Inauguration and Oath-taking of Civil Servants Lemhannas RI

he Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI, Police Commissioner General Drs. Purwadi Arianto, M.Si., was present as the Ceremony Inspector for Inauguration and Oath-taking of Civil Servants of Lemhannas RI on Thursday (9/12/21), at the Dwi Warna Room, Lemhannas RI.

In his remarks, the Prime Secretary of Lemhannas RI stated that fundamentally, the Inauguration and Oath-taking is the preparedness of Civil Servants to be able to carry out their roles as the state apparatus and public servants. The Prime Secretary also stated his hope for the inaugurated civil servants to comply with the Law Number 5 of 2014 Concerning State Civil Apparatus that have objectives to create professional and neutral State Civil Apparatus with high integrity and performance.

According to the Prime Secretary, a civil servant is expected to work with the core value of state civil apparatus, namely BerAKHLAK (berorientasi pelayanan, akuntabel, kompeten, harmonis, loyal, adaptif, dan kolaboratif) which means service oriented, accountable, competent, harmonious. loyal, adaptive, collaborative. "As a civil servant, do not demand services, but provide excellent services instead," Prime Secretary said.

In line with the core value of state civil apparatus, the inaugurated civil servants were also expected to make themselves ready and to carry out their duties by considering all the consequences of their actions, so that they can maintain the image of civil servants that is positive and avoid acts that deviate from the regulations and code of ethics.

The Prime Secretary emphasized that inaugurated servants must work to their potential and become pioneers of a healthy bureaucracy and good governance. "Be the agent of unifying the nation and servants for the people. Uphold the profession of civil servants by prioritizing professionalism," he said.

The Inauguration and Oath-taking of Civil Servants was witnessed only by several representatives of Lemhannas RI's officials and was carried out in a short time by implementing strict health protocols including physical distancing, use of masks, and hand washing.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Attends FGD for the Presidential Special Staff for Legal Affairs



he Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo was one of the speakers in the Focus Group Discussion (FGD) of the Presidential Special Staff for Legal Affairs with the title "Draft of Presidential Decree on TNI's (The Indonesian Armed Forces) Tasks in Overcoming Terrorism" on Wednesday (15/12/21) at Le Meridien Hotel, Jakarta.

In the FGD, the Governor of Lemhannas RI raised the topic of TNI Involvement in Counter Terrorism Handling. "Terror is a method, so that its background, organization, purpose can be used by anyone. The the word "Rism" is a sect, belief, ideology. If that method is believed to be a way to achieve goals, it will be a belief, then it becomes terrorism," he said when opening his presentation.

Furthermore, the Governor said that the notion of terrorism has national and international aspects so as to provide an understanding that the threat of terrorism cannot be absolutely separated as a threat from within or outside the state.

According to the Governor, taking action against acts of terrorism that occur abroad is the duty and role of TNI in the

form of military operations. Meanwhile, the prosecution of acts of terrorism that occur in the jurisdiction of the domestic national jurisdiction is the duty of law enforcement officers in the criminal justice system. However, the Governor see that there are no clear and explicit boundaries regarding the role of TNI and Polr (The Indonesian Police) in counter-terrorism. It provides an opportunity to determine the limits of authority between TNI and Polri in counter terrorism.

At the end of his presentation, the Governor underlined that efforts to suppress terrorism require a consistent response from law enforcement by law enforcement officers. The efforts to deal with terrorism are currently quite effective by the Police. The governor also added that the role of TNI in handling counterterrorism can be interpreted to deal with acts of terrorism that occur outside the jurisdiction of national law. Domestically, the role of TNI can be accommodated in TNI assistance operations to civilian authorities in peacetime.

Lemhannas RI Ranks Second in the Criteria for Non-Ministerial Institutions at the 2021 Integrity Assessment Survey

Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK) released the National Integrity Index which is the result of the 2021 Integrity Assessment Survey (SPI) on Thursday (12/23/21) online and onsite at Merah Putih Building KPK, Jakarta.

During the event themed "Measuring the Level of Corruption in Indonesia", KPK Chairman Police Commissioner General. Drs. Firli Bahuri, M.Si, stated that all people of the nation is obliged to realize the noble ideals of the nation's founders, which is the goals of our country. The KPK chairman called upon all elements of society to take part in this action because the country's goals will be difficult to achieve if there is no unity of rhythm and action from the whole community.

Concerning corruption, the KPK chairman believed that the nation's people must join hands and make Indonesia to be a corruption free country. In carrying out the mandate of Presidential Regulation Number 54 of 2018 Concerning the National Strategy for Corruption Prevention and the 2020-2024 National Mid-Term Development Plan, KPK carried out an Integrity Assessment Survey (SPI).



