



LEMHANNAS RI'S CONSULTATIVE MEETING WITH RI VICE PRESIDENT

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A., accompanied by Lemhannas RI's officials, had a consultative meeting with the Vice President Prof. Dr. Boediono, M.Ec. in the context of "Lemhannas RI towards a World-Class Institute" on Tuesday, (3/1/2012).

The Vice President was accompanied by the Minister of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform Azwar Abubakar, Secretary of the Vice President Mohamad Oemar, Deputy Secretary for Political Affairs to the Vice President Dewi Fortuna Anwar and expert staff member for the vice president Sofyan Djalil.

On the occasion, the governor gave a presentation on the problems faced by Lemhannas RI and its future Strategic Plan (Renstra). "The today's meeting is very important for us, as it will give us an idea of the things that we need to carry out", said the governor in the meeting room of the vice president in Jakarta.

He gave a presentation regarding various efforts and action plans that were, are and will be conducted by Lemhannas RI to become an education and research institution with world-class quality, efficiency and effectiveness as well as inward-looking and outward-looking characters.

The consultative meeting was a response to the desire expressed by the President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono at the inauguration of the Governor of Lemhannas RI on 17 February 2011, and during an audience between the Governor and the President on 5 August 2011, that Lemhannas RI should become a world-class institution.

The meeting was also a response to the direction and expectation conveyed by the Vice President during the briefing of the PPRA XLVI participants at the Vice Presidential Palace on 17 November 2011.

The vice president expected that Lemhannas RI should examine the development of the strategic environments at home and abroad that could affect the national life, such as the issues of globalization, democracy, nationalism and leadership.

The Minister of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform also gave his views on the concept and position of Lemhannas RI in the context of bureaucratic reform. *(continued on page 2...)*

The Vice President asserted that Lemhannas RI has a very strategic role in the management of the state. Therefore, bureaucratic improvement is a very important thing to do in restructuring the organizational system.

In his opinion, the roles of Lemhannas RI should be clearly positioned as the current conditions have changed contextually in terms of global and domestic politics. Hence, an appropriate design for the future needs to be formulated.

Before closing the meeting, the Vice President gave some important points of emphasis, which are, **first**, the need to formulate a clearer and more strategic roles, functions and position of Lemhannas RI, as Lemhannas is expected to be a part of the action plan; **second**, Lemhannas RI should be an exemplary institution for its graduates who are national leader cadres; **third**, the need to improve the quality and structuring of human resources and the recruit of *faculty* and participants of Lemhannas RI.

On December 22, 2011 at 11:00 A.M. the Governor of Lemhannas RI, who was accompanied by the Head of Public Relations Bureau and the Head of Cooperation Bureau of the Principal Secretary's Office of Lemhannas RI, received a Courtesy Call of the Republic of Fiji Islands Ambassador to Indonesia H.E. S. T. Cavuilati, with the purpose to nominate a Fiji participant for the coming PPRA educational course.

On the occasion, the ambassador, who was accompanied by the embassy's Second Secretary Pauliasi Tokasaya, in the governor's guest-room expressed his gratitude to the governor for the invitation to attend the national seminar held by Lemhannas RI on 13 December 2011 and the closing ceremony of the PPRA XLVI which took place on December 16, 2011. The ambassador also expressed the purpose of his visit, which was to propose, again, a participant for the next PPRA educational course from his country. Previously, a Fiji's Police Commissioner Sakeasi Tamani has completed his PPRA XLVI educational course in Lemhannas RI.

Fiji is a small archipelagic country. Like Indonesia, it is also multi-ethnic and multi-religious. The courtesy call was expected to bring the relationship between Indonesia and the Republic of Fiji Islands closer. The courtesy call ended at 11:30 P.M. with a joint photo session of the governor and the ambassador.

The purpose of the courtesy call was for the Ambassador to formally introduce himself to the governor and conveyed an invitation to the latter to be a speaker on the campus of the Algerian War Staff College in March 2012.

The governor on the occasion was accompanied by the Head of Public Relations Bureau and Head of Cooperation Bureau, while the Ambassador by the Director of the War Staff College Major General Khaloui Nouredine.

For the PPRA XLVIII educational course that will be started in March 2012, Algeria has sent two participants who

currently follow the Language Education and Training at the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Indonesia.

