The President of the Republic of Indonesia Dr. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono inaugurated on January 17, 2011 Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, D.E.A. as Governor of Lemhannas RI, replacing Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. The inauguration of the Governor of Lemhannas RI, which was carried out in conjunction with the inauguration and oath-taking ceremony of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and 10 members of the National Ombudsman’s Office at the State Palace.

Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA was inaugurated as the new governor to replace Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. who had served as the Governor of Lemhannas RI from 2005 to 2011. The appointment of the new governor was followed by a series of farewell and welcome event of governors and post handover ceremony of the chairman of Dharma Wanita that was held on February 21, 2011 in Trigatra Building Fl. III East, Lemhannas RI. The event was attended by Vice Governor Air Marshal Dr. Rio Mendung Thalieb Rio, Ph.D., Secretary of the Governing Board Dr. Ardi Partadinata, M.H., M.Sc., Acting Chief Secretary Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals, Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI, the family of Prof. Dr. Ir. Budi Susilo Soepandji, DEA and the representatives from Lemhannas RI’s members.

On January 19, 2011 Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Chairman of the Indonesian Young Entrepreneurs Association (HIPMI) Erwin Aksa on the Training and Education of National-Level Organization (Kortina) of HIPMI in Building II of the Vice Presidential Palace. The signing was held on the sidelines of the Plenary Board Session II of the Special National Conference of HIPMI. The event was officially opened by the Vice President Prof. Dr. Boediono.

Though it was still incidental, last year Lemhannas RI organized Training and Education for Cadres of National-Level Organization of HIPMI. Lemhannas RI and HIPMI have discussed carrying out the training and education continuously. The training and education of the Cadres of National-Level Organization (Kortina) were held by HIPMI as an effort to achieve organizational goals through a conscious and systematic process. It is expected that, through this training and education, young cadres and entrepreneurs who have an entrepreneurial spirit with a national viewpoint, and a tough, professional and competitive character in the

framework of national interests will be created.

With the signing of the MoU, HIPMI has a clear legal basis in the implementation of its Training and Education of Cadres of National-Level Organization (Kortina) which will run continuously in each management of HIPMI's Central Executive Board in the future. INITIAL BRIEFING OF BPK-RI AUDIT OF LEMHANNAS RI'S FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Pursuant to the coordination between Lemhannas RI and the Indonesia's Audit of Board BPK RI and related agencies in the Ministry of Finance, Lemhannas RI has sought to accelerate the preparation process of Financial Statements for 2010.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. expressed his hope to facilitate the inspection process during the Preliminary Briefing for BPK-RI audit of the Financial Statements of Lemhannas RI on January 26, 2011 at Nusantara I Meeting Room, Trigatra Building. The event was attended by

Secretary of the Governing Board Dr. Ardi Partadinata, M.H., M.Sc., Acting Chief Secretary of the Main Secretariat Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., Main State Auditor of BPK RI Gatot Supiartono, S.H., M. Acc., Ak., CFE along with audit team members of BPK RI and other invitees.

The governor also stressed that the entire leadership of the work unit at Lemhannas RI that will be the object of examination can assist with the implementation of audit by BPK RI through a good cooperation. Hopefully, with the provision of documents and information regarding budget execution and

accountability comprehensively, quickly and communicatively, the audit team can draw up conclusions and assessments objectively, so as to give a precise opinion of the management and accountability of state finances conducted by Lemhannas RI.

To realize accountable management of state finance, Lemhannas RI has made preventive efforts in the budget implementation. The efforts shall be incorporated into operational guidelines of the program and budgets, evaluation of activity implementation and budget through management meetings and monitoring which is conducted by the Chief Secretary and the implementation of internal supervision by the Inspectorate.

With the initial briefing, it is expected that there will be a cooperation between the audit team of BPKRI with each audited work unit of Lemhannas RI. Work dynamics based on a good cooperation and coordination will lead to harmonious working relationship without affecting the independence of the audit institution. Therefore, it is expected that a good accountability of state finance can be achieved as one of the elements in the implementation of good governance.

to the strategic development requirement, either at national, regional or international level. Thus, it is expected that Lemhannas RI will become the center of strategic studies which has the capability to assess various problems faced by the state and the nation. In addition, as the president's "think-tank" institution in the studies field, Lemhannas RI is required to have a quality study standard. Institutional strengthening, particularly in the study area, is a responsibility that should be attached to every Lemhannas RI member, especially expert analysts.

In his keynote speech, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed that Lemhannas RI has been trying to make improvements and innovation in completing a variety of tasks, especially in the field of studies by following and analyzing the strategic environment development so that it can contribute in the form of strategic study concepts. Therefore, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed his expectation to all expert analysts associated with studies field to always make self-assessment and do introspection based on objective parameters and performance indicators in accordance with the strategic environment that is very dynamic and complex.

FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION ON STRATEGIC STUDIES

Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI on Wednesday, February 2, 2011 held a Focus Group Discussion on Strategic Studies on “Enhancing Synergy for Natural Disaster Prevention and Handling in Order to Prevent the Occurrence of Mass Casualties in the Framework of National Resilience”. The event was opened by Acting Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI, Inspector General of Police Drs. M. Rashid Ridho, S.H., M.H. in the Astagatra Building Fl. III. The event was attended by Director of Social Protection for Victims of Natural Disasters at the Ministry of Social Affairs Dr. Ir. Andi Zainal, MCM, M.Sc. and Sea and Coastal Areas Director at the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries Dr. Ir. Subandono Dipoastono, M.eng. and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI.

In his opening remarks, Acting Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI elaborated on the position of Indonesia which is situated on the equator and has a tropical climate and a relatively high level of rainfall. Its geological and topographic conditions have, geologically, various advantages and disadvantages. In addition, Indonesia is also a meeting area of Circum-Pacific Belt and Circum-Mediterranean Belt (ring of fire), so that at the level of the earth’s surface there are many volcanoes that are prone to trigger a natural

disaster.

In the process of natural disaster management, there are some strategic steps that can be taken to reduce the risk or the occurrence of mass casualties, which are prevention, emergency response and recovery. However, so far the preventive and recovery measures have not been optimally carried out and thus, the occurrence of losses due to disasters is still very high. The efforts made are hampered due to poor natural disaster management such as bureaucracy, coordination in the field and supporting facilities and infrastructure limitations.

Therefore, comprehensive and integrated (comprehensive-integral) studies are needed to explore the obstacles in the synergy implementation among stakeholders. In addition, solutions should also be sought in order to improve the synergy in the prevention and handling of natural disasters, either at pre-disaster, emergency response or post-disaster levels. In this way, mass casualties can be avoided. This is all done in the framework of national resilience, which is based on the arranging and managing of prosperity and security in a balanced, harmonious way and is in tune with all aspects of national life wholly, comprehensively and integratedly based on Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution and National Viewpoint.

MEETING ON FINAL-STAGE SELECTION OF PPRA XLVI CANDIDATES

On Monday, February 7, 2011, a meeting on the final-stage selection of the candidates of the Regular Education Program Batch XLVI (PPRA XLVI) 2011 of Lemhannas RI was held in Nusantara I Meeting Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The meeting was chaired by the Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. as the chairman of the final-stage selection committee. The meeting was also attended by Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Dr. Rio Mendung Thalieb, Secretary of Governing Board Dr. Ardi Partadinata, M.H., M.Sc., Acting Chief Secretary, Drs. Chandra Manan Mangan, M.Sc., Deputies of Lemhannas RI, and other structural officials of Lemhannas RI who are involved in the final-stage selection of PPRA XLVI candidates.

The PPRA XLVI in 2011, which will be opened on March 22, 2011 and closed on December 16, 2011 has a total of 100 participants. Based

on the outcome of the Administrative Selection Committee Meeting, the potential candidates for PPRA XLVI still totaled 127 people. The final-stage selection meeting was held to choose the participants according to the determined allocations with

the composition of 31 people from the Indonesian National Armed Forces (TNI), 20 people from the Indonesian National Police (POLRI), 4 people from Ministries, 1 person from State Institution, 13 people from abroad, 7 people from non-ministry government institutions, 1 person from SOEs, 2 people from regional governments, 1 person from State University, 2 persons from political organizations, 9 persons from mass organizations, 8 persons from Functional Organizations and 1 public figure.

The composition of PPRA XLVI participants are fairly evenly spread from various components of society, namely from suprastructure, infrastructure, substructure, political parties and universities. This will greatly benefit the education program participants as it will broaden their horizons and enable them to establish networking.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Muladi S.H. conveyed the 2010 Work Program and Budget of Lemhannas RI to the House of Representatives' Commission I in DPR RI building.

A hearing between Lemhannas RI and Commission I of the House of Representatives was held on February 8, 2011 in the DPR RI building. Governor of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Muladi, S.H. gave an explanation on the report of the implementation of the 2010 Work Program and Budget, and the 2011 Work Program as well as the follow-up of BPK RI's audit of the first semester of 2010.

In a written statement, Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed the following:

First, the evaluation of the 2010 work program of Lemhannas RI.

Second, the absorption of the 2010 budget of Lemhannas RI and follow-up on the results of BPK RI's audit of the 1st semester of 2010. The programs which have been implemented are as follows: good governance implementation program, state apparatus supervision and accountability improvement program, human resources management program, science and technology research and development program, national resilience development program.

As a follow-up of the BPK RI audit result in the first semester of 2010, Lemhannas RI regained an unqualified opinion. Thus, Lemhannas RI has received unqualified opinions for three consecutive years in 2007, 2008, and 2009.

Thirdly, the 2011 Work Program of Lemhannas RI. In 2011, Lemhannas RI has conducted a restructuring of the programs and activities that are now equipped with performance indicators and budget. Thus, they can be used as a benchmark to achieve an effective and efficient development goal by using the three programs, which are consisted of two generic programs – management support program and technical task implementation program – and apparatus supervision and accountability improvement program of Lemhannas RI, as well as one technical program, the national resilience development program.

