# Governor of Lemhannas RI Welcomes Chairperson of DPP GAMKI

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo welcomed several officials from the Central Board of the Indonesian Christian Youth Force Movement (DPP GAMKI) on Friday (16/4) at the Governor's Executive Guest Room. During the audience, the DPP GAMKI group was directly led by the Chairperson of GAMKI Willem Wandik, S.Sos.

On this occasion, the Chairperson of GAMKI, Willem Wandik, S.Sos stated that GAMKI apprehends the importance of the state in national life in which the people have the same rights for peace, prosperity, justice, and obligation in order to maintain mutual values.

Furthermore, Willem expressed his hopefulness that he could share thoughts with Lemhannas RI and for Lemhannas RI to incessantly develop alternative discussions regarding the

challenges of GAMKI cadres throughout the archipelago in order to preserve the existence of native culture. "We hope that assisted the educational training institute Lemhannas RI, a diplomatic discussion can be formulated for the church community that are still tangled up in savage conflicts," Willem said.

GAMKI also hopes that Lemhannas RI can help disseminate information to education participants who study at Lemhannas RI to pay great attention to humanity throughout Indonesia, including Papua. "We hope that through Lemhannas RI we can convey great ideas regarding how the state deals with indigenous community's conflicts which are also GAMKI service areas throughout the archipelago," Willem said.

"Therefore, in order to uphold the ideology of national defence, we, from the DPP GAMKI hope that Lemhannas

RI can collaborate with the DPP GAMKI in every implementation of Lemhannas RI education and the collaboration can be stated in an MOU or cooperation," Willem said.

Responding to this, the Governor of Lemhannas RI welcomed the plan of the memorandum of understanding and said that at Lemhannas RI, the memorandum of understanding would be followed by and elaborated with detailed agreements regarding forms of cooperation.

On this occasion, the Governor said that Lemhannas RI provides opportunities regarding the participation of DPP GAMKI cadres in education at Lemhannas RI which discuss the Basic National Consensus, Pancasila, UUD 1945, NKRI, Bhinneka Tunggal Ika, National Resilience, and Archipelago Insights.



# The Governor as a Speaker in Ramadhan Salam IAIN Syekh Nurjati Cirebon

**T**he Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo was present as a speaker in the event Ramadhan Salam: National Recitation of the Islamic Perspective Rahmatan Lil Alamin on Wednesday (21/4) online.

On this occasion, Agus explained that the nation's founders had carried out a long process regarding the formulation of the constitution. In this case, the values of Islamic teachings have been synergized by the founders

of the nation so that they are aligned with the objectives of the nation. Therefore, a dichotomy is totally unnecessary to differentiate between the constitution and the values of Islamic teachings.

Agus also emphasized that if there are parties imposing a certain religion to change the basic consensus of the nation, those are the parties that have a fragmentary understanding. "We question why there are groups that deviate and leave the constitution,

we can predict and suspect that the aspects which are difficult to unite come from a starting point outside the basic consensus of nationality," Agus said.

In addition, Agus stated that political dynamics can occur if there is a grouping of differences in opinions and views. This will clearly lead to horizontal conflicts in society due to an incomplete understanding of the value of Islamic teachings and an understanding of democratic politics. This can be foreseen from the previous regional head election and presidential election.

Agus further revealed that education at Lemhannas RI tries to re-establish a complete understanding for all students. Therefore, according to Agus, later when education participants of Lemhannas RI have occupied positions with the responsibility to determine policies, they will be capable to act in dealing with various dynamics of differences in society. With a complete understanding, education participants of Lemhannas RI can observe how the society, nation and country should be structured.

Concluding his lecture, Agus Widjojo expressed his deep belief that the values of Islamic teachings contain all the requirements to bring blessings to all of the followers. However, this depends on how the adherents practice and implement these teachings. Agus Widjojo hopes that regarding Islamic teaching, we should not only implement them on the sharia stage but we also need to further understand them until the moral level. Therefore, we are protected from debates that lead us away from rahmatan lil alamin.



