This study is one of a series of studies to be carried out in 2023 with the aim of finding new solutions that can win the hearts of the Papuan people for the integrity of the Republic of Indonesia from Sabang to Merauke. peaceful, and the economy in the Papua region will increase and synergize with other regions in Indonesia," Deputy for Strategic Studies Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P said when delivering her report.

The implementation of elections undoubtedly contains susceptibilities which that not only can occur in the election process but also have the potential to become security vulnerabilities and thus must be anticipated.

Concluding his presentation, Andi Widjajanto advised the Deputy Chief of Staff for Politics, Law, Defense, Security, and Human Rights to keep monitoring the development of digital platforms.

#### Lemhannas RI Holds FGD on **Projection of Global Political Risk** for the First Quarter of 2023

JAKARTA - The Deputy for Strategic Studies at Lemhannas RI held a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) "Projection of Global Political Risk for the First Quarter of 2023" on Wednesday (29/3) at Kresna Room, 4th Floor of Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

In her speech, The Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P stated that the global political risk study is conducted based on the dynamics of the development of the strategic environment in 2023 that are increasingly dynamic along with the escalation of global politics in the midst of the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine.

Tensions between big powers tend to escalate due to NATO's interests with the United States to create military superiority against Russia in the war in Ukraine. In addition, the momentum of XI Jinping's visit to Russia indicates that the competition between the big powers China and the United States is likely to heat up, although Xi Jinping seeks to play a constructive role in resolving the Ukraine issue by offering a proposal to end the war between Russia and Ukraine which is called "Global Security Initiatives".

The FGD presented speakers from various fields, namely Director of Europe II of Directorate General of America

and Europe of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia, Mr. Winardi Hanafi Lucky; Head of the National Strategic Installation Agency of the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Indonesia, Maj. Gen. Yudi Abrimantyo, S.I.P., M.sc.; Senior Researcher of Politics Research Center of the National Research and Innovation Agency of the Republic of Indonesia, Drs. M. Hamdan Basyar, M.Si.; Director of the Graduate School of Diplomacy of Paramadina University, Dr. Phil Shiska Prabawaningtyas; Lecturer of the Postgraduate Program of People's Republic of China Politics at Driyarkara School of Philosophy, Dr. Klaus H. JAKARTA - Eighty prospective participants of the Short Education Program Batch 24 (PPSA 24) took part in the re-registration process at Lemhannas RI. Re-registration was carried out for three days (4-6/4) which took place in the Diponegoro Room, Pancagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The re-registration is one of the series before the beginning of PPSA 24 of Lemhannas RI which opens in mid-April.