CELEBRATION OF THE BIRTHDAY OF THE PROPHET MUHAMMAD SAW 1432 HIJRI

In order to commemorate the birthday of Prophet Muhammad SAW, Lemhannas RI held a commemoration of the birth anniversary of Prophet Muhammad SAW of 1432 Hijri (*maulid*) on February 16, 2011 in Trigatra Building Fl. III East. The commemoration, themed “Let Us Make the Commemoration of the Birthday of Prophet Muhammad SAW as a Momentum to Actualize Islamic Values comprehensively” had H.M. Subki Al-Bughury, S.Sos.I. as the preacher.

The commemoration of the *maulid* was attended by the Governor, Vice Governor, Secretary of the Governing Board, Acting Chief Secretary, Deputies, Expert Lecturers, Expert Analysts, Expert Professionals, and management of Dharma Wanita of Lemhannas RI. The event was preceded by the recitation of Quran verses by First Lieutenant Inf. Abdul Kahar and the recitation of the Indonesian translation by Fitria. At the event, the Governor conveyed that the commemoration of the *maulid* is a good momentum for everyone to explore the meaning of the Quran and to do self-introspection to know how far, we, as Muslims, have implemented, carried out and emulated the Sunnah practice of the Prophet Muhammad SAW in everyday life.

Further, preacher H.M. Subki Al-Bughury in his sermon talked about the life of the Apostles, Prophets, and companions who gave a good example in building relation with other human beings, or with God Almighty. Being committed to Islamic values means implementing the Quran and Sunnah practice of the Prophet Muhammad SAW in one’s everyday life, which is to sense the presence of Allah SWT in his/her heart, such as when in performing prayers, giving alms, and doing good deeds. The example set by the Prophet should be integrated with the basic guidelines that we have, either as followers of a religion, state officials/civil servants or members of society so that our attitude, words, and actions are a reflection of Islam and can be used as an example for our surroundings.

Flag-Raising Ceremony on 17 Feb 2011

Flag-raising ceremony was held by Lemhannas RI on February 17, 2011 at the Central Field of Lemhannas RI with Vice Governor Air Marshal Rio Mendung Thaileb, Ph.D. acting as the Inspector of Ceremony. The flag-raising ceremony was followed by all personnel of Lemhannas RI by all personnel Lemhannas RI. The Governor of Lemhannas RI, in his message read by the Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, conveyed a few things that need to be known by all ceremony participants, namely:

First, BPK RI is conducting an audit of the implementation of the 2010 work program and budget of Lemhannas RI for 35 working days. Therefore, all work units in Lemhannas RI are expected to prepare everything needed by BPK in order to help and facilitate the auditing process;

Second, the outcome of a hearing with the House of Representatives' Commission I which called for Lemhannas RI need to conduct in-depth studies of the problems faced by the nation, such as the increasing horizontal conflicts, human security, vulnerable areas, border areas and regional election in various regions;

Third, consolidation activities for expert lecturers, expert analysts, expert professionals, resource persons and structural officials of Lemhannas RI aimed at setting a common vision and perception of the mechanisms of education, teaching materials, and socialization of technical manual on the organizing of PPRA XLVII and PPSA XVII programs;

Fourth, the Deputy for Strategic Studies will conduct a quick assessment of the development of the most controversial issues that occur in the society besides the ongoing actual and contemporary assessment activities that it has carried out, with the hope that it will give a contribution to the government;

Fifth, the Deputy for Stabilization of Nationalistic Values will synchronize between academic papers and the preparation of a book about 4 (four) pillars and a book about 6 (six) cores of Lemhannas RI. They will be used as materials/teaching materials in the consolidation forum activity for suprastructure, infrastructure and substructure;

Sixth, the Main Secretariat will carry out various activities, such as preparing the 2011 Revised State Budget, the 2012 State Budget, entering into cooperation with domestic and foreign institutions (foreign loan and grant/PHLN with Spain) and increasing Internet connection speeds to 10 Mb. Besides, it will also facilitate the construction activities of four-story mess for the participants. The mess will have 140 rooms and one floor for an auditorium. Later, in 2011 a corridor will also be built connecting Astagatra building to Trigatra building. There will also be supervisory activities of the renovation of the damaged Lemhannas buildings caused by the construction activities of the Jakarta Provincial Government's buildings.

Therefore, it is expected that a democratic Indonesian society with a strong nationalistic viewpoint and statesmanship will be created based on Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution, the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia and Unity in Diversity (*Sesanti Bhinneka Tunggal Ika*).

This can only be realized with the support of the Indonesian people who have morality, faith and character as well as high work ethics, which are based on good discipline.

SOCIALIZATION OF PPRA XLVI TO FOREIGN DEFENCE ATTACHES

The governor also expressed some hopes that he desired from the participants of the consolidation event, namely: first, act professionally and responsibly; second, be a good role model for the participants in terms of attitudes and behavior; third, have the character and ability that one can be proud of and have characteristics appropriate to a scientist; fourth, have the ability to act as a good motivator and innovator; fifth, be pro-active and communicative and show high concern for the environment; sixth, have a creativity and constantly develop one's ability independently, so that he/she can have extensive knowledge and forward-looking view.
