Lemhannas RI Signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Ombudsman RI and ADEKSI



Lemhannas RI signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Ombudsman RI and ADEKSI to build a cooperation in Nusantara Lobby, Trigatra Building 1st Floor, Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (7/9). The MoU was signed by Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo, Head of Ombudsman RI Prof. Amzulian Rifai, S.H., LL.M., Ph.D, and Chairman of ADEKSI Ir. H. Amruji, M.H.

Agus Widjojo said in his remark that this MoU represented a joint effort among three institutions to strengthen synergies. "This Memorandum of Understanding is our joint efforts to strengthen synergies of work programs among three institutions in order to encourage the realization of a strong national resilience," said Agus Widjojo.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) among Lemhannas RI, Ombudsman RI, and ADEKSI included improving the quality of human resources through education and training, experts exchange, and strengthening program of national values, information exchange and technology support in the context of measurement of national resilience, the assessment implementation, and other fields in accordance with the provisions which have been agreed.

This MoU, continued Agus Widjojo, will be followed up with real programs and concrete events related to the scope of the cooperation. For Lemhannas RI, this cooperation can enhance the role of Lemhannas RI in disseminating and strengthening national insight to all components of the nation, including Ombudsman RI and ADEKSI.

The event which closed with a group photo session and luncheon was also attended by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M., Principal Secretary Inspector General of Police Drs. Arif Wachyunadi, Deputies, Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI and the invited guests of Ombudsman RI and ADEKSI.



Refinement and Analysis RTD of Strategic Issues on National Resilience

Lemhannas RI held Roundtable Discussion (RTD) on Refinement and Analysis of Strategic Issues which led by Deputy of Strategic Studies Prof. Djagal Wiseso Marseno, M. Agr. in Kresna Room, Astagatra Building 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI on Thursday (8/9).

The RTD was begun with the presentation of national resilience measurement result by Prof. Miyasto. He explained briefly that during 2010 to 2015, the result of the national resistance index tends to increase, but it decreased in 2015. The decrease was found in economics, politics and geographic aspects. The fall of those aspects raised some similar issues in society from year to year such as the quality human resource, poverty, unemployment, inequality, regional infrastructure, environment, capacity and quality of natural resource as well as food, energy, and water security.

Governor of Lemhannas RI in his remark read by Prof. Dr. Djagal Wiseso Marseno, M. Agr. said the same thing concerning some problems that should be sharpened like economic growth, poverty, unemployment, sovereignty of natural resource management, import of raw material, and also 12 unimplemented economic policy packages.

The strategic issues are agreed by the speakers; Expert Staff

of Population Affairs of Coordinating Ministry of Human Development and Culture Dr. Harri Sonny B. Harmadi, Deputy of Balance and Statistical Analysis of BPS RI Dr. K. Suhariyanto, Secretary of Dir. Gen. Regional Financial Management of Ministry of Home Affairs Drs. Indra Baskoro, M. Si and INDEF Director Dr. Enny Sri Hartati.

The main issue facing this nation is a matter of economics. Economic problems causes other problems especially in health and education sectors. It is indicated by the number of people who only get educated up to primary school so it makes them difficult to get a job which lead to unemployment. In addition, the economic problem also signed by Indonesia dependency in food, water, and energy sovereignty by importing raw materials such as rice and corn. Furthermore, there are also income inequality and improper development.

Besides discussing several issues related to economic sectors, it was also discussed about National Mid-Term Development (RPJMN) and fiscal policy. Those issues will be discussed deeper to provide some inputs to The President.

RTD moderated by Prof. Dr. Sudarsono, S.U. was attended by Deputy of Strengthening of National Values Rear Admiral Ir. Yuhastihar, Deputy of National Level Leader Rear Admiral Dedy Yulianto, Faculty Members, and Structural Official of Lemhannas RI.

One of the agenda in Cambodia was meeting with Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the Kingdom of Cambodia, Mr. Pitono Purnomo, and all ranks of the Indonesian Embassy in Phnom Penh on Tuesday, September 20th, 2016 at Wisma Indonesia.

On the occasion, Ambassador of The Republic of Indonesia

to the Kingdom of Cambodia presented the development of political, economic, social, cultural, and defense and security in the Kingdom of Cambodia and its influence on Indonesia in particular and within the framework of ASEAN cooperation in general. The event ended with discussion and questions and answers between participants SSLN with the whole range of the Embassy.

On the same day, all participants SSLN in the Kingdom of Cambodia also held a meeting with officials of the Defense Ministry of the Kingdom of Cambodia, which was welcomed by the Director General of Political and International Cooperation. The discussion focused on the process of reconciliation after the civil war and the development of defense and security in the Kingdom of Cambodia today as well as some prospects to increase cooperation between Indonesia and the Kingdom of Cambodia, particularly in defense and security.

On the occasion, Director General of Political and International Cooperation of Royal Cambodian Defense Ministry stated that the significance of Indonesia's role are both in the process of reconciliation in Cambodia through peace in Paris and also Indonesia's help in improving the professionalism of the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces through training by Indonesian military, including sending 2 officers of Royal Cambodian Armed Forces to join the education at Lemhannas RI. As in Indonesian Embassy, the event in Ministry of Defence of the Kingdom of Cambodia also concluded with a discussion and question and answer session followed with great enthusiasm by all SSLN participants.

The establishment of international economic institutions also change the face of developed countries in Asia, South America, and East Europe. To deal with those developments, Gita Wirjawan hoped that Indonesian Leader can pay more attention on national economic challenges ahead in the middle of economic global. “The purpose (of paying attention to national economic challenges) is to increase national economic with export, import, production, consumption, and government spending. Need to be paid more attention (by Indonesian

leaders) is the efforts to create continous middle class, as happened in Singapore and The United States, which provides opportunites for the middle class to own property such as subsidized apartments or houses;” said Gita Wirjawan.

In line with the fact, Governor of Lemhannas RI in his closing speech said that Indonesian people in the future face challenge to develop Indonesia into democratic, dignified, prosperous and equitable country. “The challenge is not only coming from the external factor, the biggest challenge comes from the internal scope of Indonesia. As stated by Bung Karno, the First President of the Republic of Indonesia ‘My Struggle is easier because I fight againts invaders, but your struggle will be more difficult because it goes against your own people;” said the Governor of Lemhannas RI.

The main purposes of the workshop are, first, to review Lemhannas RI's findings on the portrait of provincial national resilience and strategic issues of each province in the last year; second, to collect some informations from those provinces, especially policy data and to analyze synergies between the policies of the central government and local governments; and thirdly is to explore regional issues which will be discussed through focus group discussion (FGD) between

Lemhannas RI's teams with the provincial government.