At least 34 Provincial Governments. Ministries/Institutions, and Regional/City Governments are involved in the 2021 SPI. The respondents consist of 154,439 internal respondents and 64,924 external respondents and 7,647 expert respondents (the Audit Board of the Republic of Indonesia, Finance and Development Supervisory Agency, Ombudsman, Media) with a total of 255,010 respondents. "Plenty information can be revealed with the Integrity Assessment Survey," the KPK Chairman said.

From the survey, the National Integrity Index of SPI 2021 got the score of 72.43, exceeding the 2021 target, which is a score of 70 with the index range of 42.01 at the lowest and 91.72 at the highest. Lemhannas RI got a score of 88.05 and placed second in the category of Non-Ministerial Institutions. "We sincerely hope that this survey will give insights to all of us as the young generation of Indonesia who play a role in carrying out the "orchestration" of corruption eradication and prevention," the KPK Chairman concluded.

Commemorating Mother's Day, Lemhannas RI Holds Self-Management Motivational Seminar

The speaker for the seminar was the Chair of the Indonesian Psychiatrists Association (PDSKJI) Dr. dr. Diah Setia Utami, Sp. KJ., MARS.

In his remarks, the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widioio, stated the urgency to increase the management of women's control in various aspects of life and to create family resilience. "The Mother's Day commemoration essentially aims is to remind all Indonesian people, especially the younger generation the meaning and significance of Mother's Day as a momentum for the nation's awakening," the Governor said.

The advancement of women will certainly be the development of the nation.

Therefore, it becomes the obligation of all parties to support the advancement and to encourage the role of women in national development. "Indonesian women bravely go beyond social boundaries, speak out for the rights of their kind and stand together with men to achieve independence," the Governor of Lemhannas RI stated.

In his presentation, the Chair of PDSKJI stated that Covid-19 pandemic changes everything and causes people to become stressed. Undoubtedly, this condition has an influence on national resilience.

The PDSKJI survey in 34 provinces involving 6,541 respondents that there is an increase in the rate of depression and anxiety in the community from an average of 40% to 73%, and even the suicide rate of around 43%. This shows that psychological conditions are also affected by Covid-19 pandemic.

The Chair of PDSKJI stated that managing mental health requires adaptability with various coping skills. This ability is needed by humans because it can strengthen physical and mental health. Coping skills to manage mental health include exercises in relaxation. breathing, praying, creative activities, positive thinking, building hope, reading, and listening to music. "People who are successful in life are people who are able to adapt in every situation," the Chair of PDSKJI concluded.

In addition to holding a motivational seminar, to commemorate the Mother's Day, Lemhannas RI is also giving charity to the families of Lemhannas RI who have been affected by Covid-19 pandemic. This aims as an effort to maintain the familial values of Lemhannas RI personnel and to support each other in facing the pandemic that is full of uncertainty.

oncluding 2021, Lemhannas RI held Year-End Statement Press Conference on Friday (31/12/21) in the Syailendra Room, 3rd Floor of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI. The year-end statement was conveyed by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo to dozens of national media who were present onsite and online.

On this occasion, the Governor of Lemhannas RI emphasized the complexity and urgency to handle the pandemic makes it necessary to implement cautious steps. Efforts to handle the pandemic and recovery measures due to the impact of the pandemic cannot be carried out in sectoral way. "The year of 2021 was a tough. Indonesia will have to deal with the pandemic and its impacts, which have not been fully resolved," he said.

To ensure the continuity of national development, synchronized vision and mission of the central and local government are necessary. The central and local governmental system must be integrated and synergized in formulating and implementing decisions and policies. "This situation is inseparable from the need to increase institutional capacity as part of strengthening the national system,"

the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed.

In the press conference attended by dozens of national media, the Governor of Lemhannas RI highlighted Indonesia's participation in the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) in 2022. According to the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Indonesia needs to improve the business and investment environment in order to increase competitiveness and take advantage of the implementation of the RCEP agreement through improvement in the ease of doing business and global competitiveness index. "RCEP can be used as a space for export and investment promotion," he explained.

The agenda of education reform is also a matter of concern in the year-end statement. The uneven distribution of education for the people and the quality of educators who have yet been fully able to keep up with the pace of advanced educational technology and developed teaching materials are one of the challenges faced by the Indonesia. Therefore, the Governor of Lemhannas RI regarded the agenda of education reform with priority in improving the quality of education and accelerating the absorption

of subjects.

On the same occasion, the Governor of Lemhannas RI stated that central and local governments needed to anticipate stunting and malnutrition condition in children as the nation's next generation. Providing nutritious food for pregnant women and children must be a priority because it is difficult to reach their superior human potential if they experience hunger, malnutrition, and stunting since early age.

