MANADO - The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto opened the 2023 Training of Trainers (ToT) for Strengthening National Values for Lecturers, Teachers and Trainers in North Sulawesi Province on Tuesday (6/6), at the Sutan Raja Hotel of Manado, North Sulawesi.

Lasting for eleven days, a hundred participants consisting of 35 lecturers, 9 trainers, 42 teachers, 8

TNI (The Indonesian Armed Forces) soldiers, and 6 members of Polri (the Indonesian National Police) took part in the implementation of the ToT. This Tot aims to strengthen national insights to achieve a strong understanding of the national insight which originates from the four basic consensuses of the nation. In carrying out the ToT, participants were provided with material on the Four Basic Consensus, namely Pancasila, the 1945 Constitution,

the Republic of Indonesia, and Bhinneka Tunggal Ika (Unity in Diversity). The participants were also provided with material on global challenges, geopolitical dynamics, and the condition of Indonesia in welcoming the political year.

Discussing Papua, Governor of Lemhannas RI Visits Komnas HAM

JAKARTA - The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto who was accompanied by the Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P. held discussions related to the efforts to overcome conflict in Papua on Monday (12/6), at the Office of the National Human Rights Commission (Komnas HAM).

During the discussion, the Chairman of Komnas HAM, Dr. Atnike Nova Sigiro, M.Sc said that the human rights issue in Papua is one of Komnas HAM's priorities. "We still need a lot of information and perspectives on the government's strategy in responding to the situation in Papua," Atnike Nova Sigiro said.

Responding to this, Andi Widjajanto said that there was a need for deeper collaboration between Lemhannas RI and Komnas HAM on human rights issues. Furthermore, Andi Widjajanto conveyed that the issue of Papua is one of the issues being studied by Lemhannas RI as requested by the President and Vice President of the Republic of Indonesia.

"Our main focus is to find out the way to ensure that acts of violence decrease or completely disappear," Andi Widjajanto said. This is because the macroeconomic and socio-economic welfare indices in Papua have improved, but on the other hand, violence has continued to increase. According to him, Lemhannas RI has conducted several quantitative studies which show no correlation between economic indicators and violence.

Another obstacle is the record of human rights violations in the past. Lemhannas RI makes scoring for the short term using an assessment methodology. "Our scoring has a modeling, for Papua the score in May is above the projected value, it is worse than we expected," he said. The score is based on the stagnation of human rights violation cases in Papua.

The Governor of Lemhannas RI Attends the Submission of the Central **Government Financial Report of the** Audit Result Statement of 2022 at the **State Palace**

JAKARTA - The Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto, attended the Submission of the Central Government Financial Report of the Audit Result Statement (LHP LKPP) of 2022 on Monday (26/6), at the State Palace, Jakarta. On this occasion, the Chairwoman of the Supreme Audit Agency of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI), Dr. Isma Yatun, CSFA., CFrA., stated that LKPP is the government's responsibility for implementing the seven components of State Budget (APBN) including budget downstream reports, changes in surplus budget balances, balance sheets, operations, changes in equity, cash flow, and notes to financial statements.

The audit results of the BPK RI gave an unqualified opinion (WTP) on the LKPP of 2022 in all material respects according to the Government Accounting Standards (SAP). The WTP opinion on the 2022 LKPP is based on the WTP opinion on 81 financial statements of ministries/ agencies and a state general treasury financial report of 2022, which has a significant effect on the 2022 LKPP.

President Joko Widodo in his remarks, expressed his appreciation to the leaders of government institutions and BPK RI who have worked together and supported the government in observing the management of state finances. In addition. President Joko Widodo

firmly reminded that the WTP opinion is not an achievement, but an obligation that must be carried out by all levels of government in managing and using the state budget.

On this occasion. President Joko Widodo also encouraged all parties to participate in overseeing the accountability and proper quality of the state financial spending. He believes that the welfare of the people and the stability of the Indonesian economy will be even stronger if it can be realized. "If we can do this, we can effectively improve people's welfare, strengthen stability and economic growth towards the advanced Indonesia that we aspire to," he concluded.

Lemhannas RI Receives Unqualified Opinion for the Eighth Time in a Row

JAKARTA - The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto received the Head of State Finance Audit I of the Supreme Audit Agency of the Republic of Indonesia (BPK RI) Nyoman Adhi Suryadnyana, S.E., M.E., M.Ak., CSFA., CertDA., CGCAE at the BPK RI Audit Result Report (LHP) submission ceremony on the Financial Report of Lemhannas RI of 2022 on Wednesday (5/7), at Nusantara II Room, 1st Floor of Trigatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

The Audit conducted by BPK RI consisted of financial audit, performance audit and audit with a specific purpose (PDTT). The financial statements audit primarily aimed at obtaining an opinion. Opinion is the professional opinion of the auditor on the fairness of the information examined in the financial statements.

"Actually, obtaining this opinion is easy. There are four criteria and this opinion is only given on the financial statements. This financial audit is mandatory for us and is carried out every semester one," Nyoman Adhi said. Based on these criteria, financial statements are categorized into four types of opinions, namely unqualified opinion, qualified opinion, adverse and disclaimer.

The results of the audit by BPK RI on the financial statements of Lemhannas RI for the last seven years from 2015 to 2021 obtained an Unqualified Opinion (WTP). In auditing the financial statements of Lemhannas RI on December 31, 2022, Lemhannas RI presented a fair report in all material respects and the realization of the budget, operations and changes in equity in accordance with the SAP (government accounting standards).

"Thus, the opinion on the 2022 Lemhannas financial statement has again earned the unqualified opinion (WTP)," Nyoman Adhi said.

Obtaining a WTP opinion is an achievement to be proud of and should be appreciated because Lemhannas RI has succeeded in maintaining the WTP opinion eight times in a row since 2015 in being accountable for the state finances.

On this occasion, Andi Widjajanto expressed his gratitude to the BPK RI team for an objective and independent audit and for helping Lemhannas RI to improve its good governance. "We are glad to be audited by the BPK RI because we are aware that at this point is Lemhannas' good governance can be improved in the following years," he concluded

YOGYAKARTA - Participants of the Short Education Program Batch 24 (PPSA 24) conducted Domestic Strategic Study (SSDN) on Monday-Friday (10-14/7) in four destination provinces namely the Special Region of Yogyakarta, West Papua, South Kalimantan, and Bengkulu.

In addition, in the aspect of the education work program, currently the Regular Education Program Batch 65 has completed the reports on the Foreign Strategic Studies (SSLN) and is preparing for National Management System Simulation, Taskap (Individual Working paper) Exam. and Seminars.