Apart from explaining the history of Lemhannas RI, the governor also gave information on the Peacekeeping Center in Sentul, Bogor, as one of the places that the ambassador may want to visit with the facilitation of Lemhannas RI.

On the occasion, the ambassador conveyed that Algeria would like to learn from Indonesia's experiences in terms of peacekeeping.

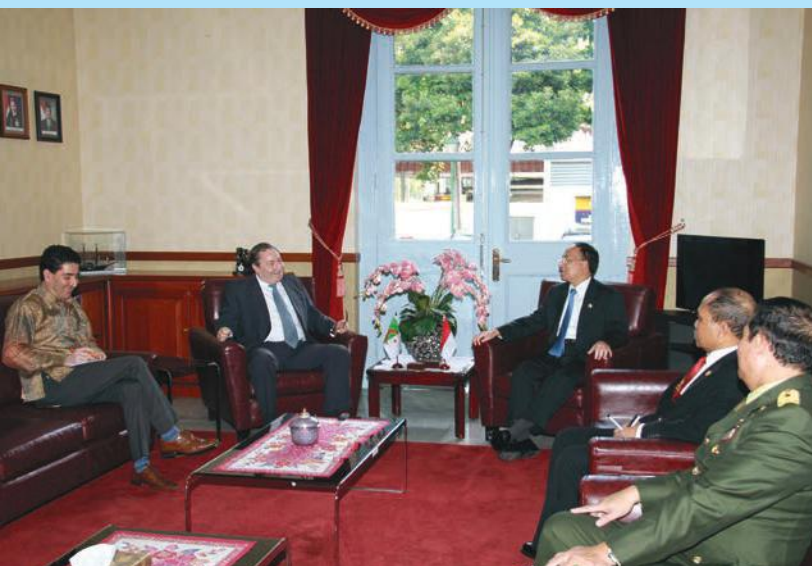
The historical relationship between Indonesia and Algeria has been initiated since the days of the struggle of the Algerian people. The Algerian people seized the independence from the French colonials (1954-1962).

When Indonesia served as the host and chairman of the Asian-African Conference in Bandung in 1955, it invited the representatives of the Algerian

National Liberation Front to attend the conference as observers.

Both parties expected that a closer cooperation can be enhanced between Indonesia and Algeria, not only limited to the education in Lemhannas, but also in various sectors.

The courtesy call was concluded at 9:30 pm with an exchange of souvenirs.

Lemhannas RI, this year, will carry out and manage educational programs for three batches at the same time, which are PPSAXVIII, PPRA XLVII and PPRA XLVIII. Consequently, the duties to be faced by Lemhannas RI will be heavier.

In his speech, the governor expected that the participants of the consolidation would anticipate such challenges and improve the quality of the education and analysis output of Lemhannas RI.

Apart from requiring the participants of the consolidation to understand the mechanisms and technical guidelines of the educational course, the governor

also expected them to also continuously improve their professional competence according to their fields and professional responsibility.

“The participants of the consolidation activities have a central and dominant role for the successful implementation of the educational course,” said the governor.

“Expert staff members and resource persons are the reflection of educational quality that will be produced by the Lemhannas RI”, added the governor.

The Team of State Audit Board (BPK RI) which will audit the 2011 financial statements of Lemhannas RI as mandated by the 1945 Constitution Article 23 E, to investigate the management and accountability of state finances in order to promote transparency and accountability.

The BPK RI audit will be conducted for 35 working days starting from Tuesday, 17 January 2012.

It was also attended by the Principal Secretary, Deputy for the Education of National-level Leaders, Deputy the Strengthening of National Values, Vice Person-in-Charge of the BPK team Drs. Tangga M. Purba, M.M., Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI and the Audit Team members of BPK RI.

In order to facilitate the auditing, the Governor of Lemhannas RI in his speech read by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI, hoped that all the leaders in the work units within Lemhannas RI, as the objects of auditing, would help BPK team through a good cooperation.

“During the auditing process by the BPK team, of course there would be a dynamic interaction between the BPK auditing team and Lemhannas’ work units, as the objects of auditing.

Therefore, I expect a good cooperation and coordination for establishing a harmonious working relationship, while maintaining and promoting the independence of the audit board, “ said the governor in a speech read by the deputy governor.

Such an emphasis was given so that the accountability of state finance management, as one of the good governance elements, can be realized and Lemhannas can have an equal position with similar institutions at the international level.
