The Governor of Lemhannas RI Explains the Dynamics of Mineral Geopolitics



JAKARTA - The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto acted as the keynote speaker at the Short Course on Energy, Natural Resources, Minerals and the Environment of the Muhammadiyah Central Executive (PP) on Tuesday (25/7), in the PP Muhammadiyah Auditorium.

The activity which was attended by 34 regional leaders of Muhammadiyah Youth throughout Indonesia with backgrounds from lecturers, academics, social community members, and advocates, raised the theme "Mineral Mining as a Leverage for Indonesia's Bargaining Position in Geopolitics".

The theme was raised, aiming to explore energy and mining issues, increase national knowledge and insights related to energy, mining to environmental sustainability for Muhammadiyah youth so that they can play a role in public policy making.

On this occasion, Andi Widjajanto spoke about mineral geopolitics. Competition for connectivity and access to strategic resources has become a characteristic of recent geopolitical dynamics. Minerals are



strategic resources that have long been the battle arena between the world's great powers. The energy transition reinforces the significance of minerals in global geopolitical dynamics. Supply limitations and concentrations have pushed many countries to compete in obtaining and securing access to minerals that are considered strategic.

Observing these challenges, President Joko Widodo asked Lemhannas RI to conduct a joint study with ministries/agencies and think tanks to calculate greenflation, namely inflation that occurs when green technology is applied. "Because now what we are campaigning for, for example, let's live with an awareness of being environmentally friendly," Andi Widjajanto said.

Regarding the strategic mineral potential in Indonesia, nickel is a strategic mineral commodity whose production continues to be encouraged. In fact, Indonesia has become a major nickel player at the global level. However, Andi Widjajanto said that nickel mining must be adjusted to downstream needs so that nickel can be managed for the next twenty-six or even twenty-seven years.

Also attending the event were PP Muhammadiyah chairman Dzulfikar A. Tawalla, PP Muhammadiyah Youth Forestry and Environment Chair Sandro Andriawan, and Chairperson of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) of PP Pemuda Muhammadiyah Dedi Irawan.

Managing Director of BPJS Kesehatan Discusses National Health Insurance



JAKARTA - Managing Director of BPJS Kesehatan (the Health Care and Social Security Agency) Prof. dr. Ghufron Mukti, M.Sc, Ph.D. had the opportunity to give a virtual lecture to participants of the Regular Education Program Batch 65 (PPRA 65) of Lemhannas RI on Friday (28/7). In his lecture, Ghufron Mukti presented material on the topic "Realizing Social Welfare through National Health Insurance".

In his presentation, Ghufron Mukti firmly underlined the importance of strengthening social security in realizing social justice. According to him, Social Justice will not be achieved if Indonesian people are not prosperous. This implies that social welfare and social security are two inseparable elements in building a just society.

"Health insurance is part of social welfare. We want health services to be faster, easier, and equal," Ghufron Mukti said.

To achieve its goal, Indonesia has stepped forward by implementing the National Health Insurance-Indonesian Health Card (JKN-KIS) program. This program is the main pillar in providing social protection to all Indonesians. Through JKN-KIS, every Indonesian citizen has equal access to quality health services, regardless of their social or economic status. Thus, this program does not only provide social welfare but also guarantees social security.

Ghufron Mukti stressed the importance of promotion and prevention in the BPJS Kesehatan program which must be strengthened to increase efficiency and effectiveness. He highlighted that BPJS Kesehatan has a crucial role in carrying out its responsibilities regarding each participant health. By prioritizing health promotion and disease prevention efforts, BPJS Kesehatan is able to reduce the burden of long-term care costs. This not only benefits participants, but also ensures the continued availability of funds for better health services.



Lemhannas RI Holds FGD on Settlement of Maritime Border Disputes Between Indonesia and Malaysia





JAKARTA - Lemhannas RI held a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) for an urgent and fast study (jurpat) with the title "Settlement of Maritime Boundary Disputes Between Indonesia and Malaysia" on Wednesday (2/8) in the Kresna Room, Astagatra Building, 4th Floor, Lemhannas RI.

The FGD is a strategic study that discusses the development of maritime boundary disputes between Indonesia and Malaysia. The development of the situation at the border needs to be studied carefully in order to guarantee the integrity and sovereignty of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia (NKRI). "This issue is a chronic issue for Indonesia and until now it has not been fully resolved," said Deputy Governor of Lemhannas RI Lt. Gen. Mohamad Sabrar Fadhilah. In the FGD facilitated by the Director of Defense and Security Studies and Geography, First Marshal Rolland D.G. Waha., is expected to be able to provide proper understanding and receive productive input to be used as study material by Lemhannas RI, whose output is in the form of input and suggestions for the Indonesian government.

