Vice President Jusuf Kalla Gives Lecture to PPRA LVII and LVIII Participants



Located in Vice President Palace in Medan Merdeka Selatan, Central Jakarta, Vice President H.M. Jusuf Kalla gave lecture to PPRA (Regular Education Program) LVII and LVIII participants of Lemhannas RI on Monday (25/6).

The lecture which was opened by a report from Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo was also attended by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito. S.E., M.M., several Structural Officials, and Faculty Members of Lemhannas RI.

In his report to Jusuf Kalla, Agus Widjojo conveyed that in 2018, Lemhannas RI held two Regular Education Program, batch LVII and LVIII. A hundred participants of the PPRA LVII consist of 58 participants from Military and Police, 35 participants from Government Institutions, Ministries, Attorney General, and political party and 7 participants from friendly countries. Meanwhile 100 participants of PPRA LVIII consist of 50 participants from Military / Police, 34 participants from Government Institutions, Ministries, Attorney General, and political party, and 6 participants from friendly countries.

Then in his lecture, Jusuf Kalla delivered material on "Democracy, Regional, and General Elections". According to him, the development

of elections in Indonesia has experienced various dynamics such as liberal, parliamentary, and then returned to the system of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia.

With the Decree of June 1959, Indonesia returned to the presidential system. Then, after the G30S movement, Indonesia returned to the parliamentary system. In the end, the democracy that developed during the New Order period which leading to authoritarianism ended in 1998," Jusuf Kalla explained.

"In Indonesia, democratic parties are a way, not a goal. Unlike the United States which makes the democracy party as a goal, for victory, democracy in Indonesia is a way to achieve prosperity," Jusuf Kalla added.

Related to the implementation of General Election in 2018, Jusuf Kalla believes Pilkada will run well and safely. According to Jusuf Kalla who witnessed the previous election 11 safe, there are five reasons to ensure that elections can run well and safely.


First, there is no national coalition. The whole party is now mixed up, there is no national axis. Second, strict KPU rules. Third, the guarantee of national security. Fourth, a lot of information already spread in social media and internet. Fifth, the existence of nationalist party. Currently there is no truly religious party, or a truly nationalist one. We can easily find a nationalist religious party, or a religious nationalist party,"he concluded.

The Courtesy Call was welcomed directly by the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Bagus Puruhito, S.E., M.M. who was accompanied by Director of Political Studies Drs. Berlian Helmy, M. Ec., Head of Bima Laksma Cooperation Budi Setiawan, S.T., Chief of Public Relations Bureau Brigadier General Mindarto, and Head of International Cooperation Division Col. Lek Rujito D. Asmoro, Gdipl In DS., M.A., RCDS.

In the Courtesy Call, Sun Weide briefly mentioned the visit of Lemhannas RI Governor to China in May 2018. Sun Weide revealed that China and Indonesia’s relationship has been growing rapidly and mutually beneficial marked by China’s role as the third largest investor

in Indonesia and there are more than two million Chinese tourists visiting Indonesia.

Meanwhile, Bagus Puruhito, related to China and Indonesia, talked about Lemhannas’ plan of organizing the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum and Presidential Lecture in October 2018. Related to Presidential Lecture, Bagus said that Lemhannas RI will invite Prime Minister of China, Australia and Singapore at the event.

Sun Weide asked Lemhannas RI to send an official letter to the Chinese Government. In addition, Sun Weide responding enthusiastically and hoped to be able to send representatives of speakers from China in the forum as in the Jakarta Geopolitical Forum 2017.

The hearings were also discussed about the IMF-WB Annual Meeting to be held in October 2018 as well as several matters relating to cooperation between the two countries, China and Indonesia.

Strengthening of Indonesian leader capacity, Theory U : Innovation for Better Indonesia

Continuing the series of Making Indonesia 4.0, Kemenko Maritim RI (Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs), Kemristekdikti RI (Ministry of Research, Technology, and Higher Education), and Lemhannas RI organized the Capacity Building Program of Indonesia Leaders which presented the Inventor of Theory U, Otto Scharmer on Thursday (5/7) at Bidakara Hotel, Jakarta.

Minister of Research, Technology, and Higher Education, Moh. Nasir as Chief of the Program said, “If we look at the 4.0 era, 70 percent of the work will be in science, math, internet of things, etc. In this case, we have to learn throughout our lifetime”. Therefore, according to Moh. Nasir, this program is very important to improve Indonesia’s competitiveness in the future.

