders of Ministries / Institutions in the AKN I.

After joining the 2-week-orientation, PPRA 60 participants would undergo the off campus activities which began with outbound training activity. The outbound training activity had been held for three days since Monday (3/20 to Wednesday (5/2) in Cikereteg, Bogor, West Java.

The Prime Secretary of Lemhannas

RI Commissioner General of Police Dr. Mochamad Iriawan, S.H., M.M., M.H. who read the Governor of Lemhannas RI's speech in the Opening Ceremony of PPRA 60 Outbound Training Activity stated that it is an outdoor activity which aimed to increase the sense of solidarity and solidity among participants.

Iriawan added that solidarity and solidity will strengthen personal relations among participants and it was expected to grow until the participants finish their education program at Lemhannas RI.

During the outbound training activity. The participants will be asked to overcome some challenges given that require their physical and mental readiness. "Carry out this outbound training activity enthusiastically but do not forget to pay attention to safety factors," Iriawan said. Iriawan also

reminded the participants to strengthen the solidarity and solidity among them during the outbound training activity.

The other purposes of this PPRA 60 outbound training activity are to foster sense of togetherness among participants, to eliminate personal barriers, to increase nationalism with The Four Basic Consensuses of the Nation namely The Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (NKRI), The 1945 Constitution, Pancasila, and Unity in Diversity.

During the outbound training activity, the PPRA 60 participants were also trained to practice integrated cooperation which include planning, doing, checking, and action. In addition to that are improving discipline, accuracy and punctuality according to QCDSM Principles (Quality, Cost, Delivery Time, Safety, and Moral).

The visit of National Resilience College of Malaysia to Lemhannas RI



led by Maj. Gen. Dato' Hj Md Yusof bin Azis, twenty-nine delegates from Maktab Ketahanan Nasional Malaysia or Malaysian National Resilience College visited Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (5/1) at Kresna Room, Astagatra Building 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI.

The purpose of the visit was so that the Malaysian National Defense Ministry delegations could learn and discuss Lemhannas RI's contribution to the state. "The purpose of our trip is as a study visit, we want to make a comparative study," Yusof explained.

The Malaysian National Resilience College is a part of the National Resilience College (NRC) which is a part of the National Resilience Study Center (Puspahannas). Under the Puspahannas, The NRC has three colleges, namely the

Malaysian National Resilience College, the Armed Forces Defense College or MPAT, and The Malaysian Armed Forces Staff College or MTAT.

On the occasion, Professional Expert for Geopolitics and Geography of Lemhannas RI Maj. Gen. (Ret) Endang Hairudin, S.H., M.A. explained about Lemhannas RI. Ending described that Lemhannas RI, led by a Governor, is a non-ministerial government agencies (LPNK) and directly responsible to the president.

Ending also explained about the vision and mission of Lemhannas RI. "The vision of Lemhannas RI is to become a quality, credible, and world-class institution in the field of national resilience," Endang said. Then Endang explained that the vision was supported by three missions, namely

preparing national-level leader cadres with comparative advantages, national character, democratic, and have strategic role in international relation through education, then providing recommendations for the government in policy making process at international, regional and national level through Strategic Studies, and prepare nation's components with national character in accordance with Four National Basic Consensus through strengthening national values.

Ending further explained that education programs held by Lemhannas RI are Regular Education Program (PPRA), Short Education Program (PPSA), and Strengthening Regional Leaders Program (P3DA). The meeting was ended with a question and answer session and discussion.

The Values of National Basic Consensus must be reflected in our behaviour, The Governor of Lemhannas RI says



The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo acted as speaker at the launching program and inaugural lecture with the archipelago santri (students of a traditional muslim school) of the Academy of Pancasila Science (AIP) on Wednesday (5/2) at Ministry of Religious Affairs Wisma, Jakarta.

The event was opened by The Governor of Academy of Pancasila Science (AIP), Haidar Alwi. The inaugural lecture was attended by the representatives of Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources, Ministry of Transportation, National Consumer Protection Agency (BPKN), teachers and students from junior high school and senior high school, and vocational high school Jakarta, representatives of non-government organizations, and libraries which will provide books related to

Pancasila at Academy of Pancasila Science.

