he Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto was present as a speaker at Kopassus Unit Commanders Assembly of 2022 on Monday (30/5/22), at Ricky Samuel Hall, Kopassus Education Center, Bandung, West Java.

During the assembly themed "Building Resilient Kopassus Commanders to Ensure the Realization of Professional & Prosperous Soldiers & Kopassus Units as pillars of the Indonesian Army," the Governor of Lemhannas RI conveyed the basic knowledge at Lemhannas RI that when it was established, Lemhannas RI was directed to be a geopolitical institute. At that time, the occurring geopolitical constellation was the Cold War between the Western Bloc and Eastern Bloc, making impacts on politics in Indonesia.

On that occasion, the Governor explained the conceptual evolution of Geopolitics I to Geopolitics V. "Geopolitics has evolved into geopolitics 5.0. At this point, what happens is the battle for connectivity; how the world is connected to each other regarding the supply chain and the battle that is going on over infrastructure," he said.

Furthermore. Governor explained that there is new literature in defense studies and military studies, namely the gray zone. Gray zone tactics facilitate states to achieve specific geopolitical goals without open war. This strategic dynamic is an aspect that must be taken into account for the national capacity building.

Furthermore, advances in the cyber dimension create novel vulnerabilities in the dynamics of global defense. "Currently, Indonesia is still at the orange level (unhealthy) so that there is a need for capacity increase to reduce risks and overcome cyber-attacks, especially those that disrupt the sustainability of the state," the Governor said. Considering this condition, a Cyber Policy and Security Bill is currently being prepared because cyberspace is one of the vital points in geopolitics 5.0.

his Concluding speech, Governor stated that there were three temporary concentrations at Lemhannas RI. First, preparing and thinking in the next three months to ensure that the described strategic issues experience no crisis. Second, thinking in the next 874 days regarding what the government will do. Third, thinking for the year of 2045 and beyond.

National Defence College of India Visits Lemhannas RI

total of 15 National Defence (NDC) College India participants were accompanied by the Indian Defence Attaché to Indonesia visited Lemhannas RI, on Tuesday (30/5/22). The visit began with a courtesy call between the Head of the Delegation from India's NDC, Major General Manoj Kumar, SM and the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Lieut. Gen. Mohamad Sabrar Fadhilah at the Executive Guest Room of Lemhannas RI.

In addition to conveying the speech of welcome and apologies from the Governor of Lemhannas RI for not being able to receive the courtesy call directly, the Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI also explained the three foremost functions of Lemhannas RI. "Conducting National-Level Leaders Education Program, Conducting Strategic Studies, and Conducting Strengthening of National Values Program," he said. Furthermore, the Deputy Governor said that in Lemhannas RI, there are two

types of education programs, namely Regular Education Program and the Short Education Program.

Meanwhile, the Head of the Delegation from India's NDC also explained that the education program at India's NDC is conducted for 11 months. During the education period, the participants will conduct research, which eventually develops security strategies and later will be implemented in various fields. At the end of the education program, the participants will make theses as India's NDC is also affiliated with Madras University.

The Head of the Delegation from India's NDC also stated that there is the overseas study program that allows several groups to visit several states. After conducting overseas study, the results of each group will be compiled an analysis.

"The participants will learn two types of strategy implementation. First, they will examine the situation within India and second, they will also examine what is happening globally so that they will have broad and thorough knowledge of conditions at home and abroad," said the Head of the Delegation from India's NDC.

In addition to making courtesy calls, during the visit, discussions were also held which was led by the Deputy for National-Level Leaders Education of Lemhannas RI Major General Sugeng Santoso, S.I.P. "It is an honor for Lemhannas RI to receive a visit from India's NDC to discuss the education system," said the Deputy for National-Level Leaders Education of Lemhannas RI. In the discussion, all participants can explore and be actively involved in the discussion to gain deeper understanding and knowledge.

Ende was selected because Ende is a historical place for Indonesia in finding the basis of the state. In Ende, during Bung Karno's exile period, Bung Karno spent 4 years contemplating and exploring the noble values that could unite the pluralistic Indonesian nation.