During the year-end statement press conference, the Governor of Lemhannas RI was accompanied by Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Air Marshal Wieko Syofyan, Prome Secretary of Lemhannas RI Police Commissioner General Drs. Purwadi Arianto M.Si., Deputy Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P., Professional Expert for Natural Resources and National Resilience of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Dadan Umar Daihani, D.E.A., Professional Expert for Economics of Lemhannas RI Ending Fadjar, S.E., M.A., and Head of Public Relations Bureau of Lemhannas RI Brigadier General A. n the beginning of 2022, Lemhannas RI implemented Capacity Building for Faculty Members (Senior Lecturers, Senior Analysts, Professional Experts), Strengthening of national Insights deputy office work plan, Strategic Studies deputy office work plan, National Level-Leader education deputy office work plan of 2022 of Lemhannas RI on Wednesday and Thursday (5-6/1/22) in Gadiah Mada Auditorium of Lemhannas RI.

During the occasion that is attended by Faculty Members and Structural Officials of Lemhannas RI, The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) AGus Widjojo conveyed that Faculty Members has important and dominant roles in supporting the success of education implementation.

Therefore, the Governor observed that the existence and the quality of faculty members must be improved and accustomed with their responsibilities as speakers, assistants, tutors, moderators, panelists, discussants, resource persons, and other tasks.

Realizing the importance of this activity, the Governor of Lemhannas RI emphasized several things to all participants. First, so that all series of activities are followed with a full sense of responsibility and discipline according to a predetermined schedule. Second, the entire mechanism for implementing educational programs is understood and explored. Third, to avoid excessive personal and sectoral and improve professionalism, coordination, cooperation, and solidity so that the quality of outputs and outcomes expected are achieved. Fourth, to always professionally, proactively. communicatively, able to motivate, and have character and abilities that can be used as role models for education participants.

In 2022. Deputy Office of National-Level Leader Education are going to hold two education programs namely PPRA 63 (Regular Education Program Batch 63) and PPRA 64 (regular Education program Batch 64) which are followed


100 participants in every batch and held for eight months. To support the implementation of both education programs, several preparations stages are needed through capacity building for faculty members (consolidation).

Meanwhile, The Deputy Office for Strengthening of National Values in 2022 will carry out 19 activities with Lemhannas RI DIPA and 13 non-DIPA activities. The implementation method has not changed much from the previous implementation, which is still lectures, panel discussions, essay writing, group discussions, intergroup discussions, and teaching practices for the participants of the Training for Trainers.

Meanwhile, the Deputy Office of Strategic Studies is planned to hold several activities, namely Long-Term Strategic Studies, National Seminars, Jakarta Geopolitical Forum, Urgent and Rapid Studies, and intellectual exercise. In addition, the Deputy Office of Strategic Studies will also write a study journal on national security which is a migration from Lemhannas RI journal. This year, it is planned that the journal will be submitted for accreditation. In addition, the Deputy Office of Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI also carries out tracer studies, compilation of strategic study repositories, and conducts opinion polls every time they visit the locus.

"Public has high expectations of Lemhannas, keep that in mind, Maintaining this high expectation is by trying to build compatible values," the Governor said. He conveyed that the emphasis of education should be placed on the teaching and learning process, analytical sharpness, and way of thinking. The Governor of Lemhannas RI said that the education of Lemhannas RI wants to prepare alumni who are excellent, have character, have integrity, are responsible, and are good citizens. In line with this, education also focuses on individual abilities, not groups.

The Chancellor of Pelita Bangsa University conveyed the need for national insight training and can be realized in the form of collaboration with Lemhannas RI. He also said that Pelita Bangsa University regularly held annual programs as a form of community service.

Because of this, the study conducted by Lemhannas RI is related to policies for national strategic leaders, especially in the core of Lemhannas RI, namely the Four Basic Consensus of the Nation and the implementation of the national paradigm. One day before inaugurated as EP Ambassador to The republic of Philiphines concurrently to Republic of Marshal Islands and Republic of Palau, The Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. (Ret.) Agus Widjojo gave a lecture to all Lemhannas RI Officials in extraordinary morning call on Tuesday (11/1/22) in cetral field of Lemhannas RI.

In his lecture, it was stated that Lemhannas RI have graduated nine batches of the Regular Education Program (PPR), three batches of the Short Education Program (PPS), and one batch of the Strengthening of Regional-Level Leaders Program. Lemhannas RI has also successfully implemented 45 Strengthening of National Values Program

and National Insights, implemented five Jakarta Geopolitical Forum (JGF), and three Making Indonesia 4.0 Program.

In line with these achievements. Lemhannas RI has also successfully met various criteria and work benchmarks.