The purpose of the establishment of the Academy of Pancasila Sciences is because Pancasila is expected to be able to fortify the community in maintaining the survival of Indonesia. "We hoped Lemhannas RI can give us direction, guidance to us and also can cooperate with AIP in the future, so that we can carry out President Jokowi's program, to disseminate the Pancasila," Haidar said in his remarks.

On the occasion, Agus also congratulated the Academy of Pancasila Science for disseminating the values of Pancasila which is a joint task, including Lemhannas RI that is in charge of implementing the strengthening national values program as one of its duties.

In his presentation, agus explained that Pancasila is an open ideology which

means an ideology that absorbs new beneficial values for the survival of the nation. The actualization of Pancasila values is needed in daily life, especially in the context of strengthening the unity and integrity of the nation.

"One of the efforts is through education that has the character of Pancasila, to create excellent and open-minded human resources in Indonesia who are also able to compete with other countries," Agus added.

Agus also conveyed that the values in Four National Basic Consensus must be reflected our behavior as Indonesians because Pancasila is the core of the original value in Indonesian society.

"Indonesians until now can live peacefully under the auspices of the Pancasila with the motto *Bhinneka Tunggal Ika* (Unity in Diversity) as a unifier," Agus concluded.

PPRA 60 Participants enter E-Learning program



The Participants of Regular Education Program Batch 60 (PPRA 60) entered the long-distance-learning system or e-Learning starting from Friday (7/2) to Tuesday (3/3). The development of information technology has encouraged Lemhannas RI to utilize the e-Learning system in the learning process. e-learning is a long-distance learning process without having to be presence at a class.

In the implementation of e-Learning, the participants are divided into some groups, and each group will be assisted by a lecturer and a tutor. The lecturer consists of Senior Lecturer or Senior Analyst or Professional Expert of Lemhannas RI which had been appointed

to assess the quality of answers and products, activities, and also the quality of participants' discussions. Meanwhile Tutor are echelon II or echelon III Officials of Lemhannas RI who assigned to check and record the attendance of the participants.

The implementation of e-Learning consists of Chatting and Video Conference. Chatting is the written question and answer session using electronic device online. During the chatting, the participants will answer the question given by lecturer and continued by discussion among participants led by the lecturer. Meanwhile during the video conference, the participants hold a face-to-face discussion by teleconference led by the group leader and guided by the lecturer.

During the e-Learning, the participants will be given six materials namely the Pancasila, The 1945 Constitution, Geopolitics and Archipelago Insight, Geostrategy and National Resilience, National Vigilance, National Management System, and Leadership.

The education program held by Lemhannas RI aims to prepare and strengthen the national-level leader cadres with comprehensive, integral, integrative, and professional way of thinking, strong character, moral and national ethics, statesman, national character, and universal perspective.

Several Defence Attaches of friendly countries attend PPRA 62 Socialization

To attract participants from friendly countries to join the Regular Education Program Batch 62 (PPRA 62) of 2021, Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI held a socialization for several defense attaches of friendly countries at Airlangga Room, Astagatra Building, 3rd Floor, on Wednesday (12/2).

On the occasion, the head of Foreign Cooperation Division Colonel Edy Supriyanto explained about Lemhannas RI. Edy said that Lemhannas RI is a Non Ministerial Government Institution responsible directly to the President of the Republic of Indonesia.

"Lemhannas RI's Vision is to be an excellent, credible, and World-Class Institution in the field of National Resilience," Edy said. Furthermore, Edy explained that the missions of Lemhannas RI are to prepare national-level leader cadres with comparative advantages, national character, democratic, and have strategic role in international relation through education, to provide recommendations for the government in policy making process at international, regional and national level through Strategic Studies and also to prepare nation's components with national character in accordance with Four National Basic Consensus through Strengthening National Values.

Then Edy talked about the implementation of PPRA (the regular education program). "PPRA is regular education program attended by eighty to a hundred participants," Edy added. The PPRA participants come from the Indonesian Military, the Indonesian



Police, and Civillian and will attend the education program for seven months consisting of one month of off campus and six months of on campus.

