

At the event moderated by Analyst in Socio-culture of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Sudaryono, S.U., it was conveyed that the strengthening of women's quality had become a basis of the sustainable development.

In his presentation, an Economic Expert of the Presidential Advisory Board Prof. Dr. Sri Adiningsih stressed the importance of strengthening women's potentials in the national development through the implementation of Medium-term Development Plan, which includes the strengthening of women's roles and equality in various strategic positions, payroll system, and provision of facilities to support women's active engagement in economy.

"The social portraits of women being left behind and the poor quality of their living conditions are big issues that need to

be addressed.

Bernard Hasibuan, MMSI., Ph.D, Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Vice Admiral Dr. Didit Herdiawan, M.P.A., M.B.A., Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Police Commissioner General Drs. Suhardi Alius, M.H., and the structural officials of Lemhannas RI.

The first session of the event featured several speakers, namely Deputy for Maritime and Natural Resources Dr. Ir. R. Endah Murningtyas, M.Sc., Head of Food Security Dr. Ir. Gardjito Budi, M. Agr. S.T., member of Commission IV of the House of Representatives Dr. Andi Akmal Palsudin, Governor of West Java Dr. H. “The Law No. 18 of 2012 in lieu of the Law No. 7 of 1996 is expected to serve as guidance which would solve the problems that exist in the food sector, said the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A.

The theme on the food sovereignty was raised in commemoration of the World Food Day. The outcome of the seminar will later be developed into policy strategies and communication models for further study.

According to Andi Akmal Palsudin, national resilience could be achieved through revitalization programs, such as food self-sufficiency, diversification, value-added exports, and improvement in farmers’ welfare. Agricultural sector has been known for its labor-intensive process and foreign exchange generation. It also helped offset inflation and drive economic growth.

Meanwhile, Ahmad Heryawan conveyed that in order to maintain food security, there were some crucial issues that need to be paid attention to, such as distribution of, and access to food.



# Organizing Committee of Administration Selection for PPRA LIV 2016 Holds Meeting



**L**emhannas RI held a committee meeting on administration selection requirements for the candidates of PPRA LIV on Thursday (15/10), in Krishna Room, Astagatra Building, 4th Floor. The meeting was attended by the Deputy for the Education of National-level Leaders who served as the Chairman of Administration Selection for PPRA LIV Year 2016 Maj. Gen. M. Nasir Majid, Director of Educational Program, Bureau Chiefs and other meeting participants.

Based on the Regulation of the Governor of Lemhannas RI No. 13 of 2013, the organizing committee is tasked with carrying out administrative selection of the PPRA candidates already registered, conducting criminal background checks of each candidate, carrying out medical check-up examinations for each candidates, and submitting the results of the administration selection, medical check-ups and academic potential tests as well as psychological tests in the final evaluation session.

“The candidates who meet the requirements will proceed to the next stage of selection, which is academic potential tests and psychological test that will be held from November 9 to 10, 2015. The result of which will become the basis in determining the final results that will be held on January 26, 2016”, said Principal Secretary of Lemhannas RI Drs. Suhardi Alius, M.H. when opening the Administration Selection meeting.

On the opportunity, the person-in-charge of the Administration Selection for PPRA LIV Chief of Cooperation Bureau of Lemhannas RI stated that the allocation for PPRA LIV for the year 2016 was 100 participants. To this day, 122 candidates have already been registered for the program, including from ministries/agencies, political parties, civil society organizations, and community leaders, consisting of 108 male candidates and 14 female candidates. The result of the administration selection will be conveyed in the next meeting as a recommendation.

# Deputy for Strategic Study of Lemhannas RI: SMEs are “Hero” for Indonesia’s Economy

**P**rof. Dr. Ir. Djagal Wiseso Marseno, M. Agr opened a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) themed the Strengthening of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs) to Boost Economic Independence for National Resilience.

The event held on Monday (19/10) at Gatot Kaca Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of Asta Gatra Building was led by Middle-Senior Analyst on National Ideology of Lemhannas RI Commodore Rosehan Chaidir.

“The SMEs play a significant role in Indonesia’s economy. Looking back at the monetary crisis in 1997-1998, it is evident that this sector was a ‘hero’ for the people. Amidst the 1998 crisis, it was only the SMEs which could survive and strive while the large scale enterprises collapsed.

However, unfortunately, the SMEs still face a lot of difficulties and challenges to develop in the national economy”, said Djagal.

While the number of SMEs continues to increase every year, the quality of SMEs has yet to be improved due to its internal and external problems.

The internal problems ranged from low quality of human resources, poor technology adaptation and lack of marketing strategies, lack of entrepreneurship spirit, limited access to capitals, information, and markets, low productivity, and other production issues.

While the external problems being faced by SMEs include huge production costs due to unfavorable business climate, scarcity of raw materials, legality issues and lack of government supports.

Thus, SMEs need to strengthen infrastructure, to develop skill, capability, technology, and to link with state-owned enterprises or large scale enterprises as well as to have access to market information in order to achieve economic independence.

The SMEs have a great potential to increase per capita income, provide job opportunities, drive rural development, reduce imports and save the economy in times of crisis. It also helps develop entrepreneurship and investment in production.

The Focus Group Discussion featured several speakers, namely Director General of Domestic Trades from the Ministry of Trades Srie Agustina, S.E., M.E., Head of SMEs Study Center from Trisakti University and SMEs and industrial economics expert from the Trisakti University Dr.

The event was moderated by PPRA LIII participant Arhanud Hasanudin Colonel and NET TV news anchor Zivanna Letisha was conducting this event.

The national seminar was the peak of the education program of PPRA LIII, which was held as a forum to share knowledge, and also served as a discourse to formulate strategic concepts for national interests. The theme raised was related with President Joko Widodo’s vision and mission to develop Indonesia into a global maritime axis. A comprehensive national security system is very important for the country to secure its natural resources and establish itself

The participants of the Short Education Program (PPSA) XX held a national seminar with the theme “Developing Indonesia into a Global Maritime Axis to Improve People’s Welfare for National Resilience”, aboard KRI Banda Aceh warship while coursing the Jakarta Bay and Thousand Islands Sea on Thursday (22/10).

The national seminar, chaired by Vice Admiral Aan Kurnia, S.Sos., who currently served as Naval Transport Command C-in-C, was one of the main activities in the education program.

The KRI Banda Aceh warship, which is of landing platform/dock type, is 125 meters in length and 22 meters in width with maximum speed of 14 knots. The warship was built by Indonesia.

“Choosing the KRI Banda Aceh warship as the venue for seminar is a smart move as we built it ourselves. The spirit in

building the ship should motivate the seminar participants to generate strategic ideas regarding maritime axis”, said Budi Susilo Soepandji.

The seminar has strategic importance for the participants to elaborate their experiences during the program through the preparation of seminar paper. “We must be aware that the development of maritime axis is the main theme of the national development,” said Budi Susilo Soepandji.