In addition to attending the 2022 Pancasila Commemoration Ceremony in Ende City, the Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widiaianto also attended the Commencement Declaration of the Pancasila Education in the National Education Curriculum. Lemhannas RI's Personnel Capacity Building in Making Indonesia 4.0 in 2022

he Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto, officially opened the Lemhannas RI's Personnel Capacity Building in Making Indonesia 4.0 Year 2022 on Monday (6/6/22) at the Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI. In his remarks, the Governor of Lemhannas RI stated

that Making Indonesia 4.0 is an integrated roadmap designed by the government to implement a number of strategies in the industrial era of 4.0.

All participants will be provided with a personnel capacity building program using Theory U and System Thinking approaches so that participants understand the structure of systemic problems, the differences between linear and systems thinking concepts and how to effectively communicate systemic challenges using systems thinking. In addition, this program is designed to provide an understanding for Lemhannas RI's personnel in the Theory U process as a framework in designing and providing innovative transformation processes at both individual and collective levels.

The implementation of this program has a correlation with the duties of Lemhannas RI to assist the president in providing education, preparing cadres and strengthening national-level leaders

with capacity to think comprehensively, integrally, holistically, integrative and professionally, having nationalistic character, morals and ethics, nationalism, archipelagic perspective, and universal viewpoint.

The Governor hopes that this personnel capacity building program will improve and optimize personnel performance. "Increasing one's capacity always starts from the individual level, and then moving to family, workplace, organisation, community, state, and the world," the Governor said. The governor also advises the participants to be able to find small changes from the training. Not only focus on what was given, but seriously finding the solutions.

The event, which was divided into two batches, was attended by a total of 180 participants, consisting of 33 echelon I participants, 11 echelon II participants, 53 echelon III participants, 73 echelon IV participants and 10 staff.

Vice President of the Republic of Indonesia K.H. Ma'ruf Amin Gives Public Lecture to PPRA 63 and 64 Participants

he Vice President of the Republic of Indonesia Prof. Dr. (H.C.) K.H. Ma'ruf Amin gave a public lecture to participants of the Regular Education Program (PPRA) Batch 63 and 64 of Lemhannas RI on Tuesday (07/06/22) at the Gadjah Mada Auditorium, Lemhannas RI. The public lecture that was delivered had two themes, namely "Public Political Education in the Context of National Resilience" and

"Multiplier Effects of the G-20 Presidency on Geopolitics and Indonesian Interests".

The Vice President stated that at the global level, Indonesia has made a historical and monumental record, among others, the execution of Asian-African Conference in 1955 and its recognition as an archipelagic state in the United Nation Convention of Law of the Sea 1982. Not to forget that this year, Indonesia also holds the G20 Presidency and next year, Indonesia will be the Chair of ASEAN. The recognition of Indonesia's role in the world is based on sincerity and neutrality in the spirit of realizing the ideals of the nation as stated in the opening of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia.

"However, it is worth remembering that the recognition that Indonesia acquired for its work abroad is impossible without us first fixing our domestic affairs by improving the political, economic, and socio-cultural ecosystems," said the Vice President.

In this regard, Indonesia took over the G20 leadership, which aims to strengthen consultation and cooperation in overcoming the crisis caused by the pandemic. The G20 presidency is a momentum for Indonesia to gain credibility or trust from the international community in leading the global recovery.

At the end of the lecture, the Vice President gave PPRA 63 and 64 participants some advice. First, a leader must be capable to build collaboration with various parties to realize equitable and just people's welfare. Second, a leader must know how to take full advantage of existing international cooperation structures. Third, a leader must strengthen partnerships and collaborations with various stakeholders. Lastly, a leader must improve his/her competence to communicate ideas effectively, analyze systematically, and organize and make use of networks to complete the duties of a leader.

"We expect all parties, including local governments and academics, to continue to strengthen national values as part of a joint effort," he said.

It is necessary to provide debriefing and continuously affiliate intergenerational unity to avoid separated generations. Therefore, Lemhannas RI also continues to synergize with various policy makers in instilling national values. "Let us, at all levels, increase the stability of national insight as a whole. Let's do it in the spirit of unity," the Deputy Governor said.

Sutarmidji, S.H., M.Hum. and Professor of the Faculty of Economics and Business of University of Tanjungpura Prof. Dr. Eddy Suratman, S.E. Lemhannas RI Attends Hearing Meeting with **Commission I of DPR RI**

Hearing Meeting (RDP) with Commission
I of House of Representatives of the
Republic of Indonesia (DPR RI) on
Tuesday (7/6/22) at the DPR RI Complex,
Jakarta.