The participant candidates who come from friendly countries must attend Bahasa Indonesia Course first. "PPRA 62 will be opened in Januari 26, 2021 and closed in August 31, 2021," Edy conveyed. For the participant candidates of PPRA 62 of 2021, the Bahasa Indonesia course will be started in Januari 1, 2020 until December 11, 2020. Furthermore, Edy explained that Bahasa Indonesia Course consists of four levels namely beginner level, intermediate level, advanced level, and expert level.

In addition to Bahasa Indonesia course, The participant candidates of PPRA 62 of 2021 will be given an introduction to local culture and pre course programs. The Introduction

of local culture aims to introduce Indonesian culture to the PPRA participant candidates by visiting several regions in Indonesia to directly learn from those regions. Meanwhile the pre-course program, the participants will be explained about the education mechanism which will be followed by the participants.

The Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI attends Commemoration of PETA Rebellion Day



The Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan attended the Commemoration of PETA (Defenders of the Homeland) Rebellion Day on Friday (14/2) at the PETA Monument and Museum, Bogor, West Java.

Starting his remarks, Wieko who represented the Governor of Lemhannas RI delivered about the history of PETA uprising in Blitar in 1945.

"The PETA rebellion in Blitar happened in February 15, 1945 led by Shodancho Soeprijadi to Japanese troops. "This rebellion arose from Soeprijadi's concern at seeing the suffering of the people who were under Japanese occupation during the Second World War," Wieko explained.

The uprising, Wieko explained, killed a number of Japanese soldiers,

as well as PETA troops led by Soeprijadi who managed to escape. However, the Japanese command structure which did not form the Peta central command succeeded in preventing the success of the rebellion.

Then, Wieko explained that the captured Peta soldiers were tried in Jakarta, as many as 68 rebels of PETA members were arrested and sentenced to death, while Soeprijadi himself was not found to this day. For his services, he was officially declared a national hero of Indonesia on 9 August 1975 based on Presidential Decree Number. 063 / TK / 1975.

Looking at the current strategic environment, Wieko expressed his concern over the desire of certain groups to disintegrate from the unitary state, increasing the threat of radicalism,

intolerance, and various forms of violence that have arisen in society.

Wieko said that the PETA Rebellion in Blitar had a very special meaning as a symbol of resistance to the occupation of a nation that caused misery and suffering. The rebellion of the Daidanco PETA in Blitar is a reflection of the spirit of courage, the soul of the patriot / love of the motherland with all kinds of sacrifices, both soul and body of the nation's sons and daughters.

I hope that we can all reflect on the struggles by the predecessors and founders of the nation. The struggle and sacrifice of the founding fathers have been and will continue to be a spirit of our people, our state life, and in defending the Republic of Indonesia," Wieko concluded at the end of his remarks.

The Monthly Flag-Raising Ceremony of Lemhannas RI

Lemhannas RI held monthly flag-raising ceremony led by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan as an inspector of the ceremony on Monday (17/2), at the Central Field of Lemhannas RI.

Wieko, read the Governor of Lemhannas RI's Speech, conveyed that currently, WHO (World Health Organization) has determined corona virus outbreak (COVID-19) as a Global Emergency. This virus has spread to almost 27 countries. Responding to this, Wieko reminded Lemhannas RI's Officials to increase awareness and anticipate all possibilities by maintaining our health.

Related to the 2020 Work Programs, Wieko said that the Deputy Office of National-Level Leader Education opened Regular Education Program Batch 60

(PPRA 60) on January 21, 2020. Meanwhile the PPRA 61 will be held on March, 2020.

In addition to that, the Deputy Office of Strategic Studies is currently focusing on preparing comprehensive studies by conducting two Focus Group Discussions (FGD) with the theme "Determining the position of State Policy Guidelines in the presidential system for the sustainability of national development" and another FGD related to "The influence of US and Iran Disputes towards national stability" in early February 2020.

In the field of Strengthening the national values, The Strengthening



National Values Program Batch 4 for KADIN members was conducted from February 17 to February 23, 2020. Then in March 2020, a national dialogue will be held at Special Region of Yogyakarta and West Java Province.

The ceremony was attended by Deputies, Faculty Members, Structural Officials, and all officials of Lemhannas RI.