While the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo, in the press conference, stated that if Making Indonesia 4.0 fails to be implemented properly, it will affect national resilience. Economic development may decrease because of the decrease in human resources competitiveness. “Leadership is the key, in the context of the system, we have to concern more on cooperation rather than individual work,” he said.

In addition Agus Widjojo also states, individual awareness of time change trigger the technological revolution to increasingly move fast. According to him, there is no other choice, humans have to start adapting to technology.

While the Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo said that the program talked about leadership, system and emphasis

on cooperation. “We have to change our mindset to face the mental revolution. The participants from all unlimited components from universities, ministries and non-ministries,” he said.

This program is organized to form the mindset by providing an understanding of the Theory U which explained how to do a form of change in the world. Prof. Otto Scharmer, a senior lecturer at MIT, provides material on the Iceberg Model.

From The Iceberg Model, it can be seen that 10 percent of reality is above water, but 90 percent of reality is under the sea, which is invisible to the eye. To move from the top to the bottom is a pattern of thinking, what you know is the same issue,” Otto Scharmer said. Scharmer divides the Iceberg Model into the sociological divide, the structure divide, and the spiritual divide.

On the same occasion, Otto Scharmer also said that in facing problems, a community can do two types of response. “Indeed many of us feel that we are not part of choices and solutions which is not true. When there is a disruption, there are two steps we can take, the first is a turning backward or avoiding a problem, and the second is learning forwards or learning to move forward,” Scharmer said.

Soenarso, other invited guests.

The workshop held by Secretariat General of National Defense Council on Wednesday (11/7) at Hotel JS Luwansa in H. R. Rasuna Said Kuningan Road, South Jakarta, also invited other speakers, namely Members of Watimpres (Presidential Advisory Board) General (Ret) Agum Gumelar, Mayor of Ambon Richard Louhenapessy, and Professor of Pattimura University, Ambon Dr. Ir. Alex S. W. Retraubun, M.Sc.

According to Agus Widjojo, the local context can have positive implications for complex society which consist of different ethnicity, religion and race such as peaceful coexistence done in pela gandong custom. Agus said that when he visited Maluku, the people of Maluku had long been taught by their ancestors to live peacefully. Peace in Ambon was not only due to the policies of the central government, but precisely because of the active involvement of local community leaders and religious leaders in Maluku.

In addition, Agus Widjojo also reminded the importance of the archipelago insight for every policy maker at the central and regional levels. A policy should balance the aspects of racial intolerance, in a population of one area which will increase vulnerability to conflict. The policy that reinforces Archipelago Insight is called as a national resilience.

Located at Novotel Hotel, Pangkalpinang, Deputy for Strengthening Program of National Values of Lemhannas RI represented by Brigadier General of Police Drs. Rafli, S.H. on Thursday (12/7) held an Evaluation program on the Alumni of Strengthening Program of National Values in Pangkalpinang, Bangka Belitung Islands Province in 2017.

In his remarks, Deputy for Strengthening Program of National Values hopes that this Evaluation process can optimize the contribution of its Alumni, especially as agents of change to disseminate national values in their respective environments.

While the Head of the National Police Agency for Bangka Belitung Islands Province Drs. H. Lemhannas RI achieves Esri Special Achievement in GIS (SAG) Award



Lemhannas RI and PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia Tbk (Telkom), were awarded the Esri Special Achievement in GIS (SAG) Award. This award is given to agencies that have used the Geographic Information System (GIS) technology creatively in order to improve the quality of the community.

Head of the Lemhannas RI Laboratory Center, Air Vice Marshal Ade Dian Suryacandra, said that with GIS technology, Lemhannas developed the National Resilience Measurement System or Siskurtannas. The system significantly improves the country's level of resilience at regional and national levels, by helping to provide a deeper understanding of potential threats.

"This system demonstrates how extraordinary the integral role that GIS technology plays in helping us to make decisions based on accurate information that bring widespread impact to national resilience initiatives," he said.

Jack Dangermond, Founder and President of Esri, a giant global mapping company, threw his praises to Telkom and Lemhannas at the world's largest geospatial event, 2018 Esri International User Conference, in San Diego, USA. These two organizations are considered successful in demonstrating a vision that produces real

forms of leadership that bring benefits to society.

CEO of ESRI Indonesia, Dr A Istamar, said the extraordinary achievements of these two organizations will inspire many people around the world and spur them to utilize GIS technology in order to strengthen their operational activities.

According to Istamar, Lemhannas RI has used a dynamic predictive model by utilizing big data from all over Indonesia which is developed spatially. This innovation helps decision makers develop and simulate the impact that can arise using the if / then scenario.