In the RDP which discussing the 2021 Realization and Evaluation of Budget Implementation and the Work Plan and Budget of Lemhannas RI for 2023, the Governor briefly explained the tasks of Lemhannas RI. Based on the Presidential Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia Number 98 of 2016, Lemhannas RI is given four keys, namely National-Level Leadership Education, Strengthening of National Values, Strategic Studies, and National Level Measurement.

"As a special note, we were asked by the President to focus on five things, namely Consolidation of Democracy, Green Economy, Blue Economy, Digital Transformation and Resilience of Nusantara, the News Capital. Then, by the Vice President, we were asked to focus on this study, also for Papua," the Governor explained.

Furthermore, the Governor also submitted the 2023 Work Plan and Budget of Lemhannas Rl. The planned programs include the National Resilience Development Program which consists of National-Level Leaders Education for PPRA 65 and PPRA 66, Strengthening of National Values, Strategic Studies, and National Resilience Measurement. "Measurement of National Resilience in 2023 will also focus on discussing issues directed by the President and Vice President," the Governor said.

On that occasion, one of the members of Commission I of DPR RI, Junico BP Siahaan, wanted to know

the indicators that Lemhannas RI wanted to achieve in providing education and preparing national leaders cadres. According to him, compare to the challenges that exist today the challenges ten years ago are different, such as the existence of asymmetric wars and the development of the digital world.

Responding to this, the Governor of Lemhannas RI explained that Lemhannas RI was undergoing a transformation that would require a new budget calculation. As at this time, Lemhannas RI was ordered to carry out a curriculum transformation whose authority was in the Steering Committee consisting of four Coordinating Ministers, Minister of Home Affairs, Minister of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Defense and Governor of Lemhannas RI. The Governor of Lemhannas RI explained that this transformation will be effortful because transforming the National Level-Leaders Education would affect the Military Education curriculum, Police Education curriculum, and the State Civil Apparatus Leadership Education curriculum.

After participating in PPRA 64, PPRA 64 participants are expected to propose changes that will bring Indonesia to the point it dreams of.

The purpose of the visit was to discuss several issues related to the global economic situation and plans for cooperation between the two institutions. "We are eager to get input from the IMF regarding Indonesia's current economic performance in particular, because it is important for us, in Lemhannas RI, to understand the situation," the Deputy Governor said.

In addition, the Deputy Governor also asked the IMF to be able to give lectures to education participants at Lemhannas RI in order to understand the global economic situation. According to him, an overview of the global and national economy is very important to reduce current and future negative issues, at least in the short or



medium term so that future leaders of Indonesia can see the economic view objectively.

"This is a good opportunity for us to talk about the economy and we are very happy to be able to help Lemhannas discuss the general economy in Indonesia," the IMF Senior Resident Representative said. According to him, in the current situation, there is a lot of confusion regarding economic conditions, especially regarding economic policies. As a country with a large economy, this has an impact on Indonesia. IMF, which has a good relationship with the Ministry

of Finance of the Republic of Indonesia, would also like to provide an overview of economic policy for Indonesia and would like to share this view with Lemhannas RI.

Member VII of BPK RI pays a Courtesy Call to Governor of Lemhannas RI



he Chief of The Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN) M. Arsyad Rasjid P.M. and Vice Chairman of transportation paid a Courtesy Call to The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto on Thursday (09/6/2022) in Governor's Executive Guest Room, Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

Starting the Courtesy Call, The Governor said that Lemhannas RI is directed by The President to focus on five studies namely consolidation of democracy, green economy, blue economy, digital transformations, and resilience of New Capital City. He also said that there are additional studies that needed to be studied, namely regarding Papua as an order from the Vice President.

"We must interact, talk, and indeed have to get directions from the chairman of KADIN as a member of the Steering Committee, what we should do in Lemhannas RI, especially those related to the non-government sector, the economic sector, the population sector," the Governor said to the Chairman of Kadin as a steering committee member who responsible for formulating public policy of Lemhannas RI.

The Chairman of Kadin proposed to organize a roadmap on Carbon Tax and Digitization for each industry together with Lemhannas RI. The governor continued that in order to collaborate on this, Lemhannas RI has a Deputy Office for Strategic Studies whose results will be submitted directly to the President.
