# Harvard Kennedy School Delegations Visit Lemhannas RI

Agr., Former Indonesian Ambassador to Myanmar Sebastianus Sumarsono, S.Ip., Director of Politic Studies Drs. Hanif Salim, M.A., Chief of Public Relations Commodore E. Estu Prabowo, M.Sc., Head of International Cooperation Colonel Rujito D. Asmoro Gdipl In DS., MA., RCDS.

Before starting a brief presentation on the Civil and Military Relations from Indonesia's experience, Agus Widjojo explained the historical background between Myanmar and Indonesia. Indonesia and Myanmar, Agus Widjojo said, were struggling to achieve their liberty. Agus Widjojo also explained the involvement of the military in Indonesia in the democratic political system after the independence. In addition, Agus Wodjojo also revealed that the formation of the Myanmar delegation attended the discussion illustrated the cooperation between civilians and military. ●

# Lemhannas RI and Commission I of DPR-RI Discussing Budget Evaluation



**T**aken Place in Nusantara II Building of House of Representatives (DPR RI) on Monday (23/1), Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. (Ret) Agus Widjojo accompanied by Lemhannas RI's Top Officials attended Hearing (RDP) with the House of Representatives. The hearing discussed about the evaluation of the achievement of Lemhannas RI's work programs in 2016 and work plan in 2017.

In the hearing, Agus Widjojo reported that total capital expenditure of Lemhannas RI absorbed in 2016 after experiencing savings, efficiency and additional budget is 99,3 %.

Regarding the work programs of Lemhannas RI in 2017, Agus Widjojo explained about three Lemhannas RI's programs. The first program is management support and other technical duties which is divided into five bureaus: Public Relations Bureau, Cooperation Bureau, General Affairs Bureau, Planning and Finance Bureau and Telematics Bureau. The second program is surveillance and enchancement of Lemhannas RI apparatus' accountability conducted by Inspectorate of Lemhannas RI. The last program is a national resilience development program which is divided into three deputy offices namely Deputy Office of National-Level-Leader Education, Deputy Office of Strategic Studies, and Deputy

Office of Strengthening of National Values.

Deputy Office of National-Level-Leader Education will conduct PPSA XXI, PPRA LVI and P3DA. Meanwhile Deputy Office of Strategic Studies will implement some conceptual and strategic assessments on strategic issues, measure national resilience index and hold Jakarta Geopolitics Forum. Then, Deputy Office of Strengthening of National Values will implement Strengthening Program of National Values for religious leaders, community leaders, military, police, bureaucrats, local leaders, regional leaders, academicians, specific profession leaders and mass organizations, implements Training of Trainers, and also hold national dialogue.

The presentation then continued by a report on interim inspections of BPK RI in detail by Inspector of Lemhannas RI. Agus Widjojo also conveyed some awards achieved by Lemhannas RI like Finance Minister Award on the success in preparing and presenting 2015 financial statements with highest standards achievement in government's accounting and financial report Finance Minister Award for contributions on not-taxes revenue, a plaque of appreciation from the Minister of Finance on order execution of 2016 tax obligations as well as intellectual property patent rights for Labkurtannas of from the Directorate of Copyright and Industrial Design of Ministry of Law and Human Rights. The Hearing was continued with open discussion with DPR RI. ●

economic situation which is very dependent to changes in world's economy, high level of unemployment and social inequality, welfare inequality between region, and the decrease of socio-cultural aspect.

Agus Widjojo statement was also in line with the statement expressed by the guest speaker at the RTD. Former Head of Geospatial Information Agency (BIG) Dr. Asep Karsidi, M.Sc. as the first speaker expressed the need to increase awareness related to the diversity in Indonesia in recent years that shows intolerance.

Meanwhile, the second speaker Prof. Dr. Ir. Rina Oktaviani, M.S., Director of International Trade Analysis and Policy Studies FEM IPB mentioned that to improve Indonesia

Lemhannas RI held Round Table Discussion (RTD) on Labkurtannas (National Resilience Measurement Laboratory) Working Group Team Consolidation and 2017 Strategic Issues Formulation in Kresna Room, Astagatra Building 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (25/1).

RTD was preceded by report from Labkurtannas Chairman Prof. Miyasto explaining the duties and functions of Labkurtannas and the data that must be measured to obtain a national resilience index so as to provide a portrait of national resilience. With the portrait of national resilience, Prof. Miyasto continued, stand out strategic issues can be formulated such as declining national values and tolerance, intersectors and central and local policy strategies, bureaucracy services, region infrastructure, food, energy, and water supply security, unemployment and other several issues related.

Indonesia national resilience index in 2016, Agus Widjojo stated, has shown an increase compared to 2015. However, Agus Widjojo reminded that there are issues that must be concerned. In the last three years there is a downward trend in national security index on ideology aspect, less tough position of political aspect, Indonesia's

national resilience index required international aspects. In the field of economics, food security is an important factor to improve the Indonesian economy. In addition, Rina Oktaviani also mentioned that Indonesia should be able to improve competitiveness in ASEAN but in the same time, also focused on Indonesia economic situation.

Regarding the unemployment rate, Sri Soelistyowati from of the Central Statistic Agency said that Indonesia will get the demographic dividend until 2030 so it should be put to good use. In addition, Sri Soelistyowati also confirmed that the Indonesian economy, which tends to increase is not directly proportional to the unemployment rate. Therefore, Indonesia should strive to continue to improve the Indonesian economy which will have a positive impact on the unemployment rate in the presence of demographic dividend that took place within a short time.

In terms of ideology and political aspects, Dr. Ichsan Malik said that currently, in Indonesia is occurring some phenomenon that affects the declining of those two aspects such as today almost all groups of people are being threatened, causing intolerance between communities. In addition, the unfair condition felt by all communities and also the stereotypes and prejudices existed among social groups. The phenomenon must be overcome by means of reconciliation and building trust between groups. ●
