Mother's Day, A Momentum to Strengthen Women's Role in Development

Tuesday (22/12), "It was right on December 22nd when the Indonesian women seized the historical moment for their awakening. And the Mother's Day, which is held annually, is intended to commemorate and appreciate the remarkable contribution of women to the national independence through their struggle alongside men", said the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA during a Mother's Day ceremony at Central Courtyard of Lemhannas RI.

The theme raised for the 87th celebration of the Indonesian Mother's Day was "Promoting Equality between Women and Men in Order to Create a Conducive Environment for Women and Children". The theme tried to portray the Indonesia's current situation and condition and adjust them to the direction of national development as stated in the National Medium Term Development Plan (RPJMN) 2015-2019. Doing so would help the government to achieve its nine priorities (Nawacita) as one of national agenda.

The Mother Day's celebration actually provides the young generation with an opportunity to revive the noble values and the spirit of struggle that they had inherited from the founding fathers and the women freedom fighters, which would eventually allow them to contribute to the national development with the spirit of unity and mutual cooperation.

On the other hand, the roles of men and families in the national development also need to be continually "campaigned" for and turned into a massive and ongoing movement in order to eliminate all forms of violence and discrimination against women and children. The facts show that various forms of violence and social problems that occur within society nowadays, such as violence, sexual abuse, trafficking, pornography, sexually contagious infections, HIV/AIDS, drugs, crimes and many others occur due to the collapse in family resilience.

Therefore, the family resilience (through the inculcation of moral values, faith and devotion) serves as one of the pillars in addressing and overcoming those problems.

The Mother's Day celebration also serves as a momentum for all elements of the society to do some reflection, introspection and contemplation by providing a platform for women to play their roles and become agents of change in the process of development.

Moreover, he conveyed that the program should not be viewed as a mere routine activity, but a means to improve the work performance from year to year.

Later on, Deputy for the Strengthening of National Values Rear Admiral Ir. Yuhastihar conveyed that the program would last for two days from 14 to 15 January 2016.

The topics being addressed at the event included the introduction to the Consolidation Program, internal evaluation of the national values strengthening program in 2015 and its impacts, evaluation of the dissemination of the 2016 work programs that would be carried out by the Deputy Office for the Strengthening of National Values as well as the assistance program for participants and facilitators.

All of the feedbacks and suggestions generated during the event will be used to further improve the 2016 work programs.

On the opportunity, Head of Regional Office of the Directorate General of Treasury from the Ministry of Finance Dra. Rina Robiati

conveyed that some strategies were required to measure the implementation of budget utilization by, among others, identifying the activities (either carried out independently or on a contract basis), inputting data to the State Treasury Service Office (KPPN), identifying the quality of human resources, submitting payment orders and conducting monitoring and evaluation.

Meanwhile, Inspector from the Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucratic Reform Devi Ananta stated that the purposes of the performance accountability report was to demonstrate the achievements of targets as established in the performance agreement. It is important in the effort to achieve institution’s accountability due to the state funds that have been used.

The workshop also featured other speakers, including Head of Asset Recovery Center of the Directorate General of Treasury from the Ministry of Finance Wahyu Prihantoro, S.E., M.P, and auditor from the Ministry of State Apparatus and Bureaucratic Reform Ministry Bagus Sundjoyo. Then event was then concluded with a question and answer session and a group photo session.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA in Communication Forum of Lemhannas RI Leaders with the Editors-in-Chief of Mass Media at the Pavilion of Trigatra Building, 3rd Floor, Wednesday (27/1) elaborated on the duties of national press in the perspective of national resilience in the context of Scenario 2045

He explained Further that the press had always been an integral part of the nation and played an important role in maintaining national resilience so it would be needed to spread the concept of nationalism, including The Scenario 2045 created by Lemhannas RI.

The Chairman of Chief Editors Forum Suryo Pratomo expressed the commitment of the Forum that it would seek to establish a common understanding with Lemhannas RI with regard to building nationalism, creating national awareness and generating national leaders in order to contribute to the

advancement of the nation.

“The strong philosophy to bring Indonesia forward is in line with the ideals set forth in the 1945 Constitution. And this could only be achieved by generating capable national leaders”, said Suryo Pratomo.

During the discussion, Putra Nababan put forth that instead of debating on the contents of the scenario, it would be better to address the ways to deliver the contents. As a government think-tank, Lemhannas RI needed to ensure that such a scenario would be easily understood by the users and that it could be conveyed to the Generation Z.

The scenario in 2045 was created by Lemhannas RI to see the picture of the future of Indonesia, 100 years after Indonesia’s independence. At this time, connectivity among humans is very solid. The results of this scenario is not a statistic prediction, but a consensus of important resource person told with qualitative style.

Laboratory of National Resilience Measurement Discuss National Resilience Index 2015

Wednesday (28/1), Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA conveyed in his speech at the Gatot Kaca Room, 3rd Floor, Astagatra Building, that in an effort to position Lemhannas RI as a world class institution, the institute had been committed to constantly improving itself, including the improvement of Laboratory of National Resilience Measurement / Labkurtannas.

In that regard, Labkurtannas, as one of Lemhannas RI's facilitating units, plays a major role in developing a system for national resilience measurement in the regions and public policy simulations as well as in producing a portrait of national resilience in the regions by identifying all of the contributing factors.

Based on the Labkurtannas findings, the national resilience index for the year 2015 in the aspects of geography, ideology, politics, and economy has decreased compared to that of 2014.

Meanwhile, the socio-cultural aspect was also found to be less resilient and has the lowest resilience index compared to the rest of

the aspects.

Furthermore, the decrease in national resilience and the unresolved national problems certainly have the potential to undermine public trust in the government despite of various efforts made by the government to remedy the situation.

The resource persons at the event included Representative of the Central Statistics Agency (BPS) Dr. K. Suhariyanto, Director of the Institute for Development of Economic and Finance (INDEF) Dr. Enny Sri Hartati, Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M., Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Commissioner General of Police Drs. Suhardi Alius, MH.

While the responders at the event included Deputy for the Education of National-Level Leaders Major General Nasir Majid, Deputy for Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Djagal Wiseso Marseno, M.Agr, and Deputy for the Strengthening of National Values Rear Admiral Ir. Yuhastihar.