# PP Japnas Courtesy Visit to Lemhannas RI

"We received information that the postgraduate scholarship program has been arranged in LPDP. We also ensured coordination with Bappenas, that



cooperation for postgraduate programs for national resilience at Bappenas is a priority. Therefore, Lemhannas RI wants to maximize the Lemhannas-Inter Universities Network (L-IUN) program," Wieko said.

Meanwhile, Associate Expert Planner of the Ministry of National Development Planning (PPN)/National Development Planning Agency (Bappenas), Firdini, stated that Bappenas supports Lemhannas RI through L-IUN to receive financial support using the LPDP mechanism.

Furthermore, Firdini conveyed that the program supports one of the national priorities that is the

development of quality and competitive Human Resources. Firdini passed the opinion that the development of Human Resources with a substantive understanding of national resilience is necessary.

Responding to this, LPDP President Director, Andin Hadiyanto, stated that for LPDP, continuing this L-IUN program is a new target. Andin further said that because this is a program related to the funding and strategic direction of LPDP, presentations will be made to the 9 board of trustees. Andin also stated that the cooperation program will be executed immediately if it has received approval from the board of trustees.

"The educational goal is an elaboration of the educational objectives and includes concrete formulas that will be realized and accounted for," Agus said.

Furthermore, Agus explained the operational constructs of education at Lemhannas RI. Participants are encouraged to think critically and strategically so that the teaching and

learning process is centered on active participants who are given actual case studies. "There is no direct practice without learning theories," Agus said.

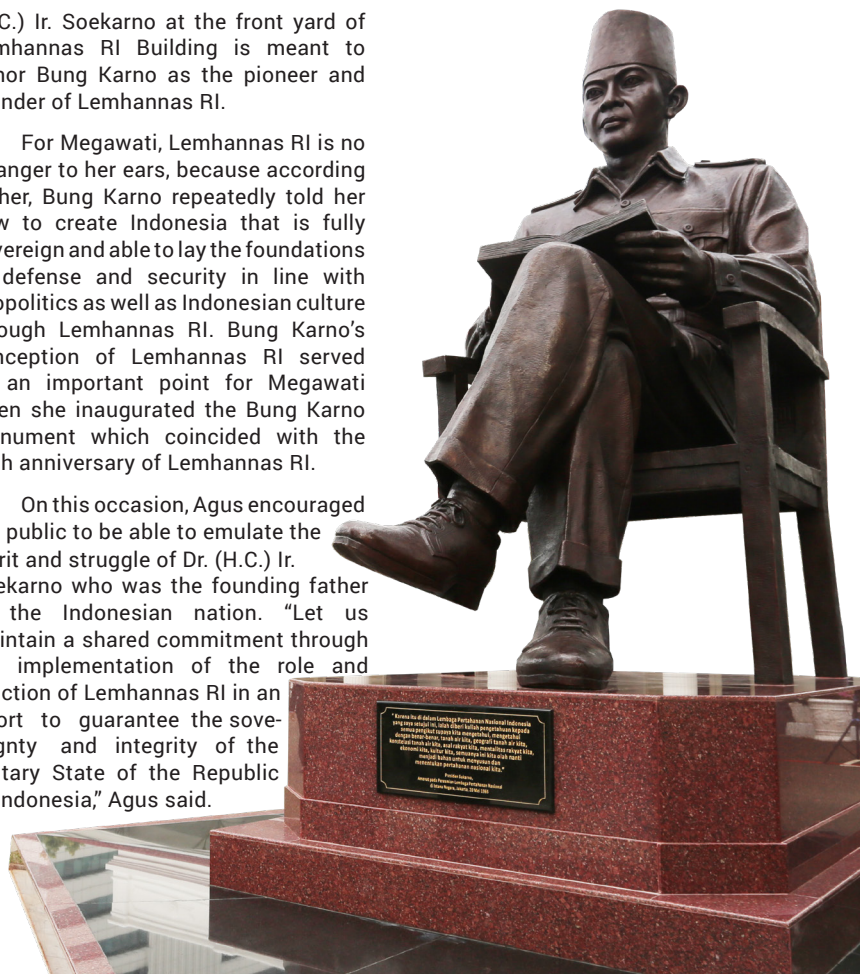