Chancellor of the University of Jenderal Achmad Yani Prof. Hikmahanto Juwana, S.H., who had the opportunity to be a guest speaker, conveyed several things about the challenges of resolving the sea boundaries between Indonesia and Malaysia. Prof. Hikmahanto also suggested that the Indonesian government needs to educate stakeholders, especially the public, that in many countries there are still many boundaries with neighboring countries that have not been resolved or completed to this day.

Several other speakers were present at the FGD, namely the Director of Legal and Territorial Agreements of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia Andreano Erwin, Assistant for Operations, Surveys and Mapping of the Indonesian Navy's Hydro-Oceanographic Center (Pushidrosal) Commodore Dvan Primana Sobaruddin, M.Sc., Director of C BAIS TNI Brigadier General Mirza Patria; and Deputy Assistant for Delimitation of the Maritime Zone and Border Areas of the Coordinating Ministry for Maritime and Investment Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia.



National Seminar on Digital Transformation of Indonesia 2045

JAKARTA - Lemhannas RI held a National Seminar "Digital Transformation of Indonesia 2045" on Monday (7/8), at the Borobudur Hotel. The event was organized by the Deputy Office for Strategic Studies and opened directly by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Andi Widjajanto.

In his remarks, Andi Widjajanto conveyed three points, namely geotechnology, Indonesia's digital transformation, and the potential of the digital economy. Regarding geotechnology, the world condition, which is moving dynamically to build digital connectivity, is challenged by competitions of giant powers. Currently, semiconductor chip technology competition is the center of competition between the United States and China.

Andi Widjajanto also said that

Singapore, apart from having the Army, Navy and Air Forces, now has the Digital and Intelligence Service (DIS) to deal with the dynamics of cyberspace. The Singaporean government believes that in the next 4-5 years, there will be a technological leap that renders all efforts in cybersecurity useless.

The second point that Andi Widjajanto conveyed was Indonesia's digital literacy position globally. Based on a study conducted by Oxford Inside in 2022, Indonesia's position is in the middle.

Lemhannas RI also analyzed the digital indexes of 2019, 2021 and 2022, starting from the Digital Readiness Index, the Innovation Index, the National Cyber Security Index, and the National Economic Transformation Index. It can be seen that Indonesia's level is at 2 to 3 consistently. "We have to achieve the 4th and 5th level regarding AI readiness in 2045," Andi Widjajanto said.

The third point was the potential for the national digital economy. Andi Widjajanto believes that the potential is especially high and must be well utilized. The largest population of digital consumers in the Southeast Asia region in 2021 will be in Indonesia, which was at 39 percent.

Furthermore, Andi Widjajanto conveyed that Indonesia has a grand task, namely digital human resources. Lemhannas RI also in this case has the task to prepare a national digital architecture, starting from doctrine, regulations, policies, programs, budget allocations, human resources and technology.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Discusses Geo V in the XV PPI International Symposium



JAKARTA - The Governor of Lemhannas RI Andi Widjajanto acted as a speaker at the XV International Symposium of the 2023 World Indonesian Students Association (PPI) with the theme "A Nation Reimagined: The Role of Students in Supporting Indonesia in Global Competition and International Contribution" virtually on Tuesday (8/8).

The International Symposium which was held for the 15th time was a collaboration between PPI Dunia and PPI Netherlands. Bringing up critical issues of national concern, the symposium is a space to explore international dynamics that are close to the Indonesian student diaspora in various countries.

On this occasion, Andi Widjajanto explained the world's geopolitical conditions which are entering the era of connectivity as part of geopolitical evolution I to V. In the era of connectivity, there were several offers from major countries. China is offering the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), the United States (US) is offering the Indo Pacific Economic Framework, and Russia is offering the International North-South Transport Corridor (INSTC). Unfortunately, these offers divide the world into parts and fail to create global connectivity.

"Hopefully later, everyone who study at universities around the world can help us in Indonesia to find more real data about how these countries have certain interests," Andi Widjajanto said.

On the same occasion, Andi Widjajanto expressed his hopes on the participants who attended to continue growing to be experts in their respective fields so that they would become a driving force towards Golden Indonesia 2045.



JAKARTA - Lemhannas RI and the Center for Geopolitics & Geostrategy Studies Indonesia (CGSI) signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on Wednesday (9/8) at the Dwi Warna Purwa Building, Lemhannas RI. CGSI is a research institute founded by Prof. Dr. Ermaya Suradinata, S.H., M.H., M.Si who is the former Governor of Lemhannas RI.

In his remarks, Ermaya Suradinata stated that the signing of the MoU is a symbol of an acknowledgment of the establishment of an independent state institution that is hoped to be able to synergize with Lemhannas RI.
